Text of the pictures :

- 1 to 4 : Reduction of the (original 6 to 6 cm Rolleiflex) Trinidad F.S. (↓) pictures (by courtesy of "O Cruzeiro", March 8, 58) and enlargement of the cuttings. In a sketch of the itinerary also the photographs nr. 5 and 6 were marked (also they had'nt succeeded in focalizing the S). For estereoscopic examination had the (H) horizon (enlargement of nr. 1 and 4) been put in proper alignment and some points of the scenery identified (k, l, m). The photographs were taken by Almiro Barauna who spoke about the event to SBEDV read Bull. 16.
- 5 - : Focalizes Prof. João de Freitas Guimarães event on the beach of São Sebastião, (as it had been reported by numerous dailies of the country), showing the Professor when giving explications to the reporters (a), the sketch of the Saucer he rode with (b), showing the dial with the three indicators of the magnetic field, sideface of the circular bank of the cabin, circular movement of the central shaft, Maj.(1) Paulo Salema and esquadron commander Cid Vieira de Almeida (read also SBEDV Bull. 21) of the Brazilian Air-Force Base Bocaina (e) on the beach, (c and d) recent sketches of the F.S. (diameter of 20 m, height 8) by Prof. Freitas showing the functioning of the retraction of the (1) landing balls (by the Prof's supposition) during the flight) with cabin of command and antenna (4 and 5), bulleyes (3), tube for locomotion in atmosphere which filters rays (6), central shaft (2).
- 6 - : a) - Enlargement of the cutting of the photograph of a F.S. by Jorge Audi, at Alto de Boa Vista (a Rio de Jan. district) at July 27, 58, by courtesy of "O Cruzeiro", Aug. 16, 58.  
b) - The same (on the left), seen in a vividly red colour (O Cruzeiro, Aug. 16, 58) by the lawyer Dr. Nilo Alves de Moraes, but when seen by binoculars (see sketch on the right) was of a dark grey colour and showed "adddicional circles as if formed of propeller".

- 7 - : a) - Enlargement of the Trindade S. which gained importance in relation of its similarity to Prof. J. de Freitas G. Saucer (read about the invitation of the Prof. on board of the ship Almirante Saldanha da Gama, where from those pictures had been taken by the photographer Almiro Barauna).  
b) - Sketch of 4 different phases of the S. in flight at Trindade, by courtesy of Prof. Freitas G. following Correio da Manhã (Rio, Febr. 21, 58), Diário da Noite (S.Paulo, Febr. 21, 58, 1.ed.).
- 8 - : A comparative study of the 3 F.S. (Alto da Boa Vista-A, Trindade-B, São Sebastião-C) by courtesy of Prof. Freitas G., and one can see the striking similarity with the F.S. of the Professor (C) if one adds the bulleyes to the sketch of the Boa Vista Saucer (Aa) and of the Trindade Saucer (Bb).
- 9 - : Sketches by description of the witness of the Blenheim sighting (Aug.-Spt. 59, by the South Island, New-Zealand Scientific Space Research Group, 33 Dee Stree, Timarú, N.Z.) when during 2 to 3 minutes (between 5.30 and 5.45 AM) the vehicle was seen hovering, (wich had approached the ground through the clouds), when two crew members (they did'nt look out) could be seen inside (one behind the other), the one in front motionless, the other one looking forward into a flickering light with a sort of helmet (d) and the machine (a, b, c, top, front and side views) with two (3) rows of jets (revolving the same way when going up and down and in a contrary movement, when hovering in the air) which could be well explained by the discharge of static electricity or ionised plasma (see N.Z., North Island Group, P.O.Box 7, Henerson, Auckland) or (July-Aug.61) F.S.R.), connected to the production of magnetic fields or rays for locomotion, since this would explain the fast movement, the "strong pepper smell" of the air afterwards (Ozone), and the black-out of the street lights of a district, when overflown by a similar craft, on an earlier date, in the same region (Could it be an instrumental guided flight, an approach to study the psycholgical reactions of the witness, graphically reproduced by the flickering light ??? The Editor).
- 10 - : We remind the reader of SBEDV Bull. nr. 10, where the contact case of Luiz Henrique da Silva was reported who spoke with a man in a space suit with sort of a different helmet (a-showing Luiz' own crude sketch of the helmet and the triangular door of the Saucer) and the writing (b) he got from the man for deciphering (which has'nt been deciphered to our knowledge).

