# ARE UFOs FROM OUR FUTURE?

Could UFOs be time travelers from our future? Here are some of the ideas which have come to me over the years since I've retired here in Oregon. I was a practicing physician and now have both children in medical school.

What I've done is to try to put together a scenario which would fit the UFO phenomenon, current and past world history, etc. Remember, it's only a possible scenario; for it to approach the truth, it would have to touch a lot of bases-- the bases being observed facts. Moreover, it should include more than just the UFOs.

There are a lot of similar enigmas whose relationship has not, I believe, been recognized. These enigmas include Velikovsky, his theory, the apparent confirmations, and the enigma of his censorship by both the media and science. When you examine the "Velikovsky phenomena" closely, you will find the exact same censorship as that suppressing general acknowledgement of the UFO.

I believe the UFOs have the

power to cross time--they come from a "future" earth, perhaps, but most likely the solar system. There may be others from other solar systems, but those with the general humanoid appearance must be from our own. There are a great many "bases" which this touches.

Moreover, Velikovsky seemed to uncover evidence that the Earth was moved into a new orbit within recorded history, a fact which seems improbable, but which was mentioned in various passages in the Scriptures. He found the same world wide catastrophe described in others of man's works around the world from diverse civilizations including China. It occurred at approximately the same period in history. There was also a lot of physical evidence geologically that this took place. But if it did, why?

The Scriptures say it was part of a war, you might say. It was, it seems, the God of the Jews protecting his children from their adversaries who were pursuing them intending to do them harm. I believe this is, in fact, based on a far greater truth than we realize. It is an allegory of what actually happened.

The ancient Jewish and Christian theologians believed the Scriptures were largely allegory. There were really three meanings held in them: moral, historical--but the ultimate was the spiritual and that was held in their allegories.

We find in the Holocaust which occurred in Nazi Germany an insanity. If Hitler's Third Reich had enlisted the services of the Jews instead of murdering them--and performing grotesque rituals of hate as they were doing it--they would have had the atomic bomb first and then the world.

I believe that insanity was superimposed across time on a civilization that was already existing in the future. There is quite a bit to

confirm this in the history books, Scripture and current events, not to mention the various religions around the world.

#### BIBLICAL REFERENCES

What effect on a future civilization already existing would moving the Earth to a new orbit in the past have? It would dissolve it as the changes from the past swept forward in time and suddenly reached the present or future.

In Psalm 75, 3rd verse, it says "...The Earth and all the inhabitants thereof are dissolved...I said to the fools (don't do it)...etc." Then it speaks of horrible vengeance of God for such an act.

The last Last Supper in the New Testament is contained in Revelation 19:17. It's slightly different than the painting in the Vatican. All mankind must attend whether they want to or not; but not to eat. They are to be eaten--by the world's vultures at "...the supper of the great God".

Now consider the spiritual. What does it claim to be able to do? It claims to be able to see across time--into the future. But if it can see the future, then a paradox seems to exist. For if you, knowing you will be killed if you cross the street at a certain hour and place, don't; the future changes. But that is exactly what premonitions and spiritual warnings in dreams are supposed to do.

A spiritual eye view of the future--or of all time--would be static, of no motion. But, if a change were injected into the picture by spiritual intervention across time, there would be a movement as that change progressed on into the

future. This is how God must have created. The ancients believed the Creation is over, however. He isn't doing it anymore.

#### THE RISE OF ISLAM

The 2nd Psalm speaks of a revolution of mankind against Heaven and its violent squashing or defeat.

If you look at current history, Judeo-Christian civilization is in trouble from two sources. One is the Red Horse of Communism which is sweeping the world. But the "long shot" of the Black Horse of Islam seems to have the ultimate victory, believe it or not.

All over the world, Islamic temples are mushrooming. Shortly after the turn of the century even Soviet Russia will have an Islamic majority. Stalin's insane purges of 10's of millions were directed at the Caucasian race largely. Even in the U.S., if present trends continue, the Caucasian or at least the European descended peoples will be a minority shortly in the next century. They already are in most of the major cities such as Los Angeles (or soon will be).

Thus, in the 2nd Psalm's "kiss the Son because he will kill you if he is upset" can be read "Stone"--as stone-God-horse-bridgroom are often interchangeable. We must recall that Ishmael "will be a wildman--his hand upon everyman..." If he indeed succeeds in what seems to be happening under "spiritual direction", he will have seized the entire world in our time.

Remember, it's just a theory. I don't necessarily believe it. It is only a scenario which seems to make sense out of the Bible. There is a passage in the New Testament which says the story of Abraham and the two sons was an allegory and that Ishmael has seized control of the world. That would have to make reference to our Age. The Lord's Prayer, if you analyze it carefully, petitions to have this fact changed.

Although there were only 150 in attendance, the Congress was pronounced a success. The small numbers were the result of a lack of reports in Belgium and the high cost of attending.

# UFOs AND THE ELECTRONIC MEDIA

The Globe and Mail, Canada's only national newspaper continued its anti-UFO tirade in a subtle way on August 21.

It did it through its television guide. The listing of Channel 57's showing of Overlords of the UFO had a distinctly cynical wording: "A documentary claiming to offer photographic evidence that identifies UFOs as flying objects from outer space." This is not quite accurate as the film points towards other dimensions as the origin of UFOs. Aside from that, one cannot claim to offer photographic evidence. Either one shows photos or one does not do so.

The same channel followed the Overlords documentary with Mysteries from Beyond Earth.

This time the Globe took a different tack. Now UFOs are psychic phenomena, it said. Here's the wording of the listing: "This documentary looks into the bizarre world of witchcraft, UFOs, the Bermuda Triangle and other psychic phenomena."

Mysteries appeared prior to August 21 on the same channel with the same TV guide wording in the Globe on Sunday, July 28. On both occasions, the Toronto Star's television listings had a reasonably fair description of the movie: "Phenomena including witchcraft, UFOs, the Bermuda Triangle and psychic healing are examined."

The Globe repeated its description of Overlords when it appeared again on Thursday, August 29 at midnight on WROC-TV in Rochester, New York. In contrast, the Toronto Star said:

"unique film footage separates facts about flying saucers from myths."
