

NEWSUnborn Baby 'Talks' To Mother

Mrs. Sophie Carmichael of Middlesex, England, knew the sex, coloring and food tastes of her child before he was born.

"From the moment I conceived him, I knew he was a boy," she said. "I can't really explain it. It wasn't as though I could speak to him, but somehow he could send messages to me through my brain, and I received them. The doctors call it mental telepathy."

"He would tell me what kind of food he liked," she said, "and I would eat it just to please him. He even told me the day he would be born, and I was very surprised. It was two weeks before he was expected, and my doctor had no idea that this would happen. However, I knew and was quite prepared."

Sophie Carmichael's son was born two weeks ahead of time, as she said.

"He was a blond, rosy-cheeked little boy," said her husband, Ian, "and looked just as Sophie said he would. He had my nose and eyes and her mouth and chin. It was amazing."

Mrs. Carmichael still has the ability to communicate with her son without words.

"I always give him the food he wants," she said. "When I am out of his room, I can always tell if he is uncomfortable, or needs anything. Three Days of Total Darkness Will Frighten World in 1970

Three days of total darkness will mystify and frighten people all over the world in 1970.

This is the prophecy of a religious mystic, professor and poet with a lifelong gift of extrasensory perception, Dr. Alexander Tanous of East Millinocket, Maine.

Dr. Tanous, who has correctly forecast many world events, was Assistant Professor of Theology at St. Anselm's College in Manchester, N.H., until last summer.

He was "eased out" of that post, Dr. Tanous said, because of his growing prominence in connection with predictions and ESP.

His prediction of three days of darkness was made public in the October 10 issue of The Church World, a New England Church publication to which he has often contributed.

He has published and broadcast a number of predictions that came true. Here are four published in the January 3 issue of The Church World last year:

° Eugene McCarthy will have marital problems.

° Judy Garland will make headline news.

° A great scandal will come out of our American government.

### Spirit Holds Home In Grip of Terror (The Edmonton Journal, Tuesday, Nov. 11, 1969)

GILLINGHAM, England (AP) - A quiet seaside home has become a residence of fear, where a three-year old girl contorts in apparent rage at the sight of a crucifix.

The baby has been taken over by a malignant spirit, says her mother, Christine Adams. A supernatural presence has possessed the girl and the modest, terraced home in this Kent coast town.

The terror began a year ago, said Mrs. Adams, when lights flickered on and off, furniture moved, closed doors opened, ash trays tumbled off tables and warm rooms suddenly became icily cold.

"Most frightening of all, though, was the transformation of Carol," she said. The child began holding conversations with another person, using no words a child her age could know, sometimes answering herself in another adult voice.

"Sometimes we could hear somebody singing -- it sounded like a lullaby -- while she was talking at the same time," the mother said.

She and her husband placed a wooden cross in their living room in an attempt to combat the presence.

"When Carol went near the cross her face contorted," Mrs. Adams, 27, recalled. "She would bunch up her fingers into claws and bare her teeth. It was frightening."

Neighbor Marjorie English told of the day she saw Carol hanging out an upstairs window.

"I rushed next door to tell her mother but she told me it was impossible -- the windows were locked and nailed down. When Mrs. Adams got home he checked and the windows could not be opened."

She added: "I have always laughed at this sort of thing. But I have seen too much."

Mrs. English's son Graham, 17, said he and Mrs. Adams heard noises from Carol's room one night and they both went upstairs to investigate. The child was "stuffed right inside a pillow case".

"We got her out and carried her downstairs but when we went back a few minutes later, we found the cot had been remade and the pillow-case, which had been thrown aside, was back on the pillow."

Said Mrs. Adams: "I am convinced a supernatural presence has taken

over the house and is appearing through Carol."

"We did not see anything but we did sense undesirable influences," said Elizabeth Langridge, a medium, who was summoned to help by Mrs. Adams. "A spirit entity was using this child." (Credit: Gene Duplantier, 17 Shetland St., Willowdale 443, Ontario, Canada)

#### Ten-Year-Old Boy Dying Of Old Age

Ten-year-old Jomar da Silva Henrique is a 60-year-old man who is expected to die in the next five years.

