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In the month of May, 1952, I, [redacted], 1927 Eastern Avenue, New Haven, Connecticut, do hereby make the following statement:

On the 10th of May, 1952, at about 1500 hours, I was in my front yard watching two jet type airplanes flying over Stratford Air Force Base. Suddenly, I noticed an object in the sky above the air-base. I called my husband who was in the house at that time. He came out, as I saw something that did not look like my airplane that I had over a city. The object was southeast of Stratford Air Force Base, at an altitude above 30,000 feet. It had no tail and seemed to be circular shaped. It was silver in color and the size was about the size of a 5-50 at 2,000 feet. The object appeared at times to flash and move. My husband and I watched this object for five (5) or ten (10) minutes.

About ten (10) or fifteen (15) minutes later, another object appeared in the southeast. This object looked similar to the first object. It was much higher than the first. As soon as my husband saw this second object, he called the Commander of the 15th Aircraft Group and James Bradford, Stratford Air Force Base. The Colonel however, the officer on duty reported that the object did not appear on his radar. This second object disappeared in about ten (10) minutes in the northeasterly direction.
