



SPECULATIONS ON UFO TECHNOLOGY

Part 2 of a two part series

Editors Note: Due to omission of graphics in part 1 we have repeated the last two paragraphs.

Slowing the time rate of passage within the power ring would also affect the weak force coupling constant, or strength of neutrino/matter coupling, through the Heisenberg Uncertainty Principle for the conjugate variables $\Delta E = \hbar \Delta t \lesssim \hbar$. With a slowing of time, the uncertainty of position on the time axis of space-time is reduced until the production of virtual W particles is favoured. The reaction, depicted in the Feynman diagram which follows, more readily proceeds due to an increase in the apparent strength of the weak force resulting from the energy borrowed from the vacuum as allowed by the uncertainty relation.



In an alternative view, using the uncertainty relation for momentum and position, a localized slowing of time might reduce uncertainty in the momentum of a virtual W particle to the point where the allowed range of positions or spatial distribution of the weak force charge carrier, expands to give increased likelihood of interaction. Either view reveals an increased coupling between neutrinos and matter due to a slowing of time in the ring. The increased coupling in association with the blue shifting of solar neutrino energies provides the inducement for beta decay boost of the fluid.

It is pleasing aesthetically to imagine the MHD power ring combined in a single unit with the NMR based space time coupling scheme to distort vacuum properties. I would suggest basing an experiment on magic angle spinning for high resolution NMR, an apparatus similar to an MHD ring in configuration, with the Z axis of the construction aligned with the solar neutrino flux, "Spin up" and "spin down" might then present opposingly chiral aspects to the neutrino flux quantumly derived from interaction with the "quantizing field" for the NMR rig. With the goal of maximizing spin flips in order to overwhelm some natural equilibrium which may exist between weak force charge and the spacetime vacuum, rather than obtaining a resonance spectrum, the intensity of the external magnetic field could be as strong as possible to create maximal difference between initial working fluid spin populations, while radio frequency and power could be applied at levels to reverse nuclear spin aspects either in mode to preserve spin population differences (thermal equilibrium) or to overwhelm such differences. Any distortion of spacetime initiated by coordinated spin reversals influencing the presumed equilibrium condition would be expected to affect the weak force coupling constant and cause blue shifting of apparent solar neutrino kinetic energies. Evidence of induced beta decays caused by spacetime distortion might be expected to display redshifting in passing from the test bed to detectors.

There are advantages to maintaining the working fluid in the molten and rotating state in this putative beta decay based generator. Given that aluminum loses electrical conductivity with heating, and that silicon,

phosphorus, and sulphur all gain in conductivity with heating, it is assumed that there is a range of values for temperature, pressure, applied magnetic field, photon flux, and applied radio frequency field within which two and possibly all of the working fluid components are closely matched in their electrical properties. Induced beta decay in the aluminum and phosphorus fractions would simply cause elemental transmutations to silicon and sulphur with little or no change in overall electrical properties of the fluid. Aluminum and phosphorus would also be chemically nonreactive at molten aluminum temperature. A high rotational velocity would ensure that the fluid components, which have no overlapping isotopic masses, remain in a segregated or stratified configuration in the ring. Any potentially undesirable elements accruing in the ring might remain in a vapor state at molten aluminum temperature and thus afford ease of concentration in a scrubbing operation for subsequent surge from the system. Sodium and either potassium, selenium, or cesium added to the ring would tend to remain at the inner and outer fluid faces respectively according to their masses and all are excellent photoelectric materials. Rotation also represents a simple control mechanism for ring output and is discussed in that context later.

To this point we have conjectured a combined MED/NMR generator based on solar neutrinos induced beta decay maintained in a chemically stable, stratified, molten, pressurized and rotating configuration. The working fluid components all have a major stable isotope with half-odd-integer spin amenable to NMR manipulation and both of the primary fluid components are bounded by excellent photoelectric materials, with the aluminum fraction containing highly photoelectric silicon, produced by beta decay boost. Induced beta events would have little effect on the electrical properties or the fluid given appropriate choice of external parameters. The natural beta half lives for unstable radioactive daughters in returning to original identities are on the order of seconds for primary components, a potentially important

consideration for control of the output. All of the components are plentiful and cheap, while the plant has an overall circular configuration, a rotational aspect, relative silence in operation due to lack of solid moving parts, potential output in excess of 10^9 megawatts based on size and an enhancement effect discussed later, needs no bulky support equipment such as turbines or heat exchangers, and needs no refuelling.

