

# Member one of four witnesses in 1979 daylight CE3 in Toronto; "about 30 E.T. shadows" reported



It was a sunny clear day in the last week of May, 1979, when Elizabeth Nagy, age 11, was leaving for school with her mother who was escorting her twin brothers Zoltan and Tibor out the rear entrance. They were leaving the high-rise apartment building at 1441 Lawrence Avenue East in Toronto, Ontario from the rear exit, between 12.30 p.m. and 1 p.m. One of her brothers happened to look back and upward and saw what is shown outlined in the photo of the building at right.

He pointed it out to the others who stood and watched it hover for between five and ten minutes. They were looking northwest and the object was just above the building's roof. The sun was behind them. The UFO was the color of a brown paper bag. It had "windows which were moving around the ship from right to left. A series of E.T. shadows were walking inside the ship—about 30 of them—like it was a school ship watching us. There was a red light on the bottom of the ship and a blue and a yellow light just under two windows. It was silent," said Elizabeth , who is now a CUFORN member.

"Suddenly it shot up diagonally, disappeared behind a cloud, reappeared, then drew away, became smaller and smaller and was gone. When it moved upward, it looked like a disc. I was very excited—it was unbelievable. I told all my schoolmates and teachers. The UFO had sharp edges, looked solid, and was larger than a basketball held at arm's length," she said.

# COUPLE IN CAR CHASE NL IN BRAMALEA

Marie and Doug Casimiri, franchise owners, of Mississauga, Ontario, were driving at 20 kph south on Dixie Road just south of North Park Drive in the city of Bramalea, 5 km. NW of Toronto on Saturday, November 26, 1988, at 1.45 a.m.

They were returning from a friend's home. The two say they have perfect hearing and vision. They said the skies were clear, there was little wind, and the temperature was 5-8 degrees C. (42-48 degrees F.) The scene was 5 km N of Pearson International Airport. What happened next is described by Marie:

"We noticed the smaller object first, traveling from east to west across Dixie Road as we drove south on it. (ED. NOTE: percipients at night usually use the word 'object' even though they see only lights) The smaller object was as bright as a star, uniformly white, self-luminous and round with sharp edges. It was the size of an apple held at arm's length. It came across the sky, then down until, in the distance, we were unable to see (it) because of houses. We watched it for approximately 30-45 seconds before it was out of sight."

## "winding pattern"

"When we looked back up into the sky in the direction it came from (east), we saw a series of very bright lights in a row. We assume the lights were on a larger round object the size of a basketball held at arm's length. It was hovering when we first noticed it. We drove toward it and it remained hovering. After two minutes, it started moving in a slow, winding pattern. We followed it in and out of the streets east to Bramalea Road, which runs north-south. We followed it on a straight line north on Bramalea Road for a few more seconds. Then, all of a sudden, it just sped off within an instant until it was out of sight heading north. We observed the second object for approximately 10-12 minutes," Marie said.

The couple did not notice the Moon or stars. They said the lights were at a 45 degree angle above the horizon. The larger object was in view continuously. No other traffic was noticed, so we do not know if there were other observers.

As for possible mundane causes, given the movements and total duration we can eliminate stars and planets. Aircraft do not take off or land at Toronto's Pearson International Airport at that hour of the night. The time also precludes weather balloons, helicopters and advertising planes.

## "curious and calm"

The next day, they called the telephone operator to ask who they should report the sighting to. The operator suggested they call Peel Regional Police. They, in turn, said they should phone the Ontario Provincial Police. The O.P.P. gave them the phone number of CUFORN's Harry Tokarz.

CUFORN's sighting report forms ask people reporting UFOs what they felt emotionally during an observation. They said they felt "curious and calm."

The couple said they had prior interest in UFOs. Marie had obtained some knowledge of UFOs through talking to other people, from movies, books and television. Doug's knowledge came only from TV.

CUFORN, after weighing the evidence adjudges the report to be one of 2 true UFOs, of the nocturnal light variety, rather than a CE, as we have no way of estimating the distance the observers were from the lights.

# STRANGE ENCOUNTERS

Valid evidence exists to substantiate the existence of celestial entities, some human in appearance, like us, and others much smaller. I know this for a fact.

