# UFOs AND THE ELECTRONIC MEDIA

## A COMPARISON OF TV GUIDES DESCRIPTIONS OF UFO FILMS & DOCUMENTARIES

"Close Encounters of the Third Kind" was presented twice, in October and November, on television stations in the Southern Ontario area, with the length of the film varying from the original, according to the guide you read.

In the 1986-87 edition of Movies on TV, edited by Steven H. Scheuer, Bantam Books, the movie is said to be two hours and 17 minutes long. We presume that this is the original version. "The Special Edition" of the motion picture added scenes inside the carrier craft. These were included for showing on TV.

On CJOH, Ottawa, Ontario, a CTV outlet, the movie lasted two hours and 40 minutes when it was shown on Saturday, October 4 at midnight. Only the Toronto Star gave a description of the movie. Their guide said

"Ordinary people are drawn by visions and incidents into a wonderful exchange with flying saucer aliens." Note the use of "flying saucer", rather than "UFO". The Star was correct in its usage here.

No description was given by the other major Toronto newspaper, the Globe and Mail, who just mentioned the name of the film in their October guide for that week.

Although we usually give you a chronological survey of the guides' listings, we will deviate from this format because the movie was repeated early on Sunday, November 2 at midnight. This time it was shown on Kitchener, Ontario's CKCO-TV.

Suddenly, we see full descriptions appear in TV Guide magazine, and the Globe and Mail and Toronto Star. Not only that, but the motion picture is said by all of them to be three hours long. Was the Ottawa station showing the original version, while the station in Kitchener put on the Special Edition? Since we in Toronto cannot get the Ottawa station, we may never know.

There is a fair bit of difference between the accounts of the film given in the television magazines. TV Guide: "Steven Spielberg's vision of an awe-inspiring meeting between humans and extraterrestrials."

The Globe and Mail: "Steven Spielberg directed this wonderfully uplifting box-office hit about an earthling's first contact with aliens. The spectacular wide-screen special effects will be lost on TV."

The Toronto Star repeated their wording for October 4. (See top paragraph in this column).

The Star just uses the word "wonderful" to describe the exchange of humans near the end of the film.

The Globe and Mail calls the motion picture "Wonderfully-uplifting", whereas TV Guide refers to the first meeting between "humans and extraterrestrials" as "awe-inspiring".

The Globe mentions an "earthling" but the other two journals pluralize, using "people" and "humans".

The Star mentions that people have visions and incidents that draw them into the exchange. TV Guide, in contrast, talks about Spielberg having put onto film his vision of the first meeting between humans and ET's. The Globe and Mail concentrates on the fact that Spielberg directed the flick. It also tries to discourage people from watching by stating that the special effects will be lost on TV.

On Thursday, October 23, "Secrets of the Bermuda Triangle" was shown on CFTO-TV in Toronto, Ontario, at 1.30 a.m. The Globe and Mail added to the title, calling it "The Secrets of the Bermuda Triangle."

The Globe said it was a documentary, the Star called it a drama, while TV Guide referred to it as speculation. The Globe erred in saying it was made in 1978, whereas the other two journals said 1977.

Only the Star made mention of UFOs as a possible cause of the mysterious disappearances of ships, etc. from the area.

Only TV Guide gave the actual

boundaries of the Triangle in its description of it. TV Guide said the area was noted for "peculiar phenomena", whereas the Star said there were "hundreds" of mysterious disappearances of ships, planes and their crews. The Star pointed out that there are various possible causes "from electromagnetics to UFOs." The Globe gave very little detail. TV Guide's description was the best of the three.

A Halloween evening showing of "The Thing" at 1.30 a.m. Saturday, November 1 on CBC Television's Toronto outlet, CBLT-TV, was depicted in three different ways by the three magazines.

The Star said it was "science" (their shortened version of "science-fiction"); the Globe called it "horror"; TV Guide referred to it as a "thriller."

The Globe did not mention the words "flying saucer", while the other two journals did so. TV Guide used humour, saying the creature looked like a "giant carrot." The Star says the creature is frozen inside a frozen saucer, while TV Guide mentions that the Arctic research team ~~recovered the~~ creature's body. The Globe states that the creature is a "murderous alien." This time the Globe gives the most accurate description, and goes further to give its opinion: "It still delivers shocks."

A French UFO comedy was shown on CBC's French TV station in Toronto, CBLFT, on Saturday, November 1 at 8 p.m. It is entitled "Le Gendarme et les extra-terrestres" and was made in France in 1978.

The 90-minute film was given a short mention in TV Guide. The Star actually catered to its readers by giving a plot outline. Translated, it read "Two policemen from St.-Tropez see a space ship taking off."

With this issue, we are discontinuing the column on the media and UFOs.

