

COMMENT and a REPORT

Sir,

I greatly enjoyed the presentation of your last issue (Vol. 1, No. 6). Could you let me know the source from where you gathered information for the first column of "Cosmos In Brief"?

I've just received the October, 1972 issue of "SKY & TELESCOPE" wherein the report of a "fireball", observed on Thursday, August 10th, appeared. Following is the essential data from that report:

"On the early afternoon of Aug. 10th, 1972, an extremely bright fireball was seen in full daylight in the western United States and Canada. It travelled northward from Utah to Alberta along a nearly horizontal trajectory, leaving a train that remained visible for well over an hour. This splendid object was widely seen and photographed ..."

According to an American UFO review, **SKYLOCK**, on page 15, Sept. 1972, #58 issue, in the United States "there really is a UFO 'flap'." The editor, Mrs. Norma Short, adds "—we've never received as many reports in one month before-- and they are still coming in."

That is in the United States, of course. And right here in Canada, Mr. Henri Bordeleau, an authoritative UFO investigator in Quebec province, and author of 3 best sellers on the topic, about a month ago, over a telephone conversation expressed his view of the approaching UFO "flap" soon to blanket this part of Canada. And, evidently, he was quite right....

WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 6th, 1972

A boy and his sister of the ages 15 and 16, respectively, reported the following UFO observations over Jonquiere:

Their first observation took place at about 10 p.m. E.S.T. The principle eye-witness, Ben V., finds engrossing interest in Astronomy and Aeronautics. He reports seeing a large red light that "appeared 20 degrees from the zenith," travelling towards the north-east. Writing down his observation, he affirmed:

"Thanks to a pair of binoculars I could watch the object properly; there was a bright red light on its center. It was constant and very clear, being more pinkish on the navel than red.

"I could make out the form of the object as it passed in front of some clouds which were illuminated by the reflection of the city lights. The UFO seemed to oscillate very slowly on the axis formed by its red central light. (see illustration #1.)



"I could also hear a slight hiss or whistling as it passed over my house... As soon as the object arrived near the horizon, it made a circular 90° turn and sped away toward the south-east."

This observation, said Ben V., lasted for about 2 min., 30 seconds. He also said that his mother and older sister saw the same object. The second observation took place at 11:35 p.m., that same evening:

"My mother saw a red light moving eastward and she pointed it out to my sister and I. We hurried outside, carrying with us a telescope and binoculars. This time we not only saw one red light, but also a green light and another white one.

"We could clearly distinguish these three lights on the body of the object. A third UFO appeared at this same moment, having characteristics similar to that object with three lights, except that the red light on this second object dominated over its green and white lights... They both zigzagged while barrel-rolling around each other.

"For about one minute the two objects disappeared from our field of vision, obstructed by a nearby house. Only one object reappeared on the other side of the house. It

continued acrobatic maneuvers for some minutes and then it started to slowly move toward the east, vanishing behind clouds."

This observation lasted for about 10 minutes, said Ben V. He had the excellent idea of phoning the editors at the office and asking them to step outside to watch the objects. Someone quickly emerged out of doors and reports watching two objects that slowly approached each other and "integrated into one".

Perhaps this could explain why our young witness noticed only one object emerge from behind the right side of the house after two objects had disappeared behind the left side of that house?

Finally, at about 12:30 that same evening, the young man, who remained out of doors scanning the skies with his telescope, made a third observation; He saw an object having "similar characteristics" as the 11:35 UFO. This last phenomena was telescopically observed "for more than half-hour".

FRIDAY, AUGUST 18th, 1972

A PERSONAL OBSERVATION

At about 9 p.m., I arrived home from the office and decidedly sat in the kitchen with a coffee and cigarette, reading newspaper clippings that have been accumulating of late.

The wife was outside, sitting on the porch-sofa, absorbing the last days of warm weather. She called me out: "Patrick, what would you say if I told you I see an airplane?"

Naturally I couldn't say much. "There, just above the reservoir," she said.

Well... It didn't look like an airplane; it was silent, first of all, and moved much too slow to be one, I thought.

It had the appearance of a bright-reddish ball of fire, approaching the distant horizon. Here I decided to check my subjectivity and phoned some people who are not ashamed of admitting skepticis.

