"N O T P R O V E N"

Of late the Editor has received quite a few letters and phone calls as well as personally put questions on the subject of the hostility of the UFO.

The prime query being caused by certain stories which have appeared from time to time in various books and especially of late, there has been a strong trend for the go getter to cash in on such data and write books many of which have appeared lately in paper back style but unfortunately not all of them sticking to the truth or in some cases deliberately setting out to a case for the hostile actions of the stories of UFO related in their books.

We have already received warning of this from our American associates who have stated that in some cases some of the cases quoted never really existed and that ~~often when investigation was made~~ no such person gave such a story, or that a certain town even existed which goes to prove how careful we have to believe in what we read. Actually your editor suspects a plot behind to discredit the UFO field and it could well be an organised one for those who we know do not want the UFO TRUTH to be known and so they set forth to smear it, or bring it discredit by creating a fear complex and its certainly not hard to make a coin or two if one has no scruples.

Not alone in this is the fact that one or two good publishers have printed material from apparently sincere good authors, but who somehow never bothered to make the best investigation into cases which they have quoted in their books. Your Editor instanced such a case recently in one of his Editorials, wherein an Australian story was quoted of a landing. Having investigated the case within a few hours he knew that the story as related was totally one which could not atand up to good investigation and added to this was given evidence to support if of a number of witnesses to the said case which had no relationship to it, but was a separate case which occured at a later date.

No doubt the author was sincere and had given the case as related to her and knowing the original source of her information, which we believe was relayed by another we are not surprised at the fantastic use of the truth.

So much for this, to return to our quest "Are they Hostile?"

It is obviously impossible to quote the numerous cases which are given from time to time which are used to support such an idea, and here we

can only quote a few over the years. Well known cases which have caused some to think that such hostility existed.

Firstly that Flatswood Monster Case. The story cannot be denied. There were too many witnesses and thorough investigations were made by very reliable people.

But the point is that in none of the evidence was it PROVEN that the "Monster" came from a UFO. Evidence was that a huge light was seen in the distance, and others claimed they saw a UFO in another area. BUT WHERE is the proof that this hideous thing came from a UFO it is pure supposition, and certainly the evidence is only circumstantial. Such testimony would not stand up in any court of law. Hence the judgement must be "Not Proven".

Even the Bender Case and those similar to it, quite a few of which have been related of late, do not prove relationship to a UFO as we know it, but rather that the people who ever they "Those three men in Black" are enemies of the UFO Researchers. For in every case the desire and attempt is always to oust them out of UFO investigations again using the fear complex.

Lets take the case of the 7 Avengers which were lost at sea and the bombers which went to find out what happened to them. Where in that official story is there proof that the disappearance was the result of contact with a UFO?

Their reports did not state any such vehicle being in their path, only some strange lights and since experimentation on Laser rays have been in vogue we could just as rightly claim it was caused by an enemy Laser ray or some other secret device, or experiment going on at the time.

Of course the historic case of Capt. Mantell who lost his life when in contact with a UFO. Even though this case does wipe away any doubt that it was a UFO he contacted. It is well known that his ignorance of the force field caused his death, NOT THE UFO, and also that he was above the height his craft was created for. Oh I know some will come up with the story about his body never being found. But since the force field which caused his plane to disintegrate was so great, what terrible devastation would have happened to a human body made of much less material to withstand it than the craft.

Coming much further afield we have the case of Barney and Betty Hill, who claimed they were taken into a saucer and operated on. Actually if such were true, they came to no harm, but it must be remembered they could only relate the story when under hypnotism, and since they had no recollection of such in normal state, we are using the fields of the mind, which are full of vagaries and untold possibilities of yet unknown depths, it is hardly fair to use this case as one of PROOF that their case was one of Hostility,

There are other cases we know which have a more reliable foundation, but since no case of real physical harm has occurred, perhaps in one case a moral law of ours being broken as we know it. It still contains no proof of actual harm being done to the young man who had the unique experience of physical contact with a space person.

Coming up to latter cases of animal destruction - the well known case of the "Skippy" incident, so well known we will not relate the sordid details.

Where in this case is PROOF that a Saucer had done this operation on the animal? There is no denial something most extraordinary had performed it, and so skilfully that even medical people attested that it was without parallel. Here no one could state they had proof that a Saucer had done this. True, a Saucer was seen in the vicinity of that area, but again the evidence is circumstantial.

