

Hungarian Woman Reports Seeing More Than a Dozen Humans on Board UFO During Her Reported Abduction

JUNE 1992 DEBRECEN, HUNGARY

A woman we will call Helen, age 50, of the town of Mezobereny, Hungary, has a series of large round marks on her body as a result of an encounter with aliens. The aliens took her aboard an egg-shaped UFO in her home town on the night of January 24, 1992.

Helen was with her husband in the kitchen of their house that day. She said she saw a dull black, egg-shaped rippling "something" three and a half feet in height move across the kitchen to another room. It emitted a "strong, snorting sound". The upper part of this entity was blue-grey. Also visible was a "vibrating orange vertical stripe".

Next to the stripe, she saw a woman who looked at her. She found she could not speak to her husband to alert him to the sight. She followed the being to the other room, but found nobody there. She then told her husband but he did not believe her (a similar being was seen by a woman near the town of Satoraljuhely).

On Monday night she felt so tired that she went to bed at 6:30 p.m., while her husband watched TV in the same room. She suddenly heard a woman's voice tell her, "Lift your arm". She did so and felt a strong twinge of pain at her elbow. She then felt compelled to go out to the garden in her nightgown and bare feet.

She saw an egg-shaped, cabin-like object standing in the garden. She entered the object to see if anyone was there, but saw no one. However, she recalls being in a wide, grey room with no furniture inside and a door at one end of the room. In the room there were 10-15 children ages 10-13 on the right side and 8-10 women in their 50's on the left.

Everyone including her was nude. She did not recall when her dress was removed. She recognized one of the women, but did not recall her name. (A similar event occurred to a girl at Kiskunfelegyhaza. She recognized her friend from school amongst girls of the same age who were abducted. Both girls have a wound at the same part of their bodies.)

Helen walked to the door at the end of the room, but when she looked into the next room, she saw nothing. When she recovered consciousness, she felt pain in her stomach and lay down on the bed fully clothed. By this time, it was 9:30 p.m. Her husband was still watching TV and did not notice anything. In the morning, she felt a bit of pain and a little pressure in the upper part of her belly. She worked all day despite this and again went to bed early. The abduction repeated itself on Tuesday and Wednesday. On Thursday and Friday, large red spots appeared on the upper part of her breasts too. She did not feel pain nor itching at this point. The marks were not sensitive to cold, heat or pressure.

Four needle-like marks appeared above the vein on the outer part of her elbows. These wounds were sensitive to pressure which caused the area to give her a burning feeling for three weeks. She also breathed hard and noisily, which her family was surprised at.

One week after the encounters, she went to the doctor and, after telling him of the events, showed him her wounds. The chief medical officer had never seen such a case and sent her to a dermatologist. But the prescribed medical cream was of no use. The marks which were red were only on areas which were not sensitive. She found her general health improving. She has no varicose veins showing now and has regained her hearing in her left ear.

Two weeks later, at 3:30 a.m., February 11, 1992, another event occurred. Helen woke up and saw her husband standing in an odd posture. He lifted his arm and held the sleeves of his dressing gown with the other hand. It looked like he was waiting for the taking of blood or an injection. She could not wake him, so she put his arm back under the counterpane.

Two Weeks of Surprises For Border Guard

A major flap of sighting reports has occurred in Bekes County, Hungary in the December 1991 - June 1992 time frame, ending with what seems like a trip to the moon for Hungarian border guard Istvan Balogh.


The flap has centered around the little town of Bekes. It all started with a series of unexplainable events which happened in the house of Jozsef Petras, a basket-maker in the town on December 4, 1991. Since then, we have been informed about another surprising event which occurred on December 26, 1991. The 21 year-old Balogh was on Christmas holiday from active service in Oroshaza.

A MECHANICAL VOICE AT NIGHT


The story really started earlier, on December 13, 1991, when a voice originating from an unknown source awakened him. He sat up in his bed, looked around, but could not see anyone. He was already inclined to think that he had dreamed or had a nightmare, but the voice was mechanical in tone and said three times: "You will meet us!". It is probable that the message was given to him telepathically, as is usual with UFO events.

