

Dear Mr. Rense

I'm referring to your weekly E-News from 7/11/99 to 7/17/99 about the Mexico UFO video report. The sighting took place here in Monterrey, N.L., Mexico, where I live, on July 7 / 1999.

My friend Fernando Von Rossum, UFO researcher and TV journalist, called me early Wednesday morning and told me that a UFO was recorded live during the news service broadcast by local TV Azteca Network at 7:30 AM. Since we have a local UFO radio show on Thursdays, he invited me to see the video in the TV Azteca studios to be able to have the complete report and interviews for our radio show.

We were received by news producer Mr. Jorge Lugo who was very friendly and helpful, and also was very excited by the event of that morning and wanted to know our opinion. He showed us the original betacam video and our first impression was very promising. It was during the newscast that morning that a

cameraman was on the roof taking images of the city to insert live views during the weather report. The news was hosted by Luis Padua and Leticia Benavides in a typical live transmission. At 7:30 AM the weather report began with a beautiful view of La Silla Mountain (symbol of Monterrey).

It was already daylight and the morning was very clear. Suddenly, during a camera pan to the right, Jorge Lugo the producer noticed something strange present in the scene. He shouted to the cameraman to freeze the camera in that direction and make a zoom to the black spot aside the Mountain. When the camera zoomed in, the strange intruder. Jorge Lugo shouted again saying: "It's an OVNI!!".

By this time Luis Padua and Lety Benavides, news casters, were hearing Lugo's conversation through their earphones and decided to make public the amazing sighting that was taking place outside and forgot about the weather for a moment to cover this "live" event. In less than a minute the response of the public arrived and the TV station began receiving numerous calls especially from the residents of that area who went out to the street and saw the unidentified object with their own eyes.

The "live" event lasted five minutes with a dialogue between Luis and Lety

wondering if this object could be one of the so-called OVNIs. Finally, the news continued its normal schedule but outside the cameraman still had the UFO in sight. In a later interview he told us that a commercial airplane appeared on scene at a certain distance and the UFO suddenly followed it, disappearing.

That afternoon we had the chance to watch the whole video sequence with the original unedited audio. The first images presented a disc-shaped UFO, static in the sky, and suddenly it moved to the left and then to the right. During this maneuver, the cameraman lost sight of the object and he had some trouble finding it again. When he centered the object again, he made a zoom and at that moment we detected an oscillatory movement of some kind from the disc and almost immediately it seemed to change shape to oval. This was the moment that it reflected the sunlight on its body and that gave us the idea that it was a metallic object. Besides, the sun was exactly in that direction and several seconds later it turned disc-shaped again.

Garfield Bowser's report of a seemingly daylight disc as reported in our last issue (January-February, 1999) was not what he thought it was at first.



CD-ROM WORK REACHES CRUCIAL STAGE

Abduction Aspects Predominate MUFON Symposium

Beverly Trout is demure, 70, the daughter of Iowa farmers and --she adds emphatically -- a frequent abductee by space aliens.

Mrs. Trout was among the speakers over the weekend at the MUFON '99 International UFO Symposium at the Hyatt Regency Crystal City in Virginia, which drew 400 attendees, many of them scientists and government workers. Also attending were curiosity seekers, New Agers and artists, who filled one room with "abductee art" of creepy scenarios featuring small, gray beings with large heads and limpid, black eyes.

Normally, the Seguin, Texas-based Mutual UFO Network sticks to more provable phenomena, such as the mysterious, huge V-shaped object that floated above Phoenix for 106 minutes on March 13, 1997. Residents flooded police departments and Luke Air Force Base in nearby Glendale with terrified calls.

This year, the MUFON conference ventured into far riskier territory by turning over much of its speaker slots to more radical territory: People who claim to have been kidnapped by aliens.

"This phenomenon is very difficult," admitted MUFON board member Thomas Deuley of San Antonio. MUFON had sidestepped the issue for some time until the number of people calling their office with abductee stories got too numerous. Now "we're in the position of having to deal with it," he said.

Dressed in a dark-colored pantsuit with silvery hair, Mrs. Trout looks more like a denizen of county fairs and rural school board meetings than an abductee of alien spaceships. Mrs. Trout started speaking out about 18 months ago when she realized she had to express the truth as she sees it.

"I was in the line of fire, and I got hit," she says of her abduction experiences that began during her childhood years. "We are being utilized [by aliens]. There is some kind of breeding program under way."