The youngster, who was born in the tiny village of Criador in Brazil in 1959, is physically the same age as he would have been had he been born 50 years ago.

To doctors in his native land and in other parts of the world, his condition is a medical mystery.

Jomar has two sisters, ages five and eight, and both are perfectly normal children. But then he too was normal at the time of his birth.

As the boy's condition worsened, the village doctor sent in reports to the major hospitals in Brazil, seeking help.

Eventually other medical men took an interest in the case but despite all their skills they could find no solution to the problem.

His head became grotesquely oversized and bald, with just a few white hairs which could only be seen in a strong light. He became nervous and timid.

Jomar's whole body began to deteriorate.

Year by year and month by month he became worse, until today he has the wrinkled skin, legs, arms, knees, elbows of a 60-year-old man.

His muscles became flabby. Even the sunlight now bothers him and he seeks dark corners of the house when he wants a place to play. (Credit: Search, address already given).

#### Supernatural Still Puzzling By Eleanor Dunn

"there are more things in heaven and earth, Horatio, than are dreamt of in your philosophy."

Thus spoke Hamlet, referring to his ghostly father, and although some centuries have passed since that was written, there are still some puzzlers.

And in this year of Aquarius, when the supernatural and the occult come to the fore, it isn't strange that Eileen Smith, a British-born television and radio performer, has written a book called "Ghosts I've Known".

Most of Mrs. Sonin's experiences with the occult occurred in England before her move to Canada 12 years ago.

She explains that a newer country has fewer ghosts, although she has been called to Lindsay, Ont. twice -- once to investigate a poltergeist and once to check up on a ghost.

And in case you didn't know, there's a big difference between poltergeists and ghosts.

The former are malevolent, the result of a built-up of resentments and worries, and generally manifest themselves in damaging and annoying ways -- throwing plates and cutlery about rooms, breaking windows and other unexplained nuisances.

They cannot be exorcised by religion, says Mrs. Sonin, and become even more angry if Bibles, crucifixes, priests or ministers are brought into the house.

Ghosts, on the other hand, result from strong emotional ties, but in fact are generally looking for ways to get to their resting place, somewhere in the misty beyond. They can be exorcised through religion,

and generally cause no harm.

Mrs. Sonin says she didn't know she was a natural medium until after she married.

She'd had experiences with ghosts, however, throughout her childhood and her teens, while travelling through England pursuing her theatrical career.

At one time she shared a London apartment with a group of ghostly children, but since she supposed other people had the same experiences, thought nothing of it.

Following her marriage, she and her husband were troubled by the unexplained phenomenon of hearing a man's footsteps on the roof of their house. She assumed that at first it was a burglar, and the police were called in, but a thorough examination turned up no trace of any intruder.

"Although about a hundred people heard these footsteps over a period of time, there just wasn't any explanation for them," Miss Eileen said in an interview at the Chateau Laurier.

Pre-knowledge of disaster helped her save her husband's life during the London blitz, and she had other experiences with precognition, which she relates in some detail in her book.

"After our experience with the ghost on the roof, two people from the Psychical Research Society advised me that I was a natural medium and I should go to the school for mediums in London.

"They thought I should learn to protect myself from evil spirits, because natural mediums are easily influenced by spirits, but I had a pretty full life then so I didn't bother." (Credit: Gene Duplantier, address already given).

### They Die Together

Seventy-two-year-old Fred Rath of Swoa City, Iowa, and his wife Marjorie had made a vow that if one of them died, the other would go also. When Marjorie died recently at the age of 67 from overexertion, Fred promptly followed suit. Within five minutes he was dead too.

Howard Preston, a neighbor who witnessed the eerie deaths, said he had gone over to the Rath's small farm to collect a newborn kitten.

"They had promised to give my little daughter one of the kittens that had just been born to their farm cat.

