...Here in brief is what happens: The Occultists tell us that deep down inside the physical body there dwells a "Divine Spark". This is the Ego, the thing we call "I am". It is the personal consciousness, the real you, and for convenience and want of a better term for this Ego and the Spark which animates it, the English language uses the popularly known word "Soul".

At the time of death this Ego (or Soul) withdraws from the physical body and takes residence in what is technically known to some groups as the "Spirit body" or, to others, as the "Astral body". This body is the direct counterpart of the physical but is composed of a much finer substance. Normally, this incorporeal anatomy is imperceptible for the average human being. (In every external respect it resembles the physical body. But internally, its organs are different.)

During earthly abode the astral body is connected to the physical by a slender, tenuous band of psychic (or magnetic) energy, known as the Silver Cord. This Cord can be stretched to great lengths, and frequently the Soul will temporarily leave the physical while one is asleep, enter the finer body, and take "astral flights" to distant lands or other spheres of consciousness. (1) As long as the Silver Cord remains intact, the Soul is assured a safe return into the physical body, awakening the individual (who may have little, if any, remembrance of being away), to earthly consciousness.

This sleep, in one respect, is a "little death" because the Soul has left, on temporary bases, the physical body. Should this Cord be damaged and broken, the vagrant Soul will have no means by which to return to the material body. Thus, death of the terrestrial existence. The physical soon decays, (2) but the Soul goes off in its new vehicle to another state of being. In all the life of the Soul itself, the Ego has continued unbroken, uninterrupted --it has merely changed bodies.

Under normal circumstances, such as old age or severe sickness for the Soul, the process of dying is painless and natural, although it is sometimes accompanied by a number of distressing manifestations in the physical body as the Soul departs.

Andrew Jackson Davis, the renowned American clairvoyant has watched a number of people die and, graphically and completely, has described the process. He claims to have

passed away. This is because the departed friend or relative has actually come back to earth and into the room where he or she are helping, that dying person make the Great Transition. At such times, according to all this testimony and the Wisdom of the Ages, the physical body suffers, but not the soul.

Death, therefore, is not a thing to be dreaded. It is not the end of individual existence, not a dissolution or annihilation of the Ego, but rather, it is a glorious rebirth into a new life.

When the Soul thus leaves the physical body under normal circumstances, the individual soon regains self-consciousness in the new surroundings. You shortly awake to find yourself well and as conscious as you before were. The only difference being that, instead of finding yourself in your accustomed physical body, you have a new and much lighter one. You feel remarkably free and buoyantly alive. In fact, you feel such a resilience of spirit that it is hardly comparable to what you felt before the Great Transition.

Perhaps you will then have the same experience as the many others who had gone before you: You may suddenly see your former body lying on the bed. At first this will be a shock. You cannot understand it. In amazement you may say to yourself "Why, that's me over there. Yet it can't be. I'm here. What has happened? Am I crazy? No, I must be dead. But I don't feel dead at all, I'm perfectly alive. How very odd...

And then perhaps you may see the doctor or nurse covering your discarded body while members of your family stand by weeping. But you don't see why they should weep. You know that nothing serious has happened to you and then, you may try to comfort them, but they don't pay any attention nor seem to see nor hear you. This makes you feel sad because you want to tell them that you are all-right and not lost forever.

You are still your old-self and, with the sole exception of having a new body, you have not changed a bit as far as you can tell. You may be confused, but you still have the same thoughts, feelings, emotions, desires likes and dislikes as you had before.

Death does not suddenly transform you or anyone into an angel or demon, nor does death give you immediate wisdom. It only gives you a different body and new surround-

watched the astral body emerge from the top of the dying person's head, (3) grow in size and form, until in a few moments it became a perfect spirit-body hovering over the prostrate and abandoned physical corpse.

For a time, the Silver Cord was still connected with the human body. Then, this has snapped and the incorporeal entity became entirely free. (4) In a number of cases, this astral figure has floated out of the window in the company of another spirit entity who is probably a member of the family who has already passed away, but who has returned to the earth plane to welcome the newly departed. Other people not blessed with clairvoyance have frequently noted that dying persons appear quite happy as the end draws near. Sometimes the dying person will sit up in bed smiling, attempting to speak to someone, although no earthly person is at hand.

There are innumerable other accounts of dying people calling out the name of some loved one who has already

2- The chemical elements keeping the physical body in position are deprived of the vital principle --the etheric. Thus decaying takes place.


3- That is to say: from the fontanel; the superior psychic center called "chakra" in Sanskrit (SAHASRARA).




