



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THE TZARICHINA UFO PHENOMENON

(Bulgaria 1989 - 1993)

Summary, comments and translation by: Y. Michael

INTRODUCTION

Theoretical interdisciplinary conference of FOCONI called "PHENOMENON TZARICHINA" held in Sofia on Nov.28,1993

In the Spring of 1993, CUFORN received a book from the "Foundation of Cosmoetic Investigations" (FOCONI), called "The case of Tzarichina" Facts and Documents, Opinions and Hypotheses, written by Mr. Kiril (Cyril) Kanev, who participated in the developments from start to finish.

This is a compilation of scientists' speeches presented at the Forum "PHENOMENON TZARICHINA" in 1993 and the minutes from meetings of scientific body's reviewing in a philosophical fashion the facts and findings pertaining to the search of an object of an unknown, possibly extraterrestrial, origin containing information about the past, present and future of humanity.

His initial interest was ignited by the publications of the newspaper "Night Work", and after reviewing the first few articles on the case in the village of Tzarichina developed a supposition bordering on the belief that a UFO phenomenon was observed.

In November of 1992, during the very first visit to the village, he registered nine single anomalous phenomena observed by four witnesses. This is just a side fact which reaffirmed his original assumptions and reinforced the probability of UFO occurrences and manipulations with regard to the incident of Tzarichina.

What is the meaning of this phenomenon remains to be seen. Even if it is just a UFO test with predetermined objectives, the occurrence and the phenomenon deserve to be further investigated and studied.

We always questioned the facts about Bulgaria assuming nothing is going on, only to be utterly shocked by the developments of the last two years during which the most interesting of ufological events was unfolding, described in the book as the second most important phenomenon in the country after the political changes.

Bulgaria is one of the oldest, if not the oldest European country, founded in 681 B.C.

It is a relatively small European country with a homogeneous population, situated between Rumania, Greece/Turkey, Serbia/Macedonia, and the Black Sea. It occupies about 111,000 sq.km. of area and has approximately 9.5 million people.

The climate is characterised by four distinct seasons with short, mild winters and limited snowfalls and lovely, long, dry summers, very lively springs and beautiful, almost, idyllic autumns.

Its agro-industrial base provided for a fairly stable national socioeconomic and political development over the last 50 years promoting enlightenment, strong family values and education with no unemployment and little crime. University was considered, from a social point of view, the natural course of developments and an extension of a high school education. Consequently Bulgaria was ranked first in the world in terms of number of university graduates per capita.

This event brings us a minor reminder of the work of Dr. Lozanov, a world renowned philologist who travelled extensively around the world and was the first person in the world to introduce the

learning of foreign languages through the use of psychotronic means.

Lectures in English, French, German and Italian were initiated at the beginning of the 60's and experimental subjects who vary in age groups and social status were procured through schools and other educational and business establishments. The students pronunciation in the respective languages was excellent and their vocabulary expanded multifold and the same process continued in geometrical progression. The success rate was phenomenal.

Bulgaria is probably one of the few countries in the world where the issue of UFO activities and their potential have been discussed publicly in Parliament. It became a subject of intense national and scientific debates involving the highest and most prestigious of organizations of the calibre of the Ministry of Defence (MOD) and its Committee for Cultural and Historical Studies, the Committee for State Security (KSS) - the equivalent of the KGB, the Sofia University (Clement Ohridsky), the National Academy of Science represented by the Department of Archaeology and the Laboratory for Instrumental Technology in Geotechnology and Archaeology, the High Military Medical Institution, the Military Medical Academy, the National Museum of History, the Association "Phenomini" and the "FOCONI", inclusive of a myriad of Ministers and scientists from a wide spectrum of disciplines, as for example history, linguistics, geology, geodesy, geophysics, robotics, psychotronics, psychology, psychiatry, etc.

CHRONOLOGY OF EVENTS

The events, as narrated in the Booklet first came to light in 1992. The following is a combination of comments and a summary of translated select excerpts from various speeches and reports of scientists detailing the events' order and presented before the theoretical interdisciplinary conference of FOCONI called "Phenomenon Tzarichina" conducted in Sofia on Nov.28,1993

During the spring of 1992, it became known that the MOD (Ministry of Defence) was involved in mysterious digging underground near the village of Tzarichina.

By the end of 1992, the mass media declared the BIG DIG the second most important

occurrence next to the political changes in the country mainly due to its unusual character and most of all because of the participation of one of the most prestigious ministries in the eyes of the people, the MOD.

The issue became a subject of interest even in the Parliament's Halls of the National Assembly where heated debates were conducted as to its nature, significance and cost.

On August 21,1993, the BBSS "Gallup" conducted a Poll in the capital of Sofia and established that 34.8% of the sampled population responded ("Yes") to the question "if they believe they have observed UFO activities in the village of Tzarichina" and 31.8 % stated "No".

The high percentage of believers who confirmed that there are ongoing UFO activities in the village of Tzarichina is a sign of an established ongoing process of cosmic social conscience/consequence.

One of the newspapers called for Tzarichina to become, a site for future national discussions and a priority for serious scientific institutions. Today its dream has materialized.

Following the course of action and reviewing matters in a chronological order, the case began developing at the end of December of 1990, when the MOD encountered a situation of a highly unusual character. Nonetheless, the MOD undertook the task after giving it its stamp of approval and a code name "GLORY".

The MOD received information pertaining to a site of the greatest of importance from two independent sources - through three contactees namely, Mr.Dimitar Sirakov, and Mrs. Dora Petrova and E.Loginova.

Having extended an invitation to the latter, the MOD initially tested their alleged psychic and psychometry abilities as well as their bioenergy diagnostic gifts pertaining to various subjects, objects and events of national and international character. The outcome proved to be highly promising, compelling the MOD to initiate a search for the site in question and proceed with its treasure search.

Upon the direction of one of the MOD 's Generals, a team was formed and delegated the responsibility of obtaining information and developing a plan based on the information

provided by the contactees. The entire information was extracted under the code name of "Sun Ray" and while one of the contactees was replaced, the work continued until September of 1992.

During the same period, the team, simultaneously initiated intelligence gathering in the region surrounding the site, inclusive of data on anomalous phenomena from the local population, which continued until such times when the members of the team came face to face with some of the unusual occurrences.

The initiation and the execution of the project was done entirely upon instructions and directions of the alien contacts.