Question 1 - There seems to exist a multiplicity of forms of F.S.. Could it be possible that one or another is identical to that one you described to have contacted at the beach of São Sebastião ?

Answer.: Yes. I know that the F.S. that was photographed over the island Trindade by the photographer Almiro Barauna was identical to the F.S. described by me (see fig. nr. 1 to 4 and nr. 7, 8c in this Bull.). This I saw when I was invited on board the mid-ship-schooling trainer "Almirante Saldanha da Gama" (2) by Dr. Vancome (3) on behalf of the officers of the aforementioned ship. I stayed there during 4 hours and all the time Dr. Vancome was present as witness and if I remember well there were shown to me 6 photographs which demonstrated the course of the F.S. in its succession (4).

Also a F.S. photographed at the city section of Alto da Boa Vista in Rio de Janeiro (publ. by "O Cruzeiro" Aug., 16, 1958, see fig. nr. 6a, 6b, 8a and 8c) in this Bull.) is identical to the F.S. that I had contacted in 1956 (it seems to me to have been on June 16) on the beach of São Sebastião. Since there had been settled another contact with the crew of the Saucer for Aug. 12, 57, and since this event got to be known by the public 3 weeks earlier, I also had made a sketch (of the F.S. I met) one year earlier to the Alto da Boa Vista Saucer and identical to it (see fig. nr. 5b).

Also when I made that sketch of a Saucer for the Cel (of the bras. Air-Force) Coqueiro he told me that in the files of the Brazilian Air-Force (FAB) there exists a photograph of a F. Saucer identical to my sketch and still he added "you shouldn't go to your (presettled) meeting with this Flying Saucer, since we (the Air-Force) will have there (on the beach of São Sebastião) two pursuit squadrons to meet the Saucer" (5), and this (all) was told in the presence of the clerk of the public notary of the 5th office of the city of Santos, with Dr. Gabriel Alca, his brother and my own son present. Nevertheless I took the resolution not to go to the meeting, since at the day before passed away the mother of my father in law and I also was exhausted, since during day and night, and sometimes until the early morning hours, I had to attend the reporters from all the country and I knew that a great mass of people was moving to the settled spot for the meeting. But I also knew that really the F.S. had been at São Sebastião at the beach of Paraqueçaba (6) and those persons gave testimony about it at the T.V. Tupi São Paulo (Capital) indicating still the names of other persons who also had been present. Even so a tape had been made of the attempts of the phone call to "Radio Cultura" of São Paulo and to TV Tupi. The latter when approached afterwards with the tape, refused to put all on the air, as expected (7).

Question nr. 2 - This what you just was telling me, why didn't you tell also to the press or did'nt publish it yourself?

Answer.: Really I did mention it, verbally, to a restricted number of persons, but I didn't publish it, since I met only indifference of many, unbelief of almost all, and

F.G.C.) since there is located the piece of land which my client Luis Rodane, had been disputing at the Tribunal of São Sebastião with his associate Felipe Genciano Bueno, a costum's officer of Santos. Those people witnessed when the machine appeared from behind the island "Bela", taking the direction of the beach of Paraqueçaba.

so I felt that only a few ones were able to probe in it, when, otherwise, for myself it seemed of utmost importance (\*). They announced that whenever I would write something this would have been for publicity of political purposes and so I wrote nothing. Also the press tried to distort the facts or to impute me others I had not referred, all this, as it seems me, to jeopardize and ridicularize my person, to confuse the public opinion, when the latter had, at that time, the perfect right to be clarified. In relation to the reality of the facts, those should be known by the people without modifications, and without interference of occult or incomprehensible motives, which turn more difficult a judicious judgement of the matter, which nevertheless, wasn't unknown in our country (Brazil). I (therefore) ask why do they not publish those photographs (of Flying Saucers) which do exist in the files of the Brazilian Air-Force (FAB), as told by the Colenel Coqueiro, to give the publication, then, the character of a "compilation about Flying Saucers" ?

