## Aliens Are Gods?

Many people seem to believe our visitors are Gods! By definition, to be god-like entities, they'd need to be flawless, omniscient, perfect. But if we base our belief in those visitors solely on reports from other witnesses, maybe we should also take a look at their inferior qualities as shown in those same reports.

Here are seven cases which I have selected to demonstrate my point (all emphasis is mine):

### CASE 1

Source: A CATALOG OF HUMANOID REPORTS FOR 1974 by Ted Bloecher, MUFON 1975 UFO Symposium Proceedings

Observer, a nurse's aide, was walking from one hospital building to another when she saw a disc descending; four legs emerged and the object landed atop the roof. A ramp, or ladder, emerged . . . **One being turned and saw the witness watching; the three then re-entered the object, which took off . . .**

### CASE 2

Source: A CATALOG OF HUMANOID REPORTS FOR 1974 by Ted Bloecher, MUFON 1975 UFO Symposium Proceedings

Truck driver observed blinding white light on the road; at 200m. his lights and Diesel motor went out ... Two 6 foot tall beings appeared ... **They looked at the witness, gestured to each other, and one pointed at him; the two then disappeared around the right side of the UFO, which rose . . .**

The next day:

- continued

Truck lights and motor killed, as before . . . **four men now appeared and approached, at which the driver got out of the truck and fled.** They followed, gaining. After running some distance, he jumped into a drainage ditch and hid; **the four searched the area but did not find him . . .** he returned on foot and saw, from a distance of 8-9m., the men digging at the roadside . . .

### CASE 3

Source: Contact 158 by François Bourbeau, 200 pages, Louise Courteau Editor, ISBN 2-89239-013-3

This is a transcript of a hypnosis session with Mr. X. This man had been abducted with his car. At this point, he is about to leave the craft:

Yvon Now, tell me how you got out?  
 X I've been told to sit in the car and to touch nothing. There will be a count-down from ten to one and at that time, I must start the engine! A door will open and I should find myself on the same road where they picked me up.  
 Yvon Where are you now?  
 X I just got in the car . . .  
 Yvon Where are you going?  
 X Outside . . . home . . .  
 Yvon What's happening?  
 X The countdown has started . . . get ready . . . (silence for three seconds) . . . THREE . . . What the hell is happening? (Mr. X shouts that sentence. He seems excited.) Oh! . . . Boy Oh Boy Oh Boy! . . .  
 Yvon What happened?  
 X I hit a road panel, on the side of the road . . .  
 Yvon Where are you precisely?  
 X On the road, I am . . .  
 Yvon What's happening?

X I've been informed that **there has been a technical error.** They say they'll come back . . .

### CASE 4

Source: TOUT SUR LES SOUCOUPES VOLANTES by Jean Ferguson, 258 pages, Leméac

- How long did you observe together?
- I'm not sure, a little more than 30 minutes.
- What happened next?
- We got back in the car completely frozen. My friend told me: "Why don't you flash your lights?" The car being in the general direction as the UFO, I thought I could try it. I did just that. And suddenly, a **very strong light was shining on us.** . . . it lasted a few seconds, then the UFO resumed its . . .

### CASE 5

Source: INTRUDERS by Budd Hopkins, 318 pages, Ballantine, ISBN 0-345-34633-5

After a hypnosis session with Kathy where she described how they removed the foetus from her womb:

I asked if she ever said anything to them, ever told them that it was cruel, that they had no right to take her baby. She spoke to me almost in a whisper, calmly furious: "I screamed it at them." Then, in a sad, ironic mix of incomprehension and profound personal loss, she added this: "**And the f\_\_\_\_\_ looked surprised.**"

### CASE 6

Source: INTRUDERS by Budd Hopkins, 318 pages, Ballantine, ISBN 0-345-34633-5

During the abduction, Ed was raped:

"... I was laying on my back on this bench and I didn't have any clothes on, and somehow they made me erect and she mounted me . . . and then she got off and left the room and the two guys, they took little spoons and scraped

the leftover semen off my penis . . .

"You know, Budd, I'm sterile . . . I'd had a vasectomy a couple of years before this." The previous night, just after he came out of the hypnotic trance, he mentioned that his **abductors had seemed angry at him**, and now I understood why.

### CASE 7

Source: NIGHT SIEGE by Dr. J. Allen Hynek and Philip J. Imbrogno with Bob Pratt, 207 pages, Ballantine, ISBN 0-345-37086-4

Slowing even more, he peered through the windshield, straining to make out some type of shape behind the lights.

"I thought to myself, 'I wish it would come closer so I can get a better look at it,' and as soon as that thought went through my mind, **the object began to descend and head straight for my car.**"

It had switched off its "searchlight" and was now about one hundred yards above the road.

Let's try to show them the way they really are: One of God's (any god) features is to be omniscient. In cases 1 and 2, they did not know, at first, that there was a human witness. In case 5, they did not understand our psychology, while in case 6, they did not know that the man they were abducting for a semen sample was sterile. Those examples show a less than know-it-all entity!

They are very curious. They travel long distances to monitor, record and collect information. They seem to like to communicate! Maybe they are not supposed to contact any earthling, but they often do anyway. In cases 4 and 7, they answer a witness and in case 7, they even give him the opportunity to get a good look at their craft (as if they were proud of it).

They can even become angry. In case 6,

Ed had a definite impression that they were angry at him. Also in case 3, although the fact is not mentioned here, there were two entities performing the abduction. The witness believed that one of them was mad at him for an unknown reason and that it could be the cause of the "technical error".

So, I think we can safely assume that these visitors are not god-like creatures. They are certainly members of advanced societies, but it does not mean that they are flawless.

## Letter to The Editor

Dear Editor,

I was pleased to read Lawrence J. Fenwick's review of my book UFOs Over Canada in the September - October, 1991 CUFORN Bulletin. The reviewer is exceptionally knowledgeable about traditional ufology and has a very sharp eye for errors, misprints, etc. Yet he shows poor judgement in devoting almost the entire review to a rambling criticism of the punch, 20-page preface that I contributed to the book. He does less than justice to the 200 pages devoted to eye-witness accounts contributed by 60 witnesses, contactees and abductees. He is obviously more interested in arguing than he is in reading.

The reviewer accuses me of "bias" and "prejudice" against UFOs, despite the fact that UFOs Over Canada is the first *neutral* book on the subject to be published in this country. He implies that I am a member of the CSICOP camp. This faulty judgment will come as surprising news to Henry Gordon; the debunker has called me, among other things, a "paranormalist"!

I do have biases and prejudices. So let me point out a few of the corresponding biases and prejudices of the reviewer, adding only that in my opinion the elimination of all biases and prejudices is not necessarily a Good Thing!

- \* The reviewer does not see or admit that there is a distinction between "evidence" and "proof". Throughout the preface I argue that although there is a lot of evidence for the existence of UFOs, there is precious little *proof* of their objective existence. I also argue that the best of the evidence takes the form of "memorates" (first-person narrative accounts).

I am the first person to use the word "memorates" to describe such narrative accounts. In previous books issued by Hounslow Press I was the first person to note the essential characteristics of paranormal memorates. The fact that I took this handy term from the discipline of folklore is held against me, despite the fact that I argue that use of the term is value-free. Maybe I should follow the reviewer's lead and note the fact that traditional ufologists take their term for events and experiences — "cases" — from criminal procedure.

- \* The reviewer is clearly uneasy with my argu-

ment that UFO studies could be viewed in light of psychical studies — so uneasy that he dismisses this line of reasoning without even noting that its application does give unity to my book and it does supply me with a rationale to present, as evidence and without argumentation, 60 highly readable, eye-witness accounts from witnesses. Where else will the reader find such a wealth of first-hand material?

- \* The reviewer suffers from "me-too-ism" and shares this characteristic with the above-mentioned Gordon. The fact that I did not mention every fact known to the reviewer does not damn me! Nor does it follow that each and every detail that he mentions is right or even relevant. A good instance of the narrator's irrelevancy concerns Reagan's remark about global unity in the face of alien invasion. Yes, I am aware that Reagan made statements to this effect on five occasions. Doesn't the reviewer appreciate the fact that politicians repeat themselves, especially when the press responds to their remarks?

Unfortunately, the reviewer's "me-too-ism" obscures the fascinating fact that I go on to make the point — never before made in print or in conversation — that a quarter of a century before Reagan spoke, Lester B. Pearson made precisely the same point on a far nobler occasion — in his Nobel Prize acceptance speech. It is obvious that the reviewer does not know how to evaluate my discovery — because Pearson's remark is *not yet* part of traditional ufology, so he gives it the blind eye. If I had more space I would give further instances of the reviewer's specialist blindness to my original Canadian and foreign contributions.

- \* My main point is that the reviewer, as a representative of traditional ufology, shows a lack of peripheral vision. He misses the Big Picture. Yes, we are dealing here with the Big Picture, an immense and immensely important human (if not also alien) phenomenon. All approaches to the subject, including Canadian approaches and especially humanistic approaches that stress the "strangeness" and "otherness" and the "imaginal" nature of the experiences, should be encouraged, not dismissed.

