

# ***Two CE1's Reported In January By Southern Ontario Couple***

On Thursday, January 21, 1988 around 10 p.m., I received a call from Eli Krstanovic of Fulton, Ontario. Eli seemed quite excited, but very collected and organized.

He began by telling me that his wife Debra had a close encounter with a UFO that evening. I asked Eli how he was able to contact CUFORN. He stated that his wife first called the local detachment of the Ontario Provincial Police. They told her that this matter was not in their jurisdiction. The same answer came from the Niagara Police Department. After Eli arrived at Dunnville from Fulton, he called the Department of National Defence's Hamilton Office who referred the couple to the Department's Toronto area office at CFB Downsview. That office called CUFORN's number.

The episode opened up in Fulton, a small town southeast of Hamilton, Ontario, high in the Niagara Escarpment only ten kilometers (6 miles) south of Lake Ontario. The young couple, who own a small business, began their adventurous evening at around 8 p.m.

## ***in a trance***

For some reason, while Eli was talking to a customer, he began to stare thoughtlessly across the room, totally ignoring the customer. This patron just walked out, leaving Eli standing and staring. Eli mentioned that he felt that he was in some type of a trance. As he recovered, he had a sore and stiff neck on the right side. This type of behaviour, he admitted, had never happened before.

Debra, a dog breeder, was going to Dunnville, 20 kilometers to the south, regarding

a dog that she had sold to another couple. Debra had mentioned to me that she very often goes out in the evening and takes her mother along for the ride. This evening, for some reason unknown to her, she did not want to take her mother along. Debra had left at 8.09 p.m. Eli had looked at the store clock just as Debra had departed and verified the exact time.

Debra began to go down Caistor Centre Road. Traffic was very light with only three cars in front of hers. The cars seemed to be pulling away from her and blended into the night, either by turning off or being too far ahead. No cars were to be seen in either direction.

## ***light descended***

Debra noticed up in the sky a small light surrounded by what she described as smoke. This object then began to maneuver to the left side of the car and slowly came lower and lower. At this time her car's speed was approximately 80 kph (55 mph).

The object levelled off at house-top elevation, now displaying its shape in the form of an extremely bright white cigar, 30 feet long. Debra became quite scared. She accelerated the car to 120 kph to outdistance the object. The object kept pace and settled into position at about five to six feet above the car. It changed its colour to a high-powered blue light with very bright white lights at each end.

The incident lasted for about seven to ten minutes. Debra described a pulling sensation on the car. Shortly after this ended, the object disappeared. Debra opened her car window. There were no sounds heard either during or after the incident. The car radio and all electrical components worked well. She reduced her car's speed to 80 kph. Arrival time at her destination was 8.40 p.m. This was verified by the people she was visiting and by Eli.

### ***knew she was calling***

As Debra arrived at her destination, she immediately called Eli to tell him of her experience. Eli, being in the store, did not answer the phone in the usual manner. He said he just knew that the phone call would be from his wife and that there was a problem. He was right.

Eli looked at the clock in the store. It was 8.40 p.m. Debra was too scared to come home alone, so Eli closed his store early and drove with some friends to bring back his wife. Close investigation of the car disclosed no scratches or unusual dents. Eli pointed out a dented hub-cap, but was not sure when this happened.

According to Eli, he and his wife have travelled this road many times before and visited these people, and that Debra should have arrived there in 20 minutes. I asked Debra to account for the other 11 minutes. She could not. Her health and general physical condition was excellent following her experience.

### ***normal reaction***

I asked Debra how the dogs behaved toward her when she arrived at the house. Debra said they were very normal in their behaviour and very friendly. If Debra was abducted, why were these dogs so friendly? It is well known to investigators that animals will sense that something is wrong and will not react normally toward an abductee for some time afterward.

What about the missing 11 minutes? Debra is considering regressive hypnosis.

It was learned later that Martin Nedelk, Jr. had also seen an object on the same night but saw it as red in colour. We are waiting for his report to come back to CUFORN for further investigation.

### ***sirens sounded***

It may or may not be connected, but at 2 a.m. on January 21, 1988 the local air raid sirens sounded. This was verified by Corporal Ralph Nelson of CFB Downsview whom CUFORN contacted.

### ***previous sighting***

Incidentally, Debra and Eli had another sighting about four years ago in the same area. A cone-shaped object was seen by them along with 20 other people. This object was visible for about an hour. It was projecting beams of light down in all directions.

