

THE ADELAIDE CONVENTION . 1970.

One hardly knows where to start in reporting this gathering of UFO.workers from around Australia. for it was beset with many difficulties in our path even when we first began our planning of the speakers.

The first setback was the sudden untimely death of Dr Miran Lindtner of.U.F.O.I.C Sydney. who was to have been one the main speakers.

Whilst we were getting over the shock of the loss of this fine worker. our arrangements with Capt. Bruce Cathie. broke down suddenly. by his relaying to his publishers through whom our own arrangements for his lecture tour of Australia was being planned. " that he couldnot come because his life had been threatened" This statement caused as much a shock to his publishers as it was to us.

This was number two off the list of those expected.

Then/when we had got fully under way with other speakers. and on the eve of the Convention. came th news from Mr H. Sloane. by telegram that they had to discontinue their journey although they were half way to Adelaide from Balarat .

Mrs Sloane we found later had been taken ill, and necessitated their return.

Mr Soane was the rpime mover of the Convention being held. and such was a loss and shock to us. but to make matters worse he was bringing with him photos and slides for viewing at the Convention of an object taken near the moon by an astronomer of the Bllarat Observatory. and which since has caused quite a stir.

But Mr Sloane sent them on by train and a telegram to pick them up at the Rail way Dept delivery. We called there every day right tup to the Monday, but were told there was nothing there for us. (We got them delivered on the following Tuesady afternoon and the cartnote stated they had been recived at the Adelaide Station on theThursday night.)

Mrs W. Lane who was to have shown some movie films of UFOs on the eve of her departure from Sydney. sprained her ankle just before leaving for the plane hence no films.

We make no comment on these mishaps. mor than state that they were indeed a series of strange co-incidences.and not as the paper said I said a hoodoo.

The outcome of the Convention was in all a success aven if not as successful as we might have desired. It well could be called a Convention of Contrasts for there were so many their who were of different approaches. from the purely scientific minded ones to those who dealt with the metaphysical.

One of the speakers expressed his regret that it all had not been scientific at which I was amazed. for one can hardly go to any type of Convention and not find a mixture of opinions , and certainly could not expect all to be in

agreement with ones own views on such a subject as UFOs which spans a wide field of research .

Our plea has always been an open minded approach and we stick to this.No matter what ones views are one does not necessarily have to accept, but he must concede the right to allow the other fellow his opinions.

We had a good sprinkling of delegates from all States. and the only State not actually represented either officially or personally. was Queensland. who had promised to send a party down but a week or so before the Convention stated that " unless all Groups are represented, particularly , the larger Groups, we feel we cannot be officially represented at the Convention . "

Such an attitude amazed your Editor. for EVERY Group in Australia had been invited to send delegates, and if they declined it was not because of lack of invitation but their own unwillingness to come the only other larger Group that could not come was the Victorian . who declined. Hence. Queensland attitude for the larger Groups was a good as saying. we are not impressed by the smaller Groups and their efforts for unity.

This brings us to the point of the purpose of the Convention . i.e. some form of unification of working together and shows clearly that what I have stated for years and even when CAGIO was formed that there can never be any form of real Unity in Australi among the Groups whilst such a spirit exists.

It was this very attitude that caused CAGIO to be dissolved. one big group dominating the smaller ones. and mainly for the benefit of the one Group.

The paper read from the Tasmanian Societies was I feel a good one for it showed us clearly that if there is the will there can be unification of sightings and reports etc, for there with three Groups operating they exchange freely and work together harmoniously . Why not others on the mainland ?

A resolution was passed that we strive to get all Groups to exchange information and especially sightings. with each other and if possible form some central body to act a a centre. for such .

The place for the next Conention was decided upon to be Canberra. A.C.T. and to be held in June next year on the Queens Birthday holiday week end. For those interested we suggest you write Mr John Drake the Pres. there. of the Canberra UFO INvest. 19m Bundarra Ave Aranda ACT. Aust. .

U.F.O. AUTHOR HAS CONTACT EXPERIENCE.

In a small tape sent to the above Convention wishing the same all success, the author of the book " Flying Saucers . What Are They ? " relates how that although he previous to writing his book he had no interest whatever in such claims. and considered them as phoney, after the book was written and on the market, he had the unique experience of having an actual contact experience himself. which has changed his whole outlook on life and of the subject of UFO. He does not elaborate in what form or how the actual experience took place but hints that it was along New Age lines. Since he mentions them in his tape and of the contacts made by them .

He states that he will be writing another book relating the whole story for us to study for ourselves . We can only await the same with the greatest of interest . Especially from a man who was so opposed to such ideas it should contain some very convincing arguments which must have been answered first to him to convince him of the genuiness of his claim.