# ANTI GRAVITATION:

pass key

to galaxies

DR. PAGES'S RESEARCHES led him to put in doubt the absolute constant of the speed of light that relativists had established. According to him, and taken into account that the photon is a particle accompanied by a wave, the speed of that wave should be null and void at the extremity of our galactic gravitational field where complete emptiness reigns.

Therefore, if we respect the key formula of undulation mechanics,  $C_2$  would equal  $C'$   $C''$  :

$C_2$  = the speed of light

$C'$  = the speed of the associated wave

$C''$  = the speed of the photon

The speed of the wave being null at the extremity of our gravitanic solar atmosphere (of which its diameter is 100 billion kilometers), that of the particle could be accelerated to a practically infinite speed. If this hypothesis were confirmed, there would be no limit to the speeds of a particle and, therefore, neither to the speeds of a rocket.

The light-year thus having lost its significance, Man could easily explore other galactic systems within the cosmos: The closest star (Wolf 369) would be Earth's neighbor instead of finding itself 20 000 light-years away to the classical rockets that (creep) in space at 50 kilometers per second.

Utopia? Germans, Russians and Americans have been secretly working on the problem for 15 years!

The veil was uplifted by the "New York Herald Tribune" when, on December 1955, an

article revealed that... "In many American laboratories and scientific research centers the first stages of an almost incredible program destined to pierce the secret of weight and universal gravitation have actually been surpassed."

Some months later, the vice - president of the Glen L. Martin Co., Mr. Georges S. Timble confirmed...

"I think we can realize gravitational propulsion, if a sufficient number of scientific brains simultaneously worked and pondered on the problem, in the same length of time it took to fabricate the atomic bomb."

On the other side of the globe, on July 19-60, Russian scientists held a conference at the military center of Dubua that was directed by Bruno Pontecorvo. The discussion that lasted many days was consecrated to the study of the antigravitation problem.

Two months prior to this conference Professor Kasitza and six of his technicians died in an explosion that destroyed one of the Russian research labs studying degravitation and the Absolute Zero.

Professor Alexander Mihlailof, from the observatory of Pulkovo, presented a report on the scientific experiments already realized in the USSR (as well as in other countries), and on the study of light deflexion by the solar field.

From his part, Professor Michail Potgo-

resky exposed works undertaken by his group for the experimental measures of antigravitational forces.

All these theoreticians thought that anti-gravitation COULD BE a property of antimatter...

Contrary to the attraction that governs our universe, antimatter would exercise a repulsion...The Russian technicians estimated that this antigravity would open fantastic perspectives "that perhaps would not be limited even by the speed of light".

They thus landed on the precise conclusion that Dr. Pagés had maintained all along and, as a result, he was fervently sought for the assurance of his assistance in the circumstances that we shall later relate.

In 1968, a NASA spokesman, reconsidering the question, confirmed...

...The rocket is actually the only way to propel astronauts. In the near future the antigravitation theory that appears like the only technique capable of assuring optimal conditions for interplanetary voyages, will have been developed...

Succinctly resumed in the last two articles, Dr. Pagés's plans have been letters patent on January 5th., 1960, under the number 814.855, entitled: ROCKET FOR COSMIC FLIGHTS.

Because of lack of financial support, Dr. Pagés could not progress further into this field --doubly so...as he collided into the hands of a veritable conspiracy by the "mandarins of science". Nevertheless Dr Pagés's discoveries refute the numerous essential arguments brought out by those who deny the existence of flying saucers as being of extraterrestrial origin .

HYPNOSIS by Susan FURCELL (abridged)

A 25 year old woman relived her fifth birthday party with the help of hypnosis.

A class of about 60 students at McGill University in Montreal watched the years roll back to the day Sabina Wengier squandered her birthday dollar in a bubble-gum

machine without getting a single lucky charm.

Ten minutes later she was back in the present with no recollection of her experience, and students were firing questions at her hypnotist.

The trip to childhood and back took only an hour, long enough to uncover forgotten incidents, buried sadness and even a language the woman can no longer speak.

Looking into her eyes, the hypnotist guided his subject into a trance by talk, quietly with her for a moment, then mentioning she would be going into a low, deep sleep, then asking her to count backwards from 100.

By the time she reached 80 Sabina was asleep, oblivious to all but the voice of her hypnotist, Mr. Spivak.

Mr. Spivak says he uses hypnosis in private practices. He stresses that hypnosis is "not a cure" but an aid in probing the subconscious.

The woman said she had been hypnotized three or four times before by Mr. Spivak , whom she described as a personal friend.