One case quoted to me for explanation was that of the three men in Brazil whose bodies were found with strange writings and messages. It was well known they were experimenting, and also that they were UFO students. A Saucer was reported seen near that area, but since no one has come up with evidence which can state clearly that these men had been killed by the Saucer, surely it is just as reliable to believe they may have killed themselves by some experiment they were conducting.

It all reminds me of a case I knew many years ago of a peasant type Italian woman, who had a son, who was epileptic. She claimed that a neighbour was responsible for these fits, "Because he had put the evil eye on the lad". The only evidence she could give was that the lad was "frightened" of the man, and that he, according to her, had the evil eye, and when he was "near" the lad he would cast a spell on him.

Poor man how much like the Saucers was he, being in the vicinity and because people had wild ideas about him, hence he must have caused the lad's fits.

What utter trash! What complete distortion of the TRUTH! Just because a Saucer is seen near some weird cases - THE SAUCERS DONE IT!

Even they were blamed for the Black-out in New York, and we cannot deny that a saucer was around as we have a slide in our collection which shows one there at the time.

But let us stop talking wild drivil. What proof is there that the Saucers caused the black out?? I stated at the time it was just as likely that some experiment had gone wild, or some experiment made by a nuclear sub. off the coast of the U.S.A. We are well aware that one of the devises the other side have is such, and that they can by pure remote control not only upset such a vast electrical system but even destroy installations.

One could go on and on, and I am well aware there are a vast number of cases which APPEAR to have a hostile action behind them, but I make an appeal for commonsense to prevail, and before we blame the Saucers for everything, let us be a bit

This all brings me round to what I stated in a few Editorials back, namely the goodies and the baddies. I am more inclined to consider such cases as those above, and the many others like them as POSSIBLY being caused by a completely different force or type of UFO from that which we believe as believe as coming from outer space.

I consider it far more logical to believe that there are two forces at work than to put them all into one bag as they say, and say they are all hostile or th t hostility has been proven I fell that so far not one case c n be presented which can wholly PROVE hostile action and that whatever evidence is available is completely circumstantial, and hence we have a case which in any court would have to be ruled out as "NOT PROVEN."

We will welcome the thoughts and criticisms of our readers on this, for this is an open Forum magazine and would delight in putting the other side forward if there are those who would care to contribute their thoughts on this subject.

BRAZILIAN SCIENTIFIC GROUP CONCLUDE UFOs ARE SPACE CRAFT.

The Brazilian Colloquium on UFOs, led by the president of the Brazilian Inst. of Aeronautics and Sapce Sciences, announced recently that a " critical, scientific study over the period of 20 years had allowed them to come to the conclusion that flying saucers exist, and are extratorrestrial objects." The group which was attended by official military and intelligence personnel, also stated its belief that the UFO enigma was a global phenomenon, inexplicable by present standards of scientific knowledge, and urged increased public and scientific acceptance of the subject. Governmental representatives at the gathering said that there was a constant exchange of information between private researchers and official agencies, in an effort to increase the amount of data on UFOs.

TELEPATHY
OR HOW NOT TO KEEP YOUR THOUGHTS TO YOURSELF.

UNIVERSITY GROUP TO STUDY PARAPSYCHOLOGY.
FROM Californian Scty. Psychical Study Inc. USA.

A new students' group has been formed on the University of California's Berkeley campus: The Prometheans. They don't want to steal fire from heaven, but rather to blow some fresh air over the smoldering coals of legitimate areas of scientific inquiry neglected for too long on the Berkeley campus.

What could be better than to start with parapsychology, a field that touches the borderlines of the best-established sciences--physics, chemistry, biology--as well as the not-so-well-established ones, especially psychology and all its branches.

What is it that makes a science well established? There are two widely recognized criteria: reproducibility and predictability of the phenomena involved. And there is a hidden consequence of those criteria: the power to handle those phenomena, which means power over Nature. Whether or not the well-established sciences have conducted humankind to the edge of extinction or to the threshold of full awareness, we do not know. However, we do know that physics and chemistry have contributed very little to our understanding of man, and of his place in this world, his mind, and his capabilities.