The message was repeated for the next 11 nights at the same time and with the same words. Balogh told no one about what had happened, thinking nobody would believe him. His nights were terrible as he could hardly sleep.

The promised meeting was on December 26, 1991. Istvan was going to the movies with his friends. He got home at 15 minutes after midnight. He entered the gate. When he reached the terrace of the house he suddenly caught sight of an unknown

object over the courtyard a few meters above the ground.

The object was bright and grey, disc-shaped (see witness' drawing) with a diameter about four meters (12 feet) and a height of 2.5 meters (7 feet).

At that moment, Istvan lost his will power. He felt as though something forced him to go under the UFO. When he did so, a ray of light (diameter 50-

60 cm) descended from the UFO. He entered the ray and immediately he was inside the UFO. It seemed to have only one room, with a window whose diameter was about 1 to 1 1/2 meters (3-4 feet).

He looked out of this window and saw his courtyard. The floor inside the UFO was bright, the walls grey and smooth.

LITTLE GREEN MEN - A RARE APPEARANCE

Two beings were in the room. Their shape was normal, human-like. They were 120-140 cm in height (4 to 4 1/2 feet). Their heads and eyes were large. They had only three fingers on longish hands. They wore black, skin-tight clothing; the uncovered skin was *green*.

One being was operating the controls while the other dealt with Istvan. This being heard him talking to him in Hungarian telepathically. He said Istvan had been watched for three years and he would be taken away. The being said their trip was 15 million light-years long, but the time of the trip was very short due to dimension change.

Later on, the being shone a green light onto Istvan's forehead. From that point on he does not remember clearly. He has some memory fragments about the trip over the moon and its craters from which light filtered through. Then he saw pyramids in views from above. He does not know whether these buildings were terrestrial or extraterrestrial - but he remembers their positions.

HEADACHES, DIZZINESS

After the event was over, he found himself two meters (6 feet) from where it began. He was on his knees, leaning over the ground as Moslems pray. He had a terrible headache, trembled and felt dizzy. His face was distorted and he could not stand up. It was now 2:00 a.m.

He entered his house and in the morning told his parents what had happened. They had slept soundly

and did not perceive anything. But they did notice that their son was in a terrible condition. They did not doubt the truth of his words.

Istvan had to go back to the barracks, but could not go on his own legs. A physician was called and he was transported by car. He reported to his superiors what had happened. Naturally, he was not believed. He insisted on the truth of his story, so he was sent for a medical examination in a nearby hospital (Gyula) and then to the Central Hospital of the Ministry of the Interior in Budapest, where he was put into the nerve and mental ward.

The goal of the authorities was obvious: if somebody talks about this kind of story, he must be a drunk or publicity seeker or insane. Unfortunately, this is the usual opinion. In this case, insanity was supposed. But the final result of the medical examination differed from the expectation. He was normal, with no symptoms of insanity. He was also healthy in all respects. But he was discharged from the Border Guards. The official reason was his unreliability, so he became unfit for further military service. Why?

We wish to make one final observation. Recently we noticed that several persons in close encounters are implanted with small pieces of platinum. For example, an old man who was abducted had a small rod of platinum in his left thigh. After the close encounter, several marks consisting of three dots were found on his thighs above the metal. These marks look like fingers had pressed the skin.

This latter is interesting because Istvan had broken his arm earlier and had platinum inserted by the doctor. During the encounter, the platinum rod was removed, although there may still remain some platinum.

It appears that metal implants are important as are implants by our doctors being of interest to the beings. I think this is not surprising. Their activities have shown their interests. People, animals, plants, machines, factories, warfare, space satellites - these fields are the center of their interest.

Letter To The Editor

The following is an excerpt from a letter; the remainder dealt with incomplete cases.

Dear Sir:

Regarding the correspondence of Rear Admiral H.B. Knowles, USN (Ret.), I find his comments quite remarkable. It would seem he was aware of a master group of individuals within the U.S. Government that maintained decisive control over official UFO matters. That group he refers to might well have been the famed MJ-12 of Operation Majestic which received much attention and funded research in the 1980's. The so-called MJ-12 Documents refer to a November 16, 1952 briefing document on UFOs prepared for President-elect Eisenhower who took office the following January.

