UFO RESEARCH IN AUSTRALIA 1990

INTRODUCTION

Overall, 1990 in Australia has continued to see reports flowing in relatively low numbers when compared to the early seventies. However, as with many areas, there are contrasts. Keith Roberts of the Tasmanian UFO Investigation Centre advises that they received only about 40 calls in 1990, over 50% down on 1989. On the other hand Phillip Frola of UFO Research Queensland relates that they have had a bumper year for reports, over 100 in all. In one area there has definitely been a difference. You will find an increasing number of abduction cases being quietly investigated, details of some of which have been published in the monthly UFORA Research Digest.

Details of research work undertaken will be found later, following the individual cases reported.

CASES FROM THE NETWORK

UFORA89036 Life-long Adelaide SA CE4 Level A S5/P4

UFORSA has now released details of yet another life-long abduction case. Carol's story began in 1968 when at age 6 she saw, together with a teacher and the rest of the class, a large silver coloured, cigar shaped object at close range.

Following this in 1972 1 night on going to bed she felt she was being watched. Looking outside she thought she saw what she took to be a big white "cat" looking in at her. Under regression she described actually seeing a Non-human, male figure and not a cat. She found herself floating up into the sky where a "star" hovered. The star resolved itself into a large object. A hole appeared in its bottom and then she can not recall a period of time.

Next, she became aware of being in a room surrounded by orange light. A number of entities were present. The room smelled like a hospital. She found herself lying down on a table. 1 of the beings used a "big match" to place a mark on her right leg just above her knee. Telepathically she was told "It's alright. Won't be long. Won't hurt." Next thing she awoke in her own bed at home.

She described the being outside her bedroom as little, 4-5 feet tall. It had a white coloured body which glowed, and a big head in proportion to its body. There was a pointed chin, yellow eyes and a skinny body. The being standing closest to Carol when she was on the table was said to have a yellow coloured body with a big head and dark-black, almond shaped eyes.

Around 1972 a nightmare commenced which occurred time and time again until she was aged 16 in 1978. The nightmare featured a 4 foot tall dwarf with a grey coloured body. It had no hair, a round head, and its eyes were bigger than a human's. It had no visible ears or lips.

Later, in 1978 she, a friend and the friend's mother, grand-father and cousin stayed at a shack near Robe South Australia. The 2 girls were getting to sleep in a dark room when the room was lit by a brilliant white light which scared them. The light moved from 1 side of the shack to the other, on the outside. Following its cessation the girls ran to the mother and they believe several hours of time are missing. Her friend, whom I have interviewed, confirmed her involvement in this episode.

Carol, beside recalling this intense light, also has fragmentary recollections of some kind of "spheres" in the room on this occasion.

There is also a long time history of paranormal episodes in Carol's account. These involve poltergeists, out-of-the body experiences, telepathy, apparitions and clairvoyance. She has extremely good imagery skills, particularly eidetic and becomes very absorbed in activities to the exclusion of other stimuli.

Carol is married, age 27 and has a young son. 1 of her sisters has also experienced a very unusual dream involving yellow skinned men.

As with Susan's case, described in the last Digest, Carol is an adult survivor of childhood sexual abuse

and is currently in therapy for this. American psychologist Rima Laibow made mention of her observations about child abuse and abductees in the May/June 1989 issue of the IUR.

Budd Hopkins in his 1987 book "Intruders" makes much of a number of strange pregnancies which some of his abductees had experienced. Carol underwent an unusual pregnancy in 1988. Her menstruation ceased and she experienced sore breasts. Morning sickness set in and she had all the symptoms of pregnancy that were present when she was pregnant with her son. However, this was followed by two days of an unusual period and the pregnancy vanished.

She reports that the phenomena continue to date. (UFORSA).

UFORA90001 11 Dec 1989 Off Mandurah WA (1200-1300)hrs Med Level C S4/P4

Mr Barry Watkins, aged 50, together with 3 other men was setting cray pots about 14nm 300 degrees off Halls Head, WA. Sometime between 1200 and 1300hrs they noted an unusual object to their south, low down near the sea horizon. It was travelling westwards. White in colour, and dome shaped with a flat bottom to it, they watched in amazement as it moved horizontally through the sky. No noise was audible from the object although a strong south-westerly wind was blowing. The sky was clear and sunny at the time. Duration was between 1 and 2 minutes. (Joan Johnston).

UFORA90002 9 Dec 1989 Longford TAS Low Level B S1/P4

Mr Danny Cassidy was driving near Launceston when he saw an object over Longford. It was like an upside down T shape with 2 lights at the bottom and fading out at the top. He took a photograph of the object which was visible for 15 minutes. When processed the photograph revealed a very bright, oval shaped white spot in the cloudy night sky. Probably Venus. (TUFOIC).

UFORA90003 Dec 1989 Speed VIC CE2 Level A S3/P4

On Saturday 16 Dec 89 Bill Chalker advised us of an article in the Melbourne "Truth" concerning the

discovery of a number of unusual circles in a wheat crop. On the following day Keith Basterfield received a call from the wife of the property owner involved, who related details of the finding.

On about the 12 or 13 December, Brian Finch and Austin Grace were stripping wheat on the property of Max and Nancee Jolly when they spotted 2 swirled circles of wheat. These were some 3m in diameter, surrounded by 3 other circles some 1m across.

The wheat had been flattened and swirled anti-clockwise in each circle. Stalks were undamaged with grain matured on the heads.

Mrs Jolly told us of a number of possibly related incidents which had occurred in recent years. These included:-

* Nov 1987. Lights in the sky. 4000 litre water tank drained.