Results: We all saw the object, (Including the editors of this magazine)... But was it an airplane?

In these remote northern regions of Quebec there are the Bagotville Airforce Base and, likewise in Bagotville, Quebecair Airlines.

The Base must surely experiment with balloons and probably does send all sorts of weird objects --including pilots!-- out to

the skies. I've noted, in bright daylight of course, helicopters and military jet-fliers zooming through these northern skies I've noticed light sports-planes and falling stars, meteors (or what I thought were meteors), and unidentified aerial objects on bright, clear nights.

Then there are commercial airliners of all sizes and sorts coming in for landings or plainly cruising the skies of these regions. But when I see an airplane, I know what I am seeing. When I see a helicopter, I know what I am seeing. When Mr. Jules Gobeil saw a hovering large, red object more than "100 feet long" on the vicinity of his farm-yard grounds in January, 1972, everybody thought he was hallucinating.

He was interviewed by Radio-Canada and, while the interviewer smirked and laughed through his teeth, Mr. and Mrs. Magella Soucy of Bagotville confirmed their observation of a similar phenomena around the same hour, (6:15 A.M.), on the same day, on their farm property!

But let us go on with our report...

AUGUST 20th, 3:30 A.M., 1972

A housewife residing in the town of Lac Bouchette, (a locality within the Lac St. Jean region), was awakened by the noise of an automobile approaching her residence.

When she got to the window and looked out, she noticed a brilliantly white, luminous object that appeared "circular-shaped, about as big as a car's head-light."

The object remained immobile for about half an hour when, suddenly, it started to "slowly move away" from her house and finally it "disappeared in the night".

AUGUST 21rst, 1972

Mr. and Mrs. A., of Jonquiere, were driving from the town of Alma towards their home town at about 2:30 a.m. A second automobile, driven by Mr. B., followed close behind them.

When Mr. A. noticed a "large luminous object in the sky that seemed to be moving," he stopped his car on the side of the road and the couple watched the brilliant phenomena. Mr. B. followed their example and, for about one minute, the three eye-witnesses stood awed, watching this large, "luminous flying object."

Suddenly the object seemed to turn off its lights; "It diminished into nothingness and disappeared from our sight!" reported

Mr. B. (The eyewitnesses asked anonymity.)

SEPTEMBER 2nd, 1972

Father Bernier, (a Dominican), who presently resides in the city of Quebec, some years ago reported having successfully utilized his invention called "AFFA Radio Signals" to establish radio contact with occupants of the "flying saucer".

Three youngsters from the town of Jonquiere, (two boys and a girl), were equally successful with Father Bernier's "Radio Signals" :

At about 9:30 p.m., the two boys, each carrying a pair of binoculars and a Walkie Talkie, decided to perch themselves upon a local hill, situated near their homes, to spy the clear evening skies and see if any UFO could be seen. The young lady remained at home, with a Walkie Talkie, prepared to establish "communications" with any aerial phenomena the boys may report through the miniature radio transmitter and receiver.

To the northeast, at about 25 to 30 degrees above the horizon, the boys watched an orange glow of light that appeared suspicious. With their binoculars, the two boys could see blue and white streaks of light emanating from the orange glow.

They reported that what attracted their attention in particular, was the light emanations from its body, and the symmetrical vertical and horizontal maneuvers it executed while remaining practically on the same spot.

Meanwhile, the young lady who remained at home played about with her Walkie Talkie, sending "morse-codes and AFFA Radio Signals" that were directed toward the object the boys notified her of.

After many transmissions with no replys, she finally started receiving weird noises through the radio. But she couldn't understand, let alone decipher, the incomprehensible dots and dashes flooding her channel.

Being a wise owl, she jotted down as much as she could on paper. Later, when the boys got back from their scientific excursion, the three worked together and tried to decode those strange looking marks the young lady jotted down.

Success wasn't easy, but the three youths did succeed, although the final product of their received message is questionable. The legible decoded message read:

"UNDERSTOOD.... REAL.... WAIT...."

The Walkie Talkie used had an 8-mile, ground-to-air range, with a 27.125 frequency. The channel the message(s) were received through was #4.

The case is being further investigated and if you don't hear anything more on this report, I suggest you don't jump to any conclusions (!)