RAdm. Knowles also refers in his letters to Mr. C.W. Fitch to be an acquaintance of Mr. Wilbert B. Smith (Director of Project Magnet, Department of Transport). Apparently Wilbert Smith brought a piece of a small observation disc to show the admiral on one of his visits. The object had been shot down by a plane and retrieved on a farm in Virginia. Smith indicated that, aside from iron, the elemental compounds were unidentified. The weight, interest-

ingly, was not extremely light. The admiral makes several references to official secrecy and even explains debunking techniques used by the U.S. Government to discredit an actual UFO event in Washington, D.C.

Having recently met the son of Wilbert Smith on a trip to Ottawa, I was fortunate enough to obtain some extraordinary documentation penned by the late Canadian scientist and engineer. Much to my amazement, both Smith and Knowles were confident about the presence of extraterrestrial beings and concluded the intelligence to be wiser than us humans. They also gave credence to the contactee experience which many ufologists today reject while endorsing the abduction experience. In deference to these sages of the 1960's, we are still waiting for the official veil of secrecy to be lifted in the 1990's.

**"FIRE IN THE SKY"
New UFO Movie Distorts Public Perception of Aliens**

Heralded by many as the motion picture which would legitimize the idea of aliens abducting humans as being true, it does just that.

This film from Paramount Pictures dwells largely on how the residents of Snowflake, Arizona reacted to the abduction of Travis Walton on November 5, 1975. When it does go off course is in its depiction of the humanoids and what they did to Walton inside the UFO. The aliens' eyes are shown as human-like and they are not shown wearing the

orange-red uniforms. Nor are the tall human-appearing people shown. The sticky, plastic see-through substance was not reported by Walton. When he gets returned by the aliens, he is not sporting a five-day growth of beard.

The film, written by independent ufologist, Tracy Tormé, was based upon Walton's original book, "The Walton Experience". It was number two at the box office in its first week in theatres. The acting and special effects are very well done, especially James Gamer's role as Sheriff Watters.

Extraterrestrial Being Visited a Man in Bekes County, Hungary

It's most likely that Josef Petras, 43 year-old basket-maker of Bekes County, Hungary, will never forget December 4, 1991. Strange things happened to him that day, which remain unexplainable even now.

There was sunny, calm weather all that day. Mr. Petras went to buy some raw materials by car (it was a Trabant). He got home from his first trip, then decided to take another drive. This time a series of strange things began.

The first uncomfortable surprise was that his Trabant wouldn't start. "It doesn't matter!" he said to himself. He had another car, a Dacia. He pushed aside the disabled car and tried to start his Dacia. It wouldn't start either. He thought the battery had run down, so he charged it. By 11 a.m., the battery was charged to such a degree that he could drive. Soon he arrived home again. A short time later, he tried to start it again, but the engine wouldn't start and the fresh battery charge did not help. He noticed the ignition wires were burnt. He also investigated the Trabant and, surprisingly, its wires were also burnt. He had not experienced such problems with either of his cars. Now the Dacia's battery was useless, although the Dacia was not yet one year old.

MISSING TIME AT NOON

Then Mr. Petras had lunch. "It was noon when I noticed my pigs were very restless in their sty. I thought I'd go and see them. I put on my rubber boots and I prepared some corn. When I entered the sty, I felt an unusually warm, suffocating smell. From this moment I do not remember what happened."

"When I recovered consciousness, I was sitting in the workroom in the chair. Surprisingly, it was already 12:45 p.m. What happened and how I

got into the workroom, I do not know. It was also odd that my rubber boots were thrown on the ground five metres (15 feet) from one another and were not on my legs. I could not remember more than half an hour. Though I racked my brain, I did not know what had happened."

After this, Mr. Petras left the workroom. He heard an unusual noise in his head and then black rings appeared in front of his right eye. These rings increased; the largest was the size of a coin. The rings turned into a red, chewing gum-sized ball. He was forced to follow this ball. He could not resist.