In the process, a representative of the MOD, General Dinev, upon instruction from the aliens approached in confidence the Director of the National Archaeological Museum requesting his opinion on 30 to 40 pages of text of unknown origin and alphabet.

The Director noted all of the information was inscribed in a quadrangle drawn by the contactee without the use of equipment. He felt the writings contained Egyptian letters and images of sphinx, pyramids, human figures with halos, in addition to a mixture of something similar to Sanskrit, Japanese, Runic and Demotic, South Chinese characters, Daoist calligraphy resembling characters from the writings of the so called "letter of the wind and the grass", Sumerian and Viking signs, ancient Bulgarian, etc. with the arabic numbers shown from 1 to 5 on the fourth line with approximately the same configurations as used today. The first line illustrated the constellation of Capricorn and some stenographic signs shown on the last line contained the astrological sign for Pisces, Jupiter and Neptune. Clearly, in his opinion, the content of the information and the data was overwhelming and indisputable and he advised the General to contact numerous experts abroad, which eventually he reluctantly did.

Regretfully, most of the foreign linguists declined to comment, responding that the information was of no interest and given it had no value or any significance, as far as they were concerned, they dropped the matter.

Dr.Habs of Israel, who concluded that this is not an ancient alphabet, felt it was a good imitation of Chinese, Malaysian, Indian, Arabic and

Egyptian letters. In the opinion of Dr.Habs, as in that of the Director of the National Museum of Bulgaria, it looked as though this was a combination of a number of alphabets.

Another Israeli professor, Dr.I.Fichtman who also took an exception to this, expressed the opinion that this was coded information where others thought there were influences of characters from Central America.

According to history, the Arabic numbers first appeared in India in the 8th century but came to Europe in the 12-16th centuries when they were first used. About the same period the science of alchemy was developed and the signs used for the seven base metals were linked to those of planets within our solar system, namely the Sun, Moon, Mercury, Venus, Mars, Jupiter and Saturn. Neptune was the only exception. There was no sign of any of the metals associated with it which was interesting enough in itself.

The history of stenography goes back as far as the fourth century B.C.. It was the invention of Cicero in ancient Rome, who developed it as a means for speedy recording of the speeches of King Tullii Tyron.

And as far as the Viking signs were concerned, the assumption was that this was the alphabet of the God Odin.

One of the first contactees to advise the military through "Phenomini" of the importance of Tzarichina and the site itself was an elevator technician who had recurring dreams which proved to be a screen memory of a meeting with a number of historical figures who lived and fought in the Turkish occupation of Bulgaria. The technician was told that he must lead the Bulgarians. Surprisingly, the President of "Phenomini" claims to have an identical dream.

As events ensue, it turned out the first contactee to lead the military to the actual site in the village of Tzarichina, was a daughter of one of the other MOD Generals who was directly responsible for the execution of the operation. This again appears to be a completely staged arrangement from the aliens.

A young, bright, pretty and very sensitive girl, called Marina, in her twenties who often stated that she did not understand the meaning of the information she was receiving from the aliens felt she was just a medium or a conduit for

transmission of information which was done entirely mechanically.

It was through her that it was established there was a buried treasure and more precisely, information and according to Mr. Ovcharov, the remains of the first man on Earth, who was most likely from space.

The MOD launched underground excavations at a virgin location within the vicinity of the village of Tzarichina about 25 to 30 km north and slightly east from the capital, the city of Sofia.

GEOLOGICAL SURVEY

Between the months of October and November of 1993, complex geological and geophysical analysis were initiated with the intent to study the geological structure and character of a select range of geophysical fields around Tzarichina, and more specifically, its district of Seville. The methodology and apparatus employed met all established national and international standards.

The purpose of the studies was to establish traces, if any, of visits of extraterrestrial civilizations which may have visited Earth and more specifically the region of Tzarichina.

The team conducting the analysis was formed by representatives of two of the most prestigious geological and geophysical organizations in the country headed by the Manager Mr.H.Riazkov, P.Eng. and the President Mr.A.Victorov, P.Eng., including:

1. Geologist Mr.G.Ilyia Stoianov, P.Eng. - with 28 years of experience in geological search and mapping of natural minerals in Bulgaria and abroad.
2. Geologist and geophysicist Mr.Nenko Sokolov, P.Eng. - 25 years career in researching of mineral and non-mineral resources who also in the last few years was involved in the sphere of engineering geology and hydrogeology.
3. Geophysicist Mr.Ivan Minkov, P.Eng. - 7 years career in the sphere of engineering technology and hydrogeology heavily engaged in computer analysis and interpreting geophysical data.

All of the above are receptive to a various degree to the thesis regarding UFO activities and psychotronic phenomena, and the possible visitations to Earth by extraterrestrial civilisations.

4. Geologist and Geophysicist Mr.Asen Victorov, P.Eng. - 25 years career in Bulgaria and abroad in the sphere of radioesthesia starting in 1968. He is a defender of the thesis of UFO existence and the fact that Earth was visited by extraterrestrial intelligence. He is also a member of the Association of the Ancient Cosmonauts with headquarters in Switzerland.
5. Geophysicist Mr.Vladimir Popov, P.Eng. - 17 years career involved in the area of nuclear geophysics.
6. Mr.Ilyia Panev, P.Eng. - 32 years experience, inventor of electronic geophysical apparatus.

An area of 30,000 sq.m. around the Tzarichina's ground "hole" was surveyed. The Geological mapping of the area was executed in accordance with established methodology for areas with sedimentary rock deposits. The applied geophysical methods were as follows:

1. The method of the natural electrical field and its potential for modification.
2. Combined profile of the area of the established zone with dimensions ranging between AO -75 m and MH - 20 m. There are no noticeable structural deviations from a standard geological point of view. The region expresses a strong tectonic character.
3. Average gradients of the established zone with dimensions running between AB - 100 m, MH - 4 m and a step of 2 m. Using this same method three sections were scanned each 30 m in length.
4. The magnetic studies included the measuring of the total vector of the earth's magnetic field. Found to be natural for the type of terrain and fully corresponding to the physical properties of the rock.
5. Radiometry - the radiometric picture

allowed to break up and identify the varieties of rocks. The field ranged between 7 to 16 MK p.hr., which is characteristic and normal of the rocky varieties the region is built of. There were no visible uncharacteristic anomalies that could be considered unhealthy and dangerous to the local human and animal population.