In 1952, age nine, summer, I believe in July-Point Defiance Park, north of Tacoma, Washington, U.S.A. Earlier in the day, I had been with my cousin and older brother, Tom. It was rather late at night, maybe around 9.00 p.m. and getting dark. I saw a light in the sky, like a light bulb (yellowish-white), moving back and forth. I was scared. I saw many small aliens; they seemed to be talking. I couldn't understand them - their sounds; they seemed to be looking at me, but from a distance. It didn't look like a room, just white- couldn't see walls. I felt like I was sitting on a stool. I know they didn't do anything to me then (at that time). Arrived home about 11.00 p.m.

15 November, 1959 (age 16). Two friends and I on a trip to Los Angeles, California, to visit a friend on leave from the army. Sunday morning, 3.00 to 5.00 a.m., about 100 miles from Sacramento, California.

Driving on old U.S. 99, was taken aboard bluish-white spacecraft ( a big one). The car was beamed up. My two buddies were asleep. I know now they were unconscious. They didn't know anything about it. I wanted to tell them, but couldn't. I never told anyone. This has been my secret. I just couldn't get it out until now. This occurred between Marysville and Chico on old U.S. 99.

Unlike most, I never forgot about this. The aliens took me to a room on the right. The room was like an operating room; on the wall to the right were some instruments - like clocks. Coming down from the ceiling were three black cords with devices on the end - lasers, a large (long) table near the cords. I remember six aliens in total; they were 4½ to 5 feet tall, unlike those in "Intruders" and "Communion" - "Missing Time" too, except for the eyes. The eyes were large, like human eyes, but big.

They (the aliens) were very friendly. I thought they were cute (at first). I was given an examination (I will not elaborate about deeper details, but everything works fine in a certain area).

After a couple of hours, the aliens put me back in the car (with my buddies). We were back on U.S. 99, just outside of Sacramento, California. I did some checking in a gas station in Sacramento.

My life was changed; never the same. I started drinking and was very hard to get along with - I was Mr. Know-it-all and don't tell me anything or what to do. I knew it all But I learned to live with it; this was locked up inside - down deep, until now.

The spacecraft was around 50 by 30 feet high. I believe the aliens had eight fingers and two thumbs - like us. I believe the spacecraft (on the bottom) had two rooms (left room, right room); the car was in the

the alien took me to the right room. I could see that the wall was kind of round where the car was, but didn't notice it in the room on the right. There was kind of a greenish mist where the car was and a whitish mist in the room on the right.

The aliens took me around the front of the car to the right. I could not move on the operating table except for my eyes; the aliens had complete control over me. Communication was done by thought. Never did I see their lips move. The aliens were very expressive with their eyes and with movement of their heads and arms. The aliens did walk, but floated at times. I don't remember if the aliens had straps on me while I was on the operating table. I don't think they did.

I did notice to the upper left what appeared to be an instrument panel and could see two aliens (perhaps to the front and up to the left- from the right room, or operating room). This may have been the flight deck or control center. There were three aliens to my right and one to the left. The two I saw up above would make six-this in the room on the right.

According to documents released last week by the Public Records Office, in 1955 Churchill wrote a typically pithy letter to the air ministry on a subject of which it would naturally have hands-on experience: "What does all this stuff about flying saucers amount to? What can it mean? What is the truth? Let me know at your earliest convenience."

The air ministry replied that a full study in 1951 had shown that reports of unidentified flying objects or "flying saucers" could be explained as: known astronomical or meteorological phenomena; mistaken identification of conventional aircraft, balloons or birds; optical illusions or psychological delusion; or, finally, deliberate hoaxes. The Americans, apparently, had come to similar conclusions a few years earlier.

The ministry added: "Nothing has happened since 1951 to make the Air Staff change their opinion and, to judge from recent press statements, the same is true in America."

We are left wondering what could have happened since that report was written that could explain the present enthusiasm for star wars. The proposed technology would seem more credible as a defence against extraterrestrials than it does against Soviet missiles. □



# SOBEPS HOST AT FIRST EUROPEAN UFO CONFERENCE HELD IN BRUSSELS, BELGIUM; 10 COUNTRIES REPRESENTED

Theoretical aspects of the electro-magnetic field along with an experiment, criteria for selecting the hardest cases, the myth of extraterrestrial visitations, and the Gulf Breeze, Florida case were among the speeches given at the November, 1988 First European UFO Conference.

Held in Brussels, Belgium, the congress was hosted by SOBEPS, the Belgian Society for the Study of Spatial Phenomena. The three-day meeting was closed to the public. It attracted approximately 50 ufologists from Italy, Spain, Switzerland, the Netherlands, Austria, France, Belgium, Great Britain, the U.S. and the U.S.S.R.