Most distressing, she reports, is the way aliens perceive humans --much in the same detached way that farmers view a breeding herd of livestock. Speaking last weekend on "Talking Back to Aliens and Humans," she ventures that there is communication between the two species, but that "it's one very dysfunctional relationship."

Sounds like "The X-Files" come to life? The very idea has sparked media reports ranging from Fox TV to PBS' NOVA show. Essentially the scenario is the same: Alien kidnapers snatch unsuspecting people and perform sexual experiments on them in the hopes of creating a hybrid human-alien race.

Aliens are apparently multi-generational, too. "Ever since I was a child, I've had encounters," Betty Ann Luca of Hays, Va., said at a press conference. After introducing her daughter, Becky, she said even her grandchildren and great-grandchildren "have had experiences."

The star speaker at the conference was Kelly Cahill of Australia, who kept several hundred people spellbound with her account of a multiwitness "abduction." It occurred early in the morning of Aug. 8, 1993, she said, when six persons in three different cars told authorities of being forced over to the side of a road east of Melbourne, the capital.

After they had gotten out of their cars to investigate what looked like a hovering craft with bright orange lights, they were approached by 7-foot beings, cloaked completely in black with luminous red eyes, she said. Partly because of her Pentecostal background and partly due to the evil feel of the "energy wave" emanating from these creatures, she first thought they were demons.

She said she was knocked to the ground and temporarily blinded. "Let go of me," she overheard her husband saying. Then, she remembers a "sarcastic, beautiful male voice" with no accent informing them that "we are a peaceful people" and telling his companions he would not harm her because, "after all, I am her father."

This frightened her, she said, as her real father was still alive. She remembers little after that, until she and her husband found themselves back in their car. Later, she told conferees, she found a triangular cut burned into her abdomen and began experiencing uterine bleeding. People in the other cars, she said, claimed to have been taken into alien ships. Two of them, she said, emerged with strange-shaped slashes on their inner thighs and ankles.

UFO researchers from a nearby university combed the site in hopes of finding some traces of paranormal activity and came up with strange holes about 19-and-a-half feet apart burned into the ground, as if a giant tripod had rested there. A soil test revealed an abnormally high concentration of sulfur in the area.

Mrs. Cahill said her religious convictions have radically changed since the incident, as the kind of Christianity she had known had no category for her experience. Conferee organizer Susan Swiatek, an Episcopalian, said abductees, including participants in an "abductee support group" in Centerville, Va., have been shunned by church members.

"Christians need to look at this with new eyes and say it's not all demons and delusions," she said. "It's either real or a new mental illness."

Not everyone attending the conference agreed that "abductees" should have been given time at the podium. Vincent J. Mooney of

Fairfax, Va., called their tales "a never-never land" of confusion.

"UFO stories are complicated to explain as it is," he said. "The abduction stories contaminate the effort. They're difficult to prove and difficult to believe."

Physicist Robert Swiatek of Fairfax said there has been plenty of evidence over the past 50 years that "something is going on." but "there is no definitive evidence to civilian UFO researchers that the UFO phenomenon is extraterrestrial in origin. If there were, we wouldn't have to be trying to convince these people there is legitimate phenomena to be studied."

"I don't know where UFOs come from, I don't know what they are. I don't know who or what mans them," he said. "It's my personal opinion it's an extraordinary phenomenon of nonhuman intelligence. . . . I cannot prove it to you definitively."

Budd Hopkins, a UFO investigator living in Manhattan, said: "If something violates physics as we know it . . . somehow it has to be rejected. It's very difficult to get to people who've already made up their minds."

He compared the UFO phenomenon to early accounts out of the Auschwitz concentration camp in 1945. "[Both] were inherently unbelievable. How could they have happened?" he asked. "If you find the material is inherently unbelievable . . . and inherently disturbing, you're not going to get people opening up their minds and allowing their curiosity and their scientific impulses to see what in fact is going on."



UFOs, The Official Secrets Act, And The Joint Intelligence Committee - A Breakthrough

Has the British Government ever employed the use of the Official Secrets Act to silence those implicated in the UFO subject? To those armchair researchers who proclaim that such an idea is absurd. I say: 'Think again.'