"When I got there," Preston went on, "Mrs. Rath had rounded up two of the little pets and she was chasing a third around the garden."

Preston was on his way to help her when she suddenly fell down and didn't move.

"She went down just like a ton of bricks, clutching her heart. She must have had a major heart attack or something because when I finally got to her she was dead."

Preston promptly called Mr. Rath who was in the house watching television.

"He came running out to see why I was making such a fuss," Preston said. "When he saw his wife, he asked me if she was dead. When I nodded he replied simply, 'Momma and I always wanted to go together, I'm going too, now,' and fell down beside her, dead."

Dr. Lester Pearson, 32, the coroner who examined the bodies, had no explanation for Fred Rath's death.

"Mrs. Rath had obviously died from a seizure -- overexertion at her age can often cause a fatal heart failure," Dr. Pearson said. "However, the husband's case is less straightforward -- I couldn't find a cause of death."

A man or woman wishing to die just sits down and gives up the ghost for no known medical reason.

In some of the African tribes and among some of the people of the

When Snow is Red, Black, Green, Or...  
(The Spectator, Sat., Nov. 15, 1969)

WASHINGTON -- Some people think the Seven Dwarf's companion could have been named Snow Yellow, or Snow Red. Or maybe Snow Bluish-Green.

Snow -- as scientists and explorers have long known -- comes in several colours. The shade depends on minute algae or dust particles that sometimes mix with flakes or tint already-fallen snow.

The result can be a colorful, though startling, winter scene.

In recent years, brown snow has fallen on Vermont and New Hampshire, pink flakes on the small town of Cuneo, Italy, and bluish-green snow on the rugged logging country of northern California.

Villagers in Russia's Caucasus Mountains are apt to witness all sorts of snowfalls.

In February, 1962, about ten inches of ordinary white snow fell on 25 square miles of the mountain's southern slopes. Then the unexpected came. A scientific report put it this way:

"To the amazement of the population of several villages, snowflakes of a black color began to fall and this continued for a period of three or four hours. On top of the ordinary snow cover there was formed a layer of black-brown snow, two or three inches thick."

The drama continued a few weeks later when a two-day display of precipitation brought a mixture of color to the mountains: yellow rain and rose-yellow snow in the central areas.

Scientists attributed the black snow to a cyclone that carried dust, soot, and sand from nearby factories.

The mixture of colors arrived on jet streams that picked up dust from storms in Tunisia, Libya, Egypt, Syria, Turkey, and Greece. The color of the snow and rain depended on which desert provided the dust.

Microscopic plants, as well as dust, often provide a rainbow of tints on snowflakes.

The winter resort of Alta, Utah, for example, received what was called a "chocolate snowfall" in 1955. Surprised vacationists saw tan and light brown crystals, colored by alkali, cover the mountainside. (Credit: Gene Duplantier, address already given)

Death Foretold Twice In Dreams

"I dreamed David would die a few weeks before it happened," said Mrs. Merle Redman-Thomas.

Her husband, David Redman-Thomas, was killed in a mysterious air crash over Wycombe Air Park, where he was to solo for the first time after a few months of flying lessons.

"I saw the whole thing in a horrible nightmare I had several weeks ago," said Mrs. Redman-Thomas.

"In my dream, I saw David take off in a plane, circle the airfield, and then fall to the ground in flames."

When she awoke in tears, she told her husband of her dream.

"David laughed at me," she said. "He told me I was being silly, and to go back to sleep, but I couldn't get it out of my mind."

A few weeks later, Mr. Redman-Thomas confidently drove his wife and family to the airfield to watch his first solo flight. While awaiting his takeoff, he accepted an offer from a friend to take a quick flip around the field.

"The minute he went up, I had a premonition something was going to

go wrong," said Mrs. Redman-Thomas. "The nightmare came flooding back, and I knew he didn't have a chance."

Seconds later, she watched her husband plummet to his death before her horrified eyes.

