THE RECURRING DREAMS OF "ORVILLE AVION" (PSEUDONYM)

An account sent to CUFORN by a new member in Etobicoke, Ontario, Canada in April, 1997. Sighting reports from Mr. "Avion" and his wife "Anna" follow on the next pages. Background: "Orville" is a university graduate and a laboratory manager, age 36. "Anna" (also a pseudonym) is an administrative assistant, which in the 1970's and earlier was called a secretary. She has a high school education. Their real names are in CUFORN'S files. Read their stories and make your own judgments.

"Somewhere between, 1972-1974, I was 12 or 14 years old and living in a bungalow in Etobicoke. At that time, I shared a bedroom with my 2 brothers, one older and one younger. We each had our own bed and mine was in the middle, the headboard on the south wall. There was a window on the west, outside wall outfitted with a roller blind that was drawn all the way down.

"Everyone was asleep, including my mother and father. At some time during the night, I awoke suddenly ... frightened...scared. I was conscious but immobile. I couldn't move my limbs. I felt pressure ... as if there was a thousand pound boulder on my chest ... but no pain. I was lying on my back, with my head facing towards my older brother and the window. I couldn't move my head from this position. I attempted to scream out, but no audible sound came out of me. I wanted help from my older brother. I felt a presence in the room, but my head would not move to look and see (or maybe I didn't want to look around).

My eyes focused on the roller blind and suddenly a flash of light surrounded the perimeter of the blind, lighting up the edges. As quick as the light came through, it diffused and then I heard a sound. It resembled, if one could imagine the sound and the speed, of a bullet whizzing past your ear. As soon as the sound was gone, so was the pressure on my chest. I could move again.

Neither of my brothers heard or saw anything. I have tried to delete this incident from my memory but because of recurring dreams, I have not been able to. Perhaps this was just "the ending" of something and I am still trying to figure out what "the beginning" was. What occurred before the light and the noise?

One of the recurring dreams is that I am walking a couple of blocks home from school with text books in my hand. I am frightened because I feel as if I am being followed. Someone is watching me. I look up and see a white, enormous plane, a gigantic Concorde. I run as fast as I can to get home, knowing it is the only safe place. Once inside, I quickly lock the door. Whatever it is, can't get in, and I know I am safe.

This dream used to recur at least twice a month until I became an adult. Now, the dreams have taken on a slightly different form and only recur three or four times a year. I am still 14 playing hide-and-go-seek with my friends. It is a beautiful summer night with stars everywhere. I look up and see spheres of different colored lights far away in the distance. They look like stars until

they start to take shape and move in repetitive motions on each side of me. Then they begin to move in a spiraling motion coming closer to me. They make formations and move in unison. They get closer and closer to me and I begin to panic again. I must get home, get inside and lock the door. I can't make it home in time, so I run into my neighbor's house...but I don't lock the door. ... I wake up. At no time do I see anyone else, no other faces or people."

In the latest dream, I am in a very modern "state of the art hanger" or something. It is very clean and bright. I am above the ground and there is a door far off in the distance that is open revealing the sky and the stars. There are forms, people, things going in and out. The forms appear to be riding one man "flying scooters". I am communicating, but I don't remember upon waking, what I was saying. I am being spoken to, but I don't remember what was being said. I don't remember what the shapes and forms look like when I awaken. I do remember knowing that I won't be there for long and I will have to leave soon. I am not afraid. I am actually enjoying it."

A DAYTIME CLOSE ENCOUNTER WITH - '30 FOOT SQUASHED HAT'-SHAPED UFO

"I cannot remember the exact date of my "close encounter" but I know that both of my sons were in grade school full time, at the same school, which narrows it down to between 1982 -1984. It was

warm and sunny outside. It was either May or June (and before the school term was over). We lived in Scarborough, Ontario, Canada at the time.

As a routine, after the children returned to school after lunch (around 1:15 p.m.) my neighbor, Shirley, would join me for coffee and we would chat at the kitchen table for an hour or so. On this particular day, my neighbor went to her daughter's house to visit instead and I, being a sun worshiper, decided to spend the afternoon basking in the rays on my balcony. We lived in a semi-detached house with a balcony off the front living room extending five feet beyond the attached house and shielded by an outside brick wall.