There are people who expect physics will be able to explain man, from his component atoms to the functioning of the brain. (Mind is just a product of the brain for them.) There are others who think this is utter nonsense; one can never explain the functioning of a complex entity by breaking it apart and showing how the parts work. Of course, people in the first group think that parapsychology as a science cannot be, for the simple reason that the phenomena "alleged" by parapsychologists cannot be explained on the basis of physics; ergo, they cannot exist. It must be fraud, or hallucinations, or self-deception, or all together.

There are many reasons why parapsychology is so controversial. The main one is not the lack of reproducibility of the phenomena it studies, but rather the fact the up to now there is no physical explanation or testable theory for

- a) TELEPATHY, the paranormal perception of the mental activities of another person;
- b) CLAIRVOYANCE, the paranormal perception of objective events, as distinguished from telepathic cognition of the mental activities of another person;
- c) PSYCHOKINESIS, the direct influencing of a physical system by a subject without any known intermediate physical energy or instrumentation; and
- d) PRECOGNITION, the cognition of a future event or series of events which could not be known through rational inference.

Now, the Prometheans want to examine all these. They want to know what has been done, what is being done, what their generation can do, in the field of parapsychology as well as in other fields they intend to examine. It is good that they are bringing the subject to the attention of students, faculty, and public on the Berkeley campus, because...

ANCIENT FORT FOUND IN THE ANDES.

NZ. Herald. Oct. 29. 1968.

Santiago. Chile. A group of climbers searching for a flying saucer base high in the Andes said yesterday they had found what could be a fortress of a previously unknown civilization.

The five-man team also claimed they had seen a flying saucer in the area and showed reporters in Santiago a photograph of a flash of light crossing the night sky above the Andes.

The team was investigating an area of Chile near Talca, 150 miles south of Santiago, following reports of flying saucers, cars stopping and starting without explanation, and out-of-season flowers suddenly blooming in a few hours.

They found nothing to corroborate these reports, but instead discovered opposite an extinct volcano, two platforms about 700 yards square, each made from 233 10-ton blocks of volcanic rock.

RIDDLE OF NATURE'S MAGIC CIRCLE

No one understands the reason for the incredible things that happen within a dusty circle on the grasslands of Oregon, U.S.A. Nature, it seems, runs wild, and no bird will fly overhead to brave the unseen forces that defy scientific scrutiny.

It lies on the dusty weed-strewn land that sloped down to the banks of Sardine Creek, a roughly marked circle 165 feet in diameter. And inside it, nature has gone dramatically and inexplicably berserk.

No one understands what causes the incredible things that occur within this dusty circle at the place they call the Oregon Vortex.

For some reason, gravity runs wild, not even birds will fly overhead, and trees have been twisted into crazy shapes, as though by some unseen hand.

For years physicists have been investigating the riddle of the Oregon Vortex which lies 30 miles from Grant's Pass in America's west coast State of Oregon, and are no nearer to the truth than when they started. The unknown and unseen forces at work there continue to defy any form of scientific scrutiny,

A Grant's Pass resident told me: "The moment you see the place, something tells you that nature has gone mad. If you are on horseback, the horse will instinctively shy away from it. Birds suddenly swing about in flight and dart away.

"Even the trees give the impression that they, too, are under the influence of a power they cannot escape. The tree limbs droop noticeable and the leaves themselves lean towards the magnetic north, although those outside the circle point straight up."

Within this circle is an old wooden shed, once an assay office, but abandoned about 1890 when the mystery forces caused the scales to play tricks!

The building itself is warped and twisted, and when you step inside, you're in another world.

You feel a tremendous pull downwards, as though gravity has suddenly become intensified. You instinctively lean at an angle of about 10 degrees to the centre of the circle.

If you lean backwards, that is, towards the outside of the circle you have an uncanny feeling of being pulled towards its centre - as scientific instruments indicate that you are.

Many experts have conducted involved experiments at the Vortex, trying to unravel its riddle.

They hung a 28lb. steel ball on a chain from a beam in the shack, and it still hangs there - at an angle, which apparently defies the laws of gravity.

It dangles perceptibly towards the centre of the circle.

Even cigarette smoke is affected by the weird forces with the Vortex. A puff of smoke blown into the still air within the shack will begin to spiral, faster and faster, until it vanishes.

