SUBJECT: Intelligence Spot Report

1. This office is reporting that some individuals of this installation, on 17 April 1952, at 1505 or 1510 hours, spotted some unfamiliar flying object while on a hike along the Colorado River, three (3) miles south of Yuma Test Station.
2. This object appeared to be flat-white, with no sheen, circular in shape, flying in a 60 degree azimuth direction.
3. Inclosed is a written statement of Lt. Bernard J. Gudenkauf, who was the leader of the group.