6. Mercurymetry - the values measured by using the method of mercurymetry (it measures the concentration of the mercury vapours) corresponds to this type of rock.
7. Spectrometry - the same can be stated for the results from the spectrometry.

The region of Tzarichina is situated in the southern part of the central section of Svoge anticlines. The latter presents a large, positive, highly elevated and erosive structure extending slightly to the east of the passage of Vitinia going as far west as the border. Thanks to this, the central sections of the structure being highly erosive, reveals one of the oldest rocks in the western part of the Balkan Range characterised by Silurian, Devonian and Carboniferous sedimentary rock deposits of the Palaeozoic era all formed in the order as listed. The first two types of rocks were originally formed about 450 to 650 million years ago while the last one was approximately 300 to 350 million years of age.

The shifting and elevation of the rock's layers throughout the centuries have brought about the formation of a multitude of canyons of varying sizes with width ranging from few meters to tenths of meters.

Due to the weakening of the physico-mechanical structure of the rocks, the greater portion of these canyons have formed a negative geomorphological relief containing mountain passages, hills, river valleys and meadows.

The younger rock formation dates back to the Mesozoic and Triassic times or about 130 to 240 million years ago.

The main section of the Triassic sector is built of sandy layers consisting of medium to large grains of partially quartz sand particles, exceptionally strong and with high density as well as red and pink quartz sand in smaller quantities but with larger grains of sand.

The sand layers are about 10 to 30 cm., seldom reaching 100 cm. The red colour becomes dark red to purple in specific locations - a result of the iron hydrooxidation also defining the continental acidity during their formation.

Not too far south from one of the major highest quality coal mining centres of the country, the village of Tzarichina is located within the oldest canyons of the Balkan Mountains, the largest range in the country, stretching from the West border all the way to the Black Sea, dividing the country into North and South.

The southern part of the district of Seville encompasses the Lower Triassic rocks, the main focus and part of the excavation operation.

The geomagnetic field of the village extends between the values of 100 to - 300 nano tesla.

The village of Tzarichina falls within the transitional zone of two well expressed gravitational minimums of which the south one is the lower.

The researched site around the "Gallery" has a magnetic field ($\Delta - T$) which varies between - 50 HT to about -400 HT, with the lowest values observed in the northwestern part of the site where the highest gradient of the field is.

The particular rocky terrain is described as a relatively tranquil area with magnetic field ranging in gradients from 0 to 100 HT in the southern part of the site and a small section in the northeast.

The Gallery in question, according to estimates, was to be located in a highly tectonic zone at the point where the three system's canyon formations met.

The values for natural electrical field varied between -40 MB to +30 MB. The lowest negative values of the field were established in the eastern, central and northwestern part of the researched area.

The northeastern and southern parts of the area are characterised by slightly negative values as in the southeastern part the value reaches up to +300 MB all attributed to the nature of the rock formations which consisted mainly of carbide and its derivatives.

Spectrometry analysis was also conducted and the results did not establish any unusual occurrences as far as the soil or the nature of the rock's formations was concerned. All tests and studies were conducted in accordance with established principles of geology and geodesy.

The magnetic and radiometric fields were found to be typical of the physical properties of the rocks within the region. In conclusion the scientists inferred that there were no noticeable traces of any kind of extraterrestrial activities.

SITE, EXCAVATIONS AND PECULIARITIES

As previously mentioned, the purpose and the object of the search was the presence of a mysterious object most likely of a cosmic or extraterrestrial origin or a property of an ancient highly advanced civilisation containing information on the past and the future of humanity.

At the very onset of the events, the military were given only three days to find the treasure. However, that period was extended on numerous occasions for a total of two years.

The site, numbered No.1, around the hole in the ground bears no traces of human endeavour since prehistoric times. It was a virgin area. It resembled a well about five to six meters in depth and the tunnel that was located at the bottom of it extended and turned and twisted erratically. All of the changes in direction were defined in advance by the contactees. The top soil was examined and sampled but no traces of radioactivity were detected. The ceiling of the tunnel was particularly smooth but there were no man made structures.

The excavated tunnel was about 160 meters in length and about 50 meters in depth with chaotic changes in direction and soil with a rich gamut of colours changing from yellow to white to red, to grey, to orange, black and brown, all very intense and with strong contrasts.

Notable is the east wall of the triangular opening on the surface where the layers are visible extending horizontally and in some sections twisted resembling a spiral positioned vertically.

On the same wall was noted a black arrow about one meter in length. It is not known what is its

significance although the speculation is it signifies the direction in which a search for the entrance leading to the essence of the site, the gallery, is to be initiated.

On the north wall, five meters underground was a carved figure varying from cherry to purple in colour resembling a man but of much bigger size. It appeared to be a very well thought out work of art whose position didn't appear to be accidental, considering the layers of soil. It changed configurations with the depth of the site.

The team of workers which was selected by the aliens consisted of officers starting with the rank of captain and going up the ladder. Entrance to the site was strictly limited to those selected and anybody venturing underground was immobilized by invisible forces compelling them to leave the site. Uninvited and unauthorized visitors felt physical discomfort and a pain but had no lasting effects once outside the tunnel. Some of them experienced something of the nature of an invisible energy wall they could not go through.

In all likelihood, the body's cell's frequencies of the individuals and/or their genetic code was used as an imprint for personal identification.

The entire process of excavation was fully controlled and overseen by the aliens. Mechanical, equipment, engine and radio interference were just part of the game - occurring frequently, most likely as a measure of control. On March 19/91, a demonstration of control was given by the aliens with Captain Yankov, being the object of their attention, who was not yet part of the team clearly confirming the fact that access to the tunnel was controlled continually.

As it appears, the entire structure was a well equipped system with provisions for total control over the site, the presence of specific individuals, the subject's personal identification, monitoring of ongoing conversations, various types of influences and interferences affecting humans and others, inclusive of surveillance of staff and security as well as any and all other contingencies.

The mining of the tunnel which lasted 600 days and as everything else, was done under specific orders from the aliens without any fortifications and notably without even a single accident or even a scratch. The actual spots for positioning of the mines were defined by a ray from an

unidentifiable source.

Not only was every single move within the tunnel controlled round the clock, but any conversations between the officers working underground were monitored by the aliens. This was just another peculiarity of this whole case, discovered much later when the contactees, who have never entered the tunnels, related detailed accounts to the superiors of the officers of their private conversations conducted while underground. At this point it should be stated clearly that all officers were found to be medically of normal (good) health and mental state with no psychological deviations.

