

In the news

Decloaking UFO's?

A silvery vision of a dozen balloon-like dots hovering in yesterday's clear-blue sky over West 23rd Street in Manhattan had thousands speculating the mysterious objects might be UFOs.

Callers began phoning the NYPD and Federal Aviation Administration at 1:30 p.m. with reports of the strange, silver objects high in the sky.

"Some people saw something described as yellow with blue lights surrounding it," said FAA spokesman Jim Peters. He added that if the objects were weather balloons -- as some suggested -- his agency had no prior notification they'd be launched.

Witness Daniel Calhoun, 52, admitted, "Common sense says it wasn't a UFO.

Common sense says it was a plane or a balloon, but this thing stopped everyone in the street for two blocks. Any New Yorker will tell you, that alone is extraordinary."

Pete Bryant, 32, said, "I saw five or six lights shining in the sky. There was no way that thing was a balloon.

"There was something weird about it. Light just doesn't reflect off balloons like that. "If Martians were to land anywhere, New York is a much better location than some backwoods town in the Midwest."

Tim Powell, 28, described the objects as "the most bizarre thing I've ever seen."

"It looked like a jellyfish made of lights that just hovered in the sky like it wanted to be seen," he said. "I was half expecting the aliens to beam down and introduce themselves." And Richard Molina, 42, compared what he saw to the "creatures from 'Predator.' " "It freaked me out. It was a real Superman moment, too," he said. "Everyone looked up in the sky. It really was an event."



Chirton Bottom near Urchfont

16th June, 2010

This amazing design has intricate detailing on the ground. It lies on land right on the edge of the busy Salisbury Plain (Ministry of Defence) Army training ground. This time on the North side (another previously at **Codford St Peter** lies to the south of the Plain).

This intricate design has some outstanding features on the ground. See the pictures opposite of 'nests' woven centrally in some circles and the multiple areas of standing crop left upright in the centre of others.

Its position is also interesting. The area above the formation is the massive army training ground that reaches from here South towards Salisbury (Salisbury Plain). It has live firing areas and a constant stream of training vehicles and aircraft maneuvering in the area day and night.

The design is in barley and measures approx. 400ft long by 220 ft wide and consists of the basic underlying 'vesica pieces' (two overlapping circles) with a chain pattern making the figure of eight within.




SIGHTING REPORTS

PENRITH NSW JUNE 2010

Around 4.30pm on Monday 14th June, my daughter and I were in a car travelling along Elizabeth Drive west towards Penrith. The sun was setting and it was a clear sky. My daughter looked up to my right and said, "What's that, up in the sky?" I looked up and saw an object that was round and white with a trail. We kept track of it as it headed towards the Blue Mountains. This object was not a jet plane, it did not change altitude and you could see the trail.

TRUNDLE NSW MARCH OR APRIL 1952

I was earth moving near Trundle NSW in either March or April 1952. At about 4.30AM one morning as I was about to begin work, I had a sighting that I have never forgotten. The skyline was just beginning to show the beginning of daylight, when I saw an object I thought resembled a sausage shaped balloon, only larger, floating slowly across the skyline, partially disappearing behind some peaks and rises in the terrain. As I watched, it ever so slowly floated across the horizon; I could see it had many windows along the side as it travelled from west to east. After watching it for about 2 minutes I woke up the other worker who had just retired to sleep. He looked out of the window and also saw the object for about 20 seconds and agreed with me that it appeared to be an airship of some substance.

The following weekend while talking to some friends, one man announced that there had been an article and picture in the Sunday Newspaper of the very same object, sighted in another area.

Noraville

My husband and I were sitting out on the beach that adjoins to the hotel we were staying at watching the sky when something we previously thought was a fairly bright star started to move. It moved up and down, side to side at quite a pace, stopping suddenly. It also looped a fair amount of times as we were watching. When planes or shooting stars arced through the sky, it would still itself, almost blending in like any other star. We were wondering about the possibility of pilots being trained at night, or a helicopter, but there were none of the usual sounds or blinking lights visible that you would associate with either of those. We sat watching this for about 2 hrs before going back inside. When we came out again at about 12am, it was still there, but in another part of the sky.

It looked to be almost playful, and upon closer inspection, it did look to be that there was another small moving object (! though, admittedly, I cannot say 100% for sure, but the main one was definitely moving). By the time we walked up to have another look, it had shot off to another part of the sky to our left, and we stayed out until about ten past one in the morning watching it until it had become barely visible anymore. During our last stay, we had not heard a single dog barking, but that night, there was an especially upset dog that seemed to react to this thing moving.

