FLYING SAUCERS ACTIVE NEAR SUDBURY, ONT.

UFO SIGHTING NEAR WANUP, 16 MILES SOUTH OF SUDBURY

On the first Thursday in August, 1959, while vacationing in the Sudbury district, a Hamilton man together with his wife and 3-year old son and his brother-in-law observed a "flying saucer".

In relating his experience, Gerald Boileau said the saucer first made its appearance rising over bushland in the vicinity of his father-in-law's farm. The time was approximately 11 p.m. of a "pitch black" night...and in the isolation of the remote farm the silence was unbroken by any sound.

The saucer appeared to the astounded group as a bright light rising slightly and moving in the general direction of the farm. As they watched it continued to move slowly towards them until at an estimated altitude of two-thousand feet it slowed and then hovered directly over the farm clearing and at an angle of about 45 degrees from the observers.

Mr. Boileau could give no estimate of the size of the vehicle because of its uncertain height. He said in

appearance it was rather elliptic with a slight bulge over the top centre section. "It was all lit up," he said "the color of the light changing from white to multi-colored, but predominantly of a rather rose-colored hue." The light was such that it rendered some features of the landscape visible below the craft.

It was the sound that convinced the party they weren't seeing things. And it was a combination of the sound and the weird spectacle that frightened the child in the group to the point of hysteria and sent him screaming into the farm house.

The sound was described as a low hum which alternately rose and fell while the saucer hovered.

At no time could any member of the group see anything other than a general outline of the shape of the craft.

After an interval of about 5 minutes during which it maintained its position over the field, the saucer began to move off slowly in a northeasterly direction, then suddenly accelerated vanishing to a pinpoint of light in a matter of seconds in the general direction of North Bay.

Questioned later by an Air Force official to whom he reported the sighting, Mr. Boileau denied suggestions that this might have been the moon, searchlights at Burwah Reformatory, light reflecting from clouds... and so on.

He summed it up thus: "I know what it was NOT but I do NOT know what it was!"

This is not the only instance of saucer sightings in that general area.

On two previous occasions Mr. Boileau's brother-in-law observed flying saucers...one of which came down as though to land nearby. This also was a night sighting, but so close was the craft on this occasion, he was able to distinguish its general characteristics. Some months later when shown the frontispiece in "Flying Saucers Have Landed" he said without any hesitation: "That's what I saw."

Another sighting in the Sudbury district concerns a hermit trapper-woodsman. There is no record as to how many times UFOs have appeared in his vicinity, but on at least one occasion he fired a shot at a saucer with a 30-30 rifle.

These are the facts as related directly to me by Mr. Gerald Boileau and to the best of my recollection they are exact in every detail.

'SPACEMEN TALKED TO KHRUSHCHEV'

London--(AP)--A spokesman for the British Flying Saucer Society said today that before the Russians--or anyone else--try to put a man on a planet they'd better get the planet's permission. "We've been informed by the Cosmic Masters," said William Mayhew in an interview, "that earth men will not be allowed to land on other planets." Mayhew, a lawyer, and 700 other members of the Society have been attending Britain's first National Flying Saucer Convention.

During their two-day session in London they said they established contact with a spokesman on Mars through one of their officials, George King.

King went into a yogi trance and said a Martian spoke through him. He "recorded" the message from Mars. The message--directed at the leaders of East and West--was broadcast through the hall.

Delegates heard the "Master on Mars" say: "Unless much ground is given by both sides alike--"

Here the spokesman was interrupted by what sounded like a very earthy cough. Delegates were unable to say if the cough was King's or the Martian's.

"If you go on as you are at the moment,"

the voice said, "fostering suspicion, arguing and boasting about your latest weapons, then a conflict will most surely come."

The voice added that the conflict would take place between 1963 and 1964.

Delegates said they were convinced that President Eisenhower and Soviet Premier Khrushchev have been approached by spacemen. (Toronto Telegram, Sept. 26, 1960)

MANY MOONS GONE DUE TO COLLISIONS

Earth once had many moons.

They were relatively small objects in comparison to the present big moon. They fell on the surface of this moon or collided with it in their orbits which is about the same thing--creating some of the great craters which now cover the face of the satellite.

This is the conclusion of Dr. P.F. Sabaneyev, of the astronomical section of the Soviet academy of sciences. He experimented by dropping various sized and shaped objects from various distances on a plastic surface believed similar to that of the aboriginal moon. A translation of his report has just been issued through the U.S. department of commerce.

