

THE WESTERN KEY By Michael Watson

What seems to have escaped the attention of everyone so far, is that nearly all of the alleged locations of entrances to cavern cities follow a remarkable geometric pattern across the landscape.

Let us begin with a short summary of alleged cavern cities in western North America.

1. In the January, 1967, issue of SEARCH magazine, George Wagner, Jr., mentioned his knowledge of a subterranean city 75 miles northwest of Portland, Oregon. He said that his knowledge of this place came from a Mr. Azerland with whom he had corresponded. The general description ran as follows: The city is said to be eight to ten miles underground, with more than a million inhabitants. It is a coastal city and has a remarkable spaceport.

2. In 1904, J. C. Brown found an artificial tunnel in the Cascades in which the walls were covered with metal shields and carvings, and the floor was strewn with human bones of gigantic proportions.

3. The next claim comes from that place of wonder, Mount Shasta. This peak, long a goal of occultists and mystics, has acquired a reputation of being unusual to say the least. The main force linking it to stories of underground habitation is the widely read book LEMURIA, THE LOST CONTINENT OF THE PACIFIC by Wishar Cerve. Mr. Cerve made use of his place in the Ancient Mystical Order of the Rosy Cross to gather accounts of members of that group who had visited and explored Mount Shasta. He claims that hundreds of people wrote to him with similar tales of tall, majestic people, living on or near the mountain. It seems that these people were never traced to wherever they lived, but were only seen when travelling. One particularly significant account tells of one group sighting a rubble and brush concealed tunnel leading into the mountain. They did not stop to investigate this tunnel, unfortunately.

What with the clear evidence of unusual people in this area and their ability to evade all searchers, it is at least possible and more likely probable, that these people live right under our noses, so to speak, and that the sighted tunnel, which was obviously manmade, may have been a passageway into their abode -- an underground city.

4. In the desert region of California, just north of Bishop, a modest resort town, is the Casa Diablo region, so named for the hot springs and geysers in this area. It seems that several years ago two explorers happened upon a steeply slanting shaft leading beneath the desert floor. It was about nine feet in diameter and sulphurous steam poured from it. As they ventured downward they found that the shaft soon became horizontal. At the end of this tunnel there was a huge stone door. As they looked about they noticed a remarkable facsimile of a human face carved in the solid rock of the tunnel wall.

Before long the tunnel began to fill with water from unseen ducts and strange music was heard. The explorers had to hurry out to escape.

5. In the Panamint mountain range in Death Valley, the Piute Indians say there dwell people who came there a long time ago and built a city beneath the stones and mountains. The idea of the Piutes concerning life after death shows how living with this knowledge of the underworld has affected them. They dream of leaving their harsh lives and venturing through gigantic caverns to an underground paradise. The Piutes claim that the subterraneans are divided into two groups, one kind and the other destructive. The former they call the

Hav-Mu-Suvs and they call the latter the U-Nu-Pits, who kidnap their victims to their caves.

6. In the book LOST MINES AND HIDDEN TREASURE, Leland Lovelace tells us that: "Two prospectors, several years ago discovered a cavern system in southwestern Nevada. In these caves they found gigantic furniture and dishes of gold."


7. White Mountains, Arizona. This is more or less a focal area for Apache traditions that span much of the southwest United States. The Indians tell of a race called the Ga'n who long ago, they say, grew tired of sickness and death on earth and went to live beneath the ground in caves.

These people are prayed to and viewed as gods. The Indians insist that the Ga'n always answer their prayers and once even caused a rock slide which stopped the Spanish troops who were coming to murder the Apache.

8. At Binger, Oklahoma, there is a large mound of earth, not unlike hundreds of similar mounds left behind by a race called the mound-builders who preceded the present Indian groups of America.

This mound is important to hidden city lore because there is a story that in the early part of the century an odd scroll was found on or near the mound telling of the experiences of a 16th century Spaniard who was part of the Coronado expedition into the wilds of then untamed America. It seems that this man became separated from the rest of his group and somehow learned of the subterranean world.

All that is known for certain is that he ventured into the caves

and never came out, although he did manage to have his message, in the form of a scroll, reach the surface. Just what the scroll said is uncertain.

