



EDITORIAL

"AN EDITORIAL STOCKTAKING. "

" OLD PATHS AND NEW HORIZONS"

This begins our fifth year of publication of the magazine and the sixth year of our work as a society . and looking back over the past years. what a vista of enlightenment . and experiences it has been.

The Society itself began in 1953, first as a small local group interested in the subject, then a little later joining up with Edgar Jarrold as a state branch of the Aust. F.S. Bureau.

The very sudden and rather mysterious folding up of that society under his leadership caused us to have to reorganise our programme and the Society now known as the A.F.S.R.S. came into being.

It was found necessary to produce our own magazine, hence the journal before you.

The Society President at the request of the few remaining members of the now extinct Bureau journeyed to NSW. to help them reorganise. and from this and two further visits a healthy Branch of the A.F.S.R.S was formed. and flourished for over twelve months. and many deep and lasting mutual friendships were formed.

Regretably however certain of the N.S.W. leaders strongly objected to the National Presidents open insistence that ALL avenues of thought must be investigated in the quest of the F.S. knowledge including the RELIGIOUS one. and because of this , suddenly without notice and warning , due to that influence, the society was informed that the N.S.W. Branch had decided to make a complete break. without any attempt of discussion of possible mutual understanding. and form a society known as the U.F.O. Investigation Centre of N.S.W.

This set back however did not cause us to disintegrate as was expected. or cease from our activity , instead we continued to

prosper and the magazine grew, despite many set backs and seeming insurmountable difficulties financially and in production, and opposition. We thank our readers for their sympathetic understanding in those difficult days, the encouraging words amidst a few sneers from a few who were once our friends who now strangely became antagonistic and belittled our struggling efforts.

Determined to ignore such and aid any who sort our aid, visits were made to Melbourne where a flourishing Branch of the Socy. was formed which later became the Victorian F.S. Rsch. Socy.

Queensland then availed itself of the Presidents aid, and the Queensland F.S. Rsch Bureau, as a sister society benefited from his visit by the public interest aroused and its ranks became consolidated, and strengthened as a result.

The following Year Perth in West. Aust. the smallest Socy. of all, sent a call for help and again we answered it and visited them, and helped them gain a clearer picture of what the open minded approach meant.

The result was a new Society with Mr Locke as Secretary was formed and began its work with Mrs. B. Perkins conducting another group.

From all these visits knowledge was not only imparted but gained to enlarge the already attained vision. Friendships of mutual understanding were formed which have lasted despite differences of opinion, and looking in retrospect to these years and visits we are indeed happy to have been so used in some small way to make such alliances and extend mutual help, to enable the work of the F.S. cause grow in Australia.

Meanwhile the International F.S. family continued to grow and we found ourselves adding to an already large overseas contact list of seekers, country after country being added to our list and exchanges of magazines and correspondence in many languages, which required interpreters to our staff.

All the while the magazine has contended for its principles and on every hand we have received encouragement and help with many congratulations for the matter printed in our pages, and here we thank our readers for such.

So much for thoughts in retrospect, What of the Future? What field of Investigation will prove the greatest to reveal what lies behind this great riddle of this age. ?/ Will there be more factual sightings, and more landings? Will the Psychic and the factual workers grow further apart, or be drawn closer together? Will the contact visits be more often accompanied by greater proof?

All these things crowd ones mind as we endeavor to peer into the future, but one thing is certain UNITY above all is vitally necessary if we are to achieve any real success, a unity that whilst not always in agreement with the other fellows opinion will allow him to have his view point yet work together for one common end in unravelling the Mystery of the Flying Saucers, and their purpose in visiting the earth at this time. THE DAWN OF A NEW AGE

The tremendous strides which science has made, in recent times have culminated in releasing nuclear energy and sending up artificial moons to circle around the earth. These achievements inspire hope that within measurable time space stations may be established and interplanetary communication may become a possibility, and ultimately the dream of exploring the cosmos may be realised.

The credit for these achievements goes to the combined efforts and technical skill of a number of scientists, who, liberally encouraged and helped by their governments, made their individual contributions at different stages and thus heralded the age of nuclear energy. But this is only a prelude to a more marvellous age of space travel.