We will advise our readers as soon as the book reaches the market.

E.S.P. or PARAPSYCHOLOGY.

The Encyclopedia Brittanica defines parapsychology as a derivative of psychology, with special reference to those allegedly supernormal capacities of the human organism, such as telepathy, clairvoyance, precognition and other not generally agreed on functions.

In research conducted in England since 1956 pschyologists have found that the size and weight of the brain in young children is increasing. They too found evidence that these children are beginning to make use of the frontal lobe of the brain, which in mankind has previously been dormant, as is commonly known, man only uses a fraction of his brain in day to day living, the major portion being in a dormant state. We have all had experience with some people whose brain seems 100% dormant!

Psychologists predict in all seriousness that within 25 years this dormant brainpower will awaken, and that mankind will be able to project and receive thoughts and pictures in the same way as radio and television; and that we will possess the power of teleportation and psychokinesis and so on.

It is a known fact that children up to the age of 3 years possess telepathic ability, and after that age gradually lose it. Quite often it will be found that this ability definitely runs in a family and is obviously being handed on in the genes. Perhaps this could explain how certain facts become known in some inexplicable way; and it could well be handing on of unconscious racial knowledge in the genetic code. This genetic knowledge is handed on in plant and animal life so why not in humans too? Twins have shown high telepathic ability; and experiments conducted in Canada with identical twins demonstrated they possessed telepathic ability in a very high degree.

The great majority of conservative psychologists do not accept E.S.P. and in the United States only a small minority are acquainted with post 1938 research; but this negative attitude is not found in British and continental psychologists; While there is plenty of documented evidence for E.S.P., the chief obstacle to scientific acceptance of these findings is the almost complete absence of any believable theoretical basis, as to the underlying causative processes. What disturbs the psychologist, is the difficulty he has in postulating even a general kind of scientific explanation for such a phenomenon as precognitive telepathy. The problem presented by E.S.P. to psychologists is more metaphysical than scientific. However, in the United States there has been a marked rise in the number of psychologists who believe that E.S.P. is either an established fact, or a likely possibility. This has occurred since 1938.

E.S.P. is a term commonly used to cover telepathy and clairvoyance; but nowadays the term P.S.T. is used, to cover all types of paranormal phenomena.

Parapsychology, the modern term for this phenomena has now almost reached the stage of respectability and general acceptance. The field it covers is extremely wide - clairvoyance, telepathy, telekinesis, teleportation, levitation, precognition to name a few facets of it.

Orthodox science has always resisted change and any new field of enquiry; has always found it hard to get recognition. These new fields must always be

expressed in terms already accepted by recognised disciplines, and it is always assumed that any new method fails to embody the scientific method of orthodox science. In recent years, Psychiatry, psychology and nuclear physics have had to surmount these barriers before being accepted.

In 1930, Dr. J.B. Rhine of Duke University began his famous card guessing experiments, and with a documented mass of statistical data has succeeded in placing this perception on a very sound basis. Active research is going on at the present time in America, Russia, England and many continental countries on each side of the Iron Curtain. To quote Dr. Eysenck of London University, "Research into this subject is going on in at least 30 universities all over the world, and several hundred respected scientists are engaged in this research". He feels that attacks on it are caused by dogmatic academics interested only in maintaining the scientific "Status quo", which is being threatened by the new science of parapsychology.

When anything is not apparent to our five physical senses we do not admit its existence, yet down through history has come recorded and documented instances of knowledge being gained in a way other than normal. Therefore, E.S.P. is the acquiring of knowledge beyond the scope of our normal physical senses. However, such knowledge is not so much beyond normal as we may think and it is probably our acceptance of what IS normal, that has to be widened.

While we may know quite a lot about the brain, we know very little about the mind, its powers and its working. Science cannot tell what the mind is, or even what thought, memory recall or consciousness are. In the late 19th century Freud brought the new science of psychiatry into being, with his theories that childhood experiences and emotions played a major part in shaping our later lives.

Current scientific thinkers have expressed in public the enigma arising from the splitting of the atom. The atom is mostly empty space and some force analogous to electricity. Matter itself is only energy vibrations. Every muscular movement, nerve impulse or thought, results in a vibration or wave. We are subjected to various kinds of waves from the sun and cosmic rays from outer space and we do not know the rate these play in our lives. We live in a world surrounded by invisible forces, and physics has shown that there is much present, that our physical senses are unable to perceive or conceive. For example, in the electro-magnetic spectrum all we can perceive is the very narrow band of visible light.