SEPTEMBER 5th, 1972

On their way back from Quebec City, (some 150 miles from Jonquiere), five witnesses noticed an "unusual" bright luminosity stationed in the sky. The witnesses first saw the object while the car they were in was within the Laurentian Park's boundaries, on route #54 north.

They report that "the bright light diminished in intensity to the point of invisibility" but, seconds later, "it would brighten up again". The object "seemed to follow us," said one of the witnesses.

The phenomena was observed for some 45 minutes, "all the way from the park to Jonquiere," a distance of some 30 to 35 miles.

One of the witnesses said that when he arrived home, "the object could still be seen moving about in the sky." But on the morning evening, the object "had disappeared".

And here is my final report for this month. It comes from The Montreal Star:

SYDNEY, AUSTRALIA (Reuter) --More than 300 flying saucer spotters --many of them in pyjamas and dressing gowns-- turned out at dawn today (9-14-72) to watch a mysterious shimmering spot in the sky.

The spot appears precisely at 10 minutes past 7 each morning, above the small town of Taree, 200 miles northwest of Sydney.

The object is described as red on the bottom and white on top. The "cigar-shaped" object is being called an UFO because of lack of any official explanation.

A Bank accountant thinks the object is "a spaceship", while the Australian air force does not think it is a weather balloon or satellite.

Dr. Harley Wood, an Australian government astronomer, said he can't explain the mystery: "If the object keeps appearing and no explanation for it is forthcoming, I will investigate it fully," he said.

I remember way back when Cosmos-Express was only a mental image of future things to come. At that time I was dreadfully apprehensive about "humanoids". I, as anyone else, seeked to know more about the subject that intrigued the imagination. But, of course, being a novice, I didn't realize what I was plunging into.

I started reading "Incident At Exeter", "The Interrupted Journey", "Flying Saucer Occupants" by Lorenzen, and other titles. I could hardly sleep nights, constantly looking over my shoulder, waiting for that moment when the ugly little extraterrestrial creature, standing outside my bedroom door, would attack and scare me to hell! Every shadow cast on those four walls curiously resembled those "bipedal creatures" the Lorenzens wrote about in their above mentioned book. In effect, over a one month period

I must have lost at least 15 pounds and many hours of sleep.

Finally Cosmos-Express was born, and with it followed many realizations: The first realization was that there actually was naught to worry about. No "extraterrestrial beast" was going to eat me up, those were inventions by the authors of such books as "Flying Saucers On The Attack", (Harold T. Wilkins). Mr. Wilkins, being an expert writer, started the preface to his book with the title: "A Foreword and a Warning"!

The following UFO cases were reported to the Citizens of Cosmos's UFO Investigation Committee in 1971. Mr. Roger Hamelin, Mrs. Pierrette Grenon, and many other individuals from the town of La Tuque, in Quebec province, took pains to investigate and, in many cases, thoroughly interview the eyewitnesses of local phenomena.

The reports were sent in, in form of question sheets based on NICAP's official questionnaire, to the central Investigation Bureau here in Jonquiere where Mr. Gilles Perron, an electronics technician, acted as director at that time.

The reports here presented are an integral part of the 1971 "flap" over this province, majorly covering the La Tuque region. In the case where the UFO observation took place outside La Tuque, the locality appears next to the date.

1971

MARCH 18th+

It was 11 p.m. when a young 18-year old girl residing in La Tuque happened to look out her bedroom window at the bright evening stars. She could slightly make out the strange glow of moving light about one mile away, in the sky. As it approached nearer, she noticed its "oval-shape," and its "solid appearance."

The noiseless object had a "blurred contour" but, added the young lady, It seemed "self-luminous," with a "yellowish-gold" aura about its periphery, and a dark hue around its center area.

When she noticed the "little dome" on its topside, she jumped off her bed and ran to procure her binoculars. But as she got back to the opened window, the object had disappeared.

She added that "four years ago" she observed a similar phenomena but never paid any attention to it.

MAY 2nd+

Madame Deslisle Floriane is a healthy, charming woman of the ripe age of 64- years who frequently sees strange phenomena in those La Tuque skies.

When she first heard of the UFO Investigation Committee in La Tuque, she did not hesitate to phone Mr. Hamelin to report her observation of a strange aerial phenomena.


