REPORT OF SIGHTING

1. A/30 Gene C. Brandmont, AF 3776607, made the following statement concerning a possible unidentified object observed by him on 9 May 1970:

1. The object that I observed appeared to be of a ball shape, like that of a ball of steel. It seemed to be shaped like an arrowhead, its size was difficult to determine because of the high altitude. There were no distinctive features. If it was the approximate size of any known aircraft, it would have to have been about 30,000 to 25,000 feet high. I could not recall from my object. The object flew upward and level and disappeared over the horizon to the south.

2. I saw the object at 1740 hours on the date indicated. It was in the sky for about 10 minutes.

3. Observing this type object is common over the ground.

4. I was on the east side of George Air Force Base when I sighted the object. It was vertically oriented and proceeded south at 30,000 to 25,000 feet altitude.

5. I was not in a position to make any tracking observation in civilian flying.

6. Visibility was good, skies were clear and there was little wind in the area.

7. There were no special conditions, meteorological or otherwise, which might account for the sighting.

8. There was no physical evidence, photographs, sketches, etc., of the sighting.

9. No identification or interview has occurred since taken.