"I think David knew it would happen," Mrs. Redman-Thomas said.

"He told me he had also had a dream in which he had fallen from a great height, but he refused to elaborate on it." (Credit: Search, address already given)

### Hamilton Psychics To Get Big ESP Chance

During the Second World War, a mother was making up a food parcel to send to her son who was fighting overseas.

Before she was finished, she turned to her daughters who were helping her and said, "It's no use. He's dead."

A few days later a telegram arrived, informing her that her son had been killed in action on the day and time she 'sensed' it.

That's extrasensory perception.

It is one person becoming tuned in to the thoughts of another that they can communicate emotions by mental telepathy. Some people claim mothers and their children have it, twins have it and most women have it, in fact everyone has it in one degree or another, it just needs developing.

And Dr. Winnifred Barton has come to Hamilton to develop the psychic powers of Hamiltonians. She has a doctorage in metaphysics from Brantwide Forest College in Sussex, England.

The 46-year-old founder and director of the Metaphysical Society of Canada -- an organization which, she stresses, is incorporated by the federal government as a non-profit organization -- starts a 10-week course in ESP at the downtown YMCA at 8 o'clock tonight as an explanatory prologue to the course.

Psychics -- people with advanced ESP -- can help society by foreseeing such tragedies as the assassination of President Kennedy, says Dr. Barton.

She explained: "The Aberfan disaster was sensed long before it happened by a number of people. Now these people could not prevent the event from happening but, if people had listened, they could have prevented it turning into a disaster by evacuating the school on the day it was due to happen.

"The mud would still have collapsed on top of the school but at least there would have been no children inside it."

This is what Dr. Barton means by people with ESP 'tuning in to events and emotions'. Psychics can sense the malice of an assassin, the pent-up emotion of the murderer or the atmosphere of foreshadowing that always exists before a tragedy, because they have developed their sixth sense to a high degree of sensitivity.

Dr. Barton's favorite example of big-time ESP is the man who 'saw' the sinking of the Titanic -- and wrote a book about it.

"Thirteen years before the disaster, American novelist Theodore Dreiser wrote a book called The Titan, about a luxury liner crossing from England to America which struck an iceberg and sank with great loss of life.

"In it there were something like 34 coincidences. He had the tonnage nearly right, the size of the ship, the numbers of dead, just about everything, long before the Titanic actually sank -- now that's more than just one big coincidence.

"If only people would learn," she says, "to take ESP a little more seriously." (Credit: Gene Duplantier, address already given).

Lama Sees Sea Serpent! By Kurt Glensner

Robert Dickhoff, Ph.D., Sungma Tenzing Lama, swears he saw a "great aquatic creature" in the Hudson River on March 18, 1970. The animal sported three black fins and travelled upstream near ebb tide at a fair speed, creating quite a wave pattern. When the thing was out of sight the river became calm again.

This unusual sight lasted for ten minutes. Dr. Dickhoff theorizes the thing was maneuvering in shallow water because it had to swim close to the surface. Exposed was a long, dark-skinned streak of the top of the animal. He feels the creature is a pre-historic sea serpent and came up the river for food. Many of the river boats dump garbage overboard and the creature probably feeds on it, says Dickhoff.

Dr. Dickhoff had seen the same wave pattern this creature created before but he had not seen the animal till March 18th. He estimated the length of the "serpent" to be some 25 to 30 yards.

'Critter' Sighted In Texas

RENO, Tex. (AP) - There must be something about Northeast Texas that brings out the mysterious and weird. Now it is something residents have named "the Critter".

Residents of this area just east of Paris have seen it -- only at night -- and their descriptions are enough to make anyone quake.

Bob Allison, 17, has seen it twice and fired two shotgun blasts in the critter's direction.

Those who have reported seeing it say it stands seven feet tall and has long, white hair over its body.

James Rogers, of Paris, who runs more than 20 head of cattle on a small ranch east of Reno, has had to round them up twice because something stampeded them through the fence.

