Statement of Observer

1. A/SG Karl Allen Christian, AF 002 4000, Headquarters Research, 14067 Air Force Group, do this date make the following statement concerning a certain unidentified object observed by me on 20 May 1967:

1. The object that I sighted appeared to be oval in shape when viewed from an overhead position; otherwise, round. Its color was a bright white, with a black line at times. No exhaust or vapor trail was apparent to me. It hovered in one spot and then, as it slowly "peeled off" or turned, it displayed a reddish brown color (which may have been the color of the other side of the object and not of the propellant). It disappeared slowly.

2. I sighted the object at approximately 1405 hours.

3. I sighted the object visually from the ground. The height of the object was very great. It appeared to be only a little bigger than a pin point. No optical aids were used in the sighting.

4. I sighted the object while on the flight line at George Air Force Base, California. The object was northwest of me at approximately a 1 o'clock position.