Throughout the ages many people have had the ability to produce paranormal phenomena by means other than through the physical senses. Many were esteemed as prophets oracles or medicine men, and others were feared and ostracised as witches, sorcerers or associates of the devil.

Examination of psychic reports show a significant proportion so well witnessed and documented, that only the most stubborn person would refuse to recognise them as being beyond the normal.

There are two main factors in all E.S.P. experiences :-

for they have time and space relations; but they are not material in character, as they are not limited to such relations. For example, recognition is not limited by time, it is a process of directly seeing the future as we do the past.

Rev. Franklin Loehr of Princeton University, holder of a degree in Divinity, and an Honors Science degree in chemistry, conducted 3 years ago of intensive research, under strict laboratory control, to determine if prayer had any measurable influence on plant growth. His discoveries were, that prayer is a power as real as sunlight or electricity and that it is a material emanation. He proved that plants, when prayed over grew much better than the control plants which were not.

Peter Hurkos, a Dutchman, known as the man with the radar brain, is like a psychic machine. According to researchers who have observed him for two years, his predictions for the future were 90% accurate. In one experiment a Dutch telepathist, Harry Stone, would hold up an object and 40 miles away Hurkos would identify it with 86% accuracy. To prove his E.S.P. power was not due to electromagnetic radiation, he was placed in a copper lined Faraday cage which prevented electrical impulses from penetrating the walls. In this case, tests proved him to be 95% accurate in his predictions.

Theodor Serios on August 13th, 1963, in a Toronto T.V. Studio, by staring into the lens of a camera produced pictures on photographic negatives by mental means. The film and camera were obtained from fresh stock from two different sources, and the test performed in the studio before reputable witnesses. What he does is psychokinesis.

Most Australians are aware of the ability of our aborigines to transmit thoughts to others, hundreds of miles away, as they are very primitive, the constant struggle for survival has sharpened their faculties. Dr. Elkin, an anthropologist of Sydney University, was surprised by his experiences with these natives. In each camp he visited in his researches, they not only knew of his imminent arrival, but what he was doing and where he had been previously. Investigations had proven that this had not been done by physical means and the natives explained that thoughts could be transmitted by the power of thought alone.

The clairvoyance and divination of natives in South Africa have been confirmed by numerous authorities, as well as the remarkable psychic powers of natives witch doctors. Most of us are familiar with the stories of firewalkers, natives in various parts of the world, notably Japan, Fiji, Tahiti, India and Africa. These people are able to walk on fire unharmed, and no one knows how it is done.

Folklore has given information of certain substances which are used to induce paranormal states. Vision producing substances produced a trance like state, and produced visions and hallucinations which were used to foretell the future.

In recent years our own medical science has come up with various hallucigen type drugs such as L.S.D. and mescaline which give very similar effects.

E.S.P. or Parapsychology - Contd.

This is the study of psychedelics and parapsychologists are particularly interested in the psychic side of these induced psychedelic revelations, in the hope that supervised testing will open up the secrets of E.S.P. There is always the chance that psychic phenomena, E.S.P. and visions may be explained in part by chemical influences on the human mind and body. It is quite obvious that these are very powerful and dangerous substances and should only be used under the strictest supervision by highly trained personnel.

E.S.P. is frequently an undeveloped power which with training could produce highly significant phenomena. Records of parapsychology are full of instances where people have tried to suppress these powers mainly because they are frightened of it. Yet when given free rein, the most startling results have been achieved, especially in the field of clairvoyance. It is a talent which can be improved by practice. All of us, irrespective of race and geographical location, possess it in some degree, though usually it is a latent power.

If you have hunches which continually come true, or if coincidences become routine, you are definitely sensitive to paranormal impressions. Some, who have this power can only produce it in certain moods - relaxed or half asleep or when stimulated by a critical situation, or shock.

Freud has said that telepathy may have been the original prehistoric means by which individuals understood each other.

It is a strange fact that all books on E.S.P. seem to gravitate eventually to speculation on life of the mind after bodily death; and communication with minds that have passed over the barrier. Modern science has not yet applied its methods to the problem of whether or not man's personality involves any element which can survive bodily death.

While belief or not in this is a highly personal matter, E.S.P. MAY be the alternative to communication with a hereafter. If mediums do not receive their information from a spirit world, then their information must come from some other supernatural E.S.P. source.

Research at Duke University into mediumistic data showed that spirit contacts, apparently communicating through a medium, were dramatic creations of the mediums own subconscious mind, making use of information picked up by E.S.P. means.

E.S.P. is not supernatural, magical or involving diabolical agencies, although it is beyond what we accept as normal at present; but it IS subject to established natural laws.