RazorBack

As the sun had set I decided to go outside and put my dogs in the garage for the night where they sleep. I called my dogs and noticed it strange that they were at the top of the driveway which is quite long. I knew they were there as my white dog glows in the dark and I could see here running as I called her. As I watched the dogs run down the driveway I saw a bright white light appear out of the corner of my eye and appear to cut the sky in a perfectly straight line and then disappear. The sighting lasted only seconds and was definitely not a shooting star. The sky was clear and I heard no noises coming from the light at all. I have a friend that I contacted immediately after what I saw who is a member of your organisation and he suggested I report what I saw to you. To be honest I have never really believed in such sightings or actually was probably too scared to think they existed. After this evening I am convinced that what I saw was something other than a Airplane or shooting star. I would be interested to hear if anyone else reports it as well. I live on top of Razorback mountain on the Donalds Range ride side and have never experienced anything like this before.




IN REVIEW

The book, one of an anticipated eleven Volumes catalogues reports carried out by us into sightings of strange objects in the sky, (UFOS) going back to the 1940's

One of the reasons why I (John Hanson) decided to take on this mammoth task was the denigrating way in which the media dealt with the UFO subject, rather than taking it seriously, at the end of the day I do not know any answers but I believe it is important to preserve such historical information for posterity.

Over the space of 16 years we have compiled and catalogued over 80K

Special Review

“Hands off”

One of our members received a very strange set of photographs – unlike any other the Society has been presented with in the last few years. Instead of images of lights in the sky or apparitions on a dark night, these were of a particular hand print that the photographer couldn't explain. Here is the report and the images so you can see and hear first hand....



Time: 4.44pm
Date: 13th July 2010
Location: Narrandera. NSW.

“At 4.44pm on the 13th July 2010 in a building located in Narrandera NSW, a handprint was discovered on a window pane. It was not noted whether the handprint was internal or external but the location was very difficult to access. The building is a renovated house that has later been used as a business residence and the window is located within a bathroom. The bathroom is on the second floor of the building and would require intelligent navigation to scale, excellent balance skills to press on the window and then descend. That is if the handprint was external.

The photographer returned to the room the next morning, to see whether the handprint was still there, it was not. By 9am on the 14th July 2010 the impression was completely not evident; in short it had been removed.



I feel it is relevant to note that the photographer is a believer in spirit beings and has a family member who is a contactee and an unawakened life long experiencer. The photographer and immediate family members are comfortable with the sharing of their evidence and experience but have chosen to remain anonymous to avoid sightseers.

While investigating the handprint evidence two independent witnesses agreed that the handprint did not appear to be that of a human being. One independent witness is a scientist with medical training that includes extensive knowledge of the human body and in particular anatomy. The second independent witness needs evidence to support a belief in Intergalactic Visitors but felt the handprint was not immediately recognisable as human and begged answers and investigation to reveal the true identity of the visitor responsible for making and leaving the handprint.

The impression on first inspection does not clearly resemble a handprint of a human being. It does however have similarities such as a palm area and extensions, just like fingers. What should be noted is the length of the extensions/fingers, they are all similar in length however human beings have fingers of varying lengths. The two outer fingers do not appear to resemble human fingers in that, where the human opposable thumb would be located is a long extension that appears to be without a ball joint, as knuckles are on a human hand.

Please examine the evidence and draw your own conclusions. I believe an Intergalactic Visitor left a calling card, as it were, a peaceful sign of their presence. No damage, no violence, no threat and at sometime afterward they even cleaned the window. I believe the Intergalactic Visitor who left the handprint on the window is an intelligent and friendly being - what do you believe?"

FACTFINDER



The Facility: In April 2009 I accompanied the group during an investigation at the Facility.

This investigation was one of the most productive I had been on. During this investigation Kellie picked up an individual who seemed rather agitated, but gave very precise details of his name and place and time of death.

We began the investigation by just having a walk-through of the various buildings that make up the facility. After this we set up the equipment in the area that we had decided to focus on for the main investigation, the area that was reportedly the most haunted.

It was then decided to head to another area of the facility while we waited for the time to pass. This area of the facility was used as the administration building during the life of the facility, and had also had strange happenings reported. We began walking through the rooms trying to pick up any spirits that may be present. It was when we were in an upstairs room that Kellie picked up a strong presence. She began to run, following the presence as it moved to different rooms in the building. The presence appeared to be very agitated.

Finally Kellie began to receive clear messages. She questioned the presence and received some very detailed answers. The spirit was that of a man who had died at the

facility. He gave his name, age and year of death.

For privacy reasons* I am unable to reveal the details, so we will call him 'R'. 'R' told Kellie that he had died at the Facility in the 1920s, and that his cause of death was a problem with his chest, but not heart trouble. Kellie asked him if it was a problem with his lungs and he replied "bronchitis".

The details he gave were so clear that I was able to find and purchase his death certificate. This confirmed his age and cause of death, as well as clarifying some other details that we had misunderstood at the time, such as his place of burial.

It was very satisfying to be able to verify so many details that this spirit had communicated to Kellie. There are several other details that were given by this presence that I am still checking from this investigation. Kellie also received an image of his appearance, and I am trying hard to track down any records that may exist that might have a photograph or physical description listed, so we can discover if the information received was accurate. 'R' was very agitated to begin with, but turned out to be very forthcoming when he finally settled down.