It goes without saying, the information was conveyed to us only through one person, Mrs. Loginova. All participants in the excavation were able to send out information but only when in the tunnel.

In the course of the excavation, the team received three types of information: a) operational directly related to the underground excavation, b) answers to questions (part of the former were accurate, part were bluffs and part were not answered at all), c) the symbols and the writings which most likely have a future strategic significance and purpose, unfortunately still unknown to us, unless one is to consider the initial statement making reference to the history of creation, development and the future of humanity.

It is worth mentioning, the excavations were accompanied by noticeable, frequent, invariable appearances of stage like lights and bright celestial-like bodies in the sky.

The complexity of the site's dynamic structure is suggestive of high security and constant surveillance by scanning devices.

One wonders, though, if more than just listening devices were focused on the tunnel. Nowhere in the book was, it mentioned if any of the participating officers had experienced any other noticeable or unusual physical, mental or physiological changes or if any have developed or suddenly acquired unusual gifts or special abilities. It would be interesting to find out, but it is doubtful anyone has even considered the possibility. Of course the probability that nothing happened is always there.

As mentioned earlier, the military posed a variety

of questions at various times that can be categorized into three groups:

1. Questions directly related to the operations associated with the excavation - the answers were always complete and accurate.
2. Questions that can be classified as scientific curiosity - the answers ranged from a bluff to most serious, always in relation to the work.
3. Questions from the third group were of varied nature and in many cases remained unanswered.

All of these experiments established that the contactee couldn't have made up the answers. This information was validated on 42 occasions.

SYMBOLS AND TEXT

RAISON D'ETRE & THEORETICAL SUPPOSITIONS

The Tzarichina region is known for its anomalous phenomena which appears to have originated in the 80's in the Western part of the country, about 20 minutes by car from Sofia and seem to have migrated gradually two years preceding the excavations to the north of it.

The essence of the phenomenon is the contact between our team and our unknown partner who initially had identified himself as "Kiki!" and later this was changed to "Roro" to "Sorel" to "Shield", "Higher Conscience" and others.

The objective was the retrieval of a buried treasure containing vital information based on transmitted particulars through the contactees.

At the very onset there were four contactees. However after the ninth month of the operation there remained only one - Mrs. Elisaveta (Elizabeth) Loginova the wife of a MOD General. Was this an accident? Most likely not. This seems to imply the selection from the aliens was completed and the one contactee that remained was the one who appeared to have proved to be the most appropriate and the strongest (mentally and physically).

The MOD was advised through numerous

sources (contactees) of the site and the buried treasure of information. According to portions of deciphered text "the information mentions the existence of civilizations about 8000 years ago and more importantly describing an event which had occurred only 100 years ago. There is an apparent enormous time gap between the time of the described event and its actual occurrence as well as the present day deciphering of the former inclusive of the transfer of the treasure coffin containing the information. None of the data appears to be known to contemporary science.

The mere fact that all this knowledge reached our times, indicates that the entire process has a well defined purpose.

If we are to use our common terrestrial logic and measurements, assuming that our unknown alien partners use the same system, one would arrive quickly at the conclusion that the whole thing makes no sense. However our two years of experience shows that this is a well thought out and planned process, executed with the highest of precision."

This brings us again to the question, why was not this information transmitted in Bulgarian or ancient Bulgarian, for that matter, even in any other contemporary or old language, but rather was presented in a format with unknown signs and symbols ?.

One of the theories was the fact it was intended to be a secret. Since the information was transmitted to us, it is easy to deduce that this was not the case. Clearly the information would have been a secret until the moment it was deciphered.

The above supposition brings us to the second question: if the information was supplied in any of the known languages what would have been the role of the MOD and the Bulgarians ? As indicated from the aliens the exact quote states "You can not wait for us to give you everything ready. You must make the effort to decipher the text and wherever necessary, we will help you. Through the text and the site, you will prove our existence and we will prove yours".

Not accidentally, the MOD was also informed through the contactees that there will be other Bulgarian and foreign parties that will take part in this process whose expertise and competence extends beyond that of their own. Given the magnitude of the data and its implications the

"Tzarichina Phenomenon" was not just a Bulgarian problem. It actually has a planetary importance and significance. The Bulgarians were nothing more than pioneers and leaders.

Some of the conclusions of individual Bulgarian scientists who have examined a section of the text believe it is young and unknown to science, with an alphabet possibly even designed specifically for the purpose of this contact.

It was transmitted through non-traditional, in fact highly unusual and certainly totally unknown and unfamiliar channels of communications to Bulgarian citizens, namely through telepathic/psychotronic means, and therefore being in our possession makes it our property and sooner or later humanity will understand its meaning and follow the specified instructions in its content.

Most likely the alphabet and the text itself do not exceed more than 100 years. It is conceivable its creation was completed shortly before originating the contact or even prepared during the communication process.

This argument is based on the fact that the contactee was given 900 symbols prior to the commencement of down-loading the actual text. In support of this is the experiment conducted with other Bulgarian citizens who have had some experiences to various degrees with receiving isolated bits of information of very similar nature. One may conclude that the source of the information was exploring other alternatives for the transmission just in case of a potential problem.

Originally, one of the main contactees, Mrs.E. Loginova, who did not know what she was writing was given 900 signs and symbols followed by a volume of 800 pages of text provided over a period of two years most of which has yet to be deciphered and is presently in the possession of either the Government or the MOD.

Deciphered components on page 49 speak of a treasure coffin with dimensions of 30 cm x 62 cm. Interestingly enough, the actual dimensions are in metric and the meter was not established as an international unit of measure until 1889.

Needless to say, all of the contactees involved have undergone the standard psychiatric and physical medical examinations by a variety of experts and qualified specialists.

The entire operation, according to the information, was conducted under guidance from aliens through the contactees and mainly through Ms. Loginova. The excavation was done in the most primitive of ways and carried out entirely by the military. It continued day and night non stop over the course of two years, nine months of which the officer lived in tents in the nearby field and made weekly visits home. All orders and instructions were given on a day to day basis and on the hour whenever required, especially during the process of excavation and the mining of the tunnel that leads to the main gallery.

Mrs. Loginova was credited with the establishment of the contact, the transmission of all 900 symbols and 800 pages of text, the initiation of operation "Glory" and the continual flow of information and guidance during the excavation none of which would have been possible without her.