### ***car followed***

On February 29, Harry Tokarz CUFORN's Treasurer and Co-Director spoke to Eli on the telephone. Eli said that, on Thursday, January 28, 1988, the couple had another UFO encounter. They were travelling in their car on the same road and were followed by a very brilliant object until a few miles before they reached home. When they got there, she went into the house. As he got out of the car, he saw a football-shaped object with coloured lights hovering over their house roof for ten minutes. It was at a 200 foot elevation and was the size of their house. Eli did not

call her out to observe the object. It may be a sign of "programming" of his mind at that point. She showed some reluctance in taking a sighting report form to her neighbors who had sighted the object on the 21st, as well. Although the couple had CUFORN's phone number, neither reported the second sighting until Harry Tokarz phoned them, at which point they mentioned the second encounter.

Other signs of programming of the people involved in this case were realized some time afterward. Harry and myself noticed clicks on the phone line when we were talking to the Krstanovic's. Harry, myself and Larry Fenwick, who was collecting data on the case, all had severe headaches during the two weeks of intense investigation of the case. Fenwick noted that he only recalled two other times in his life when he had headaches. Harry, too, is not subject to headaches, although I have had tension-induced migraine headaches in the past. Debra said that she had migraine headaches during the period following the encounters. Both Debra and Eli are young, she being 20 years old.

### **forgetful?**

Another possible bit of evidence for programming occurred when I took a videocamera and 35 mm. camera to the location of the sightings. I did not use either item, as if I was made to forget to use them.

### **programmed?**

It is possible that the young couple have had other encounters and have repressed their memories of them, or maybe there was some mental programming by the aliens which influenced the people involved in this investigation.

When I looked at the sighting report form filled out by Debra, I saw that she described the object as solid-looking, and she gave two different descriptions of the object. In one section, she said it was a cigar-shaped object; in another, that it looked like a light bulb. It seemed to drift along when following her car. She thought that there was 15 minutes of time which she could not account for, and that there were a series of lights underneath the object which turned on and off in a counterclockwise direction. The actual time of the encounter was given as 8.10 p.m. She was driving a Plymouth Reliant K-Car, of recent vintage. The night was cold, with a partly cloudy sky. There was no precipitation. Her vision and hearing are good. There are high tension power lines in the vicinity. The object's surface appeared smooth. The location of the encounter is fairly remote, with only a few residences nearby.

## BEACH AT HAIFA BURNED DURING 1987 UFO FLAP IN ISRAEL

Reliably investigated reports abound from every non-communist country in the world and although the "veil of ridicule" prevails everywhere, we generally collect better data from those states with a solid democratic foundation.

Yet there are exceptions. For instance, when CUFORN members were alerted to a compendium of apparently solid UFO cases coming from the state of Israel, we immediately made special efforts to verify the information. An assortment of CE1's, CE2's, a landing-trace and possible abduction were things that were filtering through and catching our attention.

Israel, despite its reputation of being the only true democracy and free state in the Middle East, has consistently clamped a tight lid on legitimate UFO reports over the years. Besides being geographically surrounded by a multitude of hostile nations and thus extra security-conscious, we have always suspected that Israeli military censors follow stiff C.I.A. leanings with regard to UFO policy. Thus, members of CUFORN immediately seized upon the rare opportunity to make these accounts available to the UFO community in particular, and to the public in general.

### press coverage

On January 10, 1988, Larry Fenwick, one of CUFORN's three Directors, received information from Lionel Beer in England regarding a number of interesting UFO incidents in Israel which were covered by the Jerusalem Post. On January 17, 12.30 p.m., Toronto time, Fenwick and I placed an overseas call to researcher Hadassa Arbel, of Haifa, Israel. Arbel, 41, had received some local press coverage for her thorough detective work on a number of CE1 and CE2 cases, including an unusual landing trace incident in her local area, a coastal town north of Tel-Aviv on the Mediterranean Sea. Hadassa, who works for City Hall by day, we learned, co-ordinates a tight-knit UFO group consisting of 20 members in her spare time.

In conversation, Fenwick and myself were immediately impressed with her integrity, intelligence and competence. She had just completed a study of a local flap which apparently began on September 19, 1987 running to October 8, with a trace-burn examination on October 4, the result of a large, glowing, rotating object seen over a beach area on September 28. A witness who underwent dramatic psychic changes is still being followed up and, in the spirit of co-operation, our group in Canada will be kept abreast of any new developments.

### power blackout

Things began to happen on September 19 when Rivka Hershku, a 32-year-old housewife from Kiryat Atta, a suburb of Haifa, reported that at 2115 hrs. in the evening, a power blackout in her home impelled her to go out in the street with a candle to wait for her three children who were due back home. A lady friend who was visiting at the time accompanied her.

Suddenly, she felt an unexplainable urge to look back and noticed at the back of the house, approximately 35 meters away, a body of light shaped like a disc.