One of his cows turned up without ears -- both had been literally chewed off -- with large, deep gashes down her back. Only the head of the calf was found. The rest had been devoured.

"A pack of dogs, maybe. Or wolves," Rogers reasons cautiously, "but those slashes down the top of her back?"

His ranch is near where Wildcat Creek joins Cuthand Creek, east of the Allison home where the critter was seen on two successive nights.

Red-Hot Whatsis Suddenly Lands in Woman's Garden

Everything did not turn up roses for a Jefferson County woman who was working in her garden Tuesday morning.

Mrs. Elida Kent, of Highway CC near Festus, told sheriff's deputies that she was working in the garden at 9 a.m. when she heard an explosion, turned around, and saw a "red-hot" cylindrical object about two inches long in the grass.

The object remained hot for 10 or 15 minutes, Mrs. Kent said, and then became heavily charred. She said she neither heard nor saw any airplane

in the vicinity.

The object, which was later taken to the sheriff's office by Deputy Sheriff Arch Mebas, was about one and one fifth inches in diameter, with a little piece chopped off one end and a lead-colored interior.

Sheriff Walter (Buck) Buerger said he would have the cylinder analyzed by the McDonnell Planetarium or by a police agency.

This spacenap of human cattle from planets in our solar system produces an abundance of flesh, so that they may become the principal ingredient in the Garuda stew.

To them we are their prisoners on a corralled planet. To maintain this constant meat supply, costing them nothing, they have introduced a subtle brainwash of this human animal, so that their spacecraft transports remain filled. The Frogmore Light By Thomas R. Grandy

During my stay in Beaufort, South Carolina, I had come across many strange and mysterious tales relating to a town called Frogmore. Frogmore is a small town in South Carolina that consists of a gas station, grocery store and post office. There are approximately twenty families that live in this dark desolate region of this mysterious world. The people of Frogmore are relatively unfriendly people who supposedly practice the art of Voodoo during the witching hour of the darkness. These people live along the Frogmore road. This road has seen more unnatural tragedies throughout the centuries than any other region in our world. The road extends approximately six miles and comes to a dead end at an old fort which was used during the Spanish-American War. At night the road is extremely dark and quiet. Not an insect nor an animal can be heard in the vast forest. The huge trees paw over the road with large amounts of Spanish moss holding on to their limbs. Skylight is almost impossible to see from the interior of the road. Three miles down the road from the town stands the largest tree of them all. The mighty oak tree. This tree has been known throughout the years as "The Hanging Tree". Its name derived many years ago during the colonization of South Carolina. A small tribe of Indians had settled around the oak tree and for some unearthly reason worshiped it. When settlers had entered the region they massacred the tribe and hung the chief from the large oak tree. Ever since then the tree has been known as "The Hangin Tree".

During the Civil War there were seven battles fought in the area of Frogmore. There were never any survivors.

As the years passed by, trivial tragedies had continued to take place. The region was coming more and more to the attention of the public. There was talk of a mysterious light that had been frequently sighted but it had not been investigated.

In January of 1960 a school bus was traveling on Frogmore road. There were twenty-three children on the bus. The bus had crashed into "the hanging tree". The bus driver was found dead but otherwise there was no trace of the twenty-three children. Search parties were sent but only to find nothing, not even a footprint in the soil. What happened to the children? Why was the school bus on Frogmore road? The children lived on the other side of town! This is one of the most amazing mysteries of the century.

Frogmore was at its peak of fame. People were traveling for miles around to Frogmore. More and more reports were flooding police stations of an unidentified light that was seen in the area. I learned later that this was a precaution against evil spirits. I parked the car by the large "hanging tree" and waited to see the light. Suddenly the light appeared a good distance down the road. I started the car and slowly started towards it. It was bright -- brighter than anything I have ever seen. The light had no direct beam, it seemed to shine in all directions. As I was moving closer to it, it seemed to be moving closer to me. It was now fifteen feet in front of me. It was approximately a foot in diameter and stood about five feet off the ground. It was at its peak of brightness when it suddenly shut off. Emptiness filled the space where the light had been. I continued to drive down the road. The light appeared in back of me. It seemed to be escorting me off the road. When I reached the town the light disappeared. I could offer no logical explanation. Some say the light is the old Indian chief looking for his killers. Could this be true?