In my first book, *A Covert Agenda*, I presented clear evidence via officially-released documents now available at the Public Record Office at Kew, that in both 1953 and 1956 orders were circulated throughout the RAF warning personnel not to talk about the UFO issue outside of official channels; however, the records which had been declassified at the time I wrote the book did not directly reference the OSA or its potential use from a ufological perspective. Nevertheless, I was also able to present the testimony of a number of individuals (some with media ties) who asserted that the OSA had been used to keep the truth surrounding UFOs under wraps.

Via a file that I secured only days ago from the PRO, however, I am now able to prove conclusively that UFOs and the Official Secrets Act go hand in hand. Exactly why the Government has

chosen to release this file is a mystery in itself, given that it sharply contradicts past assertions.

The file in question (titled 'UFO Policy') covers the period 1958 to 1963 and revolves around UFO investigations undertaken by various Air Ministry departments during that time frame. Contained within the file is a 6-page document dating from December 1960 and circulated at 'Secret' level throughout the Royal Air Force. Like earlier papers, it details the procedures to be followed in the event that military radar operators, RAF pilots, civil pilots or members of the public should report a UFO.

Interestingly, however, the paper in question contains two eye-opening revelations. First, it states that in situations where UFOs were tracked on radar, any military aircraft in the vicinity were to be diverted from their normal flight to 'investigate the phenomena'. Second, and far more significant, is the Air Ministry's overwhelming desire to prevent the media and the public learning about such intrusions, trackings and interceptions. I quote from the paper in question:

"The Press are never to be given information about unusual radar sightings. Unauthorised disclosures of this type will be viewed as offences under the Official Secrets Act.

Although brief in nature, this document (which remained in use until the formation of the MoD on 1 April 1964 - how appropriate) makes it abundantly clear that the UFO issue was indeed covered by the OSA.

On another - but equally important - matter, the file in question also makes a very brief reference to a pre-1959 study of the UFO mystery carried out by none other than the British Government's Joint Intelligence Committee (JIC)! Certainly, it has long been recognised that at various times since the late 1940s investigations into UFO encounters have been undertaken by the Royal Air Force, the Air Ministry and the Ministry of Defence. However, the revelation that the JIC also carried out an investigation more than 40 years ago is of great significance. Why so?

First, the membership of the JIC includes not just elite personnel from the MoD, the Treasury and the Foreign and Commonwealth

Office, but also the heads of MI5, MI6 and the Government Communications Headquarters at Cheltenham - GCHQ!

Second, the fact that (to my knowledge) no rumours have ever circulated to the effect that the JIC undertook its own UFO investigation programme in the late 1940s or 1950s, is an indication of the level of secrecy that surrounded the project.

The files at the Public Record Office concerning the JIC make no reference to a 1940s/50s UFO investigation; however, I am now actively looking to resolve this issue via several methods and hope ultimately to reveal further findings at a later date. At this stage, the extent to which any of this may have a bearing on the allegations of direct UFO studies undertaken by GCHQ, MI5 and MI6 both decades ago and in the present day, can only be guessed at.

Riddle of a silver UFO 'the size of a battleship'

CONSPIRACY theorists had a field day yesterday over reports that a UFO 'the size of a battleship' had been spotted 28,000ft above the North Sea. Both the Civil Aviation Authority and the Ministry of Defence confirmed they were aware of the alleged sighting but denied they were investigating it. 'This may sound silly,' said the CAA, 'but it is a matter for the MoD.'

The MoD commented: 'Our people have been looking at it but we are not investigating.'

One UFO spotter declared: 'Well, they would say that, wouldn't they?'

The mysterious craft - said to be silver-coloured and pencil thin with square windows along the fuselage - was reported by a pilot on a private charter flight between Linköping, in Sweden, and Humberside on February 3.

The pilot, from the Luton-based airline Debonair, was flying a BAe 146 jet off Denmark when the cockpit was immersed in 'incandescent light'.

A CAA spokesman said 'He saw an unidentified bright light below the aircraft. The area was illuminated for tens of seconds.'

'Three other aircraft reported seeing it moving at high speed, or static. As far as we are concerned, the matter is closed.'

Debonair refused to name the pilot. 'He is on four days leave,' said a spokesman. 'He definitely saw a big red light.'

DR. MICHAEL WOLF: INSIDE LOOKING OUT

Dr. Michael Wolf is a former Alpha-com Team Leader, Area-51 employee, National Security Council Consultant, and independent contractor to the Central Intelligence Agency and National Security Agency. His bosses at the National Security Council told him that they wanted him, as a government scientist with Above Top Secret Clearance, to generate a controlled leakage of major amounts of information. This information is about the UFO reality and the extraterrestrial contact with humans, including the government's involvement.

