The sighting of an unidentified flying object was reported to the Director of Intelligence, 90th Bombardment Wing M, Forbes Air Force Base, Topeka, Kansas, on 3 May 1952 by Mr. Delmar G. Fox, Special Agent, OSI. Coordinated investigation disclosed the sighting at Topeka, Kansas, of an alleged unconventional aircraft at approximately 2000 hours, 29 April 1952, reported by Mrs. Sarah Wilson, a resident of 618 Oakley Street, Topeka. Object described as oval in shape, pale pink in color, and traveling at great speed. Investigation failed to reveal presence of any conventional aircraft or weather balloons in vicinity at time of sighting. No celestial phenomenon noted which would account for incident; however, spotlights used by local drive-in theaters reflecting against overcast sky could have produced effect similar to the one reported.