On two engrossing problems depends the fate of the world and the future of mankind. However gratifying the progress made in the realm of science may have been, it has now brought the world to the brink of utter ruin if a single false step is taken. The mounting tension among the Great Powers, armed with nuclear weapons, may at any time result in a global war the consequences of which are too appalling to imagine. The face of the earth would be distorted out of shape; the human race would be wiped away, and the survivors, if any, would be reduced to the most primitive conditions of living, civilization and science becoming things of the past.

To avert such a dire calamity and colossal devastation is the most important function of the United Nations Organisation. It has to strive successfully for the universal acceptance of the ideal of ONE world; otherwise one spark will carry man to his inevitable doom.

The other problem equally fraught with the gravest consequences is of interplanetary communication, of space ships and flying saucers, and man's dream of space conquest. The UNO must address itself to this problem also on a worldwide basis, so that the conquest of space by one country may not become a menace or source of terror to the other countries. And for this it is necessary that the UNO should exercise control over the development of the elemental atomic energy and its uses for humanity. This will not only ensure its use only for beneficial purposes but help in its speedy development by the joint and co-

operative effort of the world scientists under the auspices of the UNO.

It is too late in the day now to deny the existence of FLYING OBJECTS FROM OUTER SPACE. Attempts to explain them away have, to say the least, proved simply puerile. Innumerable sightings by hundreds of observers the world over, and their authentic evidence are so overwhelming that even the mighty governments can no more mislead the people or conceal the obvious facts. Political reasons may have some justification for avoiding panic among the people but the frequency with which the unidentified foreign objects have been appearing leave no room for doubt in the minds of reasonable persons that the denizens of other planets have already achieved what our scientists are only striving for and in which they are still in the initial stages.

There is no remedy for the attitude of cynical scepticism. Those who are determined to shut their eyes to the obvious can never be convinced. In the highest quarters the reality of these objects and their spatial origin is admitted. There is now abundance of literature on the subject, press reports and current journals, the perusal of which will convince any inquirer who cares to know the truth. The massed evidence of the flying saucers and space ships has been supported by photographs and the testimony of observers whose veracity cannot be doubted.

For ages man believed that the earth was the centre of the universe and that he was at the top of the created beings. Entertaining such notions about his own superiority and his domain it is naturally difficult for him to admit readily a lower position for himself and for the earth in the solar system. Now he has to realise the fact that he is not the kind of the universe. He did not believe that the planets or stars had any living beings. The scientist also, till the other day, proclaimed that the moon and Mars could not sustain life as known upon the earth. It is no easy matter to dislodge such beliefs held since the dawn of civilization. Any references to space flights and communication with the planets in ancient lore have always been treated as figments of imagination. Man will have to give up his unscientific notions and sacrifice his ego when accepting the latest discoveries made by the scientist and the astronomer. In the Middle Ages the defiance of the prevailing faith and challenge to superstition meant torture and death, but in the present age of science one can smother truth and refuse to accept an established fact with impunity. At least it has been the case with the flying saucers, the truth about which has been deliberately suppressed by governments and very high officials. There is ample evidence to show that there is a conspiracy of silence in the United States Government and crude attempts are made to conceal true facts from the public.

From the innumerable observations recorded by laymen, scientists and astronomers, some important features of space ships and flying saucers have been definitely laid down. In shape and form they are entirely different from all man-made flying machines. Space ships are of a very big size and contain in them smaller flying saucers - say half a dozen. The mother ship can stay in the sky steady and motionless, while the saucers come down near to upon the earth, to rise again and to be taken in by the mother ship. Almost always they are silent though at times attaining the tremendous speed of 25,000 miles per hour in our atmosphere, and yet remaining unharmed by the friction. In the outer space above the atmosphere they may possibly attain the speed of light - 1,86,000 miles per second. They are undoubtedly controlled by intelligent beings who have achieved mechanical perfection for their craft yet unknown to man. Not only is the suppression of sound vibrations made possible, but they are converted into light vibrations of different colours. The Tibetan Yogis are said to know the secret of converting sound into light which they use when required in their dark caves. The motive power of the space ships is not the same as that used by man-made craft. It is probable that they use electro-magnetic power or the inexhaustible energy of the cosmic rays. No man can survive at the tremendous speed of these weird machines, especially when they take sudden and sharp turns maintaining uniform speed. It seems that the intelligent operators of the space ships command unlimited power and know how to convert atomic energy directly into electricity and have discovered the secret of freedom from gravitational attraction.

