

Statement of Observer

1. A/C Milton A. Waller, AF420004, No. 4 No. 14041 Air Base Group Base Flight, George AFB, California, in his date above the following statement concerning observation on 13 May 1957 of an unidentified flying object.

2. The object was about 100 miles and appeared to be very far away. The color was whitish but not bright like a reflector as at the time. There was only one and there was no trail as it passed in and still in the air. At one time the object seemed to turn on its side and become thinner for about 30 seconds. I was looking at the object and it was almost directly overhead when it disappeared. The object disappeared very fast, almost like a light being turned off. It must have gone straight up.

3. Time elapsed 1205 to 1255 13 May 57.  
Time observed - 30 minutes.

4. Visual observation from the air. Speed 150 mph. Altitude 11,000. Type of aircraft - B-29.

5. I was sitting in the rear seat of the aircraft north of George AFB about 10 or 15 miles. The object was almost above me but a little north of me. The aircraft I was in flew east to west and west to east, back and forth. The distance of the object was at least 10,000 feet above me. It appeared to be above a B-29 in the area and that aircraft had vapor trails from it.

6. I am 33 years old and have completed two years of college. I worked for 13 months at Hughes Aircraft, Torrance, California, the latter six months in the flight test department as a field attendant. I have completed a six month aircraft and engine mechanic's course at Shepherd Field, Texas, in April of this year. I have flown in aircraft since I was 18 years old and never witnessed anything similar.

7. The weather was very clear - no clouds and a slight haze below me.

8. The object might have been from George Air Force Base.

9. None.

10. As high as we could in our aircraft.
