The following information was extracted from the last monthly intelligence report #1 dated 10 May 1952 prepared by the NATO Liaison Officer, 1503rd Air Detachment, Atlantic Division, WFO, Rangoon, Ceylon.

At approximately 2000 hours on 10 May, in the city of Rangoon, Ceylon, a group of persons including a noted British Scientist sighted an unidentified object which appeared to rise sharply from the level of the sea and disappeared into the sky. The object appeared to the observers to be of a circular shape and emitted a luminous light. It appeared to move back and forth for a brief interval before fading out of sight directly overhead. At the time of the incident the sky was clear and there was no air traffic in the vicinity of Ceylon.