All these features conclusively prove that the luminous flying saucers cruising at fantastic speeds come from the outer space and are piloted by beings of superior intelligence who have acquired mastery over the forces of nature yet unknown to man. From this it naturally follows that some of the planets are inhabited by thinking, intelligent beings more advanced than man. There is every probability that there are distant worlds inhabited by beings whose knowledge and attainments are beyond our wildest dreams.

Not only do the flying saucers prove that some of the planets are inhabited, but independent testimony of some astronomers supports this fact. After making thousands of observations, and after mapping about 700 canals, Lowell, a distinguished astronomer, announced: "Mars is inhabited. We have absolute proof." Changes on its surface have been noticed which indicate that they are artificial and made by intelligent beings. Like our earth, other planets can also evolve life if conditions are congenial. And if life is evolved, later mind must also evolve. Different atmospheres

and other varying factors may evolve forms and features of beings DIFFERENT FROM THOSE OF MEN.

Astronomers have been keenly watching mysterious activities on the surface of the moon. Scientists tell us that there is no atmosphere there, and consequently no life can exist there. Extremes of temperature, too, cannot allow any living creature to survive. But these surmises are based upon the conditions required by man for his existence. There may be life there of some kind to which the physical conditions are congenial. In recent times dome-like structures and a big bridge have appeared on the surface. So there may be a moon race or a base may have been formed there by the inhabitants of Mars or some other planet. If Russians claim to reach the moon within twenty years, the more advanced denizens of some planets may be already there by their superior scientific knowledge.

Flying saucers have not only appeared in our skies but landed too. George Adamski has had the unique good fortune of not only photographing a flying saucer but also meeting an occupant of it who came from Venus and seeing the inside of a space ship. Relating his extraordinary experience, he and his companions swore an affidavit before a notary public. His books "Flying Saucers have Landed" and "Inside the Space Ships" are convincing and are of absorbing interest. Inhabitants of Saturn, Venus and Mars have been reported to have landed and safely returned to their respective planets.

The question is: Why do they come? We do not know and speculate that they come on pleasure trips with a feeling of triumph on their achievements. They are friendly and desire contact with us. They warn us that the nuclear explosions here are fraught with tragic possibilities not only to our earth but also to the entire solar system. If our world is destroyed, the rhythmic movements of the solar system are bound to be affected. They desire to help us in our effort to conquer space and give us the advantage of their superior knowledge, and draw us closer to them. At present there is only one-way traffic; with their help it can become a two-way one. The visitors from outer space are not hostile; this is proved by the fact that they have done nothing wrong to anybody. Two tragic accidents are said to have happened. In the one case an aeroplane pursued a flying saucer and went dangerously near it and was destroyed on account of its close proximity by some ray or emanation from the saucer. But it was not an intentional hostile act. In the other case the pursuers were perhaps kidnapped by the occupants of the flying saucer and safely carried to some other planet. There was absolutely no trade of the pursuing aeroplane or its remnants.

Care has to be taken that no flying saucer is fired on, lest it should provoke retaliation. It seems that the

visitors are afraid that men here may damage their machines. making their return flight impossible or capture the visitors and ill-treat them. It is conceivable that mass landings will take place when peace prevails on earth and there is no danger of a global war.

Thus we see that the UNO has a double role to play firstly, to establish peace here and eliminate the fear of war, and secondly, to organise world opinion for a friendly attitude towards the visitors from outer space and ensure their safety.

It may safely be predicted that the visitors, if properly welcomed and treated with due consideration, may show us the way to peace and prosperity never known before, and usher us into a Golden Age in which the conquest of space will become a reality.

NORTH QUEENSLAND NEWS.


A BLOOD RED MOON WITH GREEN HALO?


A New Zealand Report from D.W.G. Saunders

What must have been one of the strangest manifestations of a U.F.O. took place here in Auckland New Zealand about eight months ago, and through the courtesy of Mr. Fred K. Stone, I am able to recount the strange incident to the readers of the "Australian Saucer Record."

It was about 8.30 in the evening and my wife was washing the dishes after the evening meal. I was sitting at the kitchen table answering overseas correspondence when my wife called to me "Come and look at the moon, it looks funny."