If a portion of the ring were now seen to be maintained in the ambient or fast time mode, then excited nuclides formed by interaction with solar neutrinos could freely decay back to their starting identities while rotating through this area.

In this case, energy borrowed from the vacuum would be paid back not to the vacuum, but to the environment, and at a greater than 10 to 1 energy advantage. For example, a solar neutrino of only 0.42 Mev energy might cause an aluminum atom to decay to Si27 while in the slow time portion of the ring. When silicon decays back to Al27 in normal time, it releases a total of 4.8 MeV on average through emission of e+ and gamma plus a neutrino. This condition would tend to drain energy from the spacetime vacuum surrounding the ring and could represent the method by which local spacetime distortion within the ring is scaled up to full craft dimensions. Radioactive decays in a fixed amount of material proceeds at a higher rate the earlier in time that it is measured, so assuming that the working fluid fully "boosts" while in the slowed time region of the putative power ring, higher rotational velocities would expose the fluid to shorter and shorter periods spent in the fast time mode but at higher and higher average rates of decay overall. The rotational velocity is thus seen to be a simple mechanical control technique to adjust ring output.

If we now assume that spacetime distortion is scaled to full craft dimensions and out beyond the physical boundary of the craft, then a great many UFO behaviours and close encounter phenomena become

amenable to explanation. With all things in the universe in motion, our planet earth is found to simultaneously undergo such movements as axis rotational, solar orbital, precessional, nutational, aberrational, and all those caused by various gravitational connections to sun, moon, planets, and galaxy. Any exploitation of this complex dance through the cosmos might appear to an observer, whose senses falsely tell him he is stationary, to be of a super technological or magical nature. For example, a craft able to maintain an independent inertial, time and gravitational frame of reference might be able to separate completely from our ambient spacetime geometry.

With the Earth in motion at over 300 km/second, a mere fraction of a second of such spacetime manipulation would cause a shift in spatial coordinates between the craft and the planet so swift as to be undetectable by eye or camera. This discontinuous appearing motion would seem to be a characteristic of the craft to an earthbound observer while it is actually the observer and the planet which are moving away from the stationary craft at such velocity as to give the impression of discontinuity. Since a mere 1/50,000th second of spacetime manipulation could counteract the pull of gravity upon a craft during the remaining 49,999/50,000th of each second it remains connected to our spacetime, and since such a short duration jump would be unobservable to the eye, any craft using this scheme would appear to be hovering or perhaps bobbing up and down in a station keeping mode displaying no visible means.

And since the Earth has very little "wobble" in its various motions, at least on a human scale of things, a craft exploiting a single planetary motion would appear to be travelling in straight lines, an effect also known as orthoteny. Again, it is the Earth moving in some manner unfelt by those upon it while the craft remains fixed in some sense of an absolute spatial position above it. The appearance of the event to the earthbound observer is exactly opposite the true state of affairs.

This method of locomotion yet offers some problems. For example, what would happen to any momentum picked up by the craft and how could it reverse course? One is forced to postulate a near continual immersion in the spacetime manipulation scheme and also ability to carry the craft forward and backward along the time axis of spacetime in order to fully exploit gravity and time to dampen and control its manoeuvres. These abilities would certainly give the craft a surreal appearance to the observer while also offering further explanation for UFO behaviours. Two crafts could conceivably time their temporal manipulations so as to maintain an exact counter position to each other. In this case they could appear to merge and occupy the same location in the observer's frame of reference with manipulations so rapid as to be undetectable by eye. Alternatively, a single craft could arrive in an observer's frame of reference while travelling forward in time and leave travelling backward in time to again give the appearance of two separate craft merging. A longer duration jump in time could cause such a large displacement in spatial coordinates by Earth in relation to the craft that it would have seemed to disappear instantaneously, while air rushing into the resulting void could produce an accompanying booming noise or thunderclap. Finally, the actual physical shape of the craft may not vary, but might appear to vary from disk to oval to cigar shape due to distortion of emitted light caused by varying dimensional manipulations in the space surrounding the craft.