What hurts me most are the persons I believed civilized (cultured), but who were incapable to admit a matter, nor at least its possibility, as this would be expected from a serious investigator. By this means the learned conviction (of those persons) against the reality of the facts, was (still) authorized and sublined by a "stupid laugh".

Question nr. 3 - Is there (any) coincidence in the description of the Cosmos as given by Gagarin and by you?

Answer.: There is entire coincidence of Gagarin's description and mine, given 4 years ago, as one may verify by comparing the descriptions given by that Cosmonaut to the press (1. ed. "Folha de São Paulo", April 14, 1961) and mine, as published (read Bull. nr. 4) in the paper (+) and (later) at the request of the nucleo Ubaldino de Metafisica, in the Bull. "Monismo" at Christmas 1959.... When one distances himself very much from our earth, then one is unable to know where is the Sun, since even so near the Earth the Sun is orange coloured, and at the distance of 200 km. approximately has the colour of gold, at a much greater distance, there one doesn't see any more the colours of the light of the Sun, and one doesn't know where it is and how it looks, when just before "Our Sun" has been given such a tranquilizing feeling as a companion to the traveller who leaves earth. ### The Eagle River Pancake

Fate Magazine, Aug, 61 (\$\$) gives short account about a contact at Eagle River at April 18, 61 but a more extensive study is done by Gray Barker about a telephone talk with Vilas County Judge Frank W. Carter in Ray Palmer's "Flying Saucers" Sept. 61 (\$\$). We think important this account and therefore we bring some excerpts of it: "Joe Simonton, a plumber (known to the Judge) living in a sparsely populated area, was alone at his house, when a disk-shaped contraption came down near his house, hovering a few feet off the ground. He was not frightened, only curious, when a kind of hatchway opened in the side of the craft, with a man in the hatchway and two more inside the darkened interior, similarly dressed people, a very tight-fitting dark grey attire which came up over the back of the head into a hood, covering the hair entirely. (without seams, zippers, buttons but skin-tight). The man at the hatchway said nothing, but made motions which Simonton interpreted as a request for water. Then he handed the plumber a very strange container (with two handles, like a soup tureen but of some very shiny metal) with which Simonton went to the nearby well and pumped it full of water, while the man at the door watched, but when receiving the water, he

touched his hand to his forehead in a gesture (interpreted by the plumber as "thank you") and in return Sim. threw up his hand in a military salute.

In an unusual aspect the two other "Crew members" took no notice of Sim., one was bent over a kind of cooking arrangement (like grill) the other occupied by what must have been the controls of the craft. Sim. slight disquietude was growing into ..curiosity.. especially about what was cooking on the grill and he motioned to his mouth and pointed toward it. The saucerian went to the cooking apparatus, cooped up a handful of grayish, pancake-like material, and put it, still hot, into Simonton's hands. With that exchange, the hatchway suddenly closed (leaving no seams visible) and the S. took off, going straight upward, then off at an angle".

Since the judge (a Nicap member) had got a cake (by Simonton) and had sent it (April, 22, 61) to Nicap for analysis and the latter, only after repeated inquiries, replied to the Judge by its secretary R. Hall in a "confidential letter", where from we may quote the following excerpts : "...much to our surprise ...you had announced this (the remittance of the cake to Nicap for analysis) to the press. We do not propose to compromise the (Nicap's liaison) work (1) (with congress) for the sake of an unproven ..claim.." From Judge's Carter's reply (to NICAP) we quote the following excerpts: "..Should I (the Judge) have kept silent as to mailing you this exhibit for analysis? Is your NICAP committee a secret one (2)? Must we keep still as to sightings or exhibits until they prove to fit into the accepted theories up to that time?... And now your secretary cries like a stuck pig that I announced the mailing of the cake to you for analysis. What's wrong with that? ..Do you know, in advance, that the cake will actually turn out to be a hoax or a fraud, without analysis (3)? May be your own former military connections places you in the same category as to other military men in the air force etc.. What have you (Major D. Kehoe) to say for yourself ?".