* Dec 1988. Son Stuart awoken by unusual noise which seemed to come from an empty sky.

* Aug 1989. Sheep disturbed. Pulsating yellow light hovered over paddock. High pitched noise audible.

On 18 Dec Bill spoke to Nancee and Stuart and ascertained that the story in the "Truth" was substantially correct although the date of the light in the sky report in 1989 might be incorrect. 5 circles were located in all. 2 had been cut during harvesting but were still evident. There is no direct correlation with a UFO event. The countryside involved is gently undulating, otherwise largely flat.

No one from the UFORA network was able to attend the site prior to Xmas, but VUFORS undertook an on site inspection, just after Xmas. Apparently further circles were found nearby. Bill's tentative conclusion was: "Interesting UFO activity, traces may not be relevant. There is no evidence to date directly linking them to UFO explanation." (Bill Chalker & Keith Basterfield).

UFORA90008 1980 onwards Adelaide and elsewhere SA CE4 Level A S4/P4

A woman has described a series of occurrences over the years. These involve sightings of nocturnal lights, telepathic communications, precognitive visions, a peak experience, a near death OBE, sleep paralysis and unexplained marks on the forehead which simply appeared one night. (K Basterfield and UFORSA).

UFORA90009 12 Jan 1990 Queenstown SA 2213hrs
Low Level C S1/P4

A meteor was the interpretation placed on the reported observation of a bright orange light in the northern sky. It had a grey/white trail behind it. (UFORSA).

UFORA90011 25 Jan 1990 Adelaide SA Low Level
C S1/P4

17 calls were received, including 1 from the South Australian police, about lights circling near/above clouds over the city. Laser lights associated with big fireworks display. (UFORSA)

UFORA90013 6 Jul 1980 Alice Springs NT Sunset
Med Level C S2/P4

Mr J C Disken, 72, his wife and 2 adult sons were standing on "Anzac Hill" watching the Sun set. Son Barry drew their attention to a brilliant light in the sky to the west. Through binoculars it appeared to be like 2 huge inverted saucers joined rim to rim, illuminated and stationary. It seemed to be rotating, then tilted and disappeared towards the west at incredible speed leaving a long white trail of vapour behind it. (Ken Hayes).

UFORA90014 14 Oct 1989 Geelong VIC 2000hrs
Low Level C S3/P4

A woman from Geelong related that she and her grand daughter, on a clear night, watched a faint pink light, high in the south-western sky. It zig-zagged several times. (Ken Hayes).

UFORA90015 11 Nov 1989 Geelong VIC 2130hrs
Low Level C S3/P4

On a Moonless night, with low altitude clouds, 2 people were travelling by car when 1 noted a "huge glowing ball of light." No sound was audible. They watched it for 10 minutes. (Ken Hayes).

UFORA90016 20 Jan 1990 Quobba WA 2230hrs
Low Level C S3/P4

21 year old Ben Patrick looked up and saw a golden coloured point source sized "flare" dropping towards

the sea. It then started to rise and then moved from side to side. It started flashing red/green/gold/white, then moved to the south, became a dull red and disappeared behind a hill at 20 degrees south-south-east. (Joan Johnston).

UFORA90017 25 Dec 1988 Quairading WA
2100hrs Med Level C S3/P4

A 12 year old girl relates that her attention was drawn to an unusual object high in the sky to the north. It was described as an orange disc about Moon sized, clearly outlined. It travelled across the sky at high speed and was lost to sight in the southern sky. There was no noise from it. (UFORA).

UFORA90018 NSW CE4?

A very complex account is unfolding of continuing nature, involving a possible close encounter, possible time loss and other experiences. (Bill Chalker).

UFORA90019 QB90002 1 Jan 1990 Malanda QLD
2050hrs Med Level A S4/P5

A couple noted that light was entering their bedroom window. The man involved looked out of the window and noted a light source to the north-west. At this time their 3 grandsons were watching television in the house, but no interference was seen on the TV. All 5 people then went outside where they saw a red oval light approach to a point 60 degrees elevation, then stop. Its distance at this point was estimated at 200m and its height at 450m. Although the object was very bright they could look at it without discomfort. Some 45m above this light mass was another smaller light, white in colour. Both moved as 1 unit. Some 30 seconds later the object moved away at about a 44 degree angle to its initial approach, and went over the horizon in 5-7 seconds. Total duration of event was 2 minutes. 2 other independent groups of people viewed the same object from nearby locations. (UFORFNQ).

UFORA90020 14 Jan 1990 Central QLD Night Low
Level B S3/P4

Residents of Maryborough, Rockhampton and Gladstone, amongst others, reported seeing "bright lights falling out of the sky". A Rockhampton policeman is reported to have been woken by a very

bright green light which lit up the sky and disappeared within 4 seconds. (UFORFNQ. "Cairns Post" 16.1.90.)

UFORA90021 17 Feb 1990 Canberra ACT 0515hrs
Low Level A S1/P5

Mr Zoran Ivanisevic went outside into his backyard and noted an unusual, soundless, object in the morning sky. It was at a low elevation in the east and was a very bright white colour with a red light on the left hand side. He returned inside to fetch his wife and a video camera, and filmed the object. After some 5 minutes, during which the object was stationary, they went inside. Upon going out again he found the object was no longer visible. However, he did say that clouds were moving in at the time. The video clip, which appeared on national television, initially shows a bright, white light. Then follows a second segment showing it as an almost round object with a hole in the centre and 2 'bites' out of the top and bottom. The witness did not report seeing both the UFO and the planet Venus which was brightness magnitude -4.6 at that time and low down in the east.

