

MECHANICAL ENGINEER-ABDUCTEE DISCUSSES THE IMPORTANCE OF THE ALIEN MAGNESIUM ROD

The magnesium rod given to an abductee in Hungary (See Bulletin Vol.18 No.1, January/February, 1997) is actually a catabolic intensifier used for energy creation.

"Catabolic" is defined by the New Webster's Dictionary and Thesaurus of the English Language, Lexicon Publications Inc. 1991 Edition, New York, as "a destructive metabolism in which complex compounds are converted into simpler ones with the release of energy."

So, since the rod was unfortunately cut into three pieces by the Hungarian abductee, we can not see the rod in action. It could have been used to change material by vibrating it to form new elements. If the rod got into the wrong hands, it could kill, rather than cure. Thus, it is a possible weapon. It can cause different vibrations to occur, with sound being one medium. The sound coming from it can effect people or things equally. This is one of the items that military intelligence agencies would like to get for military usage. This explains why they are interested in the UFO phenomenon.

How does the rod cause vibrations? First, we must realize that we are dealing with ideas that are completely foreign to us. In the thinking of the "greys" there is no hydrogen or other elements. They do not use the same terms for these substances. Knowledge of their concepts has been implanted to form a central core of the thinking in central Asia.

The rod demonstrates a catabolic-anabolic phenomenon. It can be used to dissociate organic material into constituent elements. For example, a plant can be broken down

into many "active ingredients", which are then isolated.

Taking this a step further, we must realize that cosmology sees the idea of worlds within worlds. In mathematics, everything represents different amounts of vibration, which depends on the number of vibrational levels, in turn. Each cell duplicates itself almost infinitely, both downward & upward in size. We should deal only with one level at a time. Take a point as "everything" or a former universe. We should use different steps in this; we must think of all worlds galaxies, solar systems, planets, etc.. Think of the relationships of the earth to the moon, the sun to the moon, and so on. Compare this system to the human body's cells where they are to be thought of as containing different levels of vibration, each of which is separate, although they form part of the cells.

The "greys" are almost complete beings compared to humans. They are born that way. When they abduct humans they extract genetic material for themselves to make their evolution complete. They do not regard themselves as beings. They have three lobes in their brains. We need to be more astute in order to understand them. They use fast mental constructs or instant mental analysis. Humans create the world through primitive thinking processes.

When we try to understand the rod's operation, we must use the continuity of its vibrational transformative capabilities. But basic scientific law says that vibrations are discontinuous. Actually, there are continuities. The "greys" study vibrations and change material by using the number of

vibrations in it. They spilt the item into many parts by vibrating it to form new elements.

Imagine that a soldier is carrying a light weight gun. Pointing a functioning rod at it

could change it into solid lead. The soldier would drop the heavy gun. What a weapon it would be in war!

Japanese-Polish Abductee Sends Further Data on Alien Magnesium Rod

On April 27, 1997, Paul Kaminski of Tokyo (formerly of Poland) sent a letter to CUFORN with additional data concerning the chemical make-up of the Alien Magnesium Rod given to Laszlo Bako of Hungary as a souvenir. (See our issue 1 of volume 18 January / February, 1997 for the original story and initial analysis). Before we give you this, here is information from Tarcali Gabor of Debrecen, Hungary. He answered questions from your editor concerning the rod.

"We can not disclose the name of the Hungarian University who did the first analysis. This is because it was done without paying the usual fee for chemical analysis. It is one of the most important Hungarian science universities, however."

Mr. Bako has only a few memories about the alien being who gave the rod to him. "The being looked like a strange man with a big head and eyes," he said.

We can not examine the interior element or elements of the rod because Mr. Bako has not agreed to this as yet.

The object looks like a long cigar case. Mr. Gabor said that this is not a coincidence, "but I have not got any idea why the rod looks like it."

Regressive hypnosis was not done on Mr. Bako for two reasons: The Hungarian UFO researchers could not find a good

hypnotherapist; secondly, Mr. Bako does not want regressive hypnosis.

Mr. Bako has reported several side-effects of his encounter. First, he had a bad headache, and a "general indisposition". Later, his symptoms were the following: eye-ache; spine-ache.

Apparently, from the gist of Mr. Kaminski's letter, the rod data was part of a video tape shown on Japanese TV. The data was obtained in the Mitsui Metal Laboratory (Mitsui Kinzoku Kenkyujo), in Tokyo. Mitsui is a very large corporation, so large that it has its own bank, with one branch in Toronto, Ontario, Canada.