Instruments have measured the outer limits of the disturbance and determined the size of the circle as roughly 165 feet. Other instruments were carefully set up beyond the influence of the Vortex itself.

By sighting through the planes of these devices, it was easy to establish that the feeling of standing at any angle within the circle was not imaginary.

By the same method, it was easy to prove that the 28lb. steel ball suspended from the chain inside the shack actually does hang at an angle towards the centre of the Vortex.

Golf clubs, sticks and brooms, placed upright in the circle, immediately lean away at an angle from the centre of the Vortex.

The phenomenon which accompanies the Vortex forces is also electro-magnetic in character.

An ordinary photographer's light-meter, which converts light into electricity and registers it on a dial will show wide variation between the daylight inside the circle and that beyond its limits.

And compasses simply refuse to function.

The Oregon Vortex is similar in some respects to another spot about forty-five miles away in the Siskiyou Mountains, although the phenomenon at the Vortex is much more profound.

At Camp Burch, Colorado, there is another "magic circle", again less powerful than the Vortex.

The force is indubitably there. It is measurable, but what it is or why it is, nobody knows. The Oregon Vortex is indeed the oddest - and perhaps the "craziest" - spot on Earth!

CANADIAN REPORT OF HOVERING U.F.O.

Port Hope Guide. Sept. 13 1968.

At 8.55.p.m. Donald Fenton and David Black saw a UFO hovering over Lake Ontario. Mr. Fenton said it appeared from nowhere. Mr Black said, "was three times brighter than the brightest star, glowing steadily as it moved in an east to west direction in an erratic course." It was described as having a "cigar shape" and when it was in the area of Hercules constellation, it went through a series of manouvres, turning 50 deg. angles.

"When it turned, it flopped on its side, revealing a saucer shape. It disappeared with a long sweep upwards into the sky," Black said. He estimated it would not have been below 3,000 ft. Its color was a constant "Blue-green".

MORE LAWN MYSTERIES.

Since our last edition more reports have come in of unusual lawn effects from various parts of the suburbs, ranging from 20 miles from each other to as close as 2 or 3 miles, but on different dates.

An unusual thing which has cropped up since our last report and which was pointed out by an observer, was that in all cases the markings were on the back or rear lawn of the dwellings concerned NEVER on the front lawn areas.

The effect has always been the same; the type as described previously, viz. dark oily substance changing to brownish powder, then greyish globules.

However as we pointed out in the last edition the analysis both by the University and now by the Police Forensic Department have proved them to be of carbon and graphite deposits, notwithstanding they were declared Fungi. Although these are contradictions in one being organic and the other inorganic no one seems to explain this discrepancy of logic.

But as we insisted before - How does fungi form perfect geometrical designs and patterns and here again in the latest cases we have the same thing cropping up, of which we quote one case for the books to be added to those already listed.

At Sefton Park a woman called and said her lawn had been affected on the early morning of Tuesday 18th March. They, like all the others, went out in the morning only to find the strange markings on the lawn in a geometrical design. (see diagram)

But there were other unusual features which accompanied this case and similar to another in which noises were heard during the early hours of the morning, at 3.30 a.m. to be precise. The woman was awakened by a very loud crack "Like the crack of a stockwhip". She thought something had fallen or a floor board had snapped, then as she sat in bed listening she heard a noise as "though her child's cot was being pulled across the bedroom floor. "At first she thought her mother may have got up to attend to the child, then her fears were increased when she threw her torch light on the area near the child's room. "The door was shut and she always left it open". Waking her husband she told him burglars were in the house. He laughed at her and told her to go to sleep, but her fears so maternal for her child made her get up. The child was fast asleep. Her mother had heard the noise but had not got up. She went to the rear of the house which she thought was the nearest to the noise, and looking out found nothing, and returned to sleep. Her father in the morning however discovered the strange markings on the lawn. But a most unusual feature was that when she opened the door to look out, the dog, who usually slept on an old chair at the back rushed in madly and dived under the bed, and no amount of coaxing or would get him out. His hair was stiff with fear and although he had never disobeyed orders before, he refused to budge. (This effect was noted in a case similar which had been investigated a

week previous by your Editor of animal fear behaviour and accompanied by strange noises in the night followed by markings on the lawn in the morning.