The object, estimated at about eight meters in length, was motionless at first sight and completely without sound. Within the body of light, Hershku distinguished rectangles, the light of which was 'different' and which she thought were 'windows'. After the ladies stared in disbelief for about 30 seconds, the object "jumped" lightly down about 50 centimetres. It continued to "jump" several times and then disappeared behind the Villa which was located behind her house.

A short time later, electrical workers arrived to investigate the power failure, only to find that the power had been restored mysteriously. With this initial incident, Arbel and her group soon began to unravel a pattern of events, which were to keep them busy for weeks. We will discuss only the more significant scenarios.

On October 8, 1987, at 0110 hours (1.10 a.m.), Amram Turgeran, a 53-year-old train engineer, prepared himself to conduct a certain locomotive to its site, when his eye caught a huge light that dived from "nowhere" in the sky and then stopped in a "very brusque manner", quite close to the ground. It then took off at tremendous speed and disappeared. The object was described as "yellowish-red" and Turgeran estimated it was about two and one-half to three meters in length, seen from a distance of 700-800 meters. The witness further described the object as having "no glow but being lighted within itself, like the moon". The form was elliptical, flew vertically and had a small "tail".

### **locomotive disabled**

At this point, another train worker named Swissa approached the witness, wondering what had happened since it seemed that another locomotive had stopped functioning. Again, as in the previous case, everything returned to normal with the departure of the UFO. In researching vehicle and electrical interference cases, so far we have been unable to trace another case where locomotives were affected by EM radiation commonly associated with UFO fly-overs.

Not surprisingly, many sightings during this time period were reported to the Haifa Police force, who traditionally "did not want their name associated with as dubious a subject as UFOs". As a result, and to our good fortune, Hadassa Artel was summoned in by the constabulary in order to drop the whole matter in her lap, including the thankless task of having to deal with the skeptical Press, in this case, the normally high-standard Jerusalem Post. Curiously, in this case, staff reporter Ya'acov Friedler managed to write a fairly objective and relatively accurate piece for his newspaper, with only a feeble attempt at debunking from an "unnamed Senior Naval Officer".

The highlight of related activity occurred on September 28, placing it right in the middle point of the flap, and caused a genuine "buzz" in this coastal community. At 2225 hours (10.25 p.m.), a young man named Ammi Achray, 27, and married with two children, spotted a massive object behind a SONOL gas station, not far from the Mediterranean beach. He later described a large body of glowing "fire" rotating at high speed around its axis and "dropping spots of white sparks". No engine noise was heard but a sound emanated like that of air being "cut". At the same

time, on the horizon, there were noiseless "flashes" reminding him of a magnetic storm.

The object rotated for about six seconds, ascended and descended slowly, disappeared for about two seconds, then reappeared about 20 meters to the right. Again it rotated in the previous manner for another six seconds, this time near the ground and then finally disappeared for good.

When Achray arrived home and reported the event to his wife, she begged him to keep his story a secret for fear of being branded insane. However, not to be deterred, he wisely related his experience to his father, an open-minded individual, who promptly urged the young man to return to the spot in search of some evidence. Ammi, still stunned by his experience, procrastinated for a week but finally relented and returned to the scene on October 4. Located at the exact spot on the beachfront was a peculiar-shaped scorched area which later to involve Artel in a gold mine of physical evidence.

For all the inaccurate press UFO's get worldwide, at the best of times the print media do manage to get names correct and with a stroke of luck this witness, Ammi Achray, happened to come across Artel's credentials published in a local newspaper. Contact was made and on October 6, witness and investigator spent two hours examining the alleged landing site.

### **six findings**

Artel's findings, as relayed to CUFORN with accompanying photos were as follows: A) We found that the scorched area was symmetrical, B) We found that it (scorch site) had the exact form of the UFO seen, in its profile (see drawing), C) Diameter was ten meters, D) On the left part of the scorched form we found unscorched "isles" of thistles which remained intact and undamaged.

At this point, it is interesting to note that Artel attempts a difficult but concerted task, that of trying to make "sense" of the "unscorched" anomaly within the scorched anomaly by presenting her own, perhaps fanciful, interpretation of the situation. As researchers, we are constantly at odds with some of the absurdities left behind in physical trace cases and are often guilty of

attempting usually fruitlessly, to bring our present-day state-of-the-art technology interpretations to bear on these things, in order to somehow come to terms with an alien constitution no doubt far removed from our present-day understanding of the physical universe, not to mention logic.