Further investigations, including the duplication of the video film taken, now lead to the conclusion that the observation and the film were almost certainly of the planet Venus. Ray Brooke of UFORSA video taped Venus one morning using his camera with the telephoto lens defocussed. The resultant images were an exact copy of the Canberra video film. (John Jensen).

UFORA90022 1987 Kellerberin WA 2300hrs Med
Level C S3/P4

A bright lights was noted hovering in the western sky, by a 44 year old man travelling by car. He stopped his car at the side of the road under trees and switched off the motor. It was a clear night and the object was described as circular, larger than a star, silver in colour, with red, orange blue and green lights about it, which were pulsating. Whilst he watched it he had left the car radio on and he noticed this was crackling. After sitting there for some 15 minutes he drove off and it took off in a southerly direction and was lost to view behind hills. He arrived home 20 minutes later shaking like a leaf. (UFORA).

UFORA90023 QA89016 29 Apr 1989 Deception Bay
QLD 1830hrs Med Level ? SP?

Two people witnessed a transparent cylindrical object with a red glow on the bottom, travel over their house towards the Samford Valley area. Duration 30 seconds. Weather was partly cloudy. (UFORQLD).

UFORA90024 QA89017 Ca 18 Jul 1990 Esk QLD
(1930-2000)hrs CE1 Level ? SP?

2 people were watching television in their mobile home when all the lights went out. A light was seen in the distance moving erratically. The next door neighbour's lights were also fading out. 1 witness, male, decided they should go the neighbour's house. The light seemed to be in a nearby paddock. When they were 10-12m from their door the light moved at speed, and stopped, hovering over them. The 2 witnesses ran under the object to get to their neighbours. The investigator's comment: "...there is a very good chance that this will turn out to be an abduction case..." (UFORQLD).

UFORA90025 TA90007 14 Feb 1990 Magra TAS
1045hrs Med Level B S3/P4

The witness was hosing down windows at her rural home, and her 3 year old son kept calling her to look at the thing in the sky. She finally did so and saw a white round shape against the clear blue sky. The shape then changed as the object moved toward the north-north-east. It appeared to be disc like as it wobbled or zig zagged away. It stopped in an instant, remained stationary for a few seconds, then gained elevation and disappeared in the north-north-east. No commercial aircraft were in the area. The weather was fine and calm, the overlaying and local wind patterns were light from the north-east to south-east. (TUFOIC).

UFORA90026 9 Sep 1989 Zanthus WA 2100hrs
Low Level B S1/P4

According to a report on Paranet, sourced from the Melbourne "Truth", the crew of a westbound passenger train going to Kalgoorlie WA reported an unusual observation, which included smoke "blacking out passenger windows" and causing the train driver to cough. Driver Lou Beccarelli was interviewed by Keith Basterfield and stated that he

was driving the train some 14km east of Zanthus WA at the time. He initially saw a pencil-shaped light in the western sky which appeared to come over the horizon and approach the train. It grew in size and appeared to be a series of lights with a white 'smoke' trail behind them. It passed to the north of the train. At closest approach it was visible as a line of 6 white lights. It was completely silent. Lou had enough time to walk over to the right hand window of the driver's cabin, and rolled down the window for a better look. He also then had time to call on the two way radio to the guard. Lou lost the object to sight when it continued to travel eastwards behind him. The total duration according to Lou was about a minute but the white 'smoke' hung in the air for about twenty minutes altogether. Lou said that Greg, the guard, said it had 'just disappeared', i.e. did not go over the eastern horizon.

Lou radioed Rawlinna, some 180km to the east but no-one there saw it. Later he heard it had been seen from:-

- * 80km north of Kalgoorlie, some 200km to the west of his position, and
- * At Merredin, some 550km west of Lou.

It was visible from all these locations at approximately 2100hrs with the same visual description, and lack of sound.

Lou was asked if the 'smoke' made him cough or covered passenger windows. He said this was completely untrue. There had been no interaction between the object and the train or crew.

In view of the data uncovered it would appear that the object was some distance away from the train, and high up. As in other reports of this nature, the indications are that it was a bright meteor entering the atmosphere. (UFORA).

UFORA90027 Dec 1989 Mt Newman WA Evening Med Level B S3/P4

One Friday night 2 people observed a star shaped light, coloured bright white and orange, which then disappeared behind trees. 1 person drove off to investigate and came upon a bright light with 2 separate orange lights, 1 on either side. He flashed the car's lights at it and it flashed back. The ute seemed 'drained' and 'going rough', although here were no effects on the vehicle's lights. After 4-5 minutes of observation he returned to pick up the

first witness. Both then went back to the scene where they now found the large light and only 1 orange light present. They estimated it to be some 300m distant. Later a third person joined them, and he reported seeing what he took to be a floodlight in the distance. (UFORA).

UFORA90028 1987? Mt Newman WA Night Med Level B S3/P4

2 people were parked some 5km from Newman. They saw an object but believed at first it was the Moon rising. However, it was a blood red colour. It rose and showed a semi-crescent shape, which then seemed to split. The part which split approached and got bigger. It then followed them along the road. At its closest it was estimated to be 20m up and 20m away. They sped at 160km/h to get away. Finally it crossed the road in front of them and sped off to their left. (UFORA).

UFORA90045 Lifelong Adelaide SA CE4 Level A S5/P4 A complex South Australian abduction report

UFOR(SA) have now released further details of their investigations into an extremely complex abduction case which they have been documenting since April 1990.

In summary, a 31 year old woman has detailed lifelong interaction with alien entities, with numerous encounters:-

* In about 1965 when she was aged 6 she, along with a group of other children, was approached by a group of unusual lights. Partial fragments of recall implies that the group was somehow "put to sleep".