I pricked up my ears at this, as there was no moon at this time. However, I went to the window and was what looked like the moon in its first quarter, but with both horns pointing downward like this  It was blood red colour, fairly

low in the western sky. The night was very calm and clear as I continued to observe an uncanny phenomenon occurred. The crescent began to slowly raise its horns until it appeared like this,  still retaining its blood red colour. It then

began to move slowly westward toward the Waitakere ranges upon passing over the ranges it broke up into a formation like this  still glowing red then sank from sight beneath the mountains.

The whole incident took about a quarter of an hour and disturbed my wife. She was very nervous for the remainder of the night. The following evening a very brilliant aura was seen in the western sky, and though the sighting was seen by many people and reported to me, the press made no statement.

Recently a strange greenish hued halo has been observed round the moon, and since I noticed it about three weeks ago many people have reported it to me, and asked for an explanation.

I have ventured to express my belief that it is some kind of magnetic force field of artificial creation no doubt set up to ward off earth missiles. Strangely enough the enquirers have been inclined to agree with me.

There seems to be a growing conviction among New Zealanders that some alien intelligence has established a base on Lunar

and that they are not over anxious for earthmen to reach them hence the force field.

It does seem odd that despite many attempts by the U.S.A. and the Soviets to fire a successful moon ~~that~~ something always seems to cause the missiles to miss their orbit, explode, or go out of control. Such incidences have become so frequent that one can not regard them as accidental so one has as an alternative the suggestion that an alien intelligence has indicated that man in his present development is not yet fit to meet people of other worlds.

Oh what a storm of protest may greet these remarks from astronomers, and other sceptics of the U.F.O. but such protests are based on fear, fear that truth will prevail in the end.

Flying Saucer Echo of the 'Joyita' Mystery.

The strange case of the cabin cruiser "The Joyita" like a few others has caused many aguess as to its fate, and more the unusual facts surrounding its disappearance has led to many odd theories as to the cause.

We have been presented with some facts which we publish now in the light of pure interest and consideration. which has brought to light due to an announcement made over the N.B.S. of a report recieved in New Zealand of a bottle washed up on the coast with anote inside purporting to have been written by a member of the crew.

NOTE IN BOTTLE ECHO OF JOYITA MYSTERY

An Australian wine bottle conataing a note purporting to have come from the ill fated cabin cruiser Joyita was picked up on Whiritoa Beach, eight miles north of Waihi, on Thurs. afternoon. It was heavily encrusted with barnacles.

The finders Two men and a woman, believe the note to be a hoax.

It read " Abandoning ship, Strange circular metallic object forcing us aboard it. Help us. Stewart. Joyita."

A small diagram of a flying saucer was also included. None of the European members of the crew nor any passengers was named Stewart.

The Joyita was reported overdue at Apia on Oct. 7th 1955 and the wreccage was found a month later.

According to Mr. A.W.B. Powell, conchologist at the Auckland War Memorial Museum, the size of the barnacles showed that the bottle had been in the sea for at least two years. Some of them were fully grown. "

The above has certain facts which are certainly interesting some of which could help to prove if the thing was a complete hoax. for instance the drift of the ocean which carried the bottle which one cannot deny its length of time in the water, further a complete and thorough investigation as to whether there was anyone at all aboard which such a name Christian or surname or nickname. for it must be remembered that the report above says " None of the European members" this does not mention any other nantionality. possibly of the crew who may have had such a name many natives have English names.

Now to add to the above intriguing facts we have been able to dig up from the files of our worthy friend and co-worker Dan Saunders of New Zealand. the following rather co-relative details which he has made available to us.

Dan is well known for his many telepathic messages which he has consistantly claimed he has recieved from the space brothers. and certainly at times at least they have been proved to be

this is not the first occasion in which very interesting news has been broadcast on the National News Session never to be repeated again or published in the papers. and even if it did reach the printed page it has been squeezed into some remote small corner where it would scarcely be seen.

We quote as an instance the huge earthquake in China last year. of gigantic proportions. , something surely of world interest . and many more such could be cited. and whilst the bottle incident could not be classed as of great interest. or the facts as indisputable as the China Earthquake. it is the rather strange pattern so often now re-occurring of news which gets "squashed" from the public. and even from those who are prepared to investigate personally such , the deliberate withholding of items of interest. cannot but cause one to feel that there is a purpose behind it all. and that it is some form of official censorship. for if the whole thing was a complete hoax. then would it not be more suited to their case to build it up in a good cynical article of exposure..