The markings were all of a circular nature except one which was square, and this, as were the discs, was $3\frac{1}{2}$ inches across, i.e. square or in diameter. The discs followed an arc pattern of about $3\frac{1}{2}$ feet between each pattern and there were six discs and one square beginning at a point near a tap at the back of the house and stretching across the lawn to the rear.

As in all previous cases, nearby objects made it impossible for there to have been a landing, such as rotary clothes lines, trees, shrubs, etc. Our explanation to the lady as we gave it is the same as we give to you.

"WE have no explanation. We cannot state that any UFO did this".

There was no evidence to point to any seen object or anything to ally it with any sighting around at the time. Just the noises and the marks and the contradictions, but above all the repeated geometrical patterns and designs.

We only wish we had the answer. Your guess is as good as ours. What is your opinion readers? Was it purely fungi formation? Are these shapes formed by some beastly or being? ... Perhaps you can solve the riddle. We find it difficult and certainly are not prepared at this juncture to dogmatically associate it with UFOs.



MORE NEWS OF LAWN DEPOSITS
FROM OVERSEAS.

WHITE GIANT MUSHROOMS ON LAND AREA OF FLYING SAUCERS IN ARGENTINE

(Republican Lorrain, 14.8.1968)
This date refers to report of
landing strips in Anden 3260m high

Land area of UFOs near Correa, 59km from Rosario, the largest town in the province of Santa Fee. With assistance of the police force landing area found. Area had a size of 600 x 800 metres flat grass land, no trees or shrubs or dwellings. Landing circles marked by UFOs approx. 50cm wide where giant mushrooms are growing - nowhere else found in that area - similar in shape to the kind of Lycoperdon bovista or Globaria bovista (found in Germany) - not found in Argentine. Diameter of mushrooms were 35cm.

18 landing areas of the following sizes were counted: Seven of a dia. of 5m, five with a dia. of 5m, five with 7m, four with 9m and 2 with 12m. All were circles but the two last ones had the form of an eight. The grass tops in the 50cm wide circles were slightly yellow-brown, on the earth surface nothing unusual to discover. To dig 2cm under the top soil within the 50cm a whitish grey mouldy growth was discovered about 7 to 10cm deep. The mushrooms were not radio active.

LANDING AREA 3260 METRES HIGH IN THE ANDEN

CONDON FLYING SAUCER REPORT SLATED

The Sun-Herald, Feb. 2, 1969.

A Sydney flying saucer investigator this week attacked a U.S. report which claimed unidentified flying objects were "myths". The 1,450 page report, compiled over two years at the University of Colorado under Dr. Edward U. Condon, said all U.F.O. sightings could be explained in "natural" terms.

The report said that on the evidence available, it would be a waste of time and money to continue investigating flying saucers. Dr. Miran Lindtner, of Strathfield, the president of the Unidentified Flying Object Investigation Centre, said the committee's findings were pre-determined. "A memorandum was circulated among all the scientists on the project instructing them about procedure," he said. "They were told to concentrate on the witnesses themselves, not on what they saw." "The object was always to attack the witnesses' reliability".

He said the commission had investigated only 59 reported sightings, when the U.S. Air Force alone had records of more than 2,000 in the past three years. "Two of the 22 scientists on the commission were fired for objecting to Dr. Condon's methods," Dr. Lindtner said. "Dr. Condon himself stated, before the investigation started, that his purpose was 'to get rid of the flying saucer myth'. One of the dismissed scientists, Dr. David R. Saunders, had written a book which contradicts the Condon findings. The book, "UFOs? Yes!" subtitled "Where the Condon Project Went Wrong," would be on sale in Sydney soon.

"From our point of view," said Dr. Lindtner, "any new scientific development goes through three stages: Ridicule, doubt and recognition. "Flying saucers are now in the second stage. The ice has been broken."

"The Condon report does nothing to clarify the question. It only confuses it." This week Dr. Lindtner, Dr. D. Herbison-Evans, an astronomer from Sydney University's physics department, and Mr. Neville Drury, a Sydney University anthropology graduate, went to Goulburn, N.S.W., to investigate a reported sighting there. They said the "sighting" was a hoax. A series of four photographs supposedly taken within a few seconds and showing a "flying saucer", were in fact taken over a period of several hours and were of a small model disc whirled around on a string. "People must realise that we are not going to be taken in by jokers," said Dr. Lindtner. "Our investigations are serious work."