However, as is often the case, Arbel presents us with an interesting interpretation which adds another mystery to the mystery. She states: "After a while, we deciphered the unscorched "isles" of the unburned thistles (see photo). We distinguished very clearly a clear cut form (in profile), of a small ufonaut about one meter in height. We distinguished his pointed helmet (or head?), his seat, his hand holding some steering wheel or gadget (profile), his leg pressing some gadget; and less than one meter in front of him we distinguished a straight, narrow, geometrically-formed strip (perpendicular) of untouched thistles which looked like a control panel. Behind him, there was another ~~symmetrical form~~ which I could not decipher--looking like this:  -maybe it was the tank of energy or vision system?" (Editor's Note: Readers may not get a grasp of this interpretation unless they are viewing original photos--repros may lose needed contrast.)

To clarify things, Arbel's contention is that the scorched site was caused by radiation or some kind of "cold fire" (micro-waves?) from the UFO seen by witness Ammi Achray, and which allegedly suffered an engine or propulsion malfunction. The oddly-shaped thistle patch that had remained untouched within was the silhouette of the UFO pilot/navigator, his hand outstretched to pull some lever. As she suggests, "He was about 90-100 cm tall and his silhouette remained unburned as he was obviously wearing some protective gear, shielding him from radiation".

As for the location of this site, it is of great significance that one of the most highly-acclaimed scientific research institutes in the world, the Technion, is but a stone's throw from the area. Many high-level secret projects are initiated here and we know from precedent that our alien visitors have shown more than a casual interest in such sites.

Lastly, (F), Arbel states: "About 20 meters to the right we found another piece of scorched earth, but not as badly scorched as the original, and without thistles. There we found another anomaly: The soil arranged itself (and still does) spontaneously in forms of symmetrical conic holes, or holes shaped like cones". (see photo).

In further developments, Arbel came into contact with a witness whom she strongly suspects had an abduction experience during the height of the flap around Haifa. The witness is fearful of hypnosis, afraid of what might be revealed and so at this time this avenue of investigation has not been explored. This witness claims that he has developed the ability to bend, by concentration, plastic gadgets, but to date no researcher has witnessed this personally.

Of particular interest, though, is his claim that he constantly visualizes a series of strange letters, between one and two meters high, on between 0800-1100 hrs (8-11 a.m.). The symbols noted here:  are "huge, persistent and unmistakable and they repeat the selves constantly". What "drives him mad" is that he is not able to decipher them. Arbel, a student of UFO literature for 20 years, notes that the only similar cyphers she is aware of were revealed in the "UMMO Affair" several years ago. Perhaps other readers may recognize similar symbols from other cases. If so, we might all be the richer in knowledge for the sharing of this information.

At this time, Hadassa Arbel and her group in Israel are keeping an eye on this witness and, if he should relent in his resistance to undergo regressive hypnosis, their findings will be published.

Some additional information sent us by our correspondent relates that a soil sample from the scorched area


was examined against a sample of normal soil 20 meters away and this sample was found to contain 6.71% materials with magnetic qualities as opposed to 0.01% of same in the normal sample outside the scorched area. The lab test was conducted by a physics professor at a well-known scientific institute and not surprisingly, both the professor and the institute requested strict anonymity.



## "SPACE GRASS" ANALYZED; RESULTS SHOW IT'S AN ALLOY

A sample of metal found forming an eight foot diameter circle in a forested area known as Bear Meadow Meadows near Hayfork, California has been sent to CUFORN for analysis. The analysis is complete and we publish the results here for the first time.

The metal was found on May 15, 1985 by a former U.S. Marine officer, who wants to remain anonymous. His first name is Jim. Jim is a friend of former U.S. Marine Major Lyle Vann of Paulden, Arizona who raises Rottweiler dogs and cattle and has been corresponding with me for the past two years. Lyle Vann mailed me the sample, late in 1987. He said that Jim was working for the Forestry Service when he came upon the circle of material. His boss called the U.S. Government in and they sent four men from Florida, one a Colonel, the others in civilian suits. They blocked off the area after they had looked at it and he told them he had not taken any of it for himself.

The men dug up what remained down to a depth of four inches in the earth. Jim was told the material was of unknown composition but was not dangerous. Jim and Lyle think it was from a UFO.

CUFORN Consultant George Hathaway, Ph.D., physics, analyzed the material in a scanning electron microscope at a voltage of 20KV, at 30 UM or microns, with a magnification level of X 1.00K. The XRF microprobe was used at the facilities of Armstrong Research in Toronto. A large graph showing the results is shown on the next page. The prime element in the sample is aluminum, with the remainder being magnesium. The diameter of the sample sent to CUFORN is one and one-half inches. It looks like aluminum filings and is very thin in terms of the individual filings. SEE PAGE 12