9. Near McAlester, Oklahoma, there is claimed to be a large cavern in which a descending staircase seems to lead downward forever. One group went deep into this cave but when they returned for provisions they were attacked by man-like creatures.

My object in retelling these stories is to point out that each of them falls within a narrow region as illustrated by the accompanying map of the western half of the U.S.A. opposite this page.

Although it is now popular to read and discuss what others have said and done it seems that the only logical and sure way to prove these tales I have mentioned, as well as any others, either true or false, is to go and see for one's self. Those who wonder why the great majority of the public still is unaware of the subterranean world, need look no further for the answer. What people want is proof. While some of us can see the reality of the cavern world from the many tales that are now told, most will insist on proof before they will believe a thing.

So, to make progress in a skeptical world there must be well-documented expeditions. The effort to learn the secrets of the underworld is a search that could be potentially of far greater importance and worth than anything man has attempted before. This actual travelling to, and going into the caves may come as an odd and strangely new idea to some, but it must come if we are to succeed.

CYCLOPS:

Many myths have puzzled man throughout the centuries and none more so than that of the Cyclops, a one-eyed creature of Greek mythology. The philosopher Empedocles thought he recognised the skeleton of Homer's polyphemus in the fossil bones of dwarf elephants that came to light in Sicily.

Giovanni Boccaccio, author of the Decameron, describes similar Sicilian finds in the 14th Century. In the fourth book of his, "Geneology of the Gods", he refers to these "Bones of the Cyclops" and cites Empedocles as his authority for this view. An elephant skull with its nasal opening looking deceptively like two merged eye sockets might easily cause an uninstructed observer to believe in the existence of gigantic, one-eyed creatures.

Noted Austrian Paleontologist, Othenio Abel, has commented: "Sailors of Homeric days, blown off their course and finding skulls in caves on the coast of Sicily, had never seen elephants. Hence they hit on the idea that the skulls must be those of huge beings with one great eye in the middle of the forehead. Thus the myth of the one-eyed cyclops probably originated - as indeed, most legends of giants are based on finds of large primordial mammals."

Othenio Abel's comments are interesting and of course correct, as no one can argue that the Sicilian skulls did not at one time belong to an extinct race of dwarf elephant. It was through ignorance then, on the part of our unenlightened ancestors, that the myth surrounding the one-eyed cyclops originated. Or did it?

Because of man's unceasing desire to unravel the puzzle that is himself it is becoming clear that many of our myths and legends which still exist today were, at one time, based on fact. As recent as July, 1973, the cyclops was yet another example of that fact.

During excavations near the town of Razlog, in southwestern Bulgaria, archaeologists uncovered the first tangible proof as to the existence of a one-eyed man. The skeleton, in excellent condition and measuring five feet eleven inches, was normal in every respect. However, it was the skull which so baffled and excited the team of archaeological experts, for it possessed only one single eye socket situated in the forehead and directly above the nose. In the hope of locating further similar specimen the team from a Sofia university intend continuing their search again this summer.

THE MYSTERIOUS

Pennsylvania recently had a rash of sasquatch sightings. One woman saw a huge hairy face peering at her through her bathroom window. The window is nine feet from the ground.

Another woman was in a graveyard in Youngstown, Pa., when she heard her little girl cry. She looked and saw a hairy creature some six to nine feet tall amongst the trees at the edge of the cemetery. The woman grabbed her child and drove home. The creature showed up there later even though the woman's house is several miles from the graveyard.

Another sasquatch was seen snatching meat from a parked car. The back seat of the car contained fresh meat. The creature tore up the back seat of the auto, ate some of the meat and took the rest.

One man managed to tape the cry of one of the ABSMs. He spotted the creature on his front yard near his living room window. As he was just using his stereo equipment, he turned on his tape recorder and put the microphone to the window. The recording is some three minutes in length.

The effects of the moon on people was studied by psychiatrists at the University of Miami School of Medicine. The four psychiatrists found a marked increase in murders at both the new and full moon. Murders committed at these times were "often of a particularly bizarre or ruthless nature." These findings resulted when the psychiatrists reviewed 1,949 homicides committed in Miami's Dade County from 1956 to 1970, and 2,033 murders in Ohio's Cuyahoga County from 1958 to 1970.