At approximately 1:30 PM, I lathered myself in suntan oil and relaxed in a chair on the balcony. After a short while, I tilted my face upwards towards the sun and saw something in the corner of my right eye emerging from the side of the brick wall. I looked again and it seemed bigger. I stood up to get a clearer view of the object that was moving south down the middle of my street.

If I had kept my eyes closed and not looked up I would never have known it was there. It made no sound. There were no visible lights. I can only describe it as a thirty foot squashed hat with rounded corners. It was a flat metallic gray color. It was moving very, very slowly, almost hovering, in a southerly direction approximately twenty feet above the height of the two story house across the street. (Standing on my balcony, I was already one story high).

I was dumbstruck, in awe, amazed. I dashed out of the house and ran to see if the neighbor two doors up was home today as she only worked part-time. No one was.

I knew Shirley wasn't home, but her husband was a school bus driver and was often at home for lunch so I ran two doors down and pounded on their door. No one answered. The lady at the corner house (four houses down) was a part-time school teacher, and, taking the chance that she might be home, I ran to her door, hoping she might answer. All the while, I kept my eye on the object (that was now heading in my direction, as I was now south of it). No-one else was outside anywhere and all the children were in school. Not a single car drove up or down the street. It was very, very quiet.

As I stood on the sidewalk at the corner of the street, the object changed direction. It began to move west at a slightly faster speed. One block west of our street was a treed area not under development yet, and the object rose above the trees as it picked up speed and continued moving west and eventually out of sight.

I ran back inside my house and instantly called my mother at her office (she also resided with us), (My husband was a police officer, and "on the road" and therefore unable to be reached). She called the airport and the local radio stations to inquire if anyone else had reported the object. No one had.

On the next page (fig. 1, page 6) is "Anna's" drawing of the object and a map

showing her location and the path taken by the UFO. She and her second husband are new members of CUFORN. Their joint sighting of another UFO appears on the pages following the sketch. In the 1982-84 sighting, note the following details: duration-3-10 minutes; Speed: 1 - 3 mph sharp edge, weather: no wind, sunny, warm-70-80 degrees F; initial angle above horizon-15-20 degrees; left area at 25-30 degrees.

COUPLE REPORT GIANT EGG-SHAPED OBJECT NEAR NUCLEAR POWER PLANT


Here is a description of a large egg-shaped object seen by a couple, Mr. and Mrs. "Avion", near the Pickering, Ontario, Canada location of a nuclear power generating plant. The description which follows is by "Anna Avion". She and her husband currently live in the city of Mississauga, Ontario, Canada, adjoining the City of Etobicoke in the western section of Metropolitan Toronto, Ontario, Canada. This was her first sighting and his second. The sighting was also reported to another local UFO group.

"Traveling west on Highway 401 between Ajax and Pickering sometime in February 1996, my husband alerted me to an object in the sky. It was very distinct as it was nearing sunset and the few wispy clouds visible in the sky were tinted pink. There were also vertical, pink vapor trails in the area. The object was very white and did not reflect the sunlight.

The object was egg-shaped. The broader end being up and the narrower end pointing down,

As we were traveling in a car, the object did not appear to be moving. It appeared to hover at approximately 50 to 60 degrees above the horizon. The edges of the object were not clearly defined; only the distinct white brightness defined its presence.

We watched the object for approximately two minutes and then it seemed to implode. It did not move away or out of sight. It was there one minute and "poof"gone the next."

"Anna" said it occurred between 4 and 5 p.m. Her husband "Orville" was driving so that he did not have as good a view of the object as his wife. It was winter with snow on the ground, although the highway was free of snow. She said they were traveling between 80 and 100 km per hour. It seems that the object did not reflect the sun because the sun was behind it. So any reflection would have been on its other side, which would not have been visible to them. Her reaction to the sighting was of "curiosity and wonder". On the sighting report form, she said the object was at an angle of 45 to 50 degrees above the horizon when they first saw it. When it disappeared, it was at an angle of 45 to 60 degrees.