GLOWING OBJECT IN SKY

Residents of several Sydney suburbs last night reported seeing "a great white light in the sky" which appeared to hover before flying off at tremendous speed. The object first was seen over Cronulla shortly after 8 p.m. Eyewitnesses described it as a large glowing object which seemed to settle in one place for about 10 minutes before zooming away. Shortly after 8 p.m. the mystery object was seen hovering over Leichhardt. John Jackomac, 16, of Myrtle Street, Leichhardt, said he observed it for about 15 minutes. "It was very big and bright, and high in the sky -

about 10,000 feet up, he said. "For a while it just floated overhead then suddenly it shot off faster than anything I have ever seen in my life."

Only five minutes later, Fairfield residents caught a glimpse of the light, which appeared to have gained altitude.

"At first I thought I was seeing things," Mr. G. Gillam, of Wray Street, Fairfield, said. "I got the lady next door and she saw it too. The object appeared to be much bigger and brighter than the largest of the stars and it travelled at phenomenal speed. It took only about two minutes to shoot right across the sky."

Spokesmen for the Department of Civil Aviation, the RAAF, and the Bureau of Meteorology last night could offer no explanation for the unidentified flying object.

"WE SAW A FLYING SAUCER AND IT SCARED US."

A group of standard four children at Te Mata School Havelock North, believe they saw a flying saucer at close range this morning - and it frightened them.

Description of the object by half a dozen children who saw it hovering over an orchard near the school at 11.11.20 am varied in detail, but all agreed to its size, shape and all said they were "scared".

They said they could see a hatch and antenna as the saucer-shaped object hovered at low level over some poplar trees.

They said they heard it make a clicking noise and was about half the size of the school's swimming pool. The children were in a non-swimming group and drew the attention of their teacher - who was giving swimming lessons to other members of the class - to the object as it suddenly "shot upward" and travelled toward Hastings leaving a vapour trail.

Teacher Watched.


A teacher said he watched the object for about 10 minutes as it travelled backward and forward across Hastings. At times the teacher thought it could be an aeroplane, but at other times it appeared to be too round to fit the description of any aircraft he knew.

He said he believed the children were genuine in their descriptions of the object. Bridge Pa aerodrome and the Civil Aviation Department at Napier reported no aircraft in the area at the time of the sighting at 11.20 am.

Gavin KING, 10, said he saw the object touching the top of a tree about 100 yards away from the school play ground "It was round with this thing on top ... there were lights all round the bottom and there was a sort of hatch on the side Flames were coming out of the bottom and there was a bit of a vapour. It was white on the bottom with a black band round the side. It made a clicking noise like a clock. (Below is a copy of a sketch Gavin King made.)



Graham HEBDEN, 10, said when he first saw it the object looked like a little bird, but it grew to the size of about half the school's swimming pool as it finally hovered over the trees.

Peter TAYLOR, 9, said the object had "things" hanging from it. They had "round things" attached to them.

Pamela BERRY, 9, saw the vapour trail and William SKIPWORTH, 10, saw the flames.

The children said there was also a "diamond-shaped" light on the dome of the object.

Lee CURRAN, 9, said it was "ghostly" and "Shimmery". Other children also reported sighting the object in the vicinity of Te Mata Peak.

According to Dr. Ramaniuk, this fact was brought to the attention of the United States Air Intelligence Centre by an astronomer, Mr Silas Newton director of the North-Western Observatory.

Dr. Roamiuk quoted Mr Newton as saying the extra-terrestrial craft had small exit traps instead of doors, allowing the passage of small sized beings only .

Inside the seamless hard metal object " six small dead bodies were found, morphologically similar to man.. probably killed by atmpspheric de- composition when one of the trap doors failed to work.," Dr Romaniuk Said.

SCARE ON FLYING SAUCERS

Mrs. Bryant said no one in the neighbourhood saw or heard anything unusual before the marks appeared.

A second impression was found a few days later on the property of Mr. J. O'Neill.

It was elliptical in shape, about 30 ft. long and 12 ft. wide.

There was no scorching, but grass in a swamp had been flattened and entangled.

Mr. O'Neill said he saw an orange light on a mountain about a mile from his house one night last week.