The only prerequisite for transmitting the information was complete silence. Mrs. Loginova was fearful that its absence may result in undesirable misunderstandings and inaccuracies in recording the information which other than for the 900 symbols and the 800 pages of text was entirely transmitted in Bulgarian.

The situation however was quite different when the symbols were transmitted. She was able to converse and take her eyes off the notebook. This spoke of an automated communication and transmission of text and symbols, as she states, "I record them as they give me the information from the aliens, which led us to the conclusion that the former were absolutely accurate. Unfortunately, there was no way this thesis could have been proven. This was only within the power of the source of the information.

No doubt Mrs. Loginova was much too intelligent with an active mind for the level of education she has reached - a college courses in ceramics and glass.

Nonetheless, one thing is for sure. The transmitted information has a strategic significance. Why else would one bother transmitting it? The hypothesis was based on the fact that long before operation "Glory" commenced, there was a bountiful aggregate of contacts established by individuals from around the country with unknown partners. For instance, in the second largest city, Plovdiv, the character "Kiki" appear to have been known to few people.

There were poltergeist activities in the northeastern village of Debech within the region of the city of Shumen. Other anomalous activities were detected in the north in Pordim within the vicinity of the city of Pleven, the fourth largest city, etc..

Not to mention the fact that while the highly secretive excavations were going on in Tzarichina, the mass media publications were conducting an ongoing campaign detailing accounts of contacts by various individuals with "Kiki", "Roro", Cirrus and many others. Interestingly enough, however, there was not a single article in any of the publications making references to our communications with the established systems.

Our suspicions however, about an alternative contingent of contactees, proved to be accurate. Natally, a friend of Mrs. Loginova was fed with information by "Roro" and later by "Bordugan" and was fully aware of the ongoing activities in Tzarichina and their tone in minute details but was not allowed to divulge any particulars. Many others are starting to come out of nowhere with the same information. Undoubtedly, the source had developed an alternative, a contingent of contactees just in case.

FACTS AND SCIENCE

Tzarichina is not a mystery. It is an active, dynamic reality. And the more seriously we undertake its investigation, so much the better for us and humanity.

The fact remains that the experiences of the officers during the two year period at site No.1, the phenomenon, the contact, the writings, the symbols and the accompanying atmospheric anomalous phenomena all have an extraordinary scientific value, while the practical side of it and the future scientific investigations can prove to be of exceptional importance to the survival of human civilization. The Tzarichina Phenomenon is as unique and as important as the Egyptian pyramids, Stonehenge, and others.

It is important to mentioned that no one was aware of the existence of the site until few days before excavations commenced which wouldn't have happened without the establishment of a contact. The knowledge gained was done in the course of excavation which too, could not have

been accomplished without making the contact. Without it we couldn't imagine receiving the symbols and the writings since there are not two people, both of whom exude energy and unaware of each other's existence, who could conceive and inscribe identical signs.

The inference is that such a contact can not be simulated, given present day human abilities. This leads to the conclusion that the symbols and the writings are real and their existence can be proven. The phenomenon and the site are also completely real and must be accepted as such.

Whether the same have scientific value is a rhetorical question. Unfortunately, the earthly sciences have no systematic knowledge. For instance, there is no academic discipline regarding studies of the "Theory and practice, and methods of realization of cosmic contacts", "Dynamics of interference and influences on the human beings from the Cosmos", "Identification of human beings from the Cosmos", "Human beings conduct during the establishment of contacts with extraterrestrial civilizations", "Methods for exchange of information with extraterrestrial beings" etc., all clearly pointing to the fact that, at the present level of preparation of domestic scientists, they are unable to deal with the situation.

Undoubtedly, it is not just any scientist that can deal with such matters but rather the ones with unconventional thoughts and open minds.

It has been scientifically proven that the changes in the thermodynamic condition of a given system are possible through exchange of energy, a result of the received and accumulated energy.

Even if one is to assume that the processes of receiving information by the brain cells of the contactee are not of entropion character, it is conceivable and may be possible that during passage through the Cosmos and the transmission phase there are periods of entropion nature.

There is no proof any of the participants had any health problems or psychological disturbances nor motives for personal gain or fame.

All verbal instructions given through the contactees were in Bulgarian. At one point the participants in the excavation questioned their source through the contactee as to why they weren't being given the exact coordinates of the

location of the information and why is it that they were given all those 800 pages of information in an incomprehensible language that they may or may not be able to decipher, especially given their concern about the welfare of humanity and the predicted cataclysmic events expected in year 2000, threatening the very existence of the former.

"Why can't you help us ?", asked the participants who felt they were sent on a wild goose chase. "We may not find them" they continued. "That means we are going to perish in the year 2000".

"Assuming we find them" they carried on, "which means we have to decipher those difficult hieroglyphics and if we don't decipher, then that means we are still going to perish". "Why", they've asked, "can't you be direct and tell us ?", "won't you help us ?"

The answer sent tremors to their systems. It was quick, to the point and out of this world "We did what we could. Now you have to make the effort". "Well ", they said with this kind of a response, we might as well dig a hole until we reach America".

SIGHTINGS

The Tzarichina phenomena is a complex of objective reality and subjective confirmations.

In its entirety the massive evidence of the phenomenon appears to fall within the field of ufology and psychotronics. These are paranormal and, as often referred to in the surrounding area, as non -periodical, rapidly occurring phenomena.

FOCONI has registered 27 observations of single anomalous occurrences in the region of Tzarichina and the surrounding area between November 1992 till November 1993, witnessed by 26 individuals.

Throughout the entire region of the canyons there were 21 single UFO sightings of extraordinary nature, two poltergeist activities of a limited nature, one observation of about a 30 cm tall darkish turquoise colour humanoid, one glowing silhouette, one case where two witnesses were surrounded by intense light dropping from the sky without a visible origin and one observation of the phenomenon of a triple sun.

The bulk of the phenomena is characterised as UFO or poltergeist activity or based on the side effects, anthropomorphic figures, glowing silhouettes, or specific light.

Two of the cases speak very eloquently and deserve to be described.