A video tape to be sent by Mrs. Kaminski will contain more data, according to Mr. Kaminski, in his letter.

He says he has been abducted, and had an implant in the calf of his left leg. He

also says he has some photos of the same kind of implant from Germany. He says he was shocked by his abduction; "I am still shocked and I have some flashbacks, that's all," he said.

A MYSTERIOUS TRIP WITH "MISSING TIME"

The time and location of UFO events in Hungary is not homogeneous. One of the locations of frequent observations is in Hajdu-Bihar County, in the area between Hajdiboszormeny and the settlement of Jozsa which forms part of the city of Debrecen. One flap area is around Highway #35.

In this area, a UFO pursued an ambulance, road inspectors met extra-terrestrial creatures, and a photographer was abducted, who later died under strange circumstances. The following case occurred close to Bodaszolo-- which has an important military base-- four kilometers from the Highway and forms part of the town of Hajduboszormeny.


On the afternoon of June 13, 1996, a citizen of Hajduboszormeny set off in his Trabant car for Bodaszolo where his older daughter was in a summer camp. He took his younger, 4-year-old daughter with him. She sat in the back seat. They were in a hurry because the older daughter was rehearsing for her part in a school ceremony that afternoon.

The weather was cloudy and chilly; rain was falling here and there. The driver turned left at the military barracks before the

town onto a dirt road. A few hundred meters further on, he turned left again on a road in the direction of the camp. Traveling along the dirt road, they found a freshly fallen tree which completely blocked the road. It was a 30 centimeter diameter poplar, which had fallen beside several of its already dead companions. The driver quickly got out of the car to pull the obstacle off the road, but he could not manage it. He got back in the car with the motor still running and started to reverse. The rain was steady, but, despite of the time he had been in the open, his jacket was completely dry.

While reversing, he could see his daughter sitting the back seat. The passenger compartment and the rainy wooded road, seen through the back window, became obscure. He does not remember anything else. He became conscious that he was traveling forward through a woods without a road, although, before that he had been reversing on a dirt road in the woods. Inching his through the trees, he slowly came out onto a build-up road, where, turning left, he headed West.

After going along the road for one to two kilometers, to his great surprise, he saw a sign-post indicating the eastern edge of the town of Teglas, nowhere near their original destination.

They arrived at the fallen tree at 2:00 p.m. Meanwhile, at least five but no more than ten minutes had passed. In this short time, the Trabant with its two passengers traveled 14 kilometers as the crow flies. In the course of this the crossing of the main road and railway line between Budapest-Zahony would demand extra attention and require them to stop.

Passing through Teglas on the main road and the Hajduboszormeny-Hajduhadhaz linked-road, they returned to Hajduboszormeny, from where they went to Bodaszolo again by route they had already taken. They both got out of the car at the fallen tree and went on foot to the camp. The return trip of 29 kilometers took 40 minutes, so they arrived back at about 3:00 p.m. Naturally, they were late for the rehearsal.

It is unimaginable that after (during) going into reverse due to the obstruction they got lost and traveled 18 to 20 kilometers on dirt roads made difficult by the rain in at

the most ten minutes, during which they had to cross a double track railway line, a first class main road and two secondary roads--stopping at each of them. During their five to ten minutes period of "missing time"-- a significant change in location occurred which they could only correct by covering a route of 29 kilometers, taking 40 minutes.

Neither of them remember what happened during the "missing time". With the assistance of regressive hypnosis, the missing events could be brought to the surface, but the father did not wish to undertake this.

Since, then the little girl has often mentioned the "horrid old men".

EDITOR'S NOTE: Were these "horrid old men" aliens who abducted the man and his daughter? We may never know.

MEMBER REPORTS NL IN TORONTO AREA JUNE 3, 1997

One of our members in the metro-Toronto city of Scarborough, Ontario, Mr. L.C. reports his sighting of a nocturnal light on June 3, 1997. Here is his account:

"On Tuesday June 3, 1997 I could not sleep and got up and watched some television. At 4:35 a.m., I was going out to buy the "Toronto Sun" and as I went out the door I noticed a moving light in the sky.

"It was a steady, bright white light which looked like a bright star but it was moving. It was traveling from North East to South West at a speed too high to be a satellite. I know this because I have seen several satellites. It could not have been an airplane or a helicopter because I didn't see any flashing lights and there was no sound.

It also could not have been a balloon because there was no wind. All told, my sighting lasted approximately one minute. The clouds, by the way were cirrus. The light gradually faded out in intensity until it was no longer visible. This fading out took about 12 seconds. I have seen other UFOs disappear in the same manner."