Acknowledged to having a Ph.D. in theoretical physics (Doctor of Science) and Neurology, his primary work encompassed a new theory on Wave Particle Duality – an interesting discipline of quantum mechanics that strays away from classical theory.

Dr. Wolf has also received his Ph.D. and M.D. in neurology, choosing to specialize in pathology. He knew that if he wanted to get anywhere, and have access to assessments on Extraterrestrial Biological Entities (EBE's), he would need the expertise for the United States Exobiology program.

Computer science, molecular computing and organic chemical reactions capable of a billion calculations per cycle are of the many academic achievements Dr. Michael Wolf has

been acknowledged to have acquired over the years. Recently, I have had the pleasure in contacting Dr. Wolf. A brief conversation occurred over the telephone.

The Catcher's of Heaven, by Dr. Michael Wolf (released by Dorrance Publishing Company Inc.) tells of his 'fictitious' account as a scientist within the United States government.

This book had to be published under fiction to acquire the copyrights. His bosses at the National Security Council would not let him do so if it did not hold a fictitious classification.

"This book has been out since 1996," said Dr. Wolf. *"Unedited portions went out to key people in 1993 when the first copyright was obtained. You have to know where this book is coming from. It is coming from all the work and involvement up till the first submission for a copyright, because agencies that I am under the jurisdiction of, said that this had to be written under fiction."* He stated further, *"I do not make one penny off it. It all goes to a children's foundation – the Daniel Wolf Memorial Foundation for Children, which is a 501©(3) tax exemption."*

Though Stanton Friedman – one of Dr. Wolf's main critics – has said time and time again that there is no credible evidence to verify Dr. Wolf's claims, the basis behind Friedman's accusations are far from the truth. Dr. Wolf has received extraordinary mail from various individuals who have verified that he did attend both MIT and McGill Universities, and was invited to a reunion of a post-graduate Ph.D. fraternity at MIT.

"The reason this man found such information, [mentioning one of the individuals]" he commented, *"was because he had a top secret clearance."*

In addition, a woman by the name of Marge Haller visited Dr. Wolf for a week in which she admitted to having seen authentic degrees from MIT and McGill hanging on his wall at home. Another woman by the name of Paula Harris visited Dr. Wolf for two days and acknowledged this as well.

Neither MIT nor McGill universities are obligated to disclose any information regarding Dr. Wolf or their scholarly association with him – especially to researchers such as Stanton Friedman.

Dr. Wolf commented, *“I was noticed by the government as a child.”*

In retrospect, this was to become a foreshadowing event of his future work within the executive branch of the United States.

“I’d like to get some of the truth out and I’m trying to.” He added, *“The book I wrote is a substantial read. But I didn’t write it for people who want a simple UFO book. I don’t speak down to people. I speak to people. I’m not a ufologist. I am a scientist. To a degree I have determined as in Einstein and many, that spirituality is the opposite coin to the coin of science. Everyone is trying to prove that this is not so. And... ‘you can’t prove this...and if you can’t see it, feel it or measure it, it isn’t there.’ No! That goes back to Dr. Hynek, who worked for the government and was told to cover it up. He finally came clean and said, ‘this is both a physical and psychological experience’. There’s the paradox.”*

The last time I had talked with Dr. Wolf was in October of last year. He mentioned a person by the name of Sandy Sandburg, a radio host of KEYL radio who interviewed him on her show. This interview came a few days prior to

our October conversation. While on the radio, Dr. Wolf talked about a startling event that took place on one of the NASA space missions. I contacted Sandy Sandburg to acquire a copy of the interview. Dr. Wolf also commented on this event during our recent conversation.

Since it was revealed he was an ex-NSA member, the grandson of his mentor announced he [Dr. Wolf] knew about a ‘monolith’ that was recovered and witnessed from space by the Apollo 10 astronauts.

“We’re still sifting through years of information we just cannot understand. It [the monolith] was what I called ‘a postcard from the edge’, the rim of the galaxy.” Dr. Wolf paused to take a breath. *“When you stood in the presence of it, and then got colon cancer, because Carl Sagan did and my mentor who was head of counter-intelligence along with myself were the first people to view it. All three of us got cancer, two of them have already died. I don’t know why I am holding on...well...maybe I do. Its just a little help from my friends.”*

Though Dr. Wolf and his team did not refer to it as a monolith – similar to the object in Arthur C. Clark’s 2001: A Space Odyssey – he did recall his experiences while in its presence.

