1. Reference is made to CG AFM, G-1 282, dated 12 April 1952.

2. This report pertains to the observation of an unusual aerial phenomenon by five persons at Fort Justice, Virginia, at approximately 2130 hours on 17 April 1952.

3. On 17 April 1952 Lt. Colonel [REDACTED], USAF, 1st Lt. [REDACTED], USAF, 1st Lt. [REDACTED], USAF, and 1st Lt. [REDACTED], USAF, reported to this office that at approximately 2130 hours on 17 April 1952, five (5) persons at Fort Justice, Virginia, had observed a luminous object, elliptical or spherical in shape and approximately 45 feet in diameter, moving northeast to northeast in a straight line, and that the object appeared to be composed of two (2) segments.

4. On 18 April 1952, Lt. Colonel [REDACTED], USAF, 1st Lt. [REDACTED], USAF, was interviewed and gave in substance the following information concerning the reports of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] that they had been watching a baseball game at the Fort Justice ball park for approximately two (2) hours when they observed the unusual phenomenon in the sky, leaving the ball park. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] proceeded to the parking lot, located to the rear of the park, to meet [REDACTED] and his wife, while conversing with Sgt. [REDACTED], [REDACTED] was facing northeast, observed a luminous object in the sky approximately
