Dear Jim,

The information you requested several weeks ago concerning a UFO report submitted to me, as reporting officer, to USAF Project Blue Book, follows:

The intervening years and a very mediocre memory do, of course, preclude my recalling the exact date, report date such as time, atmospheric conditions, flight altitude (which would have been about 2000 to 3000 feet), names of observers, etc., etc. I will, however, relate the incident to you to the best of my recollection.

This observation occurred in the hours just before noon in the early months of 1955. (The 1st, April, May or June.)

While standing on the front entrance steps of the (Cavalry) Nathan 4th Force Base Hospital, I observed the approach of two UFOs upon a B-26 flying on a general east-west heading directly over the base. The two spacecrafts it seemed to glow white and were indistinguishable in color. (The same color as the B-26.) The objects approached the aircraft from the north-west and passed about three or four times that of the aircraft.

The two objects appeared to be about the same size when first observed. The object appeared to pass altitude as it approached the aircraft because it seemed to glow smaller. It stationed itself, at the 7-10 speed, just behind and to the left side of the B-26. The other object approached the aircraft at the altitude of the B-26 and stationed itself between the propeller-type propellers and the leading edge of the starboard elevator. The air crew, which included the aircraft at 10,000, and were interrogated by me, confirmed the ground observer's stationing of this object in the extremely close proximity to the aircraft.

I can no longer remember the length of time of the observation but all of the air crew members, except one who flew the aircraft out of the airport incident, were able to see the air phase observation but to see the UFO.

The objects were reported to be symmetrically shaped top and bottom, about two or three feet thick from top to bottom at the widest and with sharp, as the sides. (The area with an approximate figure in inches at this point cannot remember.) The object was reported by the crew, a will remember, to be about twenty or twenty-five feet in diameter. (It is rather roughly between airplane and elevator.)

One of the air crew members reported seeing a pale ball of red color about 100 feet away between the two and the edge of the object. (I cannot see this color and, however,
