1. Observers estimated approximately a total of ten (10) objects were present, although only six or two were visible at any one time. They appeared to be very small cylindrical shaped objects of a bright metallic color such as polished aluminum. One object would suddenly become visible, apparently followed by a trail of some type, and then disappear into the clouds. Searches show these objects traveled at a considerably greater speed than jet aircraft and were definitely not birds or balloons. These objects were observed for approximately five or ten minutes upon which time they vanished, re-appearing five minutes later in the same vicinity for approximately one minute.

2. Observation was made at approximately 1215 Central Standard Time 7 May 1958.

3. Visual ground identification was made.

4. Observed from the Tyndall AFB site, located twelve (12) miles from the southeast end of the northeast-southwest runway (approximately 200°-220° at bearing line where road). The objects were at an approximate altitude bearing of 30° from the observers. In terms of size objects were indistinct but they appeared to be approximately the same elevation as the base of the cloud layer.