As a result of these experiments Dr. Sabaneyev concluded that "lunar craters were formed by the impact of dense, homogenous, definitely circular masses of loose material. The size of the craters indicates falls of large masses rather than high impact velocities.

"Their circular shape suggests vertical falls but occasional oval shapes of craters, irregularities of their inner structure and their orientations are proof that cases of oblique falls do exist. All this suggests that the falls were mainly the result of the moon's gravitation. In case of vertical fall the velocity was not higher than 24 kilometers a second and probably not higher than 2.75 kilometers.

"Simultaneous falls of two adjacent masses near to each other occurred only once in several thousand cases, but consecutive adjacent falls were frequent. This shows that the masses that fell were common in space before they were attracted by the moon. Clustering of craters may be taken as evidence of the attraction by the moon of masses moving in the same direction.

Earth: You know, when one nation gets into a fight with another and they kill off each other's populations?

Tau Ceti: Boy, are you sick! Just a moment please...Our Time Story Guardian says there is a reference to that sort of thing far back in our Time Story but it's very vague and no one here really knows anything about it. The whole idea sounds pretty foolish.

WHAT IS THE SHAVER MYSTERY?

I guess that many people interested in 'flying saucers' have heard something on "The Shaver Mystery" yet may know very little of the beliefs and claims founded by Richard S. Shaver. The chief source by which the information was made public was through Gray Barker in his book "They Knew Too Much About Flying Saucers".

It is of interest to know that people such as Albert K. Bender, Gray Barker, and Ray Palmer, place special emphasis on the Shaver Mystery as playing an important role in solving the UFO enigma. To quote a few of Shaver's beliefs:

...some saucers originate from space, but not all...the rest are said to be resident underground dwellers...mention is also given to a third type which come from nowhere; projections in other words, used for the purpose of inducing the observer away from the real saucer, it is alleged that these projection devices were constructed by our intelligent and mighty ancestors. Are being seen today though unrecognized for what they are...he claims that the long awaited visitors from space are already here and have been since time which antedates official recorded history... the saucer people, according to Shaver have no friendly intentions towards man...in fact they are here for a purpose...a valuable treasure lies within the earth...a treasure which present surface man doesn't know exists.

Humans are just part of the scenery. In answer to the question as to whether the saucer pilots look like us...Shaver's reply is as follows: "They are likely to resemble us in appearance in the same way as an alligator is like a Komodo dragon, but by this it is dangerous to assume that they think like us." They are described as walking the streets of earth but disguised in mink, monocles, and continental accents. As to the question why don't they attack us? The answer is given in this vein: They have contacted our gov't. mentally to find out just what they want to know. They don't attack us for this reason...we are useful to them as their instruments. The less one knows about their activities the safer one is said to be.

The foregoing appears to us as fantasy and on an extremely negative viewpoint

unlike the evangelical messages given by the spacepeople who are said to have contacted Angelucci, Schmidt, Adamski, Betherum, Fry, etc. Personally, I am no longer able to accept the interplanetary hypothesis as accounting for all unexplained objects observed in our skies. The subject is far deeper than that. Even Adamski's spacemen referred to the Brush Creek contacts with broad-shouldered midgets, and green men (mentioned in Appendix B of "Inside the Spaceships") as actual, although the craft and the people as quite separate or distinct from their group.

Correspondence on UFO's and the Shaver Mystery is being received, and certain hints as to the answer have been given as follows: Study the Bible as an historical event instead of a religious myth...discover information on the polar areas, especially Antarctica. Admiral Byrd claimed to have discovered unknown land abundantly fertile when he flew beyond the polar area in about the year 1910. This gives rise to basis for the legend on "rainbow land beyond Antarctica."

Perhaps parts of the Shaver Mystery could be discounted as fiction, yet containing some basis for the theory. The following sighting data are a few acceptable truths from a vastly misunderstood yet vital subject: (1) UFO's have been seen landing in desert areas where caverns are known to exist. (2) UFO's have been observed diving into the ocean depths. (3) Near the polar regions. (4) And over the 'flight rich' Amazon. The latter is where George H. Williamson and expedition has recently been seeking for an important lost city. It was previously known that UFO's were seen in large numbers around that area...



TO STUDY "GHOSTS" SEEN ON HIGH FLIGHTS
(The Edmonton Journal, September 28/60)

Washington (NANA) -- Scientists on a navy research project have discovered that when there is ample light but nothing to see, the mind supplies "visible" objects to the observer--hallucinations that are nonetheless real to the person who sees them.

They are studying the psychological effects of the "Ganzfeld," an adequately lighted but absolutely empty visual field.