Her husband "Orville" also filled out a form. On it, he noted that his vision and hearing are good; the time of the sighting was between 4.10 to 4.30 p.m.; the duration was 3 to 4 minutes, the sky was partly cloudy; it was cold with light winds; the object seemed almost transparent. It was seen at a 35 to 40 degree angle above the horizon, at first at

a 40 to 45 degree angle seen at a distance in the north to northwest and it disappeared at the same angle. Their car was traveling at 100 km per hour. There were other cars in view during the observation. The object was to the right or north of Highway 401 over an open field.

"Orville" said the temperature at the time was -5 to -10 degrees Celsius. There were broken clouds at the horizon. The wind speed was light; the object had a rough texture. He was uncertain about the object's luminosity, and the object was a "long, oval (egg-shaped), standing on end." It had no sharp edges, was fuzzy, grayish-white, non-reflective, almost transparent. There were no other objects nearby to give a frame of reference.'

He was alerted to it by its "unusual, unnatural shape and position. It was a stand-alone object. its position appeared not to move, however, its edges were wavy. At first I thought it might be a cloud. I became excited when the object's edges appeared to show movement, yet the core remained unaffected. I knew the object was going to vanish about five seconds before it did. The object imploded."

He said "the Pickering Nuclear Plant was directly across from the object."



TORONTO AREA MAN REPORTS TWO OF HIS SIGHTINGS IN OTTAWA, ONTARIO IN 1980

As a result of my ad in Buy and Sell Newspaper in Toronto, (a free ad), CUFORN got a call, from a "Zeb Ovni", (pseudonym). Three sighting report forms were sent out and returned, one of which we will leave until the next Bulletin. Here are two of his reports, summarized and with a drawing of each UFO.

"Zeb"'s first sighting: was "approximately October, 1980", when he was 19 years old and living in Canada's capital City, Ottawa, Ontario. He wears glasses. He is currently unemployed. The time was around 10 p.m. It was clear and cool. A solid light appeared. "It first appeared as a reddish light, then a silvery metallic disc, with sharp edges as it got closer." It was the size of first an orange held at arm's length, then a baseball. The location was Bellamy Street. It first "zigzagged, then possibly hovered and lowering", he said. "There appeared to be a washboard-type surface that was lit up, which somebody can interpret as windows."

He was asked if any people of military rank questioned him about the sighting. He replied "No, but I suspect there were other observers and I feel like I'm being harassed because of it." He said the object's surface was not clear until it got closer. He does not recall the exact duration of the sighting but it was around three minutes.

He stated that when it hovered, it had green and red lights which flashed. "When the UFO was gone", he said, "I heard a loud thunder-type sound and seen(sic) flames in the sky."


He reported the sighting to family, friends, neighbours," possibly the medical community, and The Skeptical Inquirer. (EDITOR'S NOTE) :

The Skeptical Inquirer is a magazine published by the CSICOP debunkers in the

U.S.) "Zeb" said the whole incident occurred as he was walking outdoors that night.

"Zeb" 's second sighting, he says, was also in October, 1980 and lasted one hour. It occurred in the area of Tunney's Pasture and went from there to Carleton Heights. It happened at 6 a.m. "It looked like a low moving star-type object, though some time during the morning, while it was still dark or light, it transformed into a silvery metallic disc, then back to a star-type quality. I believe this happened more than once. When the UFO was gone, I heard a low thunder-type sound, then sometime later, I heard a loud thunder-type sound and seen(sic) an image of a charioteer, chariot and horse formed by a cloud in the sky."

He said "the UFO first appeared as a white light, spherical, and fuzzy around the edges. Then it possibly appeared as a silvery metallic disc that looked something like this:



"Zeb" stated that the object in the second sighting was smaller than a dime held at arm's length. It moved at the speed of a car at times. He saw it first when walking, then later in a moving vehicle. He told another unnamed UFO group at that time. He was not sure if he had seen one or two objects.

The two sightings occurred about one week apart, he said.

CORRECTION TO PAGE 5 TO CUFORN BULLETIN VOL. 18 No. 1 JANUARY / FEBRUARY 1997