As he led her from birthday to birthday to early childhood, Mr. Spivak's knowledge of Yiddish came in handy. By age seven her voice became slightly accented and at six, she responded in Yiddish. Later she spoke Polish, a language she has since forgotten

Reliving her 10th birthday, the woman spoke with triumph of her gift --a brown leather school bag "with a lock and key ." -- "I can open and close it whenever I want", she said emphatically.

At each stage of regression the woman was asked to write her name on the blackboard. At age ten she hesitated for a long time and finally got over some mental hurdle by drawing three horizontal lines and carefully forming her signature within them.

Her only real resistance emerged when Mr. Spivak tried to project her 25 years into the future to the age of 50. His idea was to root out some of the imagined fears in a person's concept of later life.

"No. No. I'm 25," she repeated stubbornly.

"Why do you not want to be fifty?"

"Old," she said dreamily. "I'm 25."

Spivak said very few of his patients showed continued resistance to hypnosis, though the trance is "not necessarily very deep."

A piece of fenced-in land just outside of La Tuque with a designator reading: "Rene -PRIVATE PROPERTY", contains a most interesting mystery...

This property some years back belonged to the Canadian National Railways who functioned a rural train station for the services to the people of La Tuque and the neighboring environs. Today this piece of terrain is under the ownership of a private fishing club.

On the 30th. of May, 1971, a middle-aged resident of one of the old dilapidated cabins happened to find himself walking towards the nearby lake for some fresh mountain air. Without realizing what was taking place, he watched a huge metallic glowing "thing" hover, and land near the rusted railway tracks just yards away from behind his cabin.

Amazed and filled with curiosity, the man approached the "thing" to from ten feet of distance. He was marvelling at it when, unexpectedly, a project-like ray shot out from the huge monstrosity and hit him. He collapsed to the ground and soon thereafter lost consciousness.


This is the way the story was recounted to me by our La Tuque investigators. The story continues: When awareness retrieved the man, the "thing" was gone. The subject immediately ran to phone a friend who lived in town, and narrated the whole frightening occurrence. Later, the friend called the Quebec Provincial Police (QPP) and they, in turn, notified the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP).

I asked for the complete written report from our La Tuque investigators. The report I received continues from where the story left off: The report affirmed that the RCMP immediatly arrived on the scene and executed minute analyses on the location where the object was seen to land, and thoroughly interrogated the sole witness. The report was accompanied by a rather mysterious thought that read: "...evidently the RCMP erraced all traces of the landing."


When I arrived in La Tuque to make my personal inquiry of this case, amongst other weird cases, sure enough, after overcoming the difficulties presented me for the permission to enter that private property, the terrain where the "thing" purportedly landed, for some obscure reason had been appended; the grass within the landing location was burned, and the leaves of a nearby tree seemed scorched beyond rehabilitation.

A conundrum arose: Who upset the soil, burned the grass, and scorched the leaves? --Why, of course, the RCMP investigators!, came the acute answer. But how does one explain the scorched leaves some 10 feet high of that tree? and how does one explain the many strange, symmetrical imprints found precisely on the landing location?

Although prudence prevents us from jumping to any conclusions, the essential evidence giving significance and providing speculative validity to the report cannot be refuted:



Finds revealed twelve square imprints in pairs of three, suggesting, perhaps, that the "thing" has four appendages, each of tripod configuration. The impressions are an estimated two inches deep within the ground, again suggesting either the ground was moist or humid at the time of the landing, or the "thing" is of a ponderous weight (--the ground is made up of loose rocks and some dirt debris.). The sets of three imprints are wide-



ly spread forming a symmetrical square as depicted in the illustration.

After investigation procedures terminated, we contacted the sole witness who would not, under any circumstances, say much more than: "I don't stumble for the mere foolishness of the act you know!" ...

Reliable sources (names have been asked to be withdrawn)-- informed us that after official authorities completed their questioning

of the testimner, "they prescribed a shut-up sentence" to the man.

#### CONCLUSION

 If we ascertain that what the "thing" our silenced observer was struck down with was not a giant grasshopper who felt like spitting his mouth full of grass onto the onlookers face, as perhaps some would want us to credulously believe, we've good reasons and firm grounds supporting our discontention. Moreover, if the interpretation of the evidence be accepted as concrete and conclusive, we may have another Betty and Barney Hills case on our hands.

MOSCOW... -- On July 22nd, 1972, the Soviet Union announced that its latest unmanned 2 600 pound Venus 8 spacecraft had made a soft landing on the planet's surface, which has been revealed as a searing, hot world, with a deep atmosphere composed mainly of carbon dioxide, and a dense cloud layer of unknown extent and composition.