On the whole, I am pleased that the CUFORN Bulletin reviewed UFOs Over Canada, though the pleasure is tempered by the fact that it occasioned such a traditional-minded, blinkered response.

## CE1 Among Three Toronto Reports - An Ongoing Investigation

During the mid to late part of October, 1991, CUFORN received three reports of strange orange balls of light in the Toronto, Ontario area.

The first report came from a family that lives in the Lakeshore district of the City of Etobicoke, specifically near Lake Ontario.

The family, who wish to remain anonymous, reported two orange balls approximately two to three miles away near the CN Tower, the world's largest free-standing structure. No other reports were received that day nor appeared in any news reports.

The second report came in of an event that occurred a week later. It was witnessed by a couple who made the initial report, and was also seen by a number of people who lived in the same apartment building. Again, the people lived at the waterfront of Lake Ontario. They saw orange balls of light at a distance over the lake. They said they saw a number of orange balls rise from the water up to the clouds, move horizontally and vertically in different directions, almost like dancing. They would rise up, then move horizontally, then come down half way to the water, then rise back up to the clouds. The observation lasted 45 minutes. No other reports were received for that day. When I called Toronto's Pearson International Airport Air Traffic Control Centre, they said the balls were being watched by the Buffalo, New York Airport's Air Traffic Control. Buffalo did not know what they were. I also contacted the Coast Guard who said that about two hours earlier they had sent up flares for some training exercise. However, the location given was well west of the location where the orange balls were seen.

## CE1 and a police denial of involvement

The third incident happened on Toronto's Bloor Street West at Jane Street near Humber River Park about two weeks later. A lady called to report strange lights outside her apartment building residence at about 2:00 a.m. the previous morning. Before calling us, she had called the Metropolitan Toronto Police. They sent an officer to the scene. When she explained what she and her male friend had seen, he laughed and said it was probably a helicopter.

The next morning she called the police to speak to the officer and was told by the police telephone operator that no such officer went out that night to a call. She was told by the operator that there was no officer by that name with that police unit.

The lady made another call to the police later that afternoon. This time another operator said the officer she named did not come on duty until midnight. So she called again and finally talked to the officer who was on duty. He denied having talked to her the night before or having been anywhere near her location.

## "a whooshing sound"

It turns out that lights were seen and noises heard by over 20 people from the building (practically all of the residents of the apartment units facing the park where the lights were seen). Here is the report:

At approximately 2:00 a.m., the woman was asleep on the couch. All of a sudden, she was awakened by a "whooshing sound" which was fairly loud. At that point, her entire living room became brightly lit.

She went to the window and saw three orange balls in formation going from east to west at tree-top elevation. They moved in front of the building above the trees, then rose and

lowered themselves beyond the trees toward the ground which is level parkland. The balls then rose and split into six balls, rose and fell, and finally climbed back to tree-top level.

Three of the six balls headed east and three went west before disappearing from sight. They were bright — about the size of a basketball or a bit bigger (when held at arm's length). At all times during the sighting, the orange balls were no more than 150 feet away from the observers.

When the ground and surroundings were checked on the following day, nothing could be found. The entire duration of the sighting was approximately one to two minutes.

When we interviewed the principal witness in the third sighting as a follow-up, she reported that she had previously had other sightings of unusual lights and that these had been seen in different locations, where she had resided. It seemed to her that they followed her any time she moved to a different home.

A further interview and investigation, which is still ongoing, disclosed that she, her daughter and her granddaughter have had some unusual experiences, some of which might be abduction experiences. One included a description of the so-called men-in-black types, which she could not understand.

We will provide further details on this case in future issues.

## The Theory of Earth's Second Moon

From the beginning of time, man has always wondered why life exists only on earth and whether or not life exists elsewhere. This is a question that is still being pondered at the end of the 20th century.

For the past 17 years, I pondered this same question until I experienced a first hand encounter with a UFO. This statement will undoubtedly make some people uncomfortable, but permit me to start from the beginning.

In my many years of space research, I was looking for life on other planets in our solar system and beyond. I discovered a fact which most people would shrug off or reject as being impossible simply because it is beyond our present knowledge. This phenomenon has commonly been referred to as a "black planet", similar to black holes in space. I am convinced that highly intelligent life exists on these so-called "black planets".

These "black planets" are black because of the extreme denseness of their mass and the very powerful magnetic field that surrounds it. It is for these reasons that the reflection of photons or other microwave signals cannot occur.