The very fact of the suppression of the news can mean one thing only . it is evidently desired that NOT TOO MUCH ENQUIRY will be made. for the public may find out something which they are not wanted to know.

It is possible that the above Joyita case is such another one that officialdom is not too anxious to release the whole facts about.

Here in Australia we have another case before our notice of a ship which cannot be found. and whose disappearance is surrounded with mystery and intrigue. we quote the "Ian Crouch" and we await further details of this. so far enquiries are still being made. but such have reached no suitable explanation of the case.

It is certain that it would be foolish to connect all disappearing ships with the Flying Saucer subject. and we certainly do not desire to convey that impression , but when certain incidents follow a pattern then it at least calls for some enquiry as to the possibility of there being some connection.

We hope our readers will find the above of interest. and will welcome any theories or clear cut exposures of any flaws in the above case.

EARTH HAS NO OXYGEN ACCORDING TO SPUTNIK.

very often prophetically "on the beam" and even if some of his critics find it hard to believe the origin of his messages at least it cannot be denied that they "have come true" on quite a few occasions.

Here then is one he received some considerable time after the loss of the Joyita it being received 12/1/56/ when he says he had no knowledge of the Joyita or its fate.

We present it in an abridged form for lack of space " A major mystery which is baffling the investigators of Shan is the disappearance of the passengers and crew of the sea vessel Joyita without trace . they are safely in our care, and are well and happy and will be returned to Shan when they so desire , if on the other hand they choose to remain with us. they are at liberty to do so. "

In a later message he says he was told that the vessel had caught fire at sea, and the space ship which was cruising in the area observed the danger to the passengers and crew and went to their rescue.

In regard to this later message we regret we cannot confirm this fact . for our files do not contain any account of the craft having been found to have been on fire. when the enquiry was made some time after its discovery. but it does state that a larger circular scorch mark was found on the upper deck.

Further the message that they were being rescued from a burning ship does not fit in with the suggestion made in the message of the bottle. for its states they were being FORCED on board the circular craft . rather the opposite to being RESCUED by a friendly rescuer.


We by no means would at this stage be prepared to accept the reliability of the message in the bottle but because it is another case of an indirect incident in which "saucers " are concerned we publish same as usual with our open minded attitude to deal with all matters directly or indirectly concerned with the subject.

The whole matter is one of conjecture. and like its sister ill fated ship the " Marie Celeste " probably will never have a complete answer.

One fact which rather made your editor a little more interested than usual was the fact that the initial message in Australia was broadcast at a noon day session. and not repeated or published in any paper. further when he made enquiries for details from the Radio station concerned and also the papers. he found a strange silence about the subject "No one knew anything" or could give details . the papers editors. "never heard of it. " and finally when pressed the Radio contact said it was a complete hoax . and therefore the records had been destroyed. rather strange if later it was found further evidence to prove it was not a hoax . and the records were wanted for reference. This would have not aroused much curiosity but for the fact that

It was taken in Tokoroa, about 40miles north of Taupo, at 7 p.m. on Thursday last. Mr. H.J. Akers , of the N.Z. Forest Dept staff at Kinleath who is a keen photographer was preparing to photograph cloud formations from his backyard whan he saw the object in the sky about 100 feet up.

" I did not have time to sight the camera properly and more or less shot from the hip" says Mr. Akers .

And this is what he got when he printed his negative- a shining , inverted dished object surmounted by a drum shaped housing which itself it topped by a smaller housing .

The object is out of focus and blurred with the movement against a darkly , over exposed cloud laden sky.

Well , thats Mr. Aker's photograph. - but the big questions are who owns this lampshade like thing ? Are they friendly or fearsome ? and are they following Mr Adamski around?.

In another edition Mr Akers says. " Surprised at the clear image I saw. I took it off an enlarged print to show to my friends "

The print shows an elliptical lighted object topped by a central light against a background of cloud and sky.

He used an ordinary twin-lensed reflex camera and estimated the height of the object at about 100 ft. although this was difficult to judge .