## 2 BOOKS TO REVEAL GOVERNMENT-ALIENS, PHILIP KASS-C.I.A. CONNECTIONS

There are two books now in the process of being written which will be very interesting to all ufologists. Each is expected to be in print and in the bookstores in the United States in the spring of 1987.

One of these will be by Lawrence Fawcett and Barry Greenwood co-authors of Clear Intent. It has been given the tentative title, Just Cause, the truth about the UFO phenomenon. The publishers are Dodd, Mead.

### TRIPLE CONNECTION

Fawcett told your editor that the book will deal with the

connection between the cattle mutilations, the Rendlesham Forest/Bentwaters UFO landing case of 1980 and Project Aquarius. Project Aquarius is the classified U.S. Government UFO investigation-classified above Top Secret, according to Fawcett.

Fawcett said he knows about Aquarius through his military contacts, one of whom includes a two-star General. Fawcett, being a police officer for many years, has also obtained a lot of information from his police and FBI friends.

He said that the Pentagon has already completed a motion

picture which reveals much about the U.S. Government's contact with an "emissary" representing 70 alien races who are visiting Earth. The on-going contact started in the middle of 1975. (Ed.Note: THIS IS THE FIRST TIME ANY UFO JOURNAL HAS PRINTED THIS INFORMATION)

Fawcett said that the film shows how the contact was begun. It ends with the statement that UFOs are not only real, but extraterrestrial in origin.

An agreement was made in 1975 for an exchange of technology. The humanoids were aided in doing their cattle mutilation work by the U.S. Military which supplied blacked-out helicopters for the operations. In exchange, we got some assistance on the Stealth technology and the Star Wars or SDI program. Fawcett did not give any other items of technological exchanges which are going on to this day.

Fawcett also said he knows more about Aquarius and the Roswell incident than member William L. Moore. He said that Presidents Carter and Reagan have been given full access to all the Project Aquarius data.

He said that humans are a "failed experiment" which was actually what we called "Adam and Eve", brought to this planet to see if a pure race could be developed, one which would have no flaws physically or mentally. It failed and is to be destroyed before the year 2000.

Fawcett said the cattle mutilations are DNA experiments by the humanoids. He also said that in the year 1990, something will occur which "will change the course of human history."

#### REPEATED SAME STATEMENT

This is what Bill Moore told members of CUFORN at a meeting held at your editor's apartment in 1983. When asked how important the event would be, Moore said: "It will be as important as if Christ had returned."

When asked about the event, Fawcett said Moore is correct. Is it geological in nature? "No," said Fawcett. "It's nothing to do with earthquakes or pole shift." "What would you say it is, good or bad for the human race?", your editor said. Fawcett said: "It will be somewhat to the good."

He went on to say that part of the exchange of technology in 1975 was the Americans acquiring a UFO from the humanoids. "It was lent to us or given to us or captured by us. This resulted in the death of U.S. Air Force General Robert Bond when he died in the crash of the craft in 1982 at Groom Lake, Nevada." (Ed. Note: Groom Lake is in the AEC test range and is surrounded by mountain ranges. So it's ideal for testing classified aircraft.) Fawcett said that the UFO was modified so that Bond could fly it.

CUFORN President Joe Muskat asked Fawcett if there was a master plan to condition the people to a certain attitude toward UFOs. He said there is one. It involves planned leaks of information, but mainly is one where motion pictures are being used. He said that Close Encounters of the Third Kind, E.T., and various situation comedies on TV which have an alien in one or all episodes are all part of the process. The intelligence agencies are behind them. The process will be complete in 1990.

The print media are controlled so as to print nothing or very little about UFOs. Clear Intent is in its

second printing and, in the United States, is in the political science sections of the bookstores.

Fawcett said that, "if the intelligence agencies tell the print media not to print something, the comply. If they say nothing goes, nothing goes."

"You've got to remember, this is one of the most closely guarded secrets of all times," he stated.

He did mention that he had some problems during the time he was writing Clear Intent. He did not say whether these were government interferences or threats against him, but one would surmise so. Obviously, he was not intimidated by them, and the book was published.

He said that the new book will have government documents within its pages. He expressed disappointment that one of his sources, independent researcher Lee Graham of California was no longer able to give him information which he had received from a military source. He said that Bill Moore had asked Graham not to give him more data because Moore wanted to use it himself to make money.

What a breakthrough it would be if Moore, Fawcett, Greenwood, Graham and people such as Len Stringfield, Bruce Maccabee and Todd Zechel were to get together and combine their research efforts into one excellent book. It would blow the Aquarius secrecy wide open and then these people could go after the media and let the world know just what is going on. As it is, we will probably have to wait until Reagan is out of office in November, 1988 to find out all about UFOs.

## MORE ON AQUARIUS

FROM A

CONFIDENTIAL SOURCE

From a source which must remain confidential, here's some more data on Aquarius.

