<p>1. In a search conducted at Fairfield, Ohio, on 24 April 1952, an unusual air object was discovered. It was a small, dark, cylindrical object, approximately 1/2 inch in diameter and 1/4 inch long. It was found in a field near the town of Fairfield, Ohio.</p>			
<p>2. The object was found by a civilian resident of Fairfield, Ohio, who reported it to the local police. It was then turned over to the 57th Air Division for investigation.</p>			
<p>3. The object was examined by the 57th Air Division and was found to be a piece of metal. It was identified as a piece of a spent shell casing.</p>			
<p>4. The object was found in a field near the town of Fairfield, Ohio, which is a known area for the firing of shells. It is believed that the object was a piece of a shell casing that had been fired from a shell.</p>			
<p>5. The object was found on 24 April 1952, at Fairfield, Ohio.</p>
