6. PATTERSON related details of the sighting in a clear, straightforward manner. In the opinion of Colonel MILLER and the writer PATTERSON appeared to be a reliable witness.

6. MOORE appeared to have difficulty in expressing his description of the object, and seemed hesitant about doing so. The writer believes that MOORE did in fact observe the object, but does not believe MOORE's description of the object to be as accurate as that given by PATTERSON and SCALAMERA.