Nowadays, psychologists and psychiatrists have discarded the Freudian theory that prophetic dreams are merely wish fulfilments, and are studying these dreams reported by patients, to find such dreams not only puzzling, but convincing and enlightening. They also state that, when in dreams a person has a vivid picture of a place or event so much so that one says it was so clear and vivid I could almost believe I was there, then that person actually was there, in the subconscious state. Evidence is mounting that the body

does have an astral state; and strange as it may seem, these are the opinions of orthodox scientists, not the members of some esteric occult society.

In our own times, we have seen ancient dreams of the magical become technical realities. We can disbelieve the major part of reported prophetic claims, but to be honest, we cannot disbelieve all of it. There is too much evidence, following patterns too similar to be discounted, from all over the world. It is not sufficient, as yet, to maintain any sort of hypothesis about prophetic experience, because we know too little to give a final judgement; but we do know too much to ignore the challenge of precognitive E.S.P.

The recognition of the natural laws behind E.S.P. and the knowledge of just how to bring these higher powers of the mind under conscious control, will be man's next great upward step in progress. Perhaps this true knowledge of the mind will eventually bring about the dream of the universal brotherhood of man.

You, no doubt wondering what all this has to do with U.F.O.'s.

There have been numerous occasions when contacts have allegedly obtained information by telepathic means. It has also been suggested that sightings have been projections of mind pictures; or the observer has seen something when his mind has been controlled by external forces.

There can be no doubt that some alleged sightings have been due to self hypnosis or wish fulfilment due to the subject's strong desire to see a U.F.O.

Opinion in U.F.O. circles throughout the world is becoming convinced that much of the phenomena is analogous to E.S.P.

Aime Michel advised that in U.F.O. research you think of everything, and believe nothing.

Investigators have almost without exception rejected the claims of E.S.P. and its implications in U.F.O. phenomena, and it is literally only within the past few months that some overseas researchers have begun to change their opinions.

Just what has been uncovered in the past 20 years in the way of hard cold facts? Precious little!

Isn't it time to look at all reports with a completely open mind, and investigate the evidence whether we agree or not with the feasibility of such. Nor does it matter if it is at odds with present orthodox scientific theories. In the past most scientific breakthroughs have been accomplished against current scientific theories and not through them.

So who can tell, perhaps from one of these apparently way out postulates may come the answer which we have all been seeking.

 WHEN THE WORLD PRAYED TOGETHER.

The above was the title of an article the Editor had begun in relation to the safe return of the Apollo 13 Moon Mission. However a paper from the Perth UFO Society reached him that day and he places the adapted version of it in its place.

How often man turns his eyes to heaven when he is in difficulty; how often has his heart cried out for help when he has appeared to be rushing towards his so called doom. Yet many people who were so deeply moved by the plight of the Apollo 13 astronauts, at other times would scoff at the thought of prayer being "received", evaluated and dealt with according to its merits". Perhaps this does reduce a Divinely-given faculty to a somewhat material level, but, if the Deity to whom prayer is directed is a just God (and of course He must be), then we must expect the "pro's and con's" to be weighed, and action taken accordingly.

Looking broadly at the mission of Apollo 13, with this in mind, one must deduce from the known facts that whilst the lives of the 3 astronauts were not lost, something was radically wrong with the mission itself. There was no secret for instance, about the fact that the third stage of Saturn V, rocket which lifted the whole complex of the Apollo craft from its launching pad at Cape Kennedy, was carried into space and placed upon a 'collision course' with the Moon so that the scientists could measure the effect of the impact through instruments left on the Moon's surface by the Apollo 12 astronauts. Maybe the Apollo 13 mission was intended to let-off other explosives charges, or, if not than perhaps a later mission was planned to do this.

The Moon is necessary to Earth's stability; it is needed to provide balance for the daily rotation, just as it contributes its "mass factor" to the overall balance within the Solar system .. and particularly to the attraction-repulsion forces which maintain the Earth-Moon orbit around the Sun. The Moon's life-force has been withdrawing for a very long time leaving a desolate, lifeless surface. The important point however is that as the life-force withdraws to the centre of the body, all the outer layers become dust and ash. But, in the case of the Moon, a degree of re-activation was applied some considerable time ago which returned a measure of solidity to parts of the surface because it was seen that the Moon would be useful as a stepping-stone to the progress of Man of Earth out into the System .. and beyond. Now, it is obvious that any shock applied to the Moon's body would disturb the whole structure, particularly the lifeless portions; an explosion of the magnitude contemplated could cause

IS APRO A "COVER UP" FOR C.I.A.'S HAND IN UFOLOGY?