* When aged 10-11, in about 1969-70, she recalls a group of entities and a ball of light entering her bedroom and abducting her. A "classical" abduction and medical examination ensued. Her sister was sharing the bedroom at the time.

* At age 12, in 1971, she was sitting on a local beach, feeling depressed, when a being came out of the water. She was then led through a white tunnel into a "craft".

* Around ages 16-17, in 1975-76, she was visited by a group of 6 small and 1 taller entities who abducted her and took her to a place. Here she was able to

walk about, and then her future life was shown to her.

* At age 19 in 1978 she has fragmentary recollections of a visitation at a time when she was sharing a town house with another woman.

The aliens involved in all of these experiences are described as follows:-

(a) The small ones. 1.23m tall. Head to body ratio larger than human. No hair on head. Large round eyes-no pupils. Dark eyes, blue or black. Slit mouth and small nose.

(b) The tall one. 2.15m tall. Slant eyes. Moderate build. Normal nose. Bigger mouth than (a). Prominent cheeks. Male. Seemed to be the leader.

In addition to all of the above, the woman reports numerous, lifelong paranormal episodes. These include poltergeists, levitation, apparitions, clairvoyance, telepathy, spirit-photography, channelling, and incubi visits.

From an abnormal psychological point of view, she experiences frequent hypnagogic/hypnopompic imagery, eidetic imagery, is an excellent hypnotic subject, can become highly absorbed in activities to the exclusion of other stimuli and her sleep patterns are not the norm.

Two unusual pregnancies are said to have happened:-

1) Around 1979. She thought she was pregnant. Nothing detected in blood or urine tests. Experienced cravings. Had enlarged stomach and cessation of periods. Breasts tender and nausea experienced. 1 month later everything returned to normal.

2) 1986. Doctor confirmed she was pregnant, although she maintains she had not had sex with her husband or any other human being. Says she did have sex with an alien incubi. She started having nightmares that the baby wasn't human. She became ill and the pregnancy terminated itself.

Investigations

As might be imagined, in a case such as this, investigations have been slow and thorough. Extensive interviews have been conducted with the woman and her husband. Her sister has been interviewed and confirms vivid memories of a ball of

light entering their bedroom in the 1969-70 episode. However, the sister recalls nothing further beyond this.

A claim was made by the woman that she may have "implants" in her upper gums, under her nostrils. She says these were detected by a dentist at an Adelaide hospital in about 1980. A search of hospital records indicates that x-rays are routinely kept for only 7 years and therefore the ones we seek have been destroyed. However, the woman has recently visited a dentist and had x-rays of her upper gums taken. She says this also shows 2 unusual items present in her gums. At interview the dentist confirmed this.

Investigations are continuing to attempt to secure appropriate medical records, to interview a girl friend who reportedly saw the witness levitating whilst asleep, and to document the case further. (UFORSA).

UFORA90046 Lifelong CE4 Level B S5/P4

A 29 year old woman from Queensland recalls a number of experiences, the first of which occurred at age 3 and a half. She recounts that at this age she can remember waking in her cot to find the room filled with small entities, who seemed to be examining her mother. This experience was vividly recalled later in early childhood when the woman was first exposed to photographs of a hospital operation. In another experience (age 19) she can recall being taken from her bed, and floating up to a "spaceship". However, she has no onboard memory. (Bill Chalker).

UFORA90047 Ca 1982 CE4 Level B S5/P4

Another Queensland woman, in her late 40's, recounts that about 8 years ago, during sleep, she found herself in a spaceship. The entities present were all human looking, both male and female. There were also a few other human beings, abductees, present there. She would not let the entities examine her as she was pregnant. The beings were apparently disturbed at having made a mistake saying they did not touch pregnant women. 1 being showed her how her baby would look when born, which the woman says was accurate. This was followed by a tour of the ship. Her next memory is of being back on Earth in the countryside. (Bill Chalker).

UFORA90048 Lifelong CE4? Level B S5/P4

Yet another woman, living in Sydney, has had repeated recollections of a "dream" where she sees herself lying in bed, with some "little people" near her. This dream first occurred in childhood and last happened some 6-8 months ago. (Bill Chalker).

UFORA90049 1978/Auckland NZ & 1981/Greece CE4 S5/P4

A 44 year old Queensland man can remember 2 occasions which seem to indicate "missing time". The first was in 1978 in Auckland. He had gone to bed one night and his next recollection was of being naked outside his house. Finding the house locked he had to attract the attention of an occupant inside to let him back in. Later, in September 1981, he was holidaying on the Greek island of Skopelos. He found himself waking up on a beach with water lapping at his feet. Orange dust, not from that area, covered him. (Bill Chalker).

UFORA90050 28 Mar 1990 Ferryden Park SA Night Low Level A S1/P4

Whilst replaying a video tape of a laser display, a man noticed an unusual bright light on the film, which he hadn't noticed when filming. Investigation by Ray Brooke at the site, determined that the most probable cause was that he had filmed a street light. (UFORSA).

UFORA90057 TA90016 Autumn 1974 Dysart TAS Med Level B S3/P3

A witness, aged 14 at the time, and her grandmother were both awoken by light shining into the room. They looked out and saw a large round greenish light some 600-800m distant at ground level. A low humming noise could be heard from the light which lit up nearby trees. After awhile it moved up into the sky diminishing to a speck and disappeared. (TUFOIC).

