<p>On 29 April 1952, at 0830 hours the following report was submitted to the undersigned by the Officer of the Day relative to sightings of unconventional aircraft on 27 April 1952:</p> <p>Mr. James Baker, 601 Hilldale, Royal Oak, Michigan, phone Lincoln 2-0331, talked to the undersigned concerning flying saucer he saw at approximately 1100 hours, 27 April 1952. He said he saw a small white object very high in the sky. It looked like a paper plate. As he watched it, it turned sideways. It seemed to be stationary. Mr. Baker reported he went into the house to get his binoculars and when he came out, it was gone.