APRO'S Directors have denied any ties to CIA and the Pentagon with vehemence in their July Aug. 1968 (page 6) Bulletin . Otherwise shows APRO excellent ties to the South American military "UFO scenery". In so far that APRO'S Directors themselves mention " most co-operative and open " officials, in their regard to their visit in Aug. 1967 to the Argentine UFO project of the Navy, and also the visit of their (fulltime employed) Assistant Director Mr. Richard Greenwell to both, the Argentine Navy and Airforce (UFO) projects, (both in downtown Buenos Aires) as stated as page 2 of their March April 1969 Bulletin.

One of the Directors (C.L.) when on a visit to Colorado (The UFO study project of USAF and Prof Condon) in Oct. 1967 " discussed there the possibility of the University (of Colorado) there receiving official UFO reports of the -unidentified category- from the Argentine Navy, with APRO and the translating go-between."

WHAT IS APRO'S OPINION ABOUT THE UFO SILENCE POLICY ?

APRO'S Directors reason in chaoter " UFO and CIA " on page 195 (Signet. New York) of their book " UFO'S OVER AMERICA " that, " Where witnesses are harassed over unlisted phones, or where the silncers drive automobiles with un-issued lincense plates, however, (it) is not easy to blame amateurs.

The type and quality of " authentication " envolved suggests the work of professional intelligence officers and/or agents! In the same book on P 183 they state " We (at APRO) feel that UFO information is withheld through the application of normal national security procedures since there is no reason why these procedures should be set aside in the case of the UFO.

A STEP UP IN SILENCING ON THE MOON .

News have filtered to the World Press that the astonauts on their way to the Moon have seen UFOs and photographed them also. Rumours in our world of Science have it that photographs have been taken of the back side of the Moon , which prove the existance of some water, atmosphere and some domed bases of UFO-Nauts. Violence begets violence.. and so, if we wish to seek God's help in time of need then we MUST respect His Property, for the Law that governs the 'reaping of the Harvest , according to the seeds sown ' applies universally . Even at this moment exploratory vessels are on their way towards the planet Venus, their courses set for a crash-landing on the surface . BRUCE CATHIE PROVES MORE THAN MATCH FOR SCIENTIFIC CRITICS OF "HARMONIC 33"

(From: TOPSIDE, Canada, Number 33, Winter and Spring, 1970.)

As was to be expected, the publication, against all odds, of Bruce Cathie's book "Harmonic 33" rocked the Scientific Establishment to its foundations and a few of the more courageous members of this profession dared to openly criticize it - only to be suitably scalped by the author, who had done his homework very thoroughly and was able to talk back at them in their own language of mathematics! We are indebted to the New Zealand Airlines Pilots' association for permission to publish the following account of one such encounter, as it appears in the Oct. 1969 issue of their journal "ALPA".

"It is not often that an active airline pilot writes a book and a successful one at that. The honour falls here to Captain B.L. Cathie with his "Harmonic 33" which to date is about to enter into its 4th edition. Although this controversial publication has already been widely read by N.Z. pilots, because there seemed to be a nice intangibility to both non-matter and U.F.O.'s, the Editor presented a copy to his twin brother, Dr. David King, both for his interest and in the hope of gaining a reasonably authoritative review. This, he was persuaded to do within the limits of his field, for besides his position on the faculty of the University of Tennessee as Professor of physics, he is Director of Union Carbide's Research Laboratory at Oak Ridge where, during World War 11, the first practical atomic reactor was built and today it is a national monument. Dr. King expressed himself verbally as lost in admiration for Capt. Cathie's enthusiasm in attempting a treatise on such a subject as an amateur, but nevertheless gave the following criticism.

"In making a contribution to the literature of U.F.O.'s, Capt. Cathie is aware (p. 205) of the close scrutiny to which the Condon group has subjected all published U.F.O. reports. Since the findings of the Condon group lead to scepticism regarding visitors from outer space, it behoves a writer in this subject area to be extremely careful. Regretfully, Capt. Cathie has not exercised this care. He blithely dismisses the notion of meteoric impact origin for terrestrial craters similar to that near Winslow, Arizona (p. 37, 39) thereby denying a large body of conclusive analysis. The further suggestion (p. 43) that Lake Pontchartrain, La. has arisen from some kind of explosion is untenable. The author is on safer ground in discussion the possible nuclear nature of energy release in the 1908 Tunguska explosion (p. 41), since the annihilation of a 1-lb. antimatter meteorite (p. 201) in the atmosphere would be equivalent to a 3-megaton TNT detonation. On this basis, it is unnecessary to invoke a visiting Saucer or attribute any special significance to the locations in diagram 2 (p. 98). Another body of misleading material is contained in Ch. 8 where it is averred that the triggering of nuclear reactions is dependent on geometric position and solar altitude. This is so contrary to common experience of criticality in fissile material as to require no comment.