"It was as if somebody had told me what I had to do," he said. He was carrying roof tiles in a wheelbarrow while the ball was continuously in front of him. He was not tired - it was as if the barrow and tiles had been weightless. He worked for about one hour and a half. Then the ball disappeared.

ELECTRICALLY CHARGED

"I tried to enter the boiler house but when I touched the door I got an electrical shock in spite of the door being made of wood. Everything shocked me when I touched it."

"Then," he said, "every half hour the ball appeared in front of my right eye and I was forced to do something. I carried feed, but it felt weightless." Mr. Petras said that during this event he heard a continuous noise and felt a terrible pain in his head. He felt as if boiling water had poured on him and somebody had wanted to pull out his eyes.

INVISIBLE TO DAUGHTER

Later, his 17 year-old daughter got home. She did not see the red ball. But she saw the unexplainable behaviour of her father. "I have to do what it wants. I have to follow it and I cannot disobey it," Petras said to his daughter. Later the ball again disappeared.

TALL, GREEN HUMANOID

After 4:00 p.m., he went to feed the pigs.

"When I finished the feeding, I entered the boiler house and put down the bucket. I closed the door and rumed around. I saw a green, human-shaped being in front of the sty at the wicket door. It was as tall as I am. Its colour was bright green like the young leaves in early spring. The being looked like a light shape but its outline was sharp, not fog-like. Limbs were not visible," he said.

"I was not frightened - I am not a timid man - but I was surprised very much. I felt as if I had seen a corpse which had watched me. Then I entered the flat. I again looked back in the window as if I had been ordered to do so and I noticed the being still stood there. Then I went to bed," he added.

ANIMALS REACT AGAIN

Mr. Petras said he had a lot of domestic animals and their behaviour was very strange and excited. The pigs were just as restless as they had been at noon; his two dogs whimpered and hid in their house. The hens left the sty - that had not happened before. His two cats fled home and only came back two days later - which had never occurred before. Something terrified them; they were almost in shock.

FOLLOWING THE RED BALL

Mr. Petras went to bed. He wanted to rest but his rest was short. Some time later, the black rings and then the ball again appeared and he was forced to follow it. His daughter did not want to let him get out of bed, but he said he had to follow the red ball. He entered the bathroom.

Although the lamp was not switched on, there was light. There was an unexplainable light, bright enough for reading. His daughter also saw this light. Mr. Petras entered the kitchen and sat down. His daughter was worried and did not understand anything. She noticed her father's head was reddened. Meanwhile, the wife also got home. The two women tried to help him, but failed. The wife and the daughter did not see anything but they also felt strange and unusual conditions.

THE GREEN MAN RETURNS

After 7:00 p.m., the events continued. The family was very frightened. The daughter went out to the garden and prayed, but when she came close to the sty, some invisible power or radiation forced her back to the kitchen. Mr. Petras was sitting there. Later he left and went to the garden. Then he tried to enter the kitchen, but was forced to look back. He again noticed that a green being stood in front of the cherry tree. The being was the same one seen previously. The distance between them was about three to four metres (9-12 feet). His wife and daughter stood behind him but they did not see anything. Additionally, they felt an unknown power forcing them back to the kitchen. They were very frightened.

A PARTIAL MESSAGE

Mr. Petras stood facing the being for about four minutes. Then the being started to slowly rise in the air. Later, a V-shaped, thin stripe appeared under the being. Meantime, the being continuously rose and became a fog-like shape at four metres (12 feet). Finally, both of them disappeared. But it was not over. When the green being disappeared, a voice from an unknown source said three times: "I come back, no.." Mr. Petras felt as though this voice came from out of the Earth. "Maybe I understand why the voice said 'Come back', but I do not know what it means by 'No'," he said.

After this, the noise in his head stopped, but he was very tired and troubled. His wife and daughter helped him to go to bed. He took a sedative and he slept.

The next day did not give him any peace. When he woke up, he was very tired and felt ill all over. He had a terrible headache. He drank a lot of water, continuously, as he was very thirsty. He felt an enormous pain along his spine from his shoulder blade, so he could not sit or stand up. The pain lasted a week. He had never had this kind of pain before.