Late on the evening of Aug.2,1993, Mrs. Kalina Mincheva and Mrs. Maria Mincheva and Mr.Ivan Milev were sitting and chatting on the terrace of their villa in Tzarichina. Around 10:35 p.m. Mrs.K.Mincheva noticed two unusual circular formations about 2.5 meters in diameter in the southwest slightly overlapping each other. She brought this to the attention of the other two parties. Her father Mr.Mincho Minchev also appeared on the terrace and the four of them continued to observe the phenomenon.

Each of the two objects exuded from their centres fan shaped bright, light blue rays at an angle of 20 degrees. The rays were rotating in a clockwise direction describing a circle closely resembling a windmill. The two objects travelled a distance of approximately 150 meters and while approaching the surface of the ground passed over the corn fields extending in front of the villa of Mr.Minchev. When they neared the dark tree on the hill situated to the northwest the two suddenly disappeared. The entire event lasted eight minutes.

Within a moment the witnesses observed a second phenomenon occurring in the exact location of the original phenomenon described as two yellowish spheres, the colour of flames, with a diameter of 80 cm at a distance of five to six meters from each other. They literally followed the path of the first two objects, but moved much more rapidly. When the two spheres reached the region of the dark green tree, the first one changed its colour and became dark red. Again, both suddenly vanished. There was no sound of any kind throughout the incident.

Case two: At the beginning of June, 1992, at midnight the dogs in the yard of Mrs.Elka Kirova, who is a permanent resident of Tzarichina, started barking. She became concerned and went out to check the surroundings. Soon she noticed an elliptical object. Appearing outside its geometrical parameters were rhumb (slightly slanted rectangular -like) formations.

The object was hovering about 4.5 meters above the ground in a northeasterly direction close to the entrance of the tunnel. The entire observation lasted about 5 minutes, following which Mrs.Kirova walked home and fell asleep. On the next morning Mrs.Kirova felt exhausted and unable to perform her daily activities. In her own words "she felt glued to the bed". This effect lasted about a day and half. In this particular case one can attribute the psychophysiological effects to the CE2 encounter itself.

The witnesses' descriptions of the objects and the character of their behaviour allow us to postulate the presence of enigmatic energy field systems in the majority of cases.

Only in one of the observations can it be assumed that the object is of solid matter. The announcement of this occurrence was made by Mr. Danail (Daniel).Doichev of the district of Busindol, in Tzarichina. At the end of May of 1992, Mr.Doichev was woken up during the night by an intense light shining through his bedroom window. He got up and looked through the window and noticed a dark cone shaped object about six meters in height. Flames coming from underneath the base of the object were moving upwards enveloping the walls of the cone. This attraction and his intense curiosity dragged Mr. Doichev outside. He intended to approach the object but the moment he showed up at the door the object lifted vertically and took off. The-lift off was accompanied by a super loud, almost deafening, sound. Early the following morning, Mr.Doichev surveyed the location of the landing and discovered a circular spot a few meters in diameter with the grass evenly and orderly levelled.

The limited spatial boundaries of the occurring phenomena compels the ufologist to hypothesize that Tzarichina is a zone of intense UFO activity. However, since the phenomena is temporary it classifies the region as a migrating anomalous zone.

The phenomena can hardly be viewed as a separate event from the activities in Bankja, a 20 minutes drive west, slightly south from Sofia, the village of Pojarevo, and the suburbs of Sofia in the direction of Lulin mountain, which developed from 1989 to 1991. During this period a large number of UFO's were seen in the lower atmosphere above those communities, only 25 km. away from Tzarichina.

In the early hours of the morning of Dec.17,1989 a number of independent witnesses observed from the military sanatorium in the city of Bankja, the landing of a UFO within the vicinity of the building and the appearance of three anthropomorphic figures from the object. On Dec.18,1989 around 7.00 p.m. an employee of the regional community of Bankja, Captain Krasimir Vezkov in the presence of his superior and deputy manager of the same took with the company's VCR camera a 17 minute videofilm of the UFO, moving toward the neighbourhood of "Gradoman" in the direction of Lulin mountain. The film was given to FOCONI and is presently kept in its archives.

On Nov.27,1991 at about 6:00 p.m.. Mr.Traicho Kolev a resident of Bankja, in the district of "Verdical", was filled with admiration observing a UFO, hovering within the region of the Odjiny cemetery located about five minutes away from the outer city boundaries. At midnight the same night Mr.Kolev without remembering what happened to him in the last six hours, suddenly and mysteriously, found himself in the village of Meshtiza, in the surroundings of the city of Pernik, a half hour drive west from the capital.

ANALYSIS OF SIGHTINGS

The empirical analysis of 26 of the 27 registered observations occurred in the period between the commencement of the excavations of the site in Tzarichina, namely December of 1990 and August,1993 at the end of the FOCONI ufological scientific research expedition "Tzarichina - '93".

UFO activity was registered in Tzarichina and its surroundings mainly in the lower atmospheric layers over the village. There were no similar phenomena registered in the neighbouring villages.

The only registered case of an observation of a UFO before that interval occurred in the winter of 1953-1954. The announcement was made by Prof.Dr.Stephen Siarov, a medical pathologist. About the same time, the priest Mr.Angelkov who was serving Tzarichina, observed from a close proximity the landings of an unidentified saucer - shaped flying object. Three anthropomorphic figures appeared from within the flying object described by the priest as "Santa Claus".

Considering the temporal comparative analysis of the anomalous zone within the vicinity of Bankja and that of the village of Tzarichina one can see that there was a one year period of overlapping UFO activities in 1991. It may not be a relevant consideration but it is not difficult to assume, that the zone around Tzarichina is an extension of the UFO activities initially registered in Bankja. In other words, the zone west of Sofia, due to unknown forces, reasons and physical laws migrated to the north of the capital establishing themselves in Tzarichina.

Here one should also mention that the city of Bankja, has always been considered to have a very special and particularly suitable climate for people with cardiovascular ailments. This fact has been known since the early 40's and perhaps even much earlier and it is here where the only sanatorium for children with heart problems is located. The city was a host for foreign dignitaries and heads of states suffering from heart diseases who were specifically sent by their personal physicians to convalescence here, among whom was the Soviet's late leader, President L.Brezhnev.

Whether this may be a result of UFO activities may take some time yet to determine. It is perhaps coincidental, but the area of Tzarichina has been noted for the same type of a healthy climate promoting steady convalescences. Are these similarities coincidental? Could it be that the electromagnetic frequencies of the surroundings of these communities have been somehow manipulated along with other subtle geophysical factors. The question still remains unanswered.

