<p>Q. What was your line of sight?</p> <p>A. About a 60° angle.</p> <p>Q. What was the appearance of the light?</p> <p>A. It was yellowish white, like a flare. A soft light.</p> <p>Q. But they were definitely in formation?</p> <p>A. Yes they were.</p> <p>Q. Chording one behind the other?</p> <p>A. Yes, definitely.</p> <p>Q. Were these lights ever doused or turned off?</p> <p>A. <p>4. Interrogation of S/Sgt Mayles, Tower Operating Room, Municipal Airport, San Antonio, at 1135 hours, 20 May 1952.</p> <p>Upon being interrogated, S/Sgt Mayles stated that he had observed the same phenomenon on several occasions following the first sighting on 13 May 52. It always occurred at a position approximately 300° from the control tower, and at a distance which is estimated as being approximately 10 to 15 miles. Consequently, he was convinced that the "object" was caused by the reflection of headlights on the highway at night at that position. This was confirmed by S/Sgt Purter, Tower Chief. Subject airmen were advised to continue observation, and inform this headquarters of activities observed.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">EVALUATION OF ABOVE <u>B-3</u></p>		
<p>5. Interrogation of Mr. Jensen, CAA, El Centro Municipal Airport, El Centro, California, at 0935 hours, 21 May 1952.</p> <p>The CAA office, El Centro Municipal Airport, was visited in an attempt to contact Mr. Layton, CAA, who had been on duty on 13 May 52 at the time the object was sighted. Mr. Layton was not there. However, Mr. Jensen furnished the report filed by Layton on the incident. This report substantiated the information in the original report received this headquarters, and the report on file in the El Centro, California Sheriff's Office (See "B").