Since a possible correlation among ring particle emission, rotational velocity, and the degree of vacuum energy deficiency has been established, it can be seen that craft luminosity and ring rotation would both be correlated to craft activity. It is further noted that since the proposed flight scheme is non-aerodynamic, there are no constraints on total craft weight and this could explain some very great calculated weights derived from study of landing traces. Any craft carrying biological entities would certainly require extensive shielding from ring gamma emission while a weighty armoured hull

might also be considered a propos when visiting planet Earth.

If the assumed scale up of spacetime manipulation were to extend well beyond the craft's physical boundary, it would be expected to induce neutrino/matter coupling in closely encountered metals, especially those having half-odd-integer nuclear spin. This effect would possibly be seen as an ionization phenomenon similar to St. Elmo's fire around copper wiring, silver salt and pepper shakers, or unplugged sodium vapour lamps. Silicon in closely encountered soil, as in UFO landing reports, might undergo beta decay transmutation in one of its isotopes to form the next higher atomic chart element, phosphorus. Following departure of the craft, the newly formed and unstable phosphorus would phosphoresce under the influence of its own beta decay back to stable silicon, thus producing the glowing ground circle which quickly fades to leave no detectable residue. Production of much longer lived nuclides in the soil by this process might explain subsequent altered plant growth in the area as being due to chemical changes from transmuted elements, radiation damage from continuing beta activity, or even the influence of a continuing low level of space, time, and gravitational distortion caused by reverse beta decay in the soil draining a small amount of energy from the vacuum.

Closely encountered humans might experience induced beta activity in the mercury of their dental filling amalgams. This would produce a temporary thallium content. The symptoms of thallium metal poisoning may include rapid hair loss, gastrointestinal problems, poly-neuritis, and in nearly all cases opto-neuritis. Following a close encounter in Bolton, England, Miss Shelley McLenaghan is reported to have suffered structural failure of her dental fillings along with medical symptoms which included poly - and opto-neuritis. While some of the symptoms of acute thallium metal poisoning closely mimic effects from radiation poisoning, actual radiation injury might also occur due to emitted gamma from a craft. If the primary purpose of the putative generator

is spacetime distortion rather than electric power generation, then energy drained from the vacuum might only be a waste product conveniently cast overboard. With possible redshifting and blueshifting and even gravitational *lensing effects acting on the gamma from the craft due to spacetime manipulations surrounding it, various physiological symptoms might be incurred ranging from mild sunburn-like irritation exposed skin to deep ionizing radiation injury in bone marrow and internal organs.

System contaminants which could build up in a craft's power ring might also inflict injury to humans if vented to the atmosphere during a close encounter. Fusion reaction between working fluid nuclei and protons emitted by unstable double beta decay daughter nuclei could occur in the ring due to Heisenberg Uncertainty of position. Sulphur and bromine in particular could explain observer testimony of a sulphureous and/or particularly foul odour, while bromine is a strong irritant of eyes, skin and respiratory passages. At Falcon Lake Manitoba, Canada, Steven Michalak was struck by a hot blast of air from a vent or grill on a landed UFO which left a pattern of burn marks matching the grillwork pattern seared into the skin of his chest.¹⁴

Consider now the reported close encounter effects of UFOs on electrical equipment and automobiles. Intense beta, gamma, and electromagnetic fields associated with the NMR and ring emission processes all may have effects on radio and TV reception. Induced beta activity in such NMR amenable electrical system components as copper, silver, and gold would also produce short lived disruptive effects in appliances and in automobile systems. Proximity to electromagnetic fields and inducement of spin flips in magnetic compass needle nuclei would both contribute to the spinning of compasses occasionally noted in aircraft encounters. A spill over of the craft's spacetime manipulation might also explain the levitation of automobiles reported at Mundrabilla, Australia and in other cases, as well as the swaying of road signs and trees. Since the sign or tree is firmly attached or

rooted to the moving planet at its base, the flexible upper portions could react to being swept up in the UFO's extended influence by first swinging in response to the craft's station keeping mode, then being pulled by the planet in an oscillating rhythm otherwise difficult to explain.