Even if this may not be considered a well founded hypothesis based on the regional occurrences regarding the appearances of UFO's, then for all intents and purposes it is an excellent picture of visual objectivity and the established consequences of their activities.

The observations in Tzarichina occurred between 10:00 p.m. and 4:00 o'clock a.m. which coincides with established world ufological data. Only in isolated cases were there observed established symmetrical range of deviations of about two hours.

The witnesses were highly credible. In 10 of the UFO cases, there was more than one witness. Many of them expressed initial scepticism and later commented on the events they witnessed

with curiosity in astonishment, saying "I didn't believe it until I saw it".

A military officer of div.34420 in the village of Ponor, stated that during 1990 or 1991 (It was impossible to establish the exact year due to the remoteness of the occurrence of the event) upon the orders of the higher commanding office he had observed a UFO hovering over the region of Tzarichina. This indicates, that the object was also observed from a different vantage point of view, namely the military compound of div.34420 located closest to the phenomenon who had to establish a visual observation.

For about 10 minutes they observed a luminous sphere with dimensions three times bigger than those of the evening star. The officers Messrs. Petkov and Angelov of the same division, professional witnesses, have noticed on numerous occasions similar objects in the air space of the region around Tzarichina.

All observations were unexpected and occurred during the normal course of performing their daily duties and activities. None of them during this period have suffered any health ailments. The events impressed them so much that they still continue to discuss and debate the phenomena.

Surprisingly, only two of all the witnesses contacted FOCONI to share their experiences. The rest of them were systematically sought out and traced by the ufologists.

Their social status differs from one to another. The group consists of a general expert of a Ministry, officers of the MOD and the Ministry of the Internal Affairs, a representative of the National Assembly, a priest, a student, the director of the local business enterprise, an employee in the service industry, an administrative employee and pensioners. Some of them have a high profile in the community.

There were no signs of attempting to mislead the investigators but rather a great effort was made to clarify in detail the answers to any questions.

Of the 26 witnesses, 15 people are periodic visitors, 11 are permanent residents in Tzarichina, 12 are women and 14 are men.

The belief exists that Tzarichina is a provocative location and a desired choice due to the presence of military forces and the newspapers hysteria related to the interest and the research

of the ufologists.

Within the limited framework of sociopsychological research, FOCONI had questioned 43 residents of the district of Seville, considered to be the centre of Tzarichina and asked them the following question "Whenever you have to go through isolated secluded areas, does it occur to you that a UFO may appear out of nowhere?" Eight of the canvassed population responded "Yes", adding they had a concern, 10 preferred to state "Yes" but they didn't have any concerns, two answered "No - since they do not believe in such things" and 23 state "it does not even cross their mind". It is important to note that 18 of the participants responded affirmatively with "Yes" and 15 alleged they have observed at least one of the illustrated 14 types of paranormal phenomena. In two of the cases the observers were able to "identify" the planet Venus.

The majority of the canvassed representatives in the sample population were disqualified due to their inability to answer the questions objectively and noted by the canvasser a sense of coquettishness and not necessarily sincere answers who apparently did not realize the implications of their responses while giving one or another statement. Consequently the results can only be considered of a general nature giving a degree of orientation and must be viewed within the context with all other empirical indicators and evidence.

There was no noticeable sign of distress in the general psychological climate of the population in the village of Tzarichina. As usual, peoples' main concern continue to be first and foremost typical for any harvesting season and agricultural problems. The researchers attracted by the development in and around the village were often the object of friendly jokes and comments by the locals some of whom felt it was their duty to convince the ufologists that they are wasting their time unnecessarily.

The complex analysis of the ufological situation in Tzarichina confirms the supposition of the existence of a ufological zone within the region. Since the first set of signs of its existence coincide with the activities of the military team, it is safe to assume the presence of a direct causal effect, a consequence of paranormal phenomenon in the region and a result of the so called operation "Glory" of the MOD and the accompanying events.

PSYCHOTRONICS AND METHODOLOGY OF COMMUNICATIONS

The case of Tzarichina clearly reveals a highly structured plan of action and equally high level of precision of execution of the entire operation.

Every significant detail was preprogrammed or stimulated by the aliens in the course of action. All essential particulars spanning from simple suggestions to stimulation of desired responses and actions, to "accidental" meetings to accidents, demonstrations of control, etc. were entirely under the control of the aliens and were all executed in accordance with the elaborate plan.

One can only speculate on the possible implications of all this, the potential and any conceivable consequences.

The review of the ufological analysis makes it obligatory to review the many forms of the occurrences. They can not all be attributed to UFOs. Only when there is an appearance of poltergeist activities, or anthropomorphic and zoomorphic shades and silhouettes as well as humanoid figures, etc. can this be categorized as ufological phenomena.

When the phenomenon capitalizes on the human psyche used as an intermediary it can be classified as psychotronic and appears as such: psychoholographic images, telepathy, automatic writing and others.

As you are already aware the founders and leaders of the Association of "FENOMINI" proposed to the former manager and Lieutenant-Colonel of the scientific department of the Bulgarian Army - Mr.Naplatanov, a program for mutual research of the problems of human bioenergy - this was to be a collective effort between the two organizations.

Following the establishment of the energy information channel, the UFOs manipulations continued until winning over the person's trust. This is usually accomplished through a demonstration of miracles and truthful, short extrasensory predictions of small and medium sized events, telepathy, internal but clear buzzing and sounds in one's head, and promoting the idea of contact with an extraterrestrial centre of

communications, suggestions of an important mission, appearance of short therapeutic bioenergy abilities, complex psychological situations, etc.

"FENOMINI" was founded on November 11, 1990 in the presence of a representative of the MOD. Literally, a few days later, out of nowhere appeared Mr. Dimitar Kekemekov, the elevator technician, referred to earlier, from the Vitosha plant, revealing that an "inner voice" used to force him to stop for years at a specific spot in Tzarichina, making him pay special attention to the spot.

The unusual, heartbreaking physical condition of Mr.Kekemekov was complemented by vivid dreams. He alleged, that during his dreams the images of Rakovski, Levski, Botev, and Vazov appeared, all historical figures of the 19th century. Rakovsky placed his hand on his shoulder and after calling him by his name said: "You must lead the Bulgarians". To add to the unusual character of the experiences, Mr.Kekemekov felt a sense of kinship to the clan of Samuil (Samuel), another former historical figure and a King of Bulgaria few centuries ago - around 950 to 1001 B.C., whose army was demolished in a battle at Ichtiman and he was declared missing in action.