Dr. Arnold Lieber, the team's chief, stated he believes the moon may cause biological tides in the human body as it does in the oceans. Scientists have also recently found that drug use in mental institutions reaches its peak during the full moon.

In Sproughton, England, a rooster named Charlie, has them mystified. Charlie used to be white but recently turned blue. Charlie's

owner, pub landlord Alan Piper, 37, called in two veterinarians who failed to have any answers. The Phoenix Gazette of January 2, 1974, reports that Piper will consult experts if his rooster continues to remain blue.

UFO reports continue to pour in from across the USA. On October 18, 1973, it was reported that during the Skylab II mission the astronauts saw a strange reddish object not more than fifty miles from their craft.

Dr. Owen Garrett, one of the Skylab II crew, described the UFO as being brighter than any of the planets. The object was visible well above the horizon one day in mid-September. The object wasn't visible on any other day.

Policeman Jeff Greenshaw, of Falkville, Alabama, took photos of a humanoid in some sort of a metallic outfit.

Greenshaw responded to a call by a woman who said she saw a "spaceship" with flashing lights land in a field. When he reached the scene Greenshaw came upon the creature standing in the middle of the road.

The creature's face had no features and it had a short antenna on its head.


When Greenshaw stepped out of his cruiser the creature began moving stiffly towards him like a robot. During this time Greenshaw took four photos.

When the creature was scarcely ten feet away Greenshaw became frightened and turned on the cruiser's flashing lights. This caused the creature to flee. Greenshaw pursued it and said it ran "faster than any human being I ever saw." Because of the high speed Greenshaw lost control of his car on loose gravel. By the time he regained control the creature had disappeared.

Two good UFO photos were taken on December 13, 1973, by Patrick Thrush of Bradenton, Florida. Thrush saw the object at 8:50 p.m. in the vicinity of the Braden River.

Thrush went to investigate and found the craft hovering 20 feet above the water with a tube going from the object to the water.

The craft left, flying a bare seven feet above Thrush's

parked Toyota.

The UFO sighting was verified by reports made by two independent witnesses. One of the witnesses, John Dowdy, 18, some two miles east of Thrush's location saw a "bright orange object, going really fast."

Possession by demons exists and the power of exorcisms to drive them out works, says the Archbishop of Canterbury, Dr. Michael Ramsey.

Dr. Ramsey, head of the Church of England, said during his New York visit, "If you produced all the 'possessed persons' to look at, I would have to say a few are genuine and the majority fiddlesticks."

NEWSFRONT

Deep in the jungles of the Andes of South America police are waging a prolonged war to snuff out the multi-million dollar "Peruvian Connection".

International drug rings have chosen the vastness of the Peruvian Andes as the starting point for a clandestine drug trade aimed at the United States and Europe.

Networks of well-equipped laboratories produce huge quantities of cocaine, opium and hallucinatory pills. In the last two years alone, Peruvian police have seized some 104 tons of drugs. About fifty local drug-running

gangs have been smashed with the arrest of 2,000 suspects including chemists, financial backers, distributors and couriers.

A former Vancouver RCMP drug squad sergeant was found guilty in February of possession of fifty pounds of stolen hash hashish and trafficking in the drug. The hash had been taken from RCMP headquarters. Donald Kinloch, 42, attempting to explain the money he used to purchase a North Vancouver equipment rental business told the court he found a large amount of cash under a tree stump.

Meanwhile a West Vancouver antique dealer testified she arranged the sale of the hash for \$34,000 of which Kinloch received \$20,000.

In March, a naked man, holding hands with two unclothed women, streaked through the main floor of the Chicago police department's traffic headquarters.

"They were giggling like crazy and really moving. The whole thing didn't last more than 20 seconds," said officer Joseph Musial, who was alone in the building at the time.

"It was really something," Musial said. "The two girls were built like something out of the Bunny Club. All I saw of the man was a pair of white socks but to tell you the truth, I really wasn't paying too much attention to him."

Early this year five masked men raided a top London gambling casino and thought they had gotten away with a huge haul of banknotes.

But, the banknotes turned out to be bundles of used playing cards.

"The cards had been packed up ready for destruction," a spokesman for the Sporting Club said later.


Checking her costume

There's more to Waterloo's Lakeshore Village than meets the eye.