From the Editor :

It seems that Nicap got his teeth stuck in the soft cake of a contactee and it may now look for a way so as to disband in an unsuspect way, since the exposure of interceptance of concrete material, as well as its prejudice (4) about contacts (5) may make it useless for the future as a governmental coverup agency for "Ufo Intelligence" (6).

- (1) - Evidently refers Nicap to Rep. Joseph E. Karth, D. Minn. to make the investigation designed to it by the chairman of the House Space committee, Rep. Overton Brooks, D. La (Long Island (NY) Press, June 26, 61 (\$\$)). At the end of an earlier hearing, Newsweek Magazine (\$\$) July 3, 61, says: "...and by the time the Airforce got through with their reports that was the end of the matter..."
- (2) - So as not to turn any probing in a pantomime it seems that Nicap's action is now dispensable, if only it would have passed to the congress the analyses of the Campinas tin sample (sent to it by the brasilian secret S. committee member A. Simoes) and if also the results were available in relationship to the Ubatuba magnesium, sent to the USAF (as told to us personally) by Dr. Olavo Fontes, (also a contact member to a military secret service, nevertheless has he an excellent record in S. research) and sent a sample also to Miss C. Lorenzen, of APRO, as told by the papers. Unfortunately the process of determination (and by whom?) of its different density (1,86) in comparison of our earthern magnesium (density 1,74) has not been disclosed by M.D. Dr. O. Fontes (now beeing expected on a visit to the U.S.A., as told by Mrs. C. Lorenzen).
- (3) - On an earlier date, as stated by Nicap's, Ufo Informer, had contactee D. Fry refused to hand over to Nicap a S. metal sample, probably by reasons that now seem us quite plausible.
- (4) - Even so stated Nicap's secretary R. Hall to us (in a letter of Nov. 7, 59) "to fight for truth over dogmatism and prejudice".
- (5) - In reference to contactees seems Mrs. Lorenzen to agree with NICAP in as much. .."contact claims in which no evidence is presented.. should not be considered in studies concerning the reality of UFO's." But naturally this reasoning can't be accepted by our present civilized world, where the courts accept the statement of sworn witnesses, a proceeding which comes down to us from roman days.

Since other Soc. ... "persue very similar principles to those of Nicap... (1) those eventually will come out now to Nicap's defense or, if Nicap's situation is indefensible, will drop it quietly. Some still wonder about Nicap's apparent fight against the USAF's "debunking and explaining away" but an old associate (2) of Nicap's secretary R. Hall, is Brasil's secret Saucer Investigation Committee man, DR, Escobar Faria, who explains nicely the same maneuver in regard to the criticism on USAF by Airforce Captain Ruppelt in his book that... "this criticism on USAF may have been cleared previously with the Airforce... so as to give (to the author) in front of the public... more independence.... and possibility to mislead (despistamento)" (3); read also about this remark nr. 1 on page 335, of the portug. translation of Ruppelt's book).

We would expect that the campaign "Flying Saucers are a conversial matter" will still go on for a time and certain Bulletins will tell us that "they (F.S.) are forth dimension, Deros and Teros, space animals, mass psychosis, Hollywood-jokes, refraction of headlights in reindroplets, planet Venus and commets" and at the same time we are told that Saucer photographs may be faked ones, since there is no proof, nor should credit be given to contactees, even if they have a clean past and their concrete proves should be dismissed and not analysed, asking (by incoerence) at the same time for the remittance of concrete proves of F.S. existence or for the description of eventual physical charactersites of the face or gait of spacecrews, so as to make interception possible by military secret services. Some of this may be done in good faith, but most of it directly by the silence group, so as to sow confusion in S. research.

