



TWO REPORTS FROM '78 OVER NUCLEAR PLANT

As a result of a television show by CUFORN's Co-Directors on Rogers Cable TV in the winter of 1978-79, two sightings were reported by Mrs. A.W. a former resident of Holwarth Cove in Dorset County, England. The observer had moved to Toronto, Ontario a few months after her sightings. She called us

during the phone-in segment of the 90-minute special and we received a completed sighting report form on March 19, 1979.


The 53-year-old woman had observations on August 16 and 17, 1978. The first one was at 8.45 p.m. of a large balloon-shaped bright silver light near the cliffs overlooking the sea at Weymouth's Navy Harbour.

She heard a noise like a "buzzing of high tension wires". She estimated its size as 25 ft. diameter. It seemed solid and hovered as she saw it outside her home in clear weather with many stars showing and a new moon visible. It hovered for five minutes, ascended at a high rate of speed and disappeared. On this and the next night, she had been horseback riding and said the animal "was very nervous."


The second observation was of one, then two frisbie-like objects over the government nuclear power plant at Winthref in the Woolwich part of Dorset, Aug. 17, at 9.25 p.m. She was a previous non-believer in UFOs. She said she was "very scared."

HOLWARTH COVE, DORSET ENGLAND*







NUCLEAR WEAPONS STORAGE AREAS AND UFO REPORTS



Note the following nuclear weapons storage areas in the United States which appear on the map above. (The map was part of an article on nuclear weapons in the August, 1985 issue of Discover Magazine.) Hanford Plant, Grand Forks AFB, Wurtsmith AFB, Minot AFB, Malmstrom AFB, Griffiss AFB, Loring AFB, Plattsburgh AFB, Pease AFB, Oak Ridge National Lab, NAS Brunswick, and K.I. Sawyer AFB. In 1975, all these facilities

were visited by UFOs. In 1980, Kirtland AFB had reports.

WHAT'S WRONG ABOUT MAKING MONEY FROM UFOLOGY?

EDITORIAL by Lawrence J. Fenwick

The November-December, 1984 issue of the SBI Report, published by the Scientific Bureau of Investigation, Inc. of Staten Island, New York, contained a rather forceful editorial by SBI's International Director Pete Mazzola. I feel it requires a comment and an adverse opinion in rebuttal to Pete's statements.

Mr. Mazzola, whom this writer has met, is a dynamic speaker and it shows in his statement. He says that a key witness in the Rendlesham Forest-Bentwaters-Woodbridge case of 1980 should be treated as one would treat a George Adamski or Eduard "Billy" Meier for several reasons. The witness, Larry Warren (pseudonym Art Wallace) tried to sell a tape recording of a U.S.A.F. encounter with the UFO in the Rendlesham Forest to the National Enquirer for \$5,000.00.

He says that Warren lacks credibility and is not reliable. ~~Warren is now writing a book~~ about the incident and trying to get a movie made about it with Robert Redford portraying himself. More of the money angle emerges here.

Pete states that SBI has done a "preliminary investigation of Mr. Warren; both past and present." It believes "that Mr. Warren has been anything but truthful in his allegations." I feel it is not justified to evaluate Warren through a "preliminary investigation." A full-scale one must be the basis for any value judgements to be made.

Pete does mention a few

criteria for a full-scale probe into Warren. He fails to say why SBI did not follow up with an attempt to do such an investigation. This belies the very title of SBI. SBI must live up to its name and has failed to do so here. Warren has alleged an event took place and all SBI has done has alleged that Warren is lying, and was not at the site of the incident but just heard about from the guards who were at the landing site.

I think that what underlies the SBI Director's comments is a purely monetary motive. He feels that if someone tries to make money from a UFO event that the person is an opportunist or charlatan. What has Pete Mazzola got against making money? Just because most, if not all UFO organizations are non-profit does not mean that someone cannot try to profit from UFOs. If we are seen as being against profit, we might be suspected as being Communists by skeptics or the government. We have enough to contend with in terms of ridicule as UFO organizations without adding to our troubles.

Sure, let's investigate thoroughly and wait until that part is complete. But let's not make unfounded allegations about Warren, as Mr. Mazzola has done, until then. And don't let anyone accuse us of being against capitalism. We are not.

Mr. Mazzola's column, Ask the Director is a regular feature in the SBI Report. His statements were made in response to a question from a subscriber as to how accurate the various UFO stories are that appear in various publications.

The investigation into the events surrounding the failed retrieval of a submerged object in the Bellingham-Seattle area of Washington State in the latter part of December 1984, as reported in the previous two Quarterly Reports, continues. A final report on the case is not yet available, but we hope it will be sent to us sometime this Fall. By that time, the sample of red material that was scraped off the submerged object may also have been tested.

To refresh the memories of those who may not have followed the case: In July of last year, an unidentified flying object was sighted by fishermen during the early morning hours over Puget Sound. According to eyewitnesses, the bright object came out of the sky at a tremendous speed, rose upwards, then crashed into the water, causing a large amount of spray and sinking below the surface, leaving only bubbles. An official U.S. Coast Guard report was made on the sighting.

A group of private divers located the object, submerged about 150 feet below, in murky water. They found a large object, about 15 - 18 feet wide, half-buried in the silt. One diver said it looked like a partially-submerged "upside-down teacup." They walked on top of the object and collected some reddish-colored mud on their diving boots. They wanted to haul it to the surface, but--lacking the necessary equipment--had to leave it unattended for three days. When they returned to the area, they couldn't locate the object again, despite an intensive search.

As has been pointed out previously, this particular case makes abundantly clear the need for a "Rapid Deployment Fund" to carry out immediate investigation and analysis of UFO cases. The response to the Fund's appeal thus far has been heartening, but--as the Treasurer's Report points out--it is only a beginning. We hope that as a supporter of UFO research, you will be able to make a special contribution to the Rapid Deployment Fund. Each contributor will receive an "I Support UFO Research" bumper sticker or button, as long as they last. Let's not forget the "UFO that got away"!

During this quarter, the Executive Committee discussed activities for National UFO Information Week, August 18 - 24. It was decided that about a dozen libraries in the Washington, D.C.-area would be contacted and offered (a) a free three-volume set of the UFO/Government Documents that are available from the FUND, plus the "Ghost of the Estimate" paper (see attached Order Form); and (b) lecturers to discuss the UFO phenomenon. It is hoped that many local libraries--including the Library of Congress--will respond positively to this offer.

The Fund also planned to mail information to news organizations across the country and contact radio and television stations in the Washington, D.C.-area, to promote the first National UFO Information Week.