There are spirited goings-on there with a wine-and-cinnamon flavor that's hard to put a finger on.

Things go bump in the night, daytime, too, 'tis said.

Well, how would you like to have a wine-quaffing ghostie with a hankering for cinnamon around the house? Could you keep your cool when doors opened and closed by themselves, lights and television were switched on when you left the house and cold, unseen hands clutched your arm in the middle of the night?

Sound ridiculous in this time and place? To a housewife in Waterloo's north end it's all very real.

"The noises bothered us at first but we learned to live with them," said the attractive mother of two, who is in her late 20s. The family refuses to be identified in case publicity adversely affects the house's sale, a possible move now that the husband is working in another city.

"Funny things happened to us ever since we got married. We think it's my husband's grandmother," she said, describing a deep attachment

the dead woman had for her grandson.

The grandmother, whom she never met, "loved wine and had a real passion for cinnamon. She would sit down and eat it by the spoonful." Twelve bottles of home-made wine and the contents of a large cinnamon container are among things that went missing. Hard liquor that was more accessible was left untouched.

There's been "rapping on the door, calling out my brother-in-law's name, noises in the fruit cellar." When they returned from outings, chairs weren't where they left them, lights and television set were turned on. Keys disappeared from the kitchen and turned up elsewhere. Chocolate chip cookies were taken, and potato chips scattered in the front hall and closet while the family slept.

During most of the eerie events, the husband's teen-age brother resided with the couple and their children, a girl, 9, and a boy, 7, in the red brick bungalow they had built four years ago.

Things were normal for their first two years there. Then things began to happen. "Things were moved discreetly." A page would be turned in an open book lying up-

turned on a coffee table, she said. "Pillows have always been something that wandered around: I don't keep cushions on the chesterfield anymore."

Soon after her brother-in-law came to live with them "things really got going good and there's just no way of explaining some of them." When the wine, a particularly nice bouquet, began to disappear, she hid two bottles, replacing them with bottles of similarly-colored water.

"Those were never touched but one of the two hidden was taken."

Then came the footsteps. "It sounded like someone mad, stomping around." Her husband would check out the basement, find nothing and say it was the pipes.

A few times she saw what looked like Victoria holiday sparklers in the air. "I withdrew rather than try to touch them." At first there were just a few, without any form. Each time she saw them there were more and "then it got so that this mass would approach me but not touch me.

"One night I was still mending at 2:30 a.m. and a cold hand just gripped me here," she said pointing to her upper arm. "I tried to put my hand over it but it moved."

The extraordinary happenings didn't bother her unduly at first ("I felt we were living in peaceful co-existence") "but then it started getting to the kids.

"Then all of a sudden there got to be a very cold feeling in the house a lot of the time — almost a hostility." Scratching under their beds wakened the children at night. One night her son ran from his room where he claimed someone "lay beside him, pushed him over and he had to crawl over it to get out.

"Then came this one night I really didn't like at all." It was in November and her husband was ill. During the night she became aware "someone was trying to move the bedroom door which sticks and requires a good push to open."

She called out, asking who was there but there was no answer. Ten minutes of silence followed, then the door burst open.


She had heard light footsteps that night and began to suspect there was an intruder in the house. Her husband was unable to leave his bed so she had her brother-in-law check the attic. Nothing was found.

As they went to the basement door the teen-ager "heard a real heavy sigh on the other side" but there was no one there when they opened it, nor did a search of the basement yield any clue.

"But the house was filled with a cold abnormal feeling, not like you get from the cold, and it was sparkling just like Star Trek." This time the sparkles were also seen by her brother-in-law.

They sat in the kitchen for a while. Then her daughter "let out a holler. She was really scared." When the mother reached her room she saw a ball of fire, about two feet in diameter. "It was white with an orange collar and it was spiralling. It went real fast and next thing it was gone.

"That really gave me a scare. I never saw the sparkles since and I hope I never see them again. The cold feeling seemed to leave the house that night."

Now she wonders "if in fact we had two forces. I still feel there's a subtle presence here but it's easy to live with and friendly. Nothing spectacular occurs anymore. Sometimes it's as if someone is with me. You can hear movements, almost like someone walking, shuffling along. Once in a while I feel someone touches me."