“When you closed your eyes in front of this thing, and listened to the harmonics you could imagine yourself looking down at the galaxy. That was why I called it a postcard from the rim...” He continued to say, *“it was just a hint to us that we were not alone, but it also taught us to be careful when bringing down something that uses cosmic energy as its source.”*

I questioned if the United States was still in possession of this object.

"I can't say," he replied. But, proceeded to state, "*people like me begged them to study it and send it back, but they did not want to do that.*" Inferring the United States government still has possession of this object and is still researching what the Apollo 10 mission found, Dr. Wolf acknowledged that because of not returning it, "*the earth and moon are both off their axes.*"

After quietly reviewing the work of Dr. David Jacobs, author of *The Threat*, and Bud Hopkins's work on alien abductions, I made inquiry to the purpose and achievement the alien abduction phenomenon served. He briefly described that abductions are not entirely based on genetic experimentation.

"You've heard of organs, but have you ever heard of organelles?" Dr. Wolf questioned, "*They're one cell that can function as an organ. And when they abduct people and do experiments on them? No. They don't. They are inserting organelles so some people can cope with the pollution that is killing this world...Abductees get upset because they are often plunged into a reality that is so totally different than their own. Fear induces the pain of the procedures. Fear of the unknown.*"

From popular UFO and abduction literature, the aliens commonly referred to as 'greys' are the ones primarily responsible for abductions.

With reference to *The Catcher's of Heaven*, the greys come from a binary star system called Zeta, or more commonly referred to as Reticulum I and II.

Dr. Wolf asserts that the greys are not as bug-eyed and evil as some people may believe, commenting, "*they do not even know what a hidden agenda means.*" This is in contradiction to what

substantial UFO literature accustoms and teaches us to believe.

While employed at Area-51, S-4 labs and other above top secret military installations, Dr. Wolf stated that the greys he associated and worked with were very lovable. "*The touch of their skin is very 'velvety' and smooth to the touch,*" he added.

Dolphins are distant relatives to the grey species according to Dr. Wolf and remarked that he underwent research with them.

"*They [dolphins] can work and communicate with electromagnetic frequencies. They can also rebalance these frequencies and know when a child is sick or in pain.*" He also mentioned that, "*they are very gentle and lovable like the Greys themselves.*"

The military industrial complex and the entertainment media, according to Dr. Wolf, are conditioning the American people to fear and feel fear. "*This is not reality,*" he declares.

Though Dr. Wolf believes there really isn't anything hostile about the extraterrestrial presence, he said, "*some people in the government would love us to believe they are. But if they ever did pose a threat, boy, would we have to prepare.*"

According to his disclosures, there are numerous species visiting earth whom coincidentally are associated with a "*Federation of Worlds*" [FoW] – a much more civilized and ancient race of beings.

The United States government apparently has signed a treaty with these visiting extraterrestrials. Dr. Wolf did not stipulate what species had specifically been involved, but mentioned that there was a predetermined landing at Holloman Air Force Base during the late sixties and early seven-

ties. It was here that they met and talked with various individuals within the United States government.

"It wasn't ratified with the Senate," Dr. Wolf remarked, "so it wasn't constitutional. They believed that this was higher than anything that you could declare constitutional or unconstitutional. They didn't want 'big-mouths' on Capital Hill talking about it, yet they still approved black budgets and the research that still goes on."

The Alphacom Team ('Alpha' meaning first and 'Com', meaning communication), was set up shortly after treaty negotiations.

Alphacom is the government's premier organization for dealing with extraterrestrial matters and was permanently 'established' after things had begun to fall into disarray with the 'guests'.

Today, this team attempting to renegotiate a restoration.

"This had been lost through hostile acts taken by a conspiratorial organization called the 'cabal,'" Dr. Wolf commented.

The "cabal" – as termed by Dr. Wolf – is a rogue group/organization within the government that perpetuates extensive disinformation campaigns about the extraterrestrial presence. Subsequently, this rogue organization is in control of SDI (Strategic Defense Initiative) and uses it in an attempt to bring down UFO's that invade American airspace.

In accord with 'cabal philosophy':

"we have laws against people entering our airspace, and we have to consider them hostile because they don't land. We have to do what we have to do," sarcastically said by Dr. Wolf while imitating personnel within the group.

He stated that acts of hostility have already been demonstrated by scientists in the STS-48 shuttle incident through the use of SDI.