Two recent advances in our NMR technology are also relevant to the theory of any NMR based UFO operating scheme. Magnetic resonance imaging machines for medical use have achieved stationary magnetic field strengths of four tesla. At this level, a small percentage of patients report physiological side effects of nausea, seeing flashing lights, and a metallic taste in their mouths. In addition, increased pulse rates for scanner fields have in some cases exceeded threshold values for production of nerve stimulation to give sensations of light tapping on the nose, the small of the back, and the inner thigh. Imaging machines of even higher field strengths, to ten tesla, are contemplated and it will be interesting to see if further physiological side effects manifest similar in kind to UFO close encounter effects.

It has also been reported that the NUMAR Corporation of Malvern, Pennsylvania, has developed an oil well logging instrument which uses NMR to image the rock surrounding a bore hole in a search for recoverable oil. The NMR can be used as an imaging technique to sense the environment surrounding an exploration craft visiting new worlds is implied by this application. In such a case, the craft's power system, its spacetime manipulation system, and its external sensing system would all be unified in one unit. The two most important things to carry from a reading of all these analyses of close encounter effects and advances in NMR are that the ability to control and manipulate a very local spacetime frame of reference can explain in a coherent whole a wide range of UFO phenomena and that it offers wholly new investigative approaches to the study of UFOs.

As an example of this last statement, I will offer a brief reference to the famous Stanford, Kentucky, close encounter IV as

presented by Mr. Leonard Stringfield in Situation Red, The UFO Siege I. In his account of the abduction experience of Mrs. Stafford, Mrs. Thomas and Mrs. Smith, Mr. Stringfield reveals that Mrs. Smith's pet parakeet panicked when she walked past its cage on the day following the abduction. On February 29th, 53 days later, Mr. Stringfield reports that the bird only panicked when Mrs. Smith placed her hand in its cage. Nearly seven months after the abduction, Mrs. Smith reacted to a strong urging late at night to return to the scene of the encounter and subsequently discovered that her rings, which were difficult to loosen from her fingers unless soap moistened, were missing without her conscious knowledge of their removal.

Given the discussions of spacetime manipulation and close encounter effects presented in this paper, it would seem that Mrs. Smith's rings had undergone some change during her initial experience which was able to be detected by the senses of the pet bird. This effect had apparently decayed to a level which only affected the bird at close range by February 29th, yet was still detectable by our technology at seven months, else why deny the rings to us? Rings commonly contain silver, gold, and copper alloyed with gold, and all of these are amenable to nuclear magnetic resonance. Solids undergoing MNR normally have their spin states raised to higher energy levels which spontaneously return to original low energy states in a process known as spin lattice relaxation. It is unlikely that any residual spin lattice relaxation was still occurring in Mrs. Smith's rings seven months after the abduction. However, a long lived beta decay daughter such as cadmium, (Cd), may have been produced from silver in the rings and its fifteen month half life in cycling back to stability would have left it vulnerable to detection. Again, excited nuclides could have resulted in a continuing drain of energy from the vacuum in the vicinity of the rings, with attendant spacetime distortion, sufficiently pronounced to have been detected by the pet bird. In any case, had the connection been made between the bird's reactions and the rings before the rings

were lost might we not then have discovered a secret of the visitors?

Well worth noting in this close encounter study are connections with rings also reported to have been experienced by Mrs. Stafford and Mrs. Thomas. Mr. Stringfield states that Mrs. Stafford's skin was rough, red, and blistered following the abduction, and that even the skin beneath her rings was blistered. One would normally expect a ring to protect underlying skin from ultraviolet emissions and subsequent irritation unless the ring itself were somehow caused to become an ultraviolet emitter due to the influence of craft technology acting upon it. Mrs. Stafford is also quoted by Judith Gansberg and Alan Gansberg in Direct Encounters: Personal Histories of UFO Abductees as saying that Mrs. Thomas told her about a strange happening in her hospital room shortly before her death from cancer years after the abduction. Strange lights were seen flashing around the room by Mr. Thomas and her roommate, and Mrs. Thomas felt sure that they were connected to the "UFO people". After the lights stopped, Mrs. Thomas found that the silver ring which she always wore had turned black and her finger was swollen. According to Mrs. Stafford, "there was something with that ring. A connection with the lights, the UFO people, and that ring. 19

