1. Interrogation of Miles L. Heck, Deputy Sheriff, Miland, California.

Q.... What time and date did you observe "object" ?
 A.... 04-42 A M 23 May 52.

Q. Where?
 A. Miland.

Q. What was the actual sighting from where you viewed?
 A. Southwest area over Cade Springs.

Q. What was your line of sight?
 A. Low, distant, approximately 3,000 feet.

Q. Exactly what shape did the object appear to have or resemble?
 A. Only as a bright light, it moved, oscillated.

Q. Would you say it may have been a Para-Flare?
 A. No, it would have put them over.

Q. What color was this light?
 A. White light, like an electric bulb.

Q. Did anyone beside yourself see it?

 A. None, other than the report by the El Centro Desk hereafter.