Mr Akers says he had not been interested in flying saucers before. but now intended to browse through some books on the subject. He would probably forward the picture to Mr. George Adamski who would no doubt be pleased to study it to determine whether or not it would add confirmation to his theories.

BRAZILIAN REPORTS UFO LAND

REPORT FROM BRAZIL

In the evening of the 9th December, 1954, a farmer, Oliniro da Costa e Rosam who lives in a village Linha Bela Vista, 2½ miles from the city Venania Aires, was a witness to the landing of a strange aeroplane in the field where he was working. What exactly happened there, he shall explain in his own words, as it was in his report to the special researches who had been sent by the Government.

"At 5 o'clock in the afternoon, I was weeding on a bean and maizefield when I heard a strange noise that sounded like a sewing machine. At the same time the animals in a nearby meadow ran hastily away. When I looked up, I saw a strange person. He was standing close by and just looked at me. Then I noticed at some distance, an aeroplane, which was shaped like a boyscout hat. The object was cream of colour and was protected by a sort of transparent smoke which seemed to surround it. It was not standing on the ground, but hung stationary in the air, about 5 feet high. I noticed a strong smell, which could be compared with that which comes from a locomotive. Then I saw behind the first man two other humans. One was in the aeroplane, and had his head outside a porthole, the other was standing a little distance further, close to the fencing and seemed to examine closely the barbed wire. On the higher part of the machine I saw three holes, but I did not know how the men got outside. I was afraid and tried to call for help but there came no sound from my throat. I couldn't even move my legs and hands. The fear had paralyzed them and the spade fell out of my hands.

The stranger made a gesture of greeting that looked like a military salute, followed by a smile. After that he knelt down to pick up the spade and looked at it from all sides, in the meantime turning it handily round in his hands. After that he gave the spade to me or rather laid it in my hands. After that he picked up some bean and maize plants from the ground. He pulled out one of each with the roots from the soil and walked with it in the direction of the machine, seemingly no longer interested in my problems. When I saw that there was nothing to fear, I controlled my nerves and walked in the direction of the machines, but my movements were intently observed by the man inside the machine. He had looked at me all that time, but did nothing to stop me. However, the man that was standing by the fence, gave me a sign that quite clearly gave me to understand not to come any closer to the machine. Of course, I went no further, and decided to go to the fence to see what he was doing there. He was studying the barbed wire and was touching it with his fingers. Some sheep that had first run away, came back and approached the spot. I saw that the stranger looked at them with interest. With words and gestures I asked him if he wished to have one as a present, but the man didn't seem to understand and made a negative gesture. What happened then, I can't tell too well because it happened too quickly. The man went back to the machine and sudden I was alone. The strange plane went up vertically and climbed to 30 feet high, from there it flew away at a great speed in a diagonal direction and in a moment had disappeared in the west.

The creatures were of middle height, wide shouldered, blond, with long hair that blew up with the wind. Their faces were so alike that they could have been twins. They didn't look like normal people, because of their slanting eyes and their deadly pale faces. The paleness of their faces was so intense that their faces looked like those of the dead. They seemed quite strong. The strange men were dressed in light brown uniforms, which were made made out of one piece like overalls. The trousers were very narrow and seemed to be connected with the shoes. The shoes had open heels, and the footprints which they left behind showed that quite clearly. The whole occurrence happened within 5 minutes. The strange flying machine was big and had a diameter of at least 50 feet. It seemed to have been made out of light yellow metal and had a brilliant glare. After the departure of the 'plane, I inspected the ground, underneath where it had been hovering. I found nothing, except the air remained cool around for some time."

Mr. A is 50 years old. He had been interviewed several times by the authorities who had come from Porte Alegre to investigate. We can expect that he has given the just and correct details and the truth of what he thought to be the truth. He told that he had never read any science fiction stories. He had never heard of flying saucers or of space people from other planets. That is what he said. He seemed to be very surprised when they asked him about that. He seemed to believe that the visitors came from another land.

The "Asapress" sent the story out some days later through the radio broadcast and it was published in one of the Rio newspapers. On the 15th January, 1955 the reporter Yaca Martino published (one of the best U.F.O. researchers) a successful report about the incident in the magazine "C. Cruzeiro", whereby he had photos of the witness and of the place of investigation.

" THE AMAZING MR. LUTTERWORTH. " DESMOND LESLIE.
