Introducing the NEWSLETTER.

It was thought and felt for a long time that the knowledge of current UFO events and allied topics should be more efficiently shared with our members.

It has been only now possible to bring into existence a periodical exclusively dedicated to this purpose. This is its first issue; the others are due to follow at six week's intervals, with the exception of July and December, the months especially assigned for the publication of Australian Flying Saucer Review.

The material presented is a digest of various overseas and local UFO publications and data obtained from other subjects essential for an unbiased conception and interpretation of life in Universe and inter-planetary communications.

In addition there are news and programmes of the Society's activities-, endeavouring to stimulate member's interest and attendance at Functions.

It is hoped that with further improvement the Newsletter will reasonably fulfil the motive of its conception, and thus to become, by keeping the members fully informed re up-to-date world UFO situation and public matters of the Society, -an official link between the external and internal affairs of the U.F.O.I.C.

The 1963 Round.

"There were more Flying Saucer reports this year than ever before" and "Flying Saucers have certainly not died out" said Dr. J. Allen Hynek, noted astro-physicist and chief UFO consultant to the US Air-force, in the Yale University Science Magazine. Indeed DISCS were reported from both Americas, Europe, Africa, Asia and Australia, climaxing in approximately thirty landings all over the world.

Britain was staggered by the Wiltshire Craters, a saucer shaped depression with a deep cylindrical shaped hole and straight edged grooves radiating evenly outwards, supposed to be marks of a 600 tons weight and a few hundred feet diameter Spaceship. The RAF investigators blamed a meteorite, but no convincing evidence was found. The matter was brought before Parliament and the Air Ministry was challenged for an answer.

Big headlines in August Chicago papers told of "Flap" in Southern Illinois where a "round ball of bright white light" chased a car at midnight along 12 miles of country roads. At one point the orange glowing object swerved directly over the car, frightening the 18 year-old driver into a 120 mph. escape race. Reaching the home speechless with fear, his entire family witnessed with awe an approximately 12 feet diameter glowing object hover over the farmhouse. The State Marshall and the Deputy Sheriff arriving half-an-hour later, just saw the UFO climb slowly away.

Similar reports of dazzling UFOs haunting cars were reported from South Australia and Argentina.

Canadian "Project Magnet" extended its world search for UFOs magnetic phenomena thro' their specially fitted airplanes.

In June citizens of Rubidoux, California, saw a red glowing "like a moon" rising object from behind the trees; atop the glowing oval body was a "silver dome" with protruding antennas.....it hovered there for an hour before rising suddenly and disappearing.

It was reported from Nairobi, Africa, that a "phosphorescent Flying Saucer" three times the size of the moon, was watched for five minutes crossing the near-by jungle.

In May the news was released of Flying Saucer landing in Buenos Aires Airport and at another Flying Saucer landing also in Argentina, the "robot" like creatures were seen emerging from the Spaceship.

In U.S.A. Professor Menzel published his new book, considered to be the best account of Flying Saucer cases, however explained away in his known negative manner. Opposedly the just as famous astro-physicist Professor Manney published his book, dis-proving Menzel's claims, and giving to the Flying Saucers full status of authenticity and unshakeable reality. NICAP is almost ready for the publication of its

ultimate report on Flying Saucer Research findings to be presented to the Pentagon. The USA President L. Johnson writes a letter to Major Keyhoe for all information gathered by civilian authorities to be compared with Airforce reports.

Two colour films of UFOs, one taken over Massachusetts and the other over Venezuela were examined and confirmed to be authentic.

In Northern Italy the Flying Saucer landing was reported and four photographs were taken. Italy also had its own UFO Convention in Bologna.

OLDEN MOORE CLASSIC .OHIO 1957. While driving along the car route No 86 near Montville Mr. Olden Moore noticed a bright object moving rapidly across the sky. Through the windshield the object appeared to split in two, of which one part proceeded towards the car with increasing brightness. He stopped the car and noticed the object changing colours from white to green, and further developing into bluish green, to stop about 200 feet in the air above a nearby field at approximately 500 feet distance. The object was disc shaped of about 50 feet diameter, and approximately 15 feet thick with a cone making its allover height 20 to 30 feet. It was surrounded by a bluish green haze, pulsating slowly, and alternating between bright and dim.