Unification of the ET, the time travel, and the interdimensional hypotheses through introduction of solar system motion through the cosmos may be combined with spacetime manipulation based on an assumed disturbance of an equilibrium state between weak nuclear force charge and the vacuum to further unify many close encounter effects and behaviours to form a surprisingly coherent whole which offers new investigative approaches to UFO phenomena. Since verification of a quantum level effect able to influence spacetime geometries would be a discovery of something existing in nature, rather than some purely artificial invention, there may well be phenomena in the environment, such as will o' the wisp, ball lightning, or certain intriguing stellar anomalies, which have the

same scientific basis for their operation. Were this basis to be shown to be capable of unlocking strange visual imagery within our psyche, perhaps demonstrated through physiological side effects from a new generation of magnetic resonance imaging machines, then further unification with the psychological/cultural/natural phenomena hypotheses may well be possible. These various unifications can be shown to impact such things as our modern day search for extraterrestrial intelligence, visitor origins, the reduction in importance of the dreaded time paradox, the frequency of UFO "flaps", how alien home planets can be said to be "hidden" within our solar system and with some thought, even alien demonstration of precognition. With this model in hand, perhaps the very next series of visitations will provide us with a full and true understanding of UFO technology to the great benefit of mankind.

Authors Postscript to Speculations

Dear reader:

Having journeyed this far toward a unified theory of UFO's please take one more mental step and imagine a civilization far in advance of ours which bioengineers its physiognomy to be fully integrated with the operating scheme of the craft in which they tour the universe. With bodies powered not by chemical energy but by cellular conversion of solar neutrinos made possible by dimensional distortion created by their craft, they would eschew the emptiness of deep-space, existing only in the light of a nearby star. Their eyes would see not our surface world of reflected starlight, but all things from within and without by resonance imaging. Needing no other bodily sustenance, living timeless lives in timetravel, these wonderfully perfect creatures would require one thing to give meaning to their lives, to make eternal existence tolerable, and that is knowledge. To explore is to learn. Theirs is to deal only in the coin of information and that means information carried in the molecules of millions of biological life forms on millions of

planets with unique ecosystems, all found only in the light. In a universe of fusion fire and cold rock once the physical is understood, only life is new, offering infinite diversity, fascinating complexity, and precious unknowns. And if they be dispassionate, uncaring, even cruel in their method of dealing with a shallow, hostile arrogant humanity, one which drives whole species to extinction, one hell bent on poisoning their planet womb of precious life, potential source yet of treasured diversity-what are eons to such as they ? - do they not have the right?

THREE FORMATIONS OF YELLOW LIGHTS REPORTED OVER TORONTO.

A 50 year old maintenance supervisor reported to CUFORN through Canadian Forces Base Downsview his sightings of three formations of hazy yellow lights over Toronto on two nights previous (April 17).

On April 9, 1994, myself and our chief field investigator, Kevin Gariepy, went to the home of William Ferris (a pseudonym), the observer.

His south-eastern Toronto area home in the Metropolitan Toronto City of Etobicoke is in the midst of a largely industrial district. Until contacting CUFORN, the only person he told about his sighting was his wife.

He had been walking his dog at 9:25 pm when he looked up and "saw travelling north west towards Pearson International Airport in the night sky seven or eight fuzzy disks in V formation. They were moving at a speed which made me think they were military aircraft. However, approximately five minutes later, two returned travelling southeasterly and in staggered formation. One turned east and returned to its original course. They continued until they disappeared from sight."

THIRD FORMATION APPEARS

"Eight minutes later, I saw the same group of disks travelling due east, although the V formation was not as sharp. They travelled east until they vanished." he added.

"These disks were a yellow colour and quite fuzzy. Their light was not unlike a battery torch or flashlight which was low on power. They were, in my opinion, high in the sky and, to my perspective, the size of a dime held at arm's length."

University educated Ferris said the three sightings lasted about 25 minutes, with their angle above the horizon around 60 degrees.