If you are ever in Frogmore, South Carolina, you can see the light for yourself. You can still see the old school bus, for it still remains embedded in the "hanging tree".

One word to the wise -- do not ever endanger the light for you may be endangering yourself.

Book Review: Uninvited Visitors By John J. Robinson

The reader, I feel sure, is well aware that the serious researcher in the ufological field realizes that science, that is reputable science, cannot accept any of the particular proofs which have been advanced as to the reality of flying saucers or U.F.O.

Reputable science is based on events which can be reproduced at will, measurable constants and logical effects. The phenomena which has been observed in our skies and at times on the ground or near it cannot be reproduced at will, its actions and movements are not measurable by any set of standards while its event and effects do not jibe with any known type of logic, scientific or otherwise. Ergo to the reputable scientist they do not exist. For him to retain his scientific status they cannot exist.

Because of this, many researchers are going further afield in order to seek the answer to the phenomena. These researchers realize that while humankind has accepted the body of scientific knowledge which has been slowly built up by reproducible experiments, the accepted facts of our present scientific knowledge is often looped with inexplicable effects, effects which have not as yet been logically answered. Science does not accept falls of angel hair, blobs of jelly-like substance which soon evaporate or even falls of fish, flesh or stones. But then science did not accept the fact that meteors fall from the sky nor was quantum physics accepted until researchers proved that the Laws of Matrix Mechanics were related to the accepted Newtonian Laws of Mechanics and we then learned to measure nuclear energy.

There is a shadow realm of science from which every once in a while some researcher brings forth another piece or part of the jig-saw of reality. It is within this shadow realm that the flying saucer phenomena dwells and it is within this realm that researchers are delving for the possible answer to the very controversial subject of flying saucers.

I propose to present the reader, first with a review of a book which will take in most of the hypothetical questions and set up a basic outline regarding them, the outline will then act as a basis for more serious thought on the subject, the shadow realm. I will then attempt to review some of the recent publications which deal with this type of research.

Uninvited Visitors

A biologist looks at UFOs by Ivan Sanderson. 244pp \$6.95 published by Cowles Educational Corp., 488 Madison Ave., New York, N.Y. 10022

The author, Ivan Sanderson, is a biologist with not only a degree in biology but also in geology and zoology. He chose to adventure about the world doing active and at times dangerous research and collecting work since this is the type of person he is. The British Navy utilized his talent for being adventuresome during the last war, using him for an intelligence officer. Since he has never been confined to the ivory towers of either academic or laboratory work, he has never been forced to limit his ideas, beliefs or research to the narrow limits which are required and maintained by those whose livelihood depends upon the ideas and beliefs of supervisors and the esteem of fellow colleagues in the same line of work.

I met Mr. Sanderson first many years ago at a meeting of the now-defunct C.S.I. (Civilian Saucer Intelligence), one of the first and finest ufological organizations in the U.S., and while I was only a visitor at the meeting, Mr. Sanderson was to the best of my knowledge a charter member.

Ivan Sanderson's book Uninvited Visitors reflects the fact that his thinking has never been stereotyped or confined, as well as the fact that he knows all the aspects of the ufological field. To my mind, the book will not only help the newcomers to the field to learn all about the various aspects related to it, but also aid any researcher as a gauge or tool in any of his cases.

The book outlines for classifying animate and inanimate UFO events which also lists natural and artificial possibilities. High and low level sightings are described and evaluated, some of which have been the author's own sightings.