Otherwise we may reason that any barrage of false rumors and propaganda may backfire on its conspirators as we saw this at the Tribunal of Nurenberg 1945. Young nations, uncommitted by unconfessionable economical or political taboos, may tell all the truth to their own people even Flying Saucer truth.

Related to this we quote excerpts from a letter (June 27, 61) of APRO's Editor C. Lorenzen (4145 E. Desert Pl., Phone EA-6-0059, Tucson, Arizona) there says she "I would also like to comment on the apparent lack of interference in UFO information from the military and government agencies of your country (Brasil)... (in the USA) Newspapers and Magazines are extremely hesitant to print anything concerning UFO which does not agree with the .. claims of the United States Air Force.." (4)

But APRO's July 1960 states that : "Major Brigadier Reinaldo de Carvalho, chief of the Air Force High Staff left (Brasil) unexpected (on July 15, 1960) for a visit to Washington.. (Also) Minister Mello left Brazil on July 22 (on) an unexpected invitation to the Brazilian Air Minister to Washington to confer with the Secretary of the Air Force (of the USA). It is possible that this... activity involving Air Force personnel of the USA and .. Brasil, was caused in part.. by UFO activity in Brazil (May, 60). It is also possible that Dr. Fontes' (contact member for a military secret service) mention of UFO activity along the South Atlantic missile run, may have alerted those in high

- (1) - As stated in a letter (7/5/60) from the secretary Mr. B. Menzies of CSI of New Zealand (Director : H. H. Fulton; Bull.: Space Probe.)
- (2) - Dr. Escobar Faria (together with Aurifebus Simões) had done the portug. translation of Ruppelt's book "Report on Unidentified Flying Objects" and has been co-editor of Nicap's secretary R. office ...on July 22, arrived in Brazil Major General Leighton I. Davis (who) now commands the Air Force Base at Cape Canaveral... His visit to Brazil is not therefore entirely un expected, considering his interest in the South Atlantic missile range, and Fernando Noronha..." (unquote from Mrs. Lorenzen's letter).

SBEDV's Editor takes in account that Mrs. C. Lorenzen's report took place in 1960 and since then the new brasilian Government took steps so as to guarantee its complete independency in internal and external politics alike, so as to international relationship. Now the question comes up, if this country (Brazil) will take steps to guarantee also its independency in an eventual future interplanetary approach, if that should prove feasible, since in Brasil besides the multiple Saucer sightings, there have been mentioned a few, but repeated reports about Saucer-landings, with crew members seen near-by (in some of the cases). If the rare cases should prove true, where contacts between our population and space crews have been mentioned, then steps should be taken so as to guarantee our complete independency to assure for Brazil an unhampered study about those facts and also the possibilites and responsabilites they may bring to and demand from our own government, independent of the different reasoning of other governments.

As an exemple of the rule of power (instead of morale) on truth, we may shivering remember the narrowmindedness of leaders in Middle Age which executed those who refused to fall in line with the phylosophy that our earth should have been the "flat center of Universe". Now in our time of the "champions of liberty and democracy", with the slogan of "liberty for all" it would be an ugly procedure, if a government, elected democratically by this liberty, would, afterwards, when in power, take cynically undue advantage of that power, so as to coerce "undemocratically" its nation by withholding or deforming the truth, by a barrage of propaganda, going on to physical coercion when necessary, so as we this saw in a scandalous manner, in politics previous to world war II, ending then with those mystifiers in the padlock at the Tribunal at Nurenberg.

Military powers react by their own laws which not allways are those of moral. Otherwise are the latter the base for diffusion of truth, and may be even a better help as a power for survival, and this message may allready beeing understood by some intelligent people amongst us.