"It is appropriate here to remark on books in which the theme is developed through mathematical reasoning. With such a powerful mode of expression, it is a clear responsibility of the publishers and their referees to ensure that the derivations are relevant and correct. Presumably their editor would expunge misspellings and split infinitives, by the same token he should remove - $\log 2948 = 4,695$ (p. 95) - and if the author protests, the

publisher should thereupon refuse to publish. With a text containing some hundreds of such mis-statements and other mathematical non-sequiturs, the publisher has plainly been derelict in his function."

Such a dismissal of the author's work sounded a little gruff from an ordinarily kind man. This prompted the Editor to ask Capt. Cathie if he had any comment as to its publication. He had.

"My reply to this is that I am not angry, worried or afraid of such a report and do not object to its publication as I am absolutely sure of the basic facts and postulations presented in my book. If I was worried by adverse reactions, I would not have written it. With due respect to Dr. King and his academic qualifications, his reaction is as I would expect from a scientist at Oak Ridge because the same reaction has been received from the scientific community of New Zealand. The fact that a layman, such as myself, has dared to encroach into their scientific backyard, has sent a wave of indignation and resentment through their ranks. I believe this attitude to be childish. As far as I am concerned, any one of them is welcome to fly an aeroplane if he has the ability to get it off the ground, I am sure of my facts because of the following reasons:-

1. The Condon Report - It was generally known round the world before the Condon Report was completed that 2 of the scientists had resigned from the committee because a memorandum came to light which directed the chairman to issue a negative finding at the conclusion of the investigation. The report was a complete wast of \$500,000 of public money and was intended to reduce the interest of the public in U.F.O. activity. Because of the Condon Report, Dr. King says I should be careful - I have been careful, Dr. King. Careful not to be hoodwinked by a half-million dollar scientific charade.
2. Large Craters - I stated that these craters were not caused by meteoritic impact. Some of your own scientists agree with this and state that some of them were caused by explosions from under the ground. I am supposed to bow to the "large body of conclusive evidence" of the scientists which postulates their meteoric origin. Possibly it was this same large body of scientists who proved conclusively that it was impossible for a heavier than air machine to leave the ground. I make my living comfortably by flying one of these highly sophisticated impossibilities.
3. Augusta Explosion, 1908 - Russian scientists agree with me in theory that this was caused by the disintegration of a space vehicle of some sort. I have further evidence of this which I will publish in my next book. Be prepared for another haemorrhage.
4. Atomic Disintegration - The triggering of an atomic explosion by the geometric positioning of the device and geometric alignment of the sun-earth relationship you dismiss with a haughty "No comment". I have on record in a Government Department in New Zealand, the fact that I can precalculate the times of atomic explosions by geometric method from the U.F.O. grid. I have also just completed a series of calculations for an American scientist, each of which was correct. A large number of

atomic test sites have been checked and all positions correspond with the geometric co-ordinates of the angular velocity of light and gravity acceleration. For example, Bikini and Eniwetok Islands are both 695 minutes of arc North latitude. 695 is the reciprocal of the angular velocity of light, as postulated in my book. Johnson Island is 169.5 West Longitude. Need I go on?

5. I was informed during an interview at the United States Embassy in Wellington that at Wright Patterson Airfield in the U.S., a scientific base has been established since the early 1950s for the purpose of U.F.O. research. The laboratory is staffed by top scientists and work is carried on round the clock, 365 days a year.
6. I was also informed at a subsequent interview at the Embassy that my grid theory is correct, this, of course will be denied.
7. A check of the positioning of many scientific stations round the world will show their correlation with the harmonic geometric co-ordinates derived from the U.F.O. grid, which proves without doubt that the scientists are aware of the system.
8. I have been asked twice if I can be bought off; I have been warned twice to stop my investigations.
9. From study of the grid, I have discovered the harmonic equation for anti-gravity, which is as follows; Anti-gravity Harmonic = $(2c + v \frac{1}{2c}) (2c)^2$ where 'c' = the harmonic of the angular velocity of light. The anti-gravity harmonic derived from the unified equation is equal to $\pi/8$ or 3926990817. This I will fully explain in my next book, "The Harmonics of Anti-Gravity".
10. Finally I will say, Dr. King, that scientists who work in glass laboratories should not throw academic bricks at the occasional layman, such as myself, who dares to look more closely at your scientific manipulations. If you check the geometric position of your physics laboratory at Oak Ridge, you find the co-ordinates are:

Latitude 36 °	01.647'	North
Longitude 84 °	12'	West
Log sine 36 °	01.647'	= 7.7695
	84 ° 12'	= 84.2 °
	Log 695	= 842 (in grid harmonics)

And as stated before, the geometric value of 695 is the reciprocal of the angular velocity of light in a harmonic sense. It's in the book, Doctor.