UFORA90058 TA90017 8 Apr 1990 Midway Point TAS Med Level A S3/P4

Witness driving home and heading north-east on Tasman Highway when a green light was noted low to

the driver's right. The light bobbed across the road at what looked like car height. It was then towards the north-east. As the witness approached the light it returned to the right of the road (east to south-east). As the witness passed Hobart airport the witness could not recall seeing the light but saw the airport lights, flashing red beacon. The highway then crosses a stretch of water on a causeway and the light was then seen as a bright traffic light green off to the right. The witness then arrived at Midway Point, at the intersection for the turn to the left (north) a green mass with glow and rectangular in shape seemed to approach the car from the eastern side. The witness was rather frightened and drove quickly home in a few minutes. She woke her husband and they looked out but only saw a bright white Venus in the eastern sky. (TUFOIC).

UFORA90059 28 Apr 1990 Elizabeth Grove SA 0528hrs Low Level C S2/P4

3 blue oscillating lights were seen travelling south, over 2-3 minutes. A whirring sound like a "washing machine" was audible. (UFORSA).

UFORA90065 27 May 1990 Truro SA 0030hrs Low Level C S4/P3

A light is reported to have "buzzed" a car. The car radio is said to have failed. The witness, a woman, is reported to have seen a red light in a paddock at one stage. (UFORSA).

UFORA90066 Various dates SA & TAS CE4 Level A S5/P4

Commencing in 1973, and ending in 1987, a series of unusual episodes have been recalled by male reporter. These include a poltergeist-like event and two bedroom paralysis occurrences. During one of the latter he felt something being pushed into a vein in an arm. Upon coming out of the paralysis he found blood emerging from a hole in his arm. (UFORA).

A man saw a "small silver bright thing" on top of Pidgeon Hill. As the sky went dark it became a brilliant white light. In addition, he saw another bigger light higher in the sky. The smaller light moved around, appearing to enter the other object and re-emerge on a number of occasions. Some 4 hours later the big light shot off at speed, then came back again before finally leaving. (UFORFNQ).

0100hrs Low Level B S3/P4

"People" magazine of the 7th March 1989 reported an "enormous craft, shaped like a saucer...sucking the water up from the creek...". However, investigations have revealed that in fact a big bright white slow moving light was seen, but that nothing further eventuated. (UFORFNQ).

UFORA90070 QB90006 July 1964 Near Yorkey's
Knob QLD Ca. 1730hrs Med Level B S4/P4

A couple were travelling by van when they noticed a shiny silver thing down the side of a mountain, an estimated 1.5km away. It looked to be some 18m in diameter and seemed to be resting on legs. They stood and watched it for some 25 minutes before deciding to leave. Returning along the same road the next day, they noticed the object was no longer there. (UFORFNQ).

QLD Low Level B S3/P4

A man, together with his wife and son, reported sighting a number of objects over the years. These orange lights moved and blinked. (UFORFNQ).

A number of experiences including visions, a UFO incident and possible "contacts" have been recounted

by a male reporter. Briefly, he reports seeing a UFO some 2km away from him on Thursday Island 15 years ago. 4-5 years ago he began to undergo visions/messages/poetry directed to him by "aliens". 2-3 years ago 2 entities appeared in his flat in Cairns. Recently he has suffered from a "rash" and believes aliens have placed something in his neck. (UFORFNQ).

S4/P4

2 men riding motorcycles observed a light come from their left. It travelled, very quickly, across the road in front of them heading south. It went out of sight. Duration 1 minute. It was described as round, yellow, 1.5m in diameter, with flickering, fuzzy edges. The brightness was similar to that of the full Moon. (UFORFNQ).

A female nurse was driving home from the hospital where she worked when an incident happened near a shopping centre. She was driving alone and stopped at a red light. No one was crossing and there was no other traffic in the area. About 150m past these lights she suddenly found herself 5km further along the same road but travelling in the opposite direction. This change of direction occurred in a fraction of a second. The woman pulled the car to the side of the road and stopped it. She experienced severe nausea, accompanied by rapid and heavy breathing and a severe throbbing pain in her head. A period of some 20-25 minutes appears to be missing from her time schedule. Later she experienced gynaecological problems. (UFORQLD).

A woman was awoken at 0200hrs by dogs and cattle exhibiting agitation. An hour later she was awoken again and saw a very bright light moving through trees. There was a swishing sound and shafts of blue light were observed. A loss of time may have occurred. Investigations were conducted on 17th May

A truck driver was followed by a bright light which changed positions several times during the course of the incident. Another truck driver travelling about a kilometre behind also reported seeing the object. (UFORQLD).

A 76 year old man was loading a caravan when his attention was drawn to what he thought was a huge "vapour" trail, travelling from north-west to east. He excluded aircraft as a cause because the head of the trail itself was only a vaporous form, white in colour. (Joan Johnston).

Whilst walking a dog a woman noted a very bright crystal shaped object in the east over the sea. The dog was adversely affected and peered towards the light, remaining motionless and silent. Apparently others reported observations of the same object to the local radio station 4SS the next morning. (UFOR(Qld) Sunshine Coast Branch).

Evening Low Level A S4/P4

A female pensioner saw an unusually bright light in the east which she watched for some time. She described it as having a rich sparkling golden glow. (UFOR(Qld) Sunshine Coast branch).

2243hrs Low Level A S4/P4

Three people saw an orange-red light low in the eastern sky at tree top level. It moved across the sky at tremendous speed to the north-west. When it reached the north it suddenly performed an upward movement, then down again. It seemed to stop then travelled on and out of sight. (UFOR(Qld) Gympie branch).