An apreciable help we got also from foreign correspondents as Mrs. Gladys Fusaro and by encouragements and Bulletins of Mrs. Coral Lorenzen. But also critics help us, especially when those come from sincere people (there allways may be some different opinions in a matter that's on the move forward, as F.S.study) as editor H. Ragaz of the outstanding "Weltraumbote" (S eestrasse 309, Zurich 2/38), who we got to know personally in 1958 as a hard and efficient worker, and we are convinced that, as research progresses, Saucer facts will be seen clearer and under the same prisma as time goes on, when finally an agreement may be reached on the crucial points; even so we have to admit that the silence group could have been interested to slip in some mock contacts (earlier, the case of a secret S. congress member was focalised in Brazil), only for confusion of research. Otherwise we also admit that some contactees may get conceited by their experience, so as to get arrogant, even so against other contactees. If only some contactees could got toguether, in each country, so as make some rules for themselves for better clarifcation, publishing also at the same time all atempts of bribery, on them, physical coercion or framing, this then could be a good contribution to close the picture of debunking of UFO truth, the excistence of which is not put in doubt, by anyone, anymore.

Pseudonyms and a tail between leg attitude are inadmissable and we all may admire the mental courage disclosed by the organizer and attendends of the Wiesbaden 1960 F.S.congress, which may have been inspired by the G.A. damsk. tour. (Read also about it in G.A's new book "F.S.Farewell").

Nº 19 - Gazeta de Notícias (Rio, May, 23, 1961) tells that on one of the days of the last week, the civil cargo plane DC-3, PP-VWA with the pilot Darré, co-pilot Corrêa and radio officer Nascimento had the flight of the plane accompanied by a Flying Saucer during more than an hour, on the route from Florianópolis to Rio de Janeiro. Darré saw a luminous disc circling on sea level and thought it the projection of a floodlight. Moments later the strange object ascended with incredible speed until the plane's level, siding with it. Without hiding his nervousness Darré contacted the station of the tower of Porto Alegre immediately, but his message was heard also at Rio de Janeiro and an uninterrupted radio contact was then established, when Darré reported that the Saucer made evolution around the plane. The plane kept its course unaltered and at the level of the port Paranaguá the Saucer moved away to the horizon leaving a luminous trail that vanished in short time. The pilot made a report to his company at his arrival at Rio de Janeiro.

Nº 20 - Correio Paulistano, June 7, 61, tells that on the free way from São Paulo to Santos, "Via Anchieta", at km 48, police man Jaime de Miranda and Autrojildo Bica Medeiros saw a "luminescent object", near the tunnel of the descending road, at 2.15 A.M.. The guards stopped 20 cars on the road so to have witnesses as Aldo Sciciliani of the "Polícia Marítima", the fiscals Danton Neves da Silva, José Aduato Conrado and Antonio Faria da Silva and 16 persons more. The officers told that there was a reply of the Saucer when signalling with the flash light, but the object remained at large. The sheriffs Zair Dornaika and Paulo Furquim of Santos and José Otavio Goudinho of Cubatão came out to the spot. The first called it a "Phenomen", the second a "Flying Saucer" and the third draw his gun, to take a shot, but was hindered to do so by his colleagues. The authorities of the airbase tried to explain to the journalists that all came from the confusion with the lights of the windows of a shaque near by, but the owner of the house stated that they had kept closed their windows all night.

Nº 21 - (Folha de São Paulo 3. ed. July 25, 61)  
Commander José Guilherme Saez when in flight from Rio do São Paulo, with his passanger plane PP-SQT, saw at 20 PM a luminous (of bluish light) object that making evolutions around another plane, but later around his own one, so that all the crew and also the 13 passengers could see (with delight) the strange movents of the object, which did' describe curves, but would also move suddenly in angles moving from one side of the plane fast to the other and so it could'nt have been another plane that was making acrobacies around the PP-SQT.

The commander put his impressions down in the Diary of the plane, so that Brigadier Clóvis Travassos of the DAC (Diretoria de Aeronáutica Civil) can take a look on it, if he wishes so.

Almiro esplained a lot the things related to the pictures he had taken.