One fall evening "I actually saw a woman standing in the bathroom. It was a fast glimpse. By the time I got stopped and back she was gone."

It occurred about 9 p.m., while it was still bright outside. She saw a grey-haired woman in a man's maroon dressing gown, belted at the waist and pulled up tight around the neck, brushing her hair. One strand fell over the left shoulder and the woman appeared to be brushing her neck strands, while looking ahead into a mirror.

"It was almost as if I expected her to be there. I felt surprise but no alarm. I thought 'Why would a woman be wearing that kind of dressing gown?'"

Her husband and a sister-in-law confirmed their grandmother wore such a garment and brushed her hair in this fashion. The only photographs of the dead woman seen by the housewife show her with hair parted in the centre and drawn back into a braided bun.

The shuffling sounds continue, pleasant flowery odors are experienced, dripping and ticking sounds with a buildup in velocity and volume are still heard.

She believes the major unpleasantness has subsided but is concerned lest there be another build-up. One reason is she fears it might harm her, an emotion helped none by an Ouija board game which indicated she would be stabbed.

The woman has had premonitions, later proved correct, many times in her life. She is also subject to what she has heard is astral projection — an experience by which she continues with whatever she's doing while another self leaves her and sits or stands at a distance. On advice, she fights this, but in spite of her efforts there are times "when I will literally get up and take off."

The four apartments in which the couple lived prior to moving to Lakeshore were also subject to odd happenings. "Thing weren't where they should have been. Papers or cushions wouldn't be where I left them."

Once \$40 was taken from a bedroom drawer and nothing else in the apartment disturbed except the bed on which someone had apparently lain. "A tired robber" was the investigating policeman's solution.

Popycock? Not everyone would agree.

A Guelph professor expressed keen interest in the Lakeshore Village events.

Researchers generally believe poltergeists (once regarded as noisy, mischievous spirits) are "some sort of energy," said Prof. Roger Smook, a philosophy professor who teaches a non-credit parapsychology course at the University of Guelph.

"It's very usual" to have these connected with a teenager, "but it's very unusual to have poltergeists and apparitions. You either have an apparition or a poltergeist."

And where it's the latter, moving away isn't much help. "It usually moves when the person does. The energy follows the person quite frequently."

How do you rid yourself of a ghost? "It seems to sort of gradually die out. Sometimes an exorcism helps — if it's connected with one particular person."

In a telephone interview from Toronto, where he now lives, Dr. A. R. George Owen, geneticist, biologist, mathematician, fellow of Trinity

College, Cambridge, England, and a leading investigator and student of parapsychology, said having poltergeists and apparitions together "is fairly unusual but it's not totally unknown . . . It usually disappears but it is more complicated with poltergeists and apparitions involved" and it doesn't always move when the people involved do.

The Toronto-based research foundation with which he works is not very keen on going outside Toronto. From the scientific viewpoint, investigating alleged phenomena is "usually not very rewarding. We like to do more definite kind of work."

Science and the Spook, which he co-authored, says many neurologists believe all apparitions seen by normal, healthy people are spontaneously revived memories arising from freak firings of neurones in the temporal lobe of the brain, and that "one normal healthy person in 10 will have by chance and through natural causes an apparitional experience, auditory or visual" in the course of a lifetime.

One of the theories put forward in the book is the trace theory which suggests an emotional charge generated by those subject or object of emotional deeds, violent or benign, rubs off on the environment and is picked up by a sensitive or mediumistic person.

Meantime, the Lakeshore housewife says she's "taking things as a matter of course since that fear has gone out of me. We (the ghost and her) try to keep out of each other's road.

"Sometimes I get a little exasperated and think, 'Good grief, couldn't you at least tidy up after yourself? I've got windows to clean. Can't you be energetic?'"

"It's different, embarrassing, interesting. And it certainly changes your outlook on things.

"It's become a joking matter around here. The neighbors drop in and ask 'Has granny visited lately?'"

Scholars divided on theory that planks are from ark

TORONTO (CP) — On the side of a mountain peak that rises 17,000 feet above the frontier between Turkey and Soviet Armenia there are ancient timbers made from an unknown, man-made structure.

Some people, including their discoverer, Fernand Navarra, a French demolition expert, believe them to be part of the skeleton of a huge, 5,000-year-old ship—Noah's Ark.