Among the better-known speakers were Walter Andrus, Jacques and Janine Vallee, Richard Haines, Hilary Evans, Jean-Pierre Petit, Roberto Pinotti, and Vladimir Rubtsov.

The total number of speakers was 19.

The SOBEPS organizing committee was headed by Jacques Scoreaux and Thierry Pindivic of France. As part of their work on the week-end of November 11 to 13, they arranged it so that each delegate received a copy of the book, "Soucoupes Volantes aux OVNI", by Michel Bougard, president of SOBEPS, some copies of SOBEPS Info-News Bulletin, and a programme.

## **"physical aspects"**

Auguste Meesen led off the speech-making after the first night's cocktail party and organizer Jacques Scoreaux's opening remarks. Meesen's lecture was entitled "Analysis of the physical aspects of the UFO problem."

Following a coffee break, Italian Maurizio Verga spoke about the Italian UFO research which now uses computer technology. The final Friday topic was the Becassine Project - a data base for statistical studies on CE3's.

Corrado Malanga and Roberto Pinotti led off Saturday's talks with a discussion of "the UNICS Project - Computer Graphics: the new UFO image computer system". Richard Haines was next, with his contribution - "Analysis of a UFO photograph". The morning ended with

Jean-Pierre Petit's presentation: "Scientific Report - Part 2".

## **informal talk**

An informal talk on the current ufological situation in Spain by Enrique de Vicente was the first order of business on Saturday afternoon. At 2.30 p.m., Michel Fiquet, a UNICAT Associate and author of the 1979 book "UFO: Close Encounters in France", spoke on the topic "Criteria for Selecting the Hardest Cases."

Next came a speech by Jacques Scoreaux, "French and Belgian Sighting Catalogues". Skeptic Claude Maugé was next. His dissertation was entitled: "a preliminary List of 'Classical' UFO/IFO Sightings."

A dual presentation by Edouardo Russo and Gian Paolo Grassino was more general in nature. Its title was "Toward a European Ufology - Where is America headed?". Russo is involved or has been involved with nine European and American organizations, is the editor of five UFO group journals, and has written articles which have appeared in seven journals. He is a tax and accounting consultant with an M.A. and Ph.D. in economics. Grassino is or has been involved with six UFO groups and has contributed articles in three UFO magazines. He is co-editor-in-chief of UFORIU.

Isabela de Vicente presented a speech titled "Ignacio Caeria's Communication," followed by Vladimir Rubtsov's lecture, "The Problem of Anomalous Aerial Phenomena and its Methodological lessons."

After dinner at a nearby restaurant, the delegates heard MUFON's International Director, Walter Andrus, speaking about the Gulf Breeze, Florida case.

"The Myth of Extraterrestrial Visitations" was the topic of Hilary Evans speech in the evening. Evans, from London, England,

# Member's drawing shows experiment in electro-magnetic radiation based on colours reported in 1965 incident at Exeter

Bruno Ericsson, 57, a CUFORN member, has been doing some experiments in physics which he says are based on various famous UFO incidents. We present a drawing he sent us of one of his ideas, this one supposedly relating to the CE2 which occurred at Exeter, New Hampshire, in the U.S. on September 3, 1965.

Ericsson has a B.A. in physics and his B. Sc., along with a B.A. in Mathematics and Chemistry. He lives in a suburb of Stockholm, Sweden, is a former Swedish Navy Petty Officer, and now makes his living as a protection technician.

You will note that he has sent a copy of the drawing here to U.S. President Reagan, although one wonders what a former sports announcer and motion picture actor would make of this drawing.

Ericsson says he has spoken to a General Field Marshall Ichi who proposed that blue would be one of the colours obtained.

is one of England's better known researchers. He is an advertising copywriter and photo librarian, and has written, compiled and edited eight books on UFOs. He is also a member of BUFORA's Council, and co-founder of ASSAP. He has a degree in literature from Cambridge University. He is a skeptic.

The next speaker was Paolo Toselli, whose background includes major involvement with four Italian UFO organizations and editor of ACOMN since 1973. He was also a contributing author for the 1982 book "First UPIAR Colloquium on Human Sciences and the UFO Phenomenon". his speech was entitled, "The Abduction Mysticism".

The concluding speech was by Pierre Lagrange, and was titled "Some up-to-date notes on Kenneth Arnold's Flying Saucers." Lagrange is known in France as a researcher specializing in the sociology of the paranormal and is most interested in reports from the years 1940 to 1950.

The week-end conference ended with a general discussion, an informal debate and concluding remarks.