UFORA90082 QA90070 1955/56 Darwin NT Med
Level A S4/P4

2 people were fishing when they sighted an unusual object. It was described as full Moon sized, a dark centre, with light surrounding it. It appeared to approach them, then stopped in mid air, soundlessly. It then moved over to the middle of the harbour. It was then seen to have 3 'stories'. Through lighted windows there seemed to be some movement inside the object. It remained motionless for some 10 minutes before it left. (UFOR(Qld) Gympie branch).

1810hrs CE1 Level A S3/P3

On a still, warm night 3 people were surf fishing when they noticed a large, bright Moon sized light. The object remained stationary for several minutes, then started moving towards the sea. All the witnesses felt physically affected, some nauseous. (UFOR(Qld) Sunshine Coast Branch.)

1930hrs CE1 Level A S3/P4

Whilst driving a man noted a bright, low, hovering, object which looked like a street lamp some 300m away and 150m up. He manoeuvred his car for a better look and the object disappeared/switched off. Duration 15 seconds. (UFOR(Qld) Sunshine Coast branch).

Maroochydore QLD (1900-2000hrs) Cel Level B
S4/P4

Some 5-6 people noted some unusual activity near their block of flats. A "spaceship" was seen in the sky. It was oval shaped, stationary and was disgorging 3-5 smaller objects. Over a period of 10-15 minutes these smaller objects went into and out of this larger one. (UFOR(Qld) Sunshine Coast branch).

Evening Med Level B S4/P3

Two fishermen in a small boat when their attention was drawn to a hovering object which was very well lit with portholes. The object descended and rose 2-3 times then suddenly took off in a southerly direction. (UFOR(Qld) Sunshine Coast branch).

UFORA90090 26 Jun 1990 Applawn TAS 2358hrs
Med Level A S3/P3

The witness, who is retired and suffers from arthritis, had gone to bed reasonably early. 1 of his dogs disturbed him as it barked on and on for about an hour, even when the witness yelled at it. He was checking the time when a light flashed in his bedroom window. Going out he saw a saucer shape with square top in the middle like a flattened cup. It was near ground level, some 200-300m away in a large paddock. It followed a fence line before the witness headed back inside. Looking out his window he could now see the object some 3km away over the hilltop. It now had a red/orange flame effect below as it dropped out of sight behind the hill. The event lasted over 5 minutes. (TUFOIC).

Level C S2/P4

Whilst travelling down the Lower NE Road near Highbury, the witness reported seeing some yellow lights to their north at about 30 degrees elevation. These lights were round in shape, and hovered initially. After some 2-3 minutes they then took off at speed. (UFORSA).

Level C S3/P3

A man was driving alone along the Duke's highway when he noted some unusual lights which appeared to be stationary. He stopped his car to get out and have a better look. There seemed to be 2 lights, 1 on top of the other. The bottom one was like a flattened oval, red in colour while the top one was like a white spotlight. The man went to walk around to the passenger's side but by the time he got there the lights had travelled away to the west. (UFORSA).

One Saturday night a couple riding along a dirt road on a motorcycle heard a strange noise like a "hummming/vibrating" sound. They also noted an indistinct circular shape which was not an aircraft. (UFORQLD Sunshine Coast Branch).

1920hrs Med Level B S4/P3

The witness was standing waiting for a lift in a suburban street when her attention was drawn to a green, spherical object which passed over her home. It travelled up the street at tree top level making no noise. (UFORQLD Sunshine Coast Branch).

QLD 0405hrs Low Level A S4/P4

Peter Pasini, UFORQLD sightings officer, while watching Venus rise from the east, saw a cigar-shaped object with white and red pulsating lights to the south. It hovered and then disappeared into the night sky. 5 minutes later a dark cloud was observed in the direction where the object had hovered. (UFORQLD).

Broadbeach Waters QLD 0130-0530hrs Low Level
A S4/P4

A man witnessed a bright light in the sky which was moving sideways over Broadbeach Waters, in an east-north east direction. He did not observe the disappearance of this object nor was he awake to see its appearance. (UFORQLD).

QLD 0208hrs Low Level A S4/P4

Gary Pasini and his wife Ellen witnessed a bright green light while getting out of a taxi at work in the early hours of the morning at Wonderland. This object hovered for about 4 seconds before taking off at great speed. (UFORQLD).

QLD 1140hrs Med Level A S4/P4

Peter Pasini witnessed a ball-like object, greyish in colour and bright as the Sun, behind and slightly higher than an inbound Australian airline jet. This object left no smoke or vapour trail nor was there any sound from it. He glanced at his watch, and upon resuming his observation, the object had disappeared. (UFORQLD).

QLD 2335hrs Med Level A S4/P4

A witness woke up from his sleep and looked out of his caravan's windows. He sighted an object (about 0.9 - 1.1m in height and 0.6-0.8m in diameter) rising. When level with his window the object hovered briefly with a slight up and down motion before taking off in an upward direction. It disappeared in a couple of seconds. The witness searched the area afterwards but found nothing abnormal. The object was jet black in colour with an iridescent blue-purple window. The underside had an array of 2.5cm diameter holes. A noise like an electric motor (whirring) was heard during the sighting. (UFORQLD).

Amanda ran in to get her spouse to see it, but by the time they got back out it had gone. Duration was estimated as 5 minutes. The children later complained of sore eyes. On Tuesday 30 October 1990 Ray Brooke received a telephone call from a television station at Port Pirie, South Australia, reporting the finding of a crop circle near Jamestown. Ray rang the property owners concerned and confirmed that they had found a circle near a main road, on Sunday, 28 October. The marking was a circle 10m in diameter, surrounded by a ring, making a total diameter of some 16m. It was located in a wheat paddock of green, not yet ripened, wheat in undulating countryside. The marking was not as distinct as the UK circles, i.e. it had ill defined edges and other features.