Madame Deslisle said that on the above date she saw an oval, "egg-shaped", luminous object at about 4:00 p.m.

She said the object appeared to be "transparent, with a fuzzy contour and it oscillated at times."

Knowing the practical means of dimensional calculations, she held a match-stick at

arms-length and estimated the objects' size was as "big as the head of a match-stick."

The sky was clear with many bright stars and a brilliant moon. Following is a diagram of the object's maneuvers before it sped away and disappeared from Madam Deslisle's sight. (ILLUSTRATION #2)



MAY 7th+

Hélène Leonard, a young 17 year old girl, was watching the sky at 11:30 p.m. Suddenly she noticed a "self-luminated star" moving from the west to west-north-west.

The object appeared "solid and clearly visible" to Miss Leonard. She later noticed that the object was round in form, with white, blue and red lights fluctuating around its circumference.

MAY 22nd+

An object shaped, and looking like a "ball of fire," being "yellowish-gold" in colour, was seen by witnesses of La Tuque at 11 p.m. "It seemed to come from the south and travelled westward in a curb, as if it was going to land behind the mountain situated just below it".

MAY 30th+

An interesting case was that reported by Patrick Caldwell in Vol. 1, No. 5, Aug., 1972. According to that report, a middle-aged caretaker was struck down by a flash of lightning emanating from a landed object which left its imprints on the soil. The incident occurred in mid-afternoon.

On that same date, May 30th, at about 11 p.m., a silver-grey, oval-shaped object was

seen by many citizens of La Tuque.

The unidentified aerial object had a dark "pipe-like protrusion (see illustration #3) on its undersides" and silently flew westward where it descended behind mountains. Nothing of the object was seen again that night.

JUNE 12th+

Eight people reunited on a second-store y balcony watched a luminous, cigar-shaped object stationary in the clear evening skies of La Tuque.

The phenomena was "distinctly noticeable because of its size" in contrast to the visible stars in the background. Witnesses said the cigar-shaped object remained "visually conspicuous from about 8 p.m. until 11 p.m.," whence obscured by clouds rising from the east

The proprietor of the residence said he "kept" his "eye" on those "strange lights" that circulated about the object's "middle", with a "telescope".

He noticed that the "thing" displayed "red, green and yellow lights: green on its far left, yellow on the far right, and the red travelling around its circumference" (see illustration #4 on the next page).

At about 10:30 p.m., the proprietor of the residence saw, through his telescope, two "tiny balls resembling street lights". He said that the "tiny" objects appeared from behind local clouds and slowly made their way "into" (or behind?) the principle cigar-shaped object from the "bottom-right corner".

Minutes later three similar "balls" exited from the "bottom-left-corner" and disappeared amidst the approaching clouds.

The proprietor later asked his guests if they had discerned any strange and unusual peculiarities about that object. No unusualness was noted except "the fluctuating red lights" that were visible to the naked eye.

The principle phenomena remained visible for some three weeks thereafter.

JUNE 13th+

Two youngsters of La Tuque saw a scintillating yellow-gold star at about 10:45 p.m. that aviated very quickly from the southwest, disappearing behind mountains in the southeast.

JUNE 16th+ JONQUIERE

Mr. Pierre Larouche of Jonquiere, P. Q. ,

reported his observation of an "elliptical" phenomena enswathed in a blinding glow of white light flying at a "very low altitude"

He said he saw the object at around 9:15 p.m.

JUNE 22nd+

In the time span of two and a-half hours (11 p.m. to 1:30 a.m.), 7 strange objects were observed over La Tuque skies by three boys:

The 1st object appeared in the south, travelling "fast", in a "broken line" to the north-east where it vanished from view. The boys thought it was a "satellite" because "it flew over clouds".

The 2nd object first appeared in the N-E. and disappeared in the S-E. This second globe of "brilliant light separated itself in two", after which it "accelerated and instantly disappeared from view."

The 3rd object made a "rapid acceleration accompanied by an augmentation of its brilliance in proportion to its acceleration." The object then stopped abruptly for a few seconds and flew back toward the south from where it first appeared. The object then made a U-turn toward the N-W. It then repeated its maneuvers twice before disappearing from view.