A discussion of the possibility that the phenomena might be a type of unknown life form contains all the author's biological information on the subject as well as a very good rendition of the Wassiliko-Seriki theory, that UFOs might be an outer space life form which derives its energy from something like solar rays. The differing types of shapes and substances of UFOs are discussed and the behaviour patterns of the phenomena is divided into five logical classifications with a definite outline for each. Humanoids are discussed and a most enlightening chapter regarding biological construction results. This deals with the theory first postulated by Christian Huygen, the theory which Willie Ley and Sprague DeCamp wrote about. It is also the same theory my wife and I wrote about (See "The Case for Extra-Terrestrial Little Men", Fall, 1966, issue of Saucer News, see also the Award book by Steiger and Whritenour, Flying Saucers are Hostile. The Saucer News article has also been listed in the Air Force Annotated UFO Bibliography).

Since Charles Fort, Morris Jessup and even Carl Sagen have postulated a theory that an extraterrestrial race may have originally planted or seeded the original DNA molecules which resulted in life on this planet this is discussed and this discussion even entertains the idea that the MIB may be agents of some such race.

A complete rewrite of the actual Allende Letters as well as the official introduction to the Varo M.S. (That edition of the Case for UFO which was so mysteriously annotated and sent to the Armed Forces). Since that involved invisibility and transference of mass, Sanderson discusses this with the idea in mind that if a race of space people have accomplished this they have solved the problem of all space travel.

The author then traces some of the early sightings back as far as the Vedic and Mesopotamian periods and even goes further back when he discusses machined articles and other artifacts which have been found imbedded in coal or sandstone which was created in Paleolithic times. The Peri Reis and Portolan maps are discussed next for these would seem to be cartographic aerial surveys made over 5,000 years ago of the exact shoreline of the Antarctic and other shorelines before erosion caused them to appear as they do now.

Mr. Sanderson ends his book with a concept of cosmic evolution which is startling to say the least in its logic as well as to the place that intelligence occupies. An appendix is given with an outline of all hypothetical theories in the book. The UFO buff who neglects this book will lack a complete write-up of all the ideas which have been rampant in the field for all these years.

Fireballs By Kurt Glenser

These strange objects were first reported in December, 1948, over the Southwestern USA. They follow a straight course and explode without sound. Their brilliant green light can be seen for hundreds of miles. Their speeds, according to radar trackings, are up to 14,000 mph. The USAF set up Project Twinkle to study the fireballs.

On November 2, 1951, a bright green object, about the size of a DC-4, left a white trail over Abeline. It traveled at an amazing speed, exploded and shot out red balls of fire.

A fireball at an altitude of 20,000 feet went over Colorado, New Mexico and Texas on September 18, 1954. It interfered with radio and TV and caused the sky to light up as if it were day. The fireball then exploded. The foremost authority on this subject, Dr. La Paz, said, "This was no ordinary meteorite. It was something unusual."

On April 6, 1955, three green fireballs flashed over New Mexico. One exploded near the mountains in a "white flashing light" after dropping from the sky. There was no smoke. Near Hobbs, New Mexico, the 12-inch in diameter fireball plunged into the earth. No fragments could be found. There had been short-wave radio and TV disturbance as the fireballs went overhead. The fireballs were seen hundreds of miles away.

Strange Smell By Kurt Glenser

Fred Reagan, a pilot, flew his Piper Cub at 8,000 feet in July, 1951. He saw an object which appeared like a "dazzling lozenge" come towards him on collision course. Reagan was thrown out of the plane by the resultant crash. He had no parachute and was falling. Suddenly he felt an invisible force halt his fall and then pull him upwards. He then realized he was being pulled towards the craft with which the plane had collided.

He was barely conscious when he got inside the object. The occupants of the craft appeared to him like "huge stalks of metallic asparagus". He lost his senses and when he regained consciousness he could see only a blue light and detected an odour that smelled like ozone or sulphur. A voice told him he was in the hands of people from another planet who accidentally hit the plane. Reagan again lost consciousness. He was found, mysteriously unhurt, beside the wreckage of his plane.

The high point to this story came when Reagan died in a Georgia state insane asylum from degeneration of the brain tissue due to atomic radiation. The authorities could offer no explanation.