I have found three such dark planets around our solar system which have an effect on their neighbouring planets. It is important to state and note that Newton's and Kepler's laws of gravity and planetary motion are negated by these planets (unlike our moon which rotates around the earth in 27 1/2 days). However, while these black planets spin on their axes, they DO NOT rotate around another heavenly body. As a result, for these planets, a solar eclipse cannot occur, but a lunar eclipse is possible. One of the planets which is affected by these black planets is the Earth and, in turn, Earth's moon.

It is for this reason that atmospheric and magnetic changes which have been measured and experienced are unexplainable. The "Bermuda Triangle" is one area where these changes have been noted. The other is the so-called "Devil's Sea" which is located at 30° longitude and 20° latitude in the sea south of Japan. These two points have inexplicable destructive powers. Electronic and magnetic equipment such as compasses, engines of ships, airplanes,

and submarines are rendered dysfunctional and/or disabled. Many are lost without a trace. Between 1945 and 1976, six hundred ships, planes and boats were lost in the Bermuda Triangle. The following examples are provided:

- On May 21, 1968, the submarine Scorpion of the U. S. Navy was lost en route to its home base.

- On September 5, 1945, five bombers of the U.S. Marine Corps were also lost.

- On March 21, 1973, the ocean liner Anita was lost.

- On April 10, 1963, the American atomic submarine Thresher, was lost.

- On March 25, 1945, a high ranking U.S. Air Force officer named Marcus Bilsan was flying from Florida to the Bahamas. He reported that the sky became so dark that he was unable to see so much so that he described the darkness as being doubled or tripled. All the instruments on the plane malfunctioned for about 10-15 minutes; then all became normal. He discovered that his location was in the Bermuda Triangle.

- On March 2, 1963, the captain of flight 211 from New York to San Juan saw (at 25,000 feet) what he described as a large white bulb that looked like a cauliflower, the size of a large airport. After a while, that bulb changed into a white circle and then disappeared.

As I stated before, these unexplained occurrences are the result of the black moon's effect on the earth. An American space scientist states that even satellites which are over 800 miles from earth, experience severe difficulties with their instruments, even to the point of being out of commission and having their magnetic impulses neutralized. Magnetic tapes on the satellites become blank. Therefore, there must be an unknown magnetic field that creates these problems and can, to a greater extent, even take the satellites out of their regular orbits.

In 1976, one of the Soviet satellites, Cosmos, went out of its orbit and crashed in Canada. In 1979, an American satellite, ST-

KM-3 was launched and disappeared without a trace when it reached an altitude of 23,000 miles. To this day, its whereabouts are unknown. I am convinced that the magnetic effects of the black moon caused these two incidents.

We can see another influence of the black moon on satellites and space shuttles. Apollo 13 lost its electrical power and experienced an explosion in its oxygen tank. All batteries failed. On July 10, 1969, when Neil Armstrong was on the moon, he said that he saw an enormous light between the moon and the earth. It lasted approximately 10 minutes and then it quickly disappeared.

In October, 1969, at 23:45, Robert Rayly, a radar engineer for the U.S. Navy, saw a moon rising in the sky but it did not reflect any light. It looked like a round sphere. After a few minutes, it disappeared. At the same time, however, our moon was clearly visible in the sky. Was it possible that two moons were seen that night?

In November, 1882, Walter Mandy, astronomer at the Greenwich Planetarium, observed a large white disk travelling from the northeast and its motions were similar to our moon or other stars. This was also observed by hundreds of thousands of people in Europe. During this time, there was a magnetic turbulence felt all over the world.

In 218 B.C., a solar eclipse occurred and it was believed at that time that a battle was taking place between the sun and the moon. That very night, there was a lunar eclipse between two moons. The reason for this, as I stated previously, is that the black moon is always in eclipse because of its position behind the earth (against Newton's and Kepler's laws) BUT sometimes, it shows itself and this eclipse of the two moons was one of these instances. Furthermore, it is interesting to note that while the earth is spinning on its axis, the Devil's Sea and the Bermuda Triangle are always under the magnetic influence of the black moon because

of its position in relation to the earth.

In the summer of 1981 and again in 1982, at dusk, people in various cities in Iran witnessed a huge light like the sun rising from the east. After a few moments, it was gone and the sky returned to normal. The ebb tides and the flow tides are under the influence of THIS black moon and NOT under the moon that is erroneously known to us.

There are numerous other examples which can be cited to substantiate the black moon's existence.


