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DETAILS:AT TUSA AIR FORCE BASE, ARIZONA

1. On 26 July 1950, Captain STEPHEN E. HENRICH, 475th Air Base Squadron, Tusa Air Force Base, Arizona, was interviewed by the undersigned. Captain HENRICH is also Wing Intelligence Officer and in conjunction with his duties as concern unidentified objects, stated that he had received no report as of 26 July 1950, relative to sighting of unidentified objects on 13 May 1950, pertaining to subject matter.

2. On 26 July 1950, 1st Sgt CHARLES H. HENRICH, 475th Air Base Squadron, 1903rd Detachment, 1900th AACS Squadron, Tusa Air Force Base, reviewed the tower log which revealed the following information:

"13 May 1950 - At 0200 HRT 21 Centro reported seeing fast moving object. Radio called to have we get a 'look-see' but never spotted anything.

0410 - Detected object at 3000 FEET; notified radio. Later check - it appeared to be lights from cars going down highway east beyond Pilot's Knob, which is in a northeasterly direction from the tower.

0600 - Fast moving object reported near Jackson Dam."

HENRICH stated the last report probably came over direct line from Flight Service Center, March Air Force Base, California.

3. HENRICH stated that 1st Sgt JOSEPH J. HAYLEN, AFM442920, was the tower operator on duty and made the one-identified statement. Further, HAYLEN departed Tusa Air Force Base on the morning of 28 July 1950 on furlough status. His residence is at land Apts. #2, Hightstown, California. HAYLEN indicated that he claimed no visiting relatives at 164 Grant Avenue, Ogden, Utah.