 ANTI-GRAVITY WORK TIED UP WITH U.F.O.
 TAURANGA TIMES N.Z. MOUNT MANGANUI.

Secret scientific work was going on in New Zealand in connection with the anti-gravity system -- established by the U.F.O. - in an effort to harness unlimited power which could revolutionise the world.

This claim was made at Mt. Manganui yesterday afternoon by NAC pilot, Capt. B.L. Cathie, of Auckland, who is regarded as NZs leading authority on UFO.

Four years ago Capt Cathie published a book on UFOs in which he theorised on the way the objects travelled. In the book he plotted main areas of UFO sightings on a world map. When the areas were linked up they formed a grid system of intriguing mathematical planning.

This grid, Capt. Cathie believes, is in fact an anti-gravity system with inexhaustible powers which UFOs harness. He thinks it is likely that the grid comprising of hundreds of stations set up at strategic points which radiate anti-gravitational harmonics or waves - is an ancient UFO power network.

The Capt. told a Bay of Plenty Times reporter that when he first wrote the book he was really building his theory of UFOs around the reliable information that was available of sightings.

"I put my theories into the book believing I could be 50 per cent right, but since then I've found that scientists are in on it. This has really convinced me."

Capt. Cathie said that he knew for a fact that there were two scientific groups involved. However, he would not elaborate further, saying he was on very touchy ground.

Later he did shed some light though when he said the experiments into the grid system were not N.Z. backed, "but were coming from an outside source another country".

"Every country that has exploded an atomic bomb has access to the anti-gravitational secrets," he said.

He believed it likely that some of the world's scientists knew in theory the secret of anti-gravity and free power, but because technology was not yet up to scratch experimentation was necessary.

Earnest and very serious, the captain said that a year after the publishing of his book he got a shock when he discovered that there was man-made equipment built into the mathematical grid system he had discovered.

At many of the intersecting points of the N.Z. grid he had found stations all of similar design. From that he assumed that 100 p.c. the system actually exists", he said. and the mere fact that this man-made gear has been built up over a number of years, means that the scientists have had knowledge of it for a long time, perhaps even over 30 years. "

Cpt. Cathie said he had evidence of 35 of these throughout N.Z. and he expected

However, thank heavens that there are many hundreds of thousands of people all over the world who have the power of their own convictions, and are able to assess things for themselves. They know that Flying Saucers are real and that it will need a lot more than Government baffle-gab to convince them otherwise.

Thinking people read accounts of how the U.S. Government is setting up bases throughout the world, in collaboration with other Western Powers, ostensibly to study aspects of Space defence. Those same people read between the lines and get a pretty good idea of what this "Space Defence" is really about. No doubt the stations' expressed function is to track American Space probes, and also to keep tabs on any Soviet spy satellites which might happen along, but what about the perspicacious Flying Saucer? Whereas the evidence of sightings from some ordinary members of the community, can often be discounted, it is very hard to disbelieve the factual testimony of serious minded scientists, particularly when supported by masses

of documented proof.

Unfortunately there is a minority of the scientific fraternity who are either disbelievers in the phenomena or, who have been subjected to pressures by their Governments, and therefore issue evaluations of U.F.O. Sightings, which are often quite contrary to their own private opinions.

This is the way, of course, in which "Project Blue Book" would seem to have been conducted for most of the time since its inception. Banal, and often ludicrous statements appeared to be the usual order of the day. Such ridiculous things as accusing seasoned air-line pilots of confusion Venus with a highly manouvable U.F.O. or perhaps Radar crews, mistakenly identifying the blip that moves across their screen at approximately 9,000 miles an hour, with a conventional flight of wild geese!

I personally am of the opinion that the personnel who worked in the office of P.B.B. were not allowed to freely express their own sentiments on the subject, and at all times were bound by U.S. Government classification regulations.

Mind you, these are my own opinions, right or wrong, quite conceivably they might also agree with many of my reader's ideas.

It now remains to be seen as to whether the U.S. Government is sincere in its statement that U.F.O.'s do not exist, or, initiates further public investigation of the phenoma at a later date.

Time will tell on this matter; I await future developments with interest to see what their excuse will be, when and if, they decide to start up again.

there were many others.

From the description he had been given he believed another station had just been found— this time in the Tauranga area.

A Fokker Friendship pilot, one of many in New Zealand. who has been on the look out for stations sighted some possible apparatus only last week, the captain said. He had to investigate it while in the Tauranga area.