The Soviet press agency, Tass, announced that Venus 8, covering a distance of about 200 million miles in 111 days since its launching on March 27th., radioed data back to earth for a period of 50 minutes on the chemical composition of Venusian rocks. This is the first time that information of this nature has been returned to earth from the surface of another planet.

The Soviet Union's Venus exploration program began in February, 1961, with the launching of Venus 1, which failed when communications ceased at a distance of about 4.5 million miles from earth.

The United States has attempted only fly-by missions by Mariner. Another fly-by is scheduled for 1973.

...NASA OFFICIALS HAVE revealed that last July the three Apollo 15 astronauts carried 400 white envelopes with them to the Sea of Rains.

The envelopes returned with the successful trio and more than 100 of them have since turned up, appropriately cancelled, in the hands of collectors. They had been sold, with the astronauts co-operation, for some \$1.500 each.

The astronauts, says NASA, were interested in setting up a trust fund for their children...

...THE RULER OF the Himalayan kingdom of Bhutan, King Jigme Dorji Wangchuk, who tried to bring one of the world's most inaccessible territories into the 20th century died in Nairobi, India, on Friday, July the twenty first, 1972.

Many Bhutanese wanted to keep the 18 000 square - mile Buddhist state the way it was --without roads, cars, radios or factories. But the king believed in liberating his 800, 000 subjects from their feudal past...

CAMPBELL'S BAY, QUEBEC -- Mrs Donna Mercer declared on Wednesday, July 19th., 1972, that she observed, on four successive nights, a mysterious light in the sky at about one a.m..

On Monday the 17th., she said she watched the first appearance. Disbelieving her eyes, she called her children out to watch the object. Later she phoned the police whereupon three men in uniform arrived.

News of the incident spread and each evening about 30 people would gather on Mrs. Mercer's property, gazing at the orange luminosity.

The Campbell's Bay school principal, Mr. M. John Lunan, said that the object was red on top and that the object displaced itself too quickly to have been a satellite.

For many years many reports of strange brightly lu-

minated objects in the skies have been emanating from Campbell's Bay (50 m. N-W of Ottawa), Chapleau, Westneath and Petawawa, all neighboring vicinities.

In Chapleau and Westneath, circular scorched areas have been found on the ground immediately following the observation of an unidentified flying object.

LONDON, ENGLAND --After plagued by mysterious and obscene telephone calls, clairvoyant Madam Jaye told the police, "I have no idea where they are coming from."

NEW YORK, N.Y. --The apple on the tree may fall because of gravity, as Sir Isaac Newton noted, but just because it happens here on earth doesn't mean such physical science constants of here and now are also valid in other regions of space and time. At least that is the thought of some physicists as the result of recent astronomical observations.

For instance, these observations have brought into question the reliability of the yardstick used in estimating distances to faraway galaxies. They have revealed objects that seem to be moving faster than light, contrary to assumed physical law. And they seemingly have shown objects whose energy output defies explanation.

servations is a theory that atoms were lighter and gravity stronger millions of years ago, when the observed events occurred. They are so distant that it has taken that long for their light to reach the earth. A more radical suggestion is that matter is entering this universe from other universes carrying with it the physical "constants" characteristic of those universes. Among such "constants" would be gravity.

According to science writer Walter Sullivan of the New York Times, the reaction of many astro-physicists to such speculation is that there is no real evidence that other universes exist. They prefer to seek explanations in accepted laws of physics. But, as one of them recently put it, "rarely in history have theorists questioned so fundamentally the precepts of their time."

REUTER --SYDNEY ...Most people dream for a bout an hour and a half almost every night of their lives.

The chances of remembering these dreams are remote unless the sleeper is awakened within a few minutes of the dream ending, or perhaps in the middle of it.

There is also a biological clock inside most people which tells them when they have had enough sleep and should awake.

"Sleep expert" Dr. Murray Johns, a research fellow in the sleep laboratory at Melbourne's Monash University has been looking into these phenomena in an attempt to unravel the mystery of sleep, which has fascinated the world for centuries.

Johns believes there are basically two different types of sleep --dreaming sleep or non-dreaming sleep.

Findings show that the quality of sleep decreases progressively from childhood to adulthood and then to old age.

"It seems that quality of sleep rather than the number of hours we sleep each night is the determinant of how we feel the next day," Dr. Johns says.

He says older people generally go to bed earlier than youngsters but because they wake up more during the night their overall duration of sleep is about the same as the young people.

Johns believes the average duration of sleep is about seven and a half hours per night or about 50 hours per week. But there are wide variations --some normal people only get three or four hours sleep a night,



he said.

He said scientific researchers were unable to say at this stage that a person of a certain age should get 8 hours of sleep or 7.2 hours sleep a night.