Ray arranged to visit the property on Friday 2 November. The circle was shown on the evening South Australian TV news on 30 October. However, on Thursday 1 November Ray received a call from the property owners to say that the marking was in fact a hoax. It had been made by rolling a 44 gallon drum, to press down the crop. Coverage of this disclosure of a hoax occurred via the evening TV news on 1 November. The identity, if known, of the person(s) responsible for creating the marking was not disclosed.

It should be noted, perhaps not coincidentally, that Jamestown was the location of a reported high strangeness close encounter and potential abduction, some 2 years ago. The latter case is still under investigation by Ray Brooke. (UFORSA).

UFORA90102 TA90038 Mid June 1990 Sandfly TAS
2300hrs Med Level B S4/P4

A person was driving home alone on a rural road south-west of Hobart. Coming up a rise he noticed a very bright white oval shape to the right of the road. As he continued on he observed an area of white light in the paddock below the object. The object and area of light moved in unison. He finally stopped after a minute or so when he was level with the larger than Moon sized oval object. It had also become stationary some 90m off the road, and less than 100m above the paddock. The object then departed at a rapid rate to the south-west at a 45 degree angle, decreasing in size to a dot in a few seconds. The area of the ground light was no longer visible. The weather was fine with some cloud but no fog. There was no other traffic about at the time. (TUFOIC)

UFORA90103 Early 1988 Palm Beach QLD CE3B
Level A S4/P4

In the early hours of the morning a woman awoke to find her husband, Des, in a frenzy resembling a heart attack. He was gasping for breath, his temperature was high and he was shaking. He kept saying that "they" wanted him to go with "them". It was still dark. She managed to get him calmed down and then they talked about his "dream". Des said that it wasn't a dream, and that there was someone out there and they wanted him to go with them but he wouldn't. He said he felt uneasy at first and then he saw faces at the window which were calling him. He started to panic. Des thinks there were three or four faces present at the window, their bedroom being on the second floor of their home. These faces were human in form but one made such an impression on him that he said he would never forget that face.

Once he told them he wouldn't go with them he started to feel stifled and they seemed to be pulling at his emotions. The next thing he knew his wife was calming him down. Within twelve months of this episode Des became very ill, so ill that the doctors thought he was going to die. However, he pulled through. (UFORQLD-Gympie Branch).

UFORA90104 22 Oct 1990 Pomona QLD 1745hrs
Med Level C S4/P4

A woman was facing south in her garden, feeding the birds when she became aware of a silver pencil shaped object in the sky. It travelled in a straight line, steadily and slowly, north to south. There was no noise associated with the object and the sky was clear at the time. She went to the phone to call someone else to see it but found the dial tone slow to appear. She also noted that the sound on her television was out at this time. (UFORQLD-Gympie branch).

UFORA90105 Spring 1969 Sydney NSW (1600-1700hrs)
Med Level A S3/P3

A 20 year old female and her male companion noted a bright object from their vehicle. They stopped the vehicle and got out, to see an object about 500m above them. It seemed to be about 30m across. It was a silver dish shape with a white blue neon type tube

around it. The object then accelerated rapidly up and then west and away. (UFORQLD-Sunshine Coast Branch).

UFORA90106 Nov 1983 Sydney NSW 2130hrs
Med Level A S4/P3

Looking out across the ocean a 35 year old woman saw two large metallic balls, some 6-10m across "scream" in rapidly across the water. They then stopped abruptly and glowed an orange colour. A third ball arrived and pulsated. All three lights left, following the cliffs. Photographs were taken. (UFORQLD-Sunshine Coast Branch).

UFORA90107 19 Aug 1990 Coolum QLD 0008hrs
Sound only

A loud humming sound woke up a 50 year old woman. There was also a sound like the rushing wind, yet the trees were not moving. An hour later the same thing happened. The woman at the shop next door had a similar experience on the other side of Coolum that night, which also upset her dog. (UFORQLD-Sunshine Coast Branch).

UFORA90108 Lifelong QLD Various Level A
S4/P3

A man called "Harry" was born in 1918 and his mother related the story that, during her pregnancy, three beings, human-like, but, she felt, not of our race, stood at the end of her bed. Despite this she was not scared.

In 1924 Harry recalls seeing an object on the ledge of a mountain near Butnes Scrub, and later saw a silver disc which took off straight up, near Boroon Pocket Dam. Two years later he saw discs flying down the Blackall Range from Montville to Maleny.

Around this time, the mid 1920's, Harry relates an interesting event of a friend of his who was a powder monkey at the Scottish gold mine in Gympie. After blasting a mine face, the miners entered a large fully glazed tunnel which was perfectly dry. A number of Government scientists arrived to inspect the tunnel which was later sealed off with concrete.

In 1946/7, again at the Bribie Passage, Harry relates the story of a six foot being in a silvery astronaut suit who walked in the front door and came into the

bedroom, while Harry's wife remained asleep. At this point, the being placed his hand on Harry's head and ruffled his hair. Harry claims that he felt calm, and to this day, believes he can detect UFOs in the vicinity. (UFORQLD-Sunshine Coast Branch).

UFORA90109 7 Nov 1990 Victor Harbor SA
1345hrs Med Level C S3/P3

A man reported watching a black triangular object of an estimated 2-3m size, making a low whistling noise, as it travelled from the south east to the north west. Duration was given as one second only. (UFORSA).