The humanoids decided to see if humans could breed a "pure" race just before World War Two. They planted into the minds of the leading Nazis the idea of breeding just such a race-pure Aryans. The experiment did not work as we all know. At the same time, they decided to try to give the idea of starting a World War to the Nazis. This did work and it ended with two nuclear blasts at Hiroshima and Nagasaki. So the humans were at the stage where they had the nuclear bombs to eliminate the experimental animals, namely themselves, by means of a nuclear war. Possibly, the humanoids have a moral code which forbids them to personally destroy the human race. So all they had to do was wait until we developed the atomic weapons to do their work for them. In a recent telephone conversation with W. Todd Zechel, your editor was told the following.

Zechel is writing a book which is solely about the UFO phenomenon. He is the former founder of CAUS, the Citizens Against UFO Secrecy, a former intelligence specialist with the U.S. Army Security Agency and the National Security Agency with Top Secret Crypto-Plus Clearance, sued the CIA under the U.S. Freedom of Information Act and won, originated the Just Cause Newsletter and is a documentary producer and writer. He turned investigative reporter and researcher in 1976.

Zechel is the publisher of a small journal, For Your Eyes Only. It's not a particularly original name, but judging by his background, it should prove to be very informative. We already have one issue in hand.

His first issue features part one of a three-part series on debunker Philip J. Klass and his CIA connection.

Forthcoming issues will have stories with the following titles:

Part two-Klass Dismissed-Klassical Disinformation; The Watergate Set-up; NASA's Sins; The Nixon/Vesco Heroin Deal; The CIA's Unreleased UFO Files; They Killed Kennedy; Spying on Ufology; and The Washington Post CIA Mission.

In a recent conversation with Larry Bryant, a former Zechel associate in CAUS, Bryant said: "Zechel is sitting on a smoking gun. I hope he gets his book out before someone gets to him or his sources."

In another phone conversation with Zechel, your editor asked him what the new book will be about. Zechel just said it deals with UFOs and other matters. He said he is very worried and afraid for his life.

Zechel's former position with NSA means he may have access to some of the Aquarius data. Since he was in cryptanalysis, he would be an expert on codes. He may have seen and decoded some of this information and decided to write a book about it.

He mentioned last names or code names in his sources for the first part of the Klass exposé. The names are Raven, Knight, and Lothar. Raven could be Francis A. Raven, head of NSA's Prod G Group. G Group processes SIGINT(Signals Intelligence) from all non-Communist areas of the world since the early 1960's. Raven is a Yale graduate and a veteran of the U.S. Navy during World War Two.

Raven is not afraid to talk, as shown by the many quotations from him on a book on NSA, The Puzzle Palace, by James V. Bamford, 1982, Houghton, Mifflin & Penguin Books Ltd.

Canada's equivalent of NSA is the Communications Branch of the National Research Council.

#### THE NSA-UFO CONNECTION

Two of NSA's Scientific Advisory Board in the past included Dr. Howard P. Robertson and Dr. Luis Alvarez. Both were on the famous 1953 Robertson Panel on UFOs, which was supposedly set up by the CIA. Was it actually NSA who convened the panel?

Robertson later became a scientific advisor to the late President Kennedy. Robertson was Professor of Theoretical Mathematics at Cal Tech; Alvarez was a radiation specialist at U.C.L.A. (Berkeley) and Associate Director of the Lawrence Radiation Lab.

One of NSA's consultants was the late John Von Neumann. He was a mathematician who taught at Princeton University. He was the father of computer logic and a pioneer in quantum physics.

According to Lawrence Fawcett's article on MJ-12(Majestic 12), the team that investigated the UFO that crashed and was retrieved at Roswell, New Mexico on July 2, 1947 included many of the same scientists who were involved in the Manhattan Project which developed the atomic bomb. One of those persons was John Von Neumann. Others included Dr. Robert Oppenheimer, Dr. Vannevar Bush, Dr. Werner Von Braun and others.

Wilbert Smith interviewed Dr. Robert Sarbacher, formerly of Georgia Tech in the U.S. on September 15, 1950. Smith was head of the Telecommunications Branch of the Canadian Government. Smith's widow and son have been in touch with your editor on a few occasions.

Dr. Sarbacher's letter to researcher William Steinman from his position with the Washington Institute of Technology in 1983 has been of interest to several researchers. One was sent to CUFORN's Bill Moore in December, 1983 and others went to Tom Benson, Gordon Creighton of FSR(U.K.), Jerome Clark, and possibly a few others.