"It wasn't urine off in the distance. It was an object getting out of the way of a Star Wars weapon."

With information being officially withheld from public scrutiny, *"there is a slow process of information being orchestrated through disclosure, set to be revealed sometime within 2003-2012."*

In hindsight, he feels that he may have gone a little to far, even though he noted, *"I am still contacted and briefed on what is happening" but, "I am not officially on payroll and not a consultant anymore."*

Plato – one of the greatest thinkers of our time – said we could know truth if we could sublimate our minds to their original purity. Dr. Wolf feels that people will know the truth if they begin to open their minds.

"They are finding out already," He softly said, *"with or without the incredible security layers and compartmentalization of every country trying to disassociate itself with a phenomena that is jumping around into peoples faces."*

Dr. Wolf took a slight breath and continued.

"Belgium isn't saying UFO's don't exist anymore, and Britain is having a tough time trying to keep it a secret, with huge football field sized triangular UFO's flying over the countryside. It is very difficult to say this does not exist anymore. They have proof. The Russians are more open about this than we are. It's hard for them to keep their secrets anymore."

Officially, the Russians had various people working on numerous "UFO programs" within the country.

"We never allowed that," attested Dr. Wolf. "If we did...we told them to shut up, or their grants would be shut off."

Since the publication of his book was written under fiction, Dr. Wolf feels that he does not need to explain himself, verify or document who he is or what he had done to anyone.

"I wrote a book of fiction" He remarked, "it's up to the reader to decide what rings true for them, or what doesn't. People have an awareness, right under the surface and as much as they want to deny it, it's still there."

Dr. Wolf admits "there are a lot of things you can believe...and there are a lot of things that I hope you do not believe, about the so-called 'authoritarian'."

He continued to say that, "ufology is not recognized as a science. Everyone and his brother are in it...and usually for the money. It's for agendas, and it's for disinformation..."

Dr. Wolf also admits that, "I have no agenda, except for enlightenment. I want to see us evolve out of this horror we are inflicting on one another. When the 'X-files' say that the answer is out there, the answer isn't out there because it's right here. You just have to open your eyes to see it."

Many people have accused Dr. Wolf of being a disinformation specialist, but as he comically points out, a disinformation specialist must know the information in order to make the disinformation. In other words, it becomes a contradiction in terms. He

feels this is the reason why everything surrounding the subject is in disarray. Governmental segregation has everyone whirling around in circles, especially the Central Intelligence Agency.

"Central Intelligence Agency?" Questioned Dr. Wolf. "The Central Intelligence Agency...there is nothing central about it. This agency is so compartmentalized that they don't know certain people that exist who are functioning within their own organization. They compartmentalize the whole thing so well."

When asked about the secrecy of MJ12SSG (Majestic 12 Special Studies Group) and the apparent rumor that it had changed names to PI-40, (stated by Dr. Steven Greer) Dr. Wolf responded that, "It goes through a lot of names, but it's still the same thing. You can call it anything you want, it's still going to be there. It's like staring through a piece of glass, but not being able to get to the other side."

The greatest fact Dr. Wolf can attest to about himself, is that he has never lied.

"All I have to do is watch that thin line between treason, and what I am suppose to be talking about," He briefly commented.

When looking at humanity and the general shape of things to come, Dr. Wolf feels that a lot has to change in order for us to have a viable legacy for our children.

"I see a whole new generation of people like you, who is growing up, saying, 'why are we killing the planet?' Because it pays. I hate to sound less optimistic than I'd like to be..."

"I don't see any positive steps in this industrialization of the world," he cautioned. "And neither do they." [E.T.]

"The Children are the hope and future of this world," Dr. Wolf sincerely declared.

"I also care about the future of humanity and of this earth, because as we all know, the earth as well as ourselves is a living entity..."

Dr. Wolf somberly added, *"humanity is not ready to handle all of it just yet, for humanity cannot even handle himself."*

In a final word, he remarked that, *"if you take all these little tid bits of information...these are all the little truths that are slipping through from all the lies. That's why I have always said, 'the truth is a lie which has yet to be exposed.'"*

All the proceeds to The Catcher's of Heaven go to a non-profit children's foundation instituted to provide a viable future for the children of this planet.

The Daniel Wolf Memorial Foundation's efforts are directed towards funding continued research in "developing treatment for autistic children and those afflicted with Down's Syndrome."