Describing the grid as a "free power" system, Capt. Cathie said that once scientists had learned to harness it, it would make every source of power now known to man obsolete, and would revolutionise space travel because rocket power would no longer be needed.


This was why the experiments and all knowledge of the system were being suppressed. However behind the suppression he believes is the weight of vested interests rather than governments. Capt. Cathie claims that attempts had been made to buy him off and he had been warned not to continue with his investigations. It was a conviction that knowledge of such an immense nature should be given to the world and not secretly held by one or more countries that was keeping him probing and publishing what he found.

MAGNETIC FLIGHT By Paul Johnson.

This principle is based on the magnetic attraction of the planet's own gravitational field.

The Craft (Fig. 1.) has six sections. all of which can change the polarity very quickly . eg.- (section 2.)



- (1) The Planet Earth . Northern hemishpere.
- (2) Earth's gravittational field
- (3) North pole.
- (4&5) The ship leaves the northern hemishpere by making it's body north so as the magnetic pole throws it off.
- (5) Half of the ship faces North or south poles of the moon.
If the ship wishes to go north the poles correspond. or vice versa.
This drags it forward , or it can apply to any planet or star depending on the rate of speed . flight path or magnetic attraction of same.
- (6) The forward flight path of the craft towards the moon.
- (7) A complete change in flight direction . The two ends of the craft as well as the top become north , and the bottom south .
The front(north) repels from the moon as well as the bottom of the craft (south).
(The south of the ship repels from the south pole , while the end of the(north) propells it forward .
The top as well as the sides (which have been neutral up this stage) attract too the south pole of Mars.
- (8) The changed flight path toward the planet Mars.

This craft needs a fantastic amount of power to magnify the fields, so much as to attract the ship in such a way .

The above is a thesis by a high school member of our Society who has created many models some of which have aroused some interest among aeronautical folk.

At the age of 14 one can hardly expect him to state how such a fantastic power could be generated. but maybe it would be wise to test it even if he knew. judging by a few past experiences. known to the Editor also.

SOUTH AUSTRALIAN SIGHTINGS. - A.E. BRAN.

Mr. Richard Cocks of Elizabeth South has a very strange and interesting story to tell of a sighting made by him and his wife, in the early hours of the morning, on the second Sunday of March, 1965.

This happened several years ago as you can see, but his story seems so well authenticated and Mr. Cocks so sincere in his statement that I pass it on for your interest.

It was 1 a.m. on a fine, warm starry night, when Mr. Cocks went out to his kitchen to get a drink. He happened to look out of his kitchen windows when to his surprise he saw a strange craft approaching his house at an approximate altitude of 100 feet, and about 10 m.p.h. It appeared to follow the course of the Grand Junction Road until it reached a railway crossing, where it hovered at about 90 feet altitude.

It appeared to be 35-40 feet in diameter, discoid in shape with portholes on the "under-belly" which emitted a pale blue light. A red and a green navigation light was visible to either side of the craft, and a strong blue-white spot light with very clear cut edges was playing directly beneath the craft onto the rail crossing!

Mr. Cocks awoke his wife and they both left their house and approached the craft, albeit somewhat frightenedly. The saucer, (a sketch of which appears with this article) was a dull metallic grey with clearly defined edges, delineated perfectly in the reflected glow of its spot-light. As it hovered it emitted a low humming noise something like a spinning top, although Mr. Cocks assures us that there did not appear to be any moving parts on the outside of the craft.

With Mrs. Cocks indulging in a slight fit of hysterics, Mr. Cocks walked towards the craft raising his arms in salute and calling out a Welcome to earth!

Unfortunately the crafts occupants did not apparently share Mr. Cocks sentiments, for the spot light went out in a flash and the craft shot up into the air at a fantastic speed, causing not one speck of disturbance on the ground!

Apart from a frustrated Mr. Cocks and his hysterical wife!

Another sighting report from Mr. Cocks occurred on 17th March of this year, at 8.45 p.m. and lasted for 150 secs.

He, his son Paul and young friend David Harris, (Mrs. Cocks being unfortunately deceased) were sitting in their lounge, when looking out the window, they observed a bright orange ball travelling from North to South across the sky.

The object which also had a red light, forward, was approximately the size of a ten cent coin, and moved very fast across the sky, disappearing at length behind a row of trees.

The wind at that time was from the East, so Mr. Cocks assures us that he feels it could not be a weather balloon, and as it was much larger than a satellite it would seem to disprove that theory also.

A peculiar coincidence in this latest sighting is that it occurred at approximately the same time of the month of March as the previous occurrence 5 years before. I wonder if they are related?
