APPENDIX II

Rio de Janeiro, Brazil - 7 May 1957

I. SUBJECT'S INCIDENT

On 7 May 1957, two photographers of "O Cruzeiro" Magazine in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, reported that they had photographed a "flying disc" at a position 23° 28' S, 47° 25' W. The object reportedly was in view one minute before which five photographs were taken.

It approached from the southeast, made a 180° turn and went out of sight toward the sea at what was described as high speed. Its color was white and it seemed to be over 1000 meters in diameter. It was later the size of a disc.

II. STATUS OF NEGATIVES

The photographers reportedly were asking \$25,000 for the five negatives; consequently, the negatives are not available for study.

III. CONCLUSIONS

Until the negatives are analyzed, it is impossible to draw any definite conclusions. It is doubtful that the pictures and story are authentic.