In addition to all of these, he felt he had to accomplish something of great significance. It was during those cold November nights when Mr.Kekemekov was "inexplicably compelled" to disclose his experiences to "FENOMINI".

Unquestionably, it was an issue of grandiose proportions, possibly buried gold treasure in Tzarichina, information about which was received directly from the "Cosmic Mind/Conscience". The understanding was that only the military forces must be advised, since it was only they who would have undertaken the unselfish task and initiative and handled the matter.

Thus, on Dec.3, 1990 two of the members of FENOMINI, Mr.Dimitar Sirakov and Mrs.Dora Petkova, communicated Mr.Kekemekov's experiences to the former military Manager of the Administrative body - Mr.Minchev.

On the 4th of December, a second meeting took place organized by the military, at which Mr.Kekemekov was invited along with the same two members of FENOMINI to tell his story to the Manager of the Scientific Department of the

Administrative body, Lieutenant-Colonel Delcho Naplatanov, who also has a Ph.D. in science & is a professional engineer as well as a Deputy Manager of Div.24190 of the Administrative Body and his deputies Lieutenant-Colonel Mr.Z. Kanev (not the author) and Major Mr. Seraphimov.

The same night Mrs.Loginova met with the Manager, Mr.Radnu Minchev, who has a rank of General Lieutenant-Colonel of the Military Administrative body, for more than two hours relating to him particulars of her communications with "Roro".

Until today there is no written record describing the discussion or itemizing the minutes from this meeting. The only few scanty details are revealed in Mr. Naplatanov's grievance addressed to the Minister of Defence and Prosecutor of the Military Forces, who mentions a drawing, prepared through automatic writing, showing one of the Bulgarian colleagues of the Manager, who happens to be a Muslim, with antennas around his head.

At the same time, "Roro" has confirmed the existence of a treasure in Tzarichina and informed General Lieutenant-Colonel Mr.Minchev that he has only three days to locate, dig and retrieve it. Having managed to successfully convince Mr.Minchev, the following day, December 5.,1990, the MOD represented by Mr.Naplattanov and a group of the three contactees, Marina and the two contactees who originally visited General Lieutenant-Colonel Mr.Minchev, embarked on a trip to Tzarichina to identify and locate the specific site. Upon their return the same night a plan of action was prepared for the execution of "Operation Glory".

The most unusual part of this whole situation is the speed with which events kept developing - Mr.Minchev heard about Mr.Kekemekov's experiences on December 3rd and the excavations began on December 6th.

Ufologists, however, are aware of the fact that any time during UFO manipulations one puts oneself under a tremendous stress.

During the first phase of the "Operation Glory" a tragic event occurred. On February 8,1991, after systematic day and night psychological warfare associated with the "Information Centre" identifying himself as "Kiki", one of his contactees, the daughter of Mr.Naplattanov was mentally instructed to commit suicide by jumping

off the 10th floor from the veranda of her parents condominium.

Mr.Dimitar Sirakov and Mrs.Dora Petkova, the two contactees who originally approached Mr.Minchev at the MOD along with Mrs.Loginova, who in the words of Major Seraphimov, a subordinate of Mr.Naplattanov, "is a woman of exceptionally cruel nature", and Marina's uncle Mr.Atanas Ivanov Atanasov, a ranking officer with the State Security Forces were all directly accused by Mr.Naplattanov and, prior to her death, Marina herself and thus implicated in instigating psychological warfare that ultimately led to her suicide.

UFO PHENOMENA AND SCIENCE

Mr.K.Kanev, after several years of researching the case of extrasensory psychotechnological manipulations had arrived at the conclusion that wherever there is intrigue of dubious character, the participants in it who manifest "extraterrestrial" motives, can always be expected to uncover a real UFO.

The case of Tzarichina, according to the opinion of all involved, is a debatable thesis. The question stands, why the scientific studies and research of the Tzarichina phenomenon were discontinued before even starting ? It appears the reason was the poor scientific approach and lack of empirical data.

Clearly there are witnesses to the most unusual of events in the last 50 years and maybe even earlier. Is it not necessary to abandon traditional limited concepts about extraterrestrial life, its essence, forms and the manner it demonstrates itself ?

The American physicists Fainburg and Shapiro's scientific hypotheses discuss possible formation of life forms expressing the opinion that the possible life forms, do not necessarily conform to a specific predetermined or defined biological material matrix-leading to their supposition that plasmoids - life plasma exists somewhere in the atmosphere of the stars - the universe. Bound by a group of mobile electrical charges, they form themselves at the expense of magnetic forces. The sunbeams that permeate stars clouds are essentially complex aggregates of atoms in agitated state.

Another important fact is that the Tzarichina phenomenon has a sociopsychological character which is obvious by the gathered evidence.

Thirdly, with regard to the method of transmission of information, in the 70's the Belorussian scientist, the academician Veinik, presented a hypothesis about the chronaxy field. In his work he stated that in the heart of each matter exists the so called quantum of time or chronaxie.

Upon their depletion, comes the biological decomposition of the cell in the organic material and decomposition of the physical atom into the undefined. The presence of these chronaxie can be received by people with specific paranormal abilities.

The accumulation of these chronaxie creates the so called energoinformational field from which one can derive information about the past, present and future. It is possible that by passing through one's unconscious this information may acquire a primitive or a comical character. Therefore the very process of separating the wheat from the chaff is a very serious one.

The writings appear to have a logical connection between the repetitive symbols even forming meaningful phrases. Clearly not of an accidental nature are the repetitive concepts of "creator" "universe" "cosmic circulation", etc. If we are to attempt to decipher the writings by resorting to ancient Hebrew and Bulgarian inclusive of hieroglyphics and other signs, one will quickly arrive at the site of a strange phenomenon of spontaneous, transmission and receiving of a complex flow of information.

As seen from the above, the case necessitates the development of an integral interdisciplinary methodology.

The reality of the phenomenon can also be seen in other unusual occurrences, as, for instance, the cloud over the city of Asenovgrad, situated in the southern part of the country, where over a four hour period a strange spiral light was seen to fall on very specifically defined spots. There was also observed a phenomenon similar to the Aurora Borealis. Masses of people stated that they have never seen such a thing before.

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
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


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



