SUBJECT: Reporting of information on Unconventional Aircraft					
In accordance with AFI 310-1, dated 15 April 1951, subject as above, the following report of unconventional aircraft is submitted:					
On the 10th of May 1954 at approximately 2200 HRS, two unconventional airborne objects were observed by Colonel and Mrs. Maurice H. Stewart from their residence at 3207 Marjorie Avenue, Albuquerque, New Mexico. The first object was not as high as the second; however, both were similar in that objects were silent, disc shaped and made no sound. Both objects were first sighted by the observer and disappeared in the northwest. There was no visible wake or contrail. Due to altitude exact could not be ascertained.					
The objects were observed from 1500 to 2000 feet. No photographs were taken.					
The information is completely reliable and Colonel Stewart is a member of the 34th Air Division Operations Division Air Force Base, New Mexico.