Along with this, the foundation intends to fund research and development towards finding new methods of treatment for pediatric cancer, AIDS and various 'orphan' diseases.

Conclusively, the sincerity and overall honesty displayed by Dr. Wolf is – in itself – an overwhelming feeling to experience.

The Catcher's of Heaven vividly grabs-hold of the many startling revelations and disclosures as witnessed by Dr.

Michael Wolf and the agencies that he had previously been employed.

Latest Revelations from NSC consultant Dr. Michael Wolf

In early 1999 I received a phone call from Dr. Michael Wolf, consultant to the National Security Council's Special Studies Group, (popularly known as MJ-12.) He provided new information, and expanded on some previous disclosures.

Wolf expanded on his previous revelation that a secret military spacecraft retrieved an extraterrestrial space beacon, dubbed The Monolith, from its position in space, and brought it back to Earth in 1972 for study. The U.S.'s removal of the powerfully-energized Monolith has caused our Moon to destabilize 2% from its normal axis. This in turn has adversely affected Earth's climate. Top International Security officials in communication with extraterrestrial representatives have requested them to restore the Moon to its proper axis. But the ETs have declined to help until the U.S. restores the space beacon to its original position in space. This is consistent with general ET policy of providing helpful advice, but not rescuing humankind from taking responsibility and action to correct our previous folly.

The conversation turned to a rash of recent reports of large anomalous objects spotted within our local region of space. Dr. Wolf minced no words about what is known within the highest National Security circles. "There are several large UFOs in our solar system."

I spoke with Dr. Wolf next about an experiencer I know, who has had frequent communication from a humanoid extraterrestrial identifying himself as originating from the Altair system. (Altair is a very bright, variable double star in the constellation Aquila, 15.7 light- years from Earth.) This woman experiencer had met this extraterrestrial in the 1950s, in the course of her training for highly-classified intelligence assignments. Wolf was nonchalant about such human-extraterrestrial interactions, having himself worked side by side in classified government laboratories with a human-appearing ET from the Altair system and a "Grey" humanoid scientist from the Zeta Reticuli system. "Altair's fourth and fifth planets are inhabited. In fact, the people from Altair colonized the Pleiades system long ago. The human-looking Pleiadean extraterrestrials some people meet are actually ancestrally Altairians. There are two variants, the Semitic-looking ones and the Nordic-looking ones. The 'Semitics' are the race which landed at Holloman Air Force Base (New Mexico) in the '60s, and conversed with some generals there."

Dr. Wolf also revealed that, as a military-intelligence Colonel-physician, he has worked with some very-high military officials who have had close extraterrestrial encounters, and needed some counseling to adjust to their paradigm-shattering experience.

We also talked about extraterrestrial-human hybrids, who have been genetically engineered by certain extraterrestrial cultures. More recently, secret U.S. national security projects have attempted to also bioengineer such hybrids, having some success. Wolf characterized such hybrids as having three-helix-strand DNA and fore-lobe brains. "Europa [Jupiter's seventh moon] is a place for such hybrids [to live]." The conversation turned to information I received from an National Security Agency source about NSA's ability to monitor an individual's brainwave and thought activity from

special surveillance satellites. Dr. Wolf did not deny such technology, and added, "The government can create confabulated [contrived] memory in a person through Amytal [sodium amobarbital, a hypnotic drug] and microwave [brain] scrambling."

Wolf brought up the current week-long series of specials on the Learning Channel about UFOs and extraterrestrial-human encounters. He touted that as part of the government's conditioning program, which he calls the Processed Release of Information. We got into our on-going argument about the pace and timing of public acknowledgment by officials of ET contact, with my arguing that such time has come. Wolf demurred, saying that the national-security Old Guard, with which he identifies himself, feel the public is not yet ready, and needs more such conditioning. This writer vigorously disagreed, pointing out that the government has consistently misread the public as fools, whereas the public is generally well ahead of government estimates. Dr. Wolf noted that the national security community is divided. The Old Guard of scientists, military and intelligence officers with access to UFO secrets is nearing retirement and want the reality of ET contact to come out, but slowly. The Cabal, a rogue group of young generals, intelligence officers and defense contractors, opposes disclosure, and wants to enjoy for themselves the power, prestige and profit that comes from continuing the monopoly on ET information and technology. Wolf said, "They are the ones who shot a [Star Wars] weapon at a UFO near [Space Shuttle] STS-48." [If you feel that the time for official acknowledgment has arrived, prove the Old Guard wrong, and fight the Cabal's selfish agenda, by deluging the White House with demands for official UFO acknowledgment. Dr. Wolf concluded the conversation cordially, despite our differences on policy. He anticipates being authorized to make further disclosures soon.