Ararat, the highest in a cluster of peaks referred to as the Mountains of Ararat, has been considered the site of the ark for centuries by the neighboring peoples.

Prof. R. K. Harrison, who teaches Old Testament in the Toronto School of Theology and is the author of numerous books and articles, said:

"There is obviously an artifact of some kind on Ararat at the 41,000-foot level. How did it get there and when? Personally, I believe it possible that the ark is there. I see the Genesis stories as ancient history writing and not as myths."

On the other hand, Prof. John S. Halladay Jr. of the department of Near Eastern studies at University of Toronto, is completely skeptical:

"What you have in the Genesis story of the flood is myth and not fact. It is common in a number of ancient traditions, some of them older than the account of Genesis, for example, in the Gilgamesh epic."

Navarra's find set off a furore both in scientific and religious circles. Although scarcely a summer has gone by since 1955, when Navarra found the remnants of the ship, without one or more attempts to follow Navarra's lead, most investigators have been amateurs with little hope of discovering anything.

One exception has been a United States-based foundation with two Canadians on its board of directors. In 1969, with Navarra as guide and assisted by Ralph Lenton, chief logistics officer for the Arctic Institute of North America, they returned to the 1955 location.

They found several pieces of the planking—one 18 inches long, four inches wide and an inch thick. Although the wood was found to be 1,400 years old, it was not old enough to be part of the ark.

Mr. Lenton, 50, is a polar explorer with 25 years experience. He has lived in the Antarctic for eight years and was deputy-leader of the Commonwealth Trans-Antarctic exploration from 1955 to 1958.

Mr. Lenton said in an interview: "I'm not an extreme

fundamentalist, but I do believe in the Bible. Archeology so far has upheld biblical truth. In my view, there was a Noah's ark that came to rest on Mount Ararat.

"One early account says the ark used to be lower down the mountain but that it was taken up and rebuilt near the peak as a shrine during the time of plague about 400 AD. The planks we found in 1969 could have been part of the newer wood used at that juncture."

Mr. Lenton expressed hopes for the future in this way: "What we really need is a wholly new organization to go back and scientifically clear out the Navarra site. If the ark is there we should be able to find timbers requiring a ship-like object to explain their shape. Whatever is there is worth exploring."

Fish slash swimmers off Miami

MIAMI BEACH, Fla. (AP) "They were really ripping chunks of flesh out," says lifeguard Jeff Fuller, one of about a dozen bathers slashed and bitten by fish caught up in a feeding frenzy.

"One of the fish knocked me off a surfboard and hit me in the mouth," said Fuller. "People were coming to us bleeding from wounds."

Haulover Beach, one of South Florida's largest public beaches, was closed for four hours Friday after schools of bluefish and jacks—both voracious feeders—sent swimmers scurrying and screaming from the water.

"In 26 years of working on the beaches here I can't remember anything like it," said Jim Holland, chief lifeguard.

Holland said most of the bitten bathers were near shore, some in as little as six inches of water, when they were attacked.

He said the bluefish and jacks were chasing mullet, a smaller fish often fed upon by larger ones, and that the

swimmers and surfers "just got in their way."

Fishing boats in the area were catching blue fish weighing up to 20 pounds apiece.

Lifeguards said blue fish, with small but razor-sharp teeth, inflicted most of the damage. Jacks have no teeth, but their gills and fins can cause scratches.

Bonnie Brown, 14, of Miami, required 55 stitches to close leg wounds.

"Bonnie had two large scoops taken out of the back of her left leg," said her father. Walter Brown said his daughter was one of six children in a church group spending Good Friday at the beach.

Dean Toney, 10, said he tried to catch a small mullet but instead had his finger bitten by a bluefish.

JONESBORO, Ark. (AP) — Two men accused of impersonating visitors from outer space have been fined \$25 each plus \$24.80 in court costs on charges of malicious mischief. Stanley Ray Burdshaw, 18, and William Don Wilson, 21, were arrested after about 20 motorists reported Sunday night seeing "little men in silver suits." State Trooper Daniel Oldham testified Monday the two were standing at the edge of the highway "covered from head to toe" with aluminum foil and jumping in front of cars.