The 4th object, appearing from the N-E, executed a flight in curb configuration, heading towards the S-E. This object is reported to have crossed a B-52 airplane approaching at a low altitude from the south.

The 5th object executed similar maneuvers as the 4th object except that it appeared in the S/S-W and vanished to the N-N-W. This object also crossed a B-52 approaching from the N/NE.

The 6th object is reported to have the appearance of a "flying saucer", (disk-shaped, with a dome on top). The boys said this object was first visible just above the N/N-E horizon when it suddenly accelerated its speed and vanished in the S-West.

The 7th object is likewise reported to look like a "flying saucer". This object travelled in a curbed flight at a rapid speed. It appeared on the S/S-E and disappeared to the E-N-E.

On the night of the above observations, visibility is reported to have been "excellent with scattered clouds dotting the sky"

The temperature was at 60° F.

JUNE 24th+

Four saucer-shaped objects were

seen on this date by many La Tuque citizens

It was reported that from 8 a.m. until 2:35 p.m., these four "flying saucers" frequently made their appearance.

The objects were an estimated "50-foot diameter". In all four cases the objects either "dipped behind local mountains", or "instantly vanished" from view.

JUNE 25th+

Another 5 objects were simultaneously seen and reported by Mr. Jacques Frigon and friends of La Tuque.

The brightly illuminated phenomena were observed between midnight and 1 a.m.

JUNE 30th+

Between 6:30 and 7 p.m., the whole baseball team of youngsters of La Tuque observed an "oval-shaped flying saucer" estimated to be some 100-feet in diameter, with a "blurred contour".

The object had a "brilliant white center and a very bright aluminium" tainted nose. It approached from the east and headed towards the opposite direction.

"When the object arrived immediately above the team of youngsters, it was at some 100-feet of altitude," reports an eye-witness. The object is noted as leaving "blue and red streaks of light behind" on its trail.




JULY 24th+

A "flying saucer" -type object was observed by residents of La Tuque at 3 in the afternoon. The object appeared seemingly from "nowhere" and disappeared to "nowhere" said a witness.



Two "tiny glowing objects" entered the huge cigar-shaped illumination from its right bottom-side and a few minutes later, three of these tiny objects exited from its left bottom-side.

It emitted an "ultra-sonic" sound and left fiery streaks in the atmosphere.

JULY 26th+

Mr. Savard Laurentian of 538 Bostonnais, in La Tuque, reports his observation of a "flying saucer with a dome on top".

The solid object "with a vague contour" was first seen above the southern horizon where it remained stationary from 5 to 6 minutes, after which it changed colours, topsided, and sped away at a "rapid velocity toward the southeast".

Mr. Laurentian said the object looked "red and bluish when immobile" but, as it accelerated, it changed to "blue and chrom like on the nose," leaving fire-red sparks on its trail.

OCTOBER 21rst+ LAURENTIAN PARK

On a Sunday evening, at about 6:30 p.m. Mr. Charles Cadou, a mutual fund broker and a retired airplane pilot, and his wife were driving to Montreal on route 4 in the Laurentian mountains, near the town of St. Adolphe d'Howard. The weather was clear; "There were no clouds in a perfectly blue sky," remarked Mr. Cadou.

All of a sudden they noticed "an orange incandescent streak vertically descending from the sky."

The couple drove up the road and parked on the hill side where they got out of their car, realizing that a second automobile with a young couple also saw the falling streak of light.

The "round, orange disk" stopped in the sky at about one mile away from the observers, hovering "just a few feet above the trees."

At first Mr. Cadou thought the object was a meteorite or an airplane in distress. But as the object "stopped in mid-air," he changed his mind; "It looked like the setting sun", said Mr. Cadou. "We could see it perfectly; an orange disk on a clear, blue background, as if an orange was placed on a sky-blue piece of fabric."

The young woman from the other car next to Mr. and Mrs. cadou's automobile, said that from the "orange ball protruded a white nozzle." But the others didn't notice such peculiarities.

After some 8 to 10 minutes, the object disappeared, "as if they just shut off the lights!" said Mr. Cadou.

(The Saint Denis Radar Station is situated near the sighting area.)

reproductions. Harold Sherman, in his book "Your Mysterious Powers of ESP", says:



