<p>On May 11, 1952, between 1900 - 1930 hrs G, two spherical flying objects were observed off the coast of Mayaguez, Puerto Rico by civilians. The objects sighted were bright orange in color and appeared to waver when observed with field glasses. The attached report is the result of an investigation made by intelligence personnel of this wing.</p> <p>From the evidence received it was not possible to determine whether or not this incident has any significance in the current "flying saucer" investigation.</p>