PLATINUM REACTION

He said that one day before the event he awoke with pain in his leg. He had broken his leg two years before. The damaged bones were joined with rivets of platinum. Nine rivets and one nut were inserted in a 9 cm portion of his leg. He had never had pain in this place since the accident. It was not sensitive to the weather. These facts may be related to the events that happened the next day. It is not impossible because, some weeks before, a man who also has platinum rivets was also visited by a strange being. This other man lives in Mezohegyes, near Bekes.

Mr. Petras does not drink any alcohol. He is a respected man who has gained nothing by telling this story. As is commented in nearly every case, Mr. Petras ended his report by saying "I know what I have experienced and I believe it."



**Crash Retrieval Book
Proves Fascinating
Crash at Corona: The U.S. Military
Retrieval and Cover-Up of a UFO
by Don Berliner and
Stanton T. Friedman**

When Stanton Friedman did a majority of the research for the first book about the Roswell, New Mexico UFO crash and retrieval he had no idea that he would be the future co-author of another book on the event.

He and aviation/science writer Don Berliner have collaborated on Crash at Corona, a 217 page tome, with photographs and a map of the site of the events. Published by paragon House of New York City, the book sells for \$19.95 in the U.S. and \$24.95 in Canada. It is hard cover and, aside from its excellent chronological recreation of the incident and its aftermath, includes a preface, introduction,

conclusion, appendices, suggested reading list and an index.

If the book has any flaw, it is that it includes the testimony of Gerald Anderson, who has proved unreliable in his so-called testimony about the second of the two crashes discussed in the book. Friedman himself has since admitted he does not trust Anderson's testimony. This does not discredit the testimony of the more than 100 other persons mentioned in the book. Without a doubt, this event did occur.

The July 2, 1947 crash and subsequent retrieval of the wreckage of two UFOs in Corona and Plans of San Agustin, New Mexico is detailed with the precision of a scientist. It is obvious that the book was largely written by Berliner, with Friedman doing most of the research.

Chapter headings include A History of Modern Sightings, The Search for Evidence Begins, The Canadian Connection, Majestic-12, Civilians Find The Wreckage, The Military Takes Over, The Great Cover-Up, Alternative Explanations For The Wreckage, Keeping The Secret and After The Crash. And there is much more.

Among the nice touches the book has in it is the inclusion of both authors' addresses and telephone numbers. This makes it easy for readers who may have more information to contact the two writers.

Direct quotes from witnesses are effectively used by the authors. The most telling are the ones from those who actually handled the debris from the Corona crash. Some credit and reference is made to the previous two books about the occurrences. One glaring omission is the fact that the co-author of the first book about the event, The Roswell Incident, Charles Berlitz, was actually Colonel Charles Berlitz of U.S. Army Intelligence and a former contract operative for the Central Intelligence Agency, according to William L. Moore, who told this reviewer of it in 1981, a year after Roswell was published.

In summary, I recommend this book highly to all ufologists and to the public.

STROBE LIGHT

This Xenon Tube Mini Personal Identification signal flash light is particularly bright when use at night or at dusk. It is specially designed for Cycling, Jogging, Walking, Skiing, Boating, etc., whenever need to be seen in the dark. Also as warning light for emergency of car on high way at dark and foggy night.

OPERATION

To install battery, unscrew the flash portion and take it out from the body. (Fig. 1)

After take out the flash portion from the body, you can see there is a contact spring inside the body. Do not take the contact spring away.

Take one pen-light size 1.5V battery and install it according to the following procedure: (Fig. 2)

- 1 - Put in the contact spring.
- 2 - put in the pen-light battery.
- 3 - put in the flash portion.
- 4 - screw in the flash portion.

When you screw in the flash portion all the way to the end, the unit starts flashing. Unscrew the flash portion one quarter to one half of a turn, the unit stops flashing. To turn on, screw in the flash portion again.

Alkaline battery is recommended for longer operation. With a new alkaline battery the unit will continuously flash for 8 hours, starting at one flash per second and gradually decreases to one flash per two seconds.

The unit can easily be wrapped around your arm with the arm strap.





