Seattle, Washington - 11 May 1952

I. DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT

At approximately 0124 to 0132 PST, on 11 May 1952 many individuals reported sighting a white like object with flaming sparks or streamers coming nearly straight down over Seattle, Washington. The object concluded in a brilliant flash, lighting up the sky and then disappeared. After the explosion, some of the witnesses experienced a tremor or shock wave of approximately nine seconds duration.

II. STATUS OF THE INVESTIGATION

The local astronomers were contacted and they stated that the object was a meteor. At the present time the astronomers are searching for fragments to confirm their statement.

III. CONCLUSIONS

Object was probably a meteor but file will not be closed until confirming evidence is found.