Bizarre Flying Disc Over Scotland Shakes Witnesses

An unidentified flying object sighted in the Angus skies near Carnoustie this morning has left a number of people mystified.

One Carnoustie resident, who wishes to remain anonymous, said he had been fairly sceptical about such things, but wanted an explanation for what he saw.

He and several members of his family, along with a Forfar couple, saw a strange red disc moving about the sky between 6.30am and 6.55am this morning.

Neither the Coastguard nor members of staff at RAF Leuchars could shed any light on the sighting.

The man said that the object, which moved about the sky, was "like nothing I've ever seen before except on the film Armageddon".

"I was out walking the dog with my wife and child near the black slab car park this morning," he said.

"We saw this red oblong shape in the sky, and it couldn't have been the moon or the sun because of the way it was moving. It then just disappeared.

"A car drew up and the man inside asked us if we'd seen it and we said yes.

"Distressed"

"The man in the car said he was from Forfar and had seen the light earlier, and we could see he was visibly distressed."

The family continued their walk along the beach and the object reappeared at about 6.55am.

"I'm neither a believer nor a non-believer in UFOs, but this time it had changed from bright red to orange, and it was much bigger," he continued.

"Anybody looking at the sky would have seen it - it was that big you couldn't miss it."

A member of the Fife Coastguard said there had been no reports of flares or other lights.

"It's been fairly misty this morning, and there is no meteorite activity as far as I know," he said.

A spokesman at RAF Leuchars discounted any official aerial activity by personnel from the Fife airbase.

"I know of no operations in the area by any of our flights," he said.

So it seems the strange red object will have to remain a mystery for the time being.

For various reasons, this is the last issue of the CUFORN Bulletin. It has been published since 1980, three years after CUFORN was founded.

Contact with members and subscribers will continue by mail and telephone. We will still investigate reports. Any major ones will be typed out and sent to IUR (the International UFO Reporter (CUFOS), the MUFON UFO Journal, FSR (Flying Saucer Review in England, Awareness in England, UFO Magazine (U.S.A.), Fate (U.S.A.), and Nexus Magazine.

The growth of ufology on the Internet has cut membership from a high of 108 in the mid-1980's to 28 now. As members get computers, they do not renew subscriptions. We have had to rely on donations from two members to stay afloat. Our current trust company account balance is less than \$20.00 (\$15.00 U.S.). Eight of our 28 members pay no fees. They exchange bulletins with us or have free membership for services rendered. Our foreign members are in the U.S.A., England, France, Belgium, Germany, Hungary, and Japan. So much for the first reason.

Another reason for winding up the Bulletin's publication is that I, my wife Betty (and our cat, Victor) moved to Mississauga, Ontario in 1997, with the kind assistance of a few members. Our home address is 7280 Darcel Avenue, Apt. 328, Mississauga, Ontario, Canada L4T 3T7, telephone (905)678-8435. In our new home, we cannot afford the cost of gasoline or the time to drive to the Downsview area of Toronto to get Bulletin expense money or the mail from CUFORN's postal box.

Our President Joe Muskat moved from Thornhill near Toronto, to St. Catharines, Ontario several years ago. This is a 90 minute drive away from Toronto. Most inconvenient for Joe.

In 1997, I was injured in a commuter train derailment in Toronto. In 1998, I retired on a small federal government pension which all senior citizens get in Canada. That same year, my car was moderately damaged in an auto accident in Mississauga. My wife Betty's Ontario government disability payments were cut by 20 percent in a right-wing government decision to eliminate the province's deficit. We have had to borrow money to buy food and are getting deeper and deeper into debt. The result is forced entrepreneurship. I am trying to start a business--the marketing of a CD-ROM for computers. I've been working on it for a year. It is the history of UFO reports in Canada. It hasn't been easy as I have tried and been unable to reach Chris Rutkowski in Winnipeg who has a lot of reports on file.

Copies of a business plan have been sent out to people who know people who invest. I'm partners with the son of one of our most loyal members. He will be doing the Master Copy of the CD-ROM. We are awaiting funds to start the company--registering the name, marketing, sales on the Internet, and getting production going with a local manufacturing firm. We have 17 people on our Board