UFORA90110 13 Nov 1990 Handorf SA 2330hrs
Low Level C S3/P3

Over a ten minute period a white/creamy glowing light moved eastwards. The reporter stated that he did not believe it to be an aircraft. (UFORSA).

UFORA90111 TA90042 Jul 1980 Sorell TAS Med
Level B S4/P4

A person was returning home on the Tasman highway some 30Km from Hobart when they noticed a triangular shape with red lights, low over roadside houses. The shape suddenly darted off and was lost to sight in the north-west. Some half a kilometre further on the same or a similar shape was noted returning towards the car from the north-west. The car was stopped as the object became stationary almost overhead. They were able to see a white, oval object with five large red lights around the base of the object. It was estimated to be only some 10-30m up in the air and 5m plus in width. The whole event took place in silence, there was no other traffic around. After about five minutes the object moved off then went up vertically and was gone in seconds. (TUFOIC).

UPDATE on UFORA89043. Balaklava

A farmer reported finding a 2 1/2-3m diameter circular hole in rough ground. It was deeper in the centre than at the edge. Although there was no known UFO connection the marking was definitely out of place. Photographs of the mark were sent to Ray Brooke who later visited the site and took some soil samples. The results of a professional analysis have just been released by Ray. The following is a

comparison of soil taken from within the mark versus a control sample taken some distance away:-

Ray Brooke's best bet as to the cause of this mystery hole is that it was caused by a block of frozen toilet waste which fell from a commercial aircraft!!

UFORA AUSTRALIAN RESEARCH IN 1990

1 Abduction research

A substantial number of abduction cases have now been reported within Australia. Abstracts of some of these cases have appeared in the Digest. As with elsewhere in the world investigations into local abduction cases are time consuming and results are only just now starting to be published in the literature.

Bill Chalker had a piece titled "Alien abductions: a Shamanic perspective on UFO's" published in the Australian magazine, Nature and Health, in early 1990.

A review article on Australian cases appeared in the International UFO Reporter (IUR) Vol 15 No 3. In addition, one of the first indepth case studies of an Australian abduction report is scheduled to appear in the IUR in early 1991.

As you may be aware, overseas, particularly in the USA, health professionals have entered the abduction debate in quite a big way. Here in Australia, Bill Chalker has for some time now been working with a Sydney clinical psychologist on a number of "missing time" cases. UFOR(QLD) is understood to have pursued at least two cases using hypnosis undertaken by an Industrial psychologist. Unfortunately, full details of the methodology utilised have not been published.

In Adelaide, Keith Basterfield, Vladimir and Pony Godic and Julia Elsbeth have been negotiating with an Adelaide clinical psychologist, and a Phd psychology student who has specialised in post

traumatic stress disorder. Both of these individuals have indicated a willingness to join us in research.

UFORA is currently preparing a catalogue of known Australian abduction cases, for publication early in 1991.

2 Commonwealth Freedom of Information Act

This year Keith Basterfield used this piece of legislation to obtain copies of UFO sightings reported to the Royal Australian Air force (RAAF) between 1984-1989. In 1984, the RAAF withdrew from its previous position of investigating all UFO reports made to it, stating that it would in future investigate only those cases which had a national security implication. Just over 100 photocopied pages were released. A copy of these papers, at cost, is available upon request.

3 Archives search

A request was submitted in February 1990 to the Australian Government Archives for access to Department of Defence files relating to UFOs. Six months later Keith Basterfield was granted access to the RAAF's early policy files on UFOs under the Federal Government's 30 year rule. A photocopy of the files covering the period July 1953-1959 was obtained, which contained, amongst other things, a copy of the 1954 Turner report and papers relating to the 1959 Gill sighting. Copies of these papers are available, at cost, from UFORA.

This search will complement that undertaken by Bill Chalker in the early 1980's, when Bill was granted access to the RAAF's files during several visits to Canberra.

4 Network expansion

The UFORA Network has expanded the number of associates it has, during 1990. The states of Queensland, New South Wales, Tasmania, Victoria, South Australia and Western Australia now all have at least one associate of the Network.

5 Circles research

Early in the year, UFORA forwarded a media release to Australian Associated Press and capital city

newspapers seeking Australian examples of swirled crop circles. The exercise was repeated in late November when a media release was despatched to 18 South Australian country newspapers in the state's wheat belt, several national farming papers and 18 light aircraft clubs. The resulting find of nil circles should be compared with the large numbers found each year in the UK, and an increasing number of such finds in countries such as Canada.

6 Classification system for reports

In March 1990 a change was made to the way of describing reports utilised by the UFORA network, and assigning a weight to them. This brings us into line with classification systems used overseas. Copies of the classification system are obtainable from UFORA.

7 Journal of UFO Studies

A review article on Australian ufology written by Keith, Vlad and Pony appears in the second volume of the CUFOS Journal of UFO Studies, published in November.

8 Electronic mail

Bill Chalker, Vladimir Godic, Bob Fletcher, Keith Basterfield, David Galea and Ross Skinner, all in the UFORA network are now able to communicate directly through their personal computers. It is hoped to gradually extend this electronic mail system to other UFORA associates in the coming months. To join in you need an IBM compatible computer and a modem. The use of computers also allows for exchange of large amounts of data/articles on disk. Microsoft Word is the word processing package in use.

Amongst other things, UFORA now runs a separate "folder" on the electronic mail system describing its services, and a regular electronic news update is provided by the UFORA research officer.

The computer system is also linked in to the US based PARANET computer service allowing Australian and American researchers on PARANET to communicate amongst themselves. This has been useful for information sharing on fast breaking news stories as well as more indepth research topics, e.g. abductions.
