1. Date object was observed 4-16-52 30
2. Time object was first seen 11:04 PM Pass. Mar
3. Place from which you observed the object 127 Main St. Vallejo, Cal.
4. How was object observed (naked eye, binoculars, etc.) Naked eye
5. What were you doing when the object was first observed? Watching the skies
6. What attracted your attention to the object? Above (5)
7. Path of object.
- a. Direction from which object appeared (degrees or direction) Near the star Regulus
- b. Direction in which object disappeared (degrees or direction) Near the stars Castor + Pollux
- c. Elevation object appeared (degrees above horizon) Consult night sky map for that date + hour & place
- d. Elevation object disappeared (degrees above horizon) Above (7c)
- e. Shape of flight path of object (straight and level, arched, etc.) Straight
- f. How did object disappear (grow dimmer, go out suddenly, etc.) Became dimmer gradually, then suddenly went out
8. Length of time the object was observed 10 seconds

- b. Apparent size of object? About 5 diameters of Jupiter