A copy of the letter was reprinted in FSR's Volume 31, No.5, 1986. In it, Dr. Sarbacher mentions the recovery of the Roswell craft and the assignment of Bush and others to investigate it. Donald Menzel was part of the MJ-12 team and he later became an associate of debunker Philip Klass, who in turn is working for the CIA. So it now appears that Philip Klass knew the details of the Roswell crash before Bill Moore through his friendship with

Donald Menzel. Now we have the spectacle of Klass going around debunking UFOs when he knows full well that they are real and extraterrestrial as well as the details of the construction of the craft. It's too bad we don't have Klass on the ufologists' side of the question. He could tell us what has been discovered about the Roswell disc. Fawcett said Smith had a piece of the Roswell disc, which was analyzed in Ottawa.

A new UFO book is due out in U.S. bookstores in April, 1986. It is titled Communion, by Whitley Strieber. The publisher is William Morrow and it deals with an abduction case. (From the Massachusetts MUFON Newsletter, October, 1986)

## ANALYSIS UNDER WAY

CUFORN is in the process of investigating a possible abduction case involving an Ontario woman. She has given samples of an odd-looking fragment of a material to CUFORN. We have sent it to the University of Toronto for analysis. Results should be available to us by mid-November. These will be published in the next Bulletin.

We are indebted to Professor George Hathaway, head of the University's Electrical Engineering Faculty for his aid in this investigation. Hathaway is a specialist in Tesla technology, particularly the use of a Tesla generator which he is using in experiments involving Einstein's Unified Field theory.

This is in response to your letter of 20 February 1986 in which you stated that, regarding your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for information on Project Aquarius, you are interested in Aquarius as it pertains to unidentified aerial objects. Please be advised that Project Aquarius does not deal with unidentified aerial objects. We, therefore, have no information to provide to you on the subject.

In your letter you also ask for information on Projects Sigma and Snowbird. The FOIA provides that a person has a right of access to federal agency records, except to the extent that such records are protected from disclosure by one of nine exemptions. It does not require that an agency answer questions. As I mentioned in my letter of 20 February, Sigma and Snowbird are not NSA projects; therefore, we have no information to give you on these topics.

Since you indicate in your letter that you will not be paying the \$15,000.00 fee to search for records pertaining to Aquarius, this response completes our action on your request.

This responds to your letter of 7 March 1986 in which you further narrowed your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for records pertaining to Project Aquarius.

The document located in response to your request as stated in your 7 March letter has been reviewed by this Agency as required by the FOIA and has been found to be currently and properly classified in accordance with Executive Order 12356. This document meets the criteria for classification as set forth in subparagraphs 2, 4, and 8 of section 1.3 and remains classified TOP SECRET as provided in section 1.1 of Executive Order 12356. The document is classified because its disclosure could reasonably be expected to cause exceptionally grave damage to the national security. Because the document is currently and properly classified, it is exempt from disclosure pursuant to the first exemption of the FOIA (5 U.S.C. section 552(b)(1)).

In addition, this Agency is authorized by various statutes to protect certain information concerning its activities. We have determined that such information exists in this document. Accordingly, those portions are also exempt from disclosure pursuant to the third exemption of the FOIA which provides for the withholding of information specifically protected from disclosure by statute. The specific statutes applicable in this case are Title 18 U.S. Code 798; Title 50 U.S. Code 403(d)(3); and Section 6, Public Law 86-36 (50 U.S. Code 402 note).

No portion of the information is reasonably segregable.

Since your request has been denied, you are hereby advised of this Agency's appeal procedures.

Any person denied access to information may, within 45 days after notification of the denial, file an appeal to the NSA/CSS Freedom of Information Act Appeal Authority. The appeal shall be in writing addressed to the NSA/CSS FOIA Appeal Authority, National Security Agency, Fort George G. Meade, MD 20755-6000.

The appeal shall reference the initial denial of access and shall contain, in sufficient detail and particularity, the grounds upon which the requester believes release of the information is required. The NSA/CSS Appeal Authority shall respond to the appeal within 20 working days after receipt.

In your letter, you take exception to the amount requested by this Agency for manpower and computer search fees to process your original request for all information on Project Aquarius. Please be advised that NSA search and duplication fees are computed in accordance with guidance promulgated in sections 6-201 and 6-202 of DoD Directive 5400.7-R.



## SYRIA'S PRESIDENT ASSAD DISCLOSES HIS INTEREST IN UFOs IN TIME ARTICLE

What has to be a most unusual landmark for ufo-logy was contained in the pages of Time Magazine, October 20, 1986.

UFOs were mentioned in a major interview by that magazine of world reknown. The interview was with the President of Syria, Hafez Assad.

The journal printed only excerpts from the interview with a group of Time journalists. Assad suggested that only ET's could make peace between the U.S. and the Soviet Union.

Assad mentioned that he had been interested in UFOs for a long time and that he takes them quite seriously. He went on to say that he would expect an extraterrestrial power to be unbiased and that it would offer only advice to Israel and the Arab powers, not military or monetary solutions.