The area of the sightings has rail road lines in it. The weather that night was clear and fresh, Ferris said. He said there was no moon that night, with many stars visible. He has good hearing and eyesight.

LARGE SILENT TRIANGLE SEEN IN SURREY, BRITISH COLUMBIA

The following report of a triangular shaped object was given to our organization in 1991 and was witnessed on Feb 27th. Since that time, we have received a total of 13 triangular reports as well as Layered Platforms Configurations with beams or columns, square and rectangular. A craft was described by a husband and wife living in Vernon, British Columbia in 1993 as hexagonal shaped, very large and moving slowly and silently from Swan Lake, over Vernon and then directly over a military base at Vernon, which by coincidence, had a large military aircraft show on the following day.

Name : Mary McNally

Location : Surrey (suburb of Vancouver, highest rate of abduction reports)

Time : 7.00 p.m.

"I was driving north on King George Highway

in Surrey. It was a very clear night with a full moon. A bright light in the east caught my eye. I thought it was probably a jet plane but as I looked again I thought I had never seen such a bright light on a plane before and never saw a plane so low. I watched this object as I stopped for a red light, I could see that it was very large. I would compare it to the size of a 747 and approximately 200 yards above the ground. It was about two city blocks to my east and about five to six blocks ahead of my car. I watched this object moving slowly to the west. As it passed over the highway towards the west, it turned and headed north. The next time I looked it was ascending to a higher altitude and I could see that it was V shaped and had seven very large white lights on both sides of the V - a total of 14 lights in all. I would assume that I had been watching this object for nearly five minutes as I sat through two or three red lights and drove at least ten blocks in heavy traffic. I continued driving a couple of more blocks when I saw another white light also in the east and very low as it crossed the highway about a half a block in front of my car to the west. This one was dull in colour and I could see the outline of a very large object again, the same size as the previous one. It passed to the right of an apartment block which is 15 stories high and I could see five stars above it when it passed to the right of the building. I saw two lights under the object which appeared to be the corners at the back. I did not see this object again. I was amazed that it did not appear that anyone else was seeing these objects when it was early evening with heavy traffic.

LETTER TO THE EDITOR

Enclosed are some initial thoughts on two projects which I am interested in developing further. Any comments, criticisms, information, etc., on the proposed projects would, of course, be welcome. The one dealing with US military and Civil Defense observers may possibly have some applicability to Canada. A whole range of questions comes to mind concerning WW II activity. During the War did Canada have a

civil defense organization similar to the US Aircraft Warning Service ? If so, did it have liaison with the Air Defense Command then headquartered at Mitchell AFB, NY? What was the extent of off-shore observers deployed for submarine and aircraft warning? Do Foo-fighter accounts exist in RCAF records, unit histories, intelligence reports, etc. Are these records available to researchers as are the ones in the US, National Archives?

The proposal to attempt to contact World War II veterans is more important of the two. Mr. Jeff Lindell, an associate of Dr. Thomas Bullard, is doing this for U.S. Army Air Corps night fighter veterans from the European theatre and Pacific B-29 bomber crews. He told me there is easily years of research work to be done in the U.S. National Archives. The reports were more numerous than we imagined and the documentation is extensive. Mr. Lindell has concentrated his current efforts on locating and interviewing U.S. pilots which is more important than retrieving documents. However, this needs to be done soon on a world wide basis. Martin Caidan has an official Foo Fighter document in his current book. I enclose an excerpt in case you have not seen it.

In addition to the above projects, I have also decided to work on the following areas:

1. Establish catalogues of reports of meteors and ball lightning found in the press accounts I screen.
2. Try to locate Ground Observer Corps (GOC, the Cold War successor to the Aircraft Warning Service) records in Federal repositories. I suspect many GOC UFO reports never made it to the USAF Project Blue Book!
3. Construct a complete as possible catalogue of pre-Arnold UFO reports. A reference list of unresolved items is enclosed.
4. Find several newspapers which Fort did not use when he compiled this works, and screen them issue by

issue for the last 150 years. The Hartford Courant is the first candidate.

5. Collect additional accounts from 1947-1954 by screening of newspapers.
6. Assist others interested in historical UFO research.

I would like to contact others who have similar interests, and request that you pass my name and address along to associates engaged in this type of research.