The Ganzfeld, whose effects are very different from those of total darkness, is sometimes encountered by pilots at very high altitudes. It is similar to the "white darkness" of the Antarctic in which, under certain weather conditions, the horizon and all visible details of the landscape fade from view.

Dr. James W. Miller, of the Hughes Aircraft Co., which is doing the research under an office of naval research contract, ascribed the weird hallucinatory phenomena in part to the very rarity of the Ganzfeld.

"Many individuals experiencing total darkness for the first time suffer various degrees of depression, often accompanied by a sensation of the environment closing in," he said in a report. "It is not surprising to these individuals however, to find that they are unable to see anything.

"When these same individuals, however, face a well-illuminated visual field and still are unable to see anything it is not only surprising but often quite disturbing."

"One has the sensation," he added, "of being completely immersed in a foglike atmosphere in which all awareness of depth disappears. He sees various hallucinatory phenomena, such as rings of different shapes and sizes, apparent movement of clouds and the random appearance of sharply defined spots.

"After a relatively short time these phenomena take on greater interest and the subject becomes fascinated by the various configurations."

Dr. Miller produced an artificial Ganz-

feld in which he tested the ability of pilots to locate suddenly appearing actual objects, such as black tennis balls. When told that these were present the subjects usually thought they saw and were able to locate them--whether they were actually present or not.

Dr. Miller also found that his subjects got a distorted picture of the shape and location of real objects placed in the hitherto empty field.

ROCKET WILL TELL WHETHER MARS IS UNINHABITED

Seattle (AP) The first rocket probe of Mars should reveal whether it has any hostile inhabitants, two California scientists have suggested.

They said the first rocket also should send back word on nature of the Martian canals and the planet's two moons.

Wells Webb, research chemist of Berkeley and Dr. James A. Harder, U of C., presented a paper to the West Coast meeting of the American Astronautical Society.

There is enough evidence of past or present intelligent life on Mars, they said, so that the first rocket should be equipped to "detect any possible interference or destruction as the result of the actions of intelligent beings." Whether Martian canals and satellites are artificial, the researchers said, might be determined by transmission of television pictures from the rocket probe. (Hamilton Spectator-9/10/60)

**A REPORT BY DeWitt Lee, Director of the
INTERNATIONAL SHIP SIGHTING RESEARCH
ASSOCIATION, HAMILTON, ONTARIO.**

From about 12:15 a.m. until about 1:10 a.m. a white spot of light flanked on the left and right by fluctuating red & blue-green lights respectively, appeared to grow smaller in size as it passed beyond the point of sight, in a straight line. The object became so small it disappeared from sight. The date was August 12, 1960.

Around 12:35 am. beams of light streaked outward from the object about three times in three different directions, north, south and south-east. The beams were followed almost instantaneously by a small dot of light that quickly followed the beam in the direction it was directed.

With a 25X telescope the object was clearly visible as a spot of pure white light, while the two colors on either side seemed to fluctuate in intensity, rather than blink off and on, which seemed to disprove any theories of it being a high flying plane. It was at an angle from the ground of about 40 degrees and moved into a northern direction of about one degree in about 1 hr. Its general movements was apparently westward because that is the direction it disappeared from sight. This sighting has been confirmed by four people who had drawn my attention to it about ten minutes to one, thirty-five minutes after they had first seen it in the western sky.

The night was clear, and the stars were not obscured by clouds of any kind. The moon was in the east and been up for only about an hour. It was in its last quarter.

Jupiter was in the south-west at about the same height as the object. The object was about one-quarter the brightness of Jupiter. In fact if my friends had not brought the object to my attention I would have never noticed it. Meteor activities were quite good because I saw an average of one every 5 minutes after this object was seen in the skies. Echo I was launched that morning and was not expected in our skies until the following evening.

JET BLAST STARTLES RESIDENTS

Lindsay, Ontario, (ENS) A thunderous bang, believed to have been caused by a jet smashing the sound barrier, brought Lindsay people streaming from their homes shortly before 10 p.m. Tuesday. Groups of people stood around discussing the noise for some time afterwards. Jet planes flew over the Lindsay area during the afternoon and evening, leaving a vast pattern of crisscrossing vapor trails.

When the bang occurred, lights dimmed in the Century Theatre and the screen shuddered as though a minor explosion had taken place behind it.

Parents reported that sleeping children were awakened by the blast, which, in some cases, rocked furniture and upset ornaments.

Damage was however, limited to a few broken window panes, one of them in the third floor of the fire hall.

LONE JET CAUSED BOOM

A single U.S. jet fighter which ventured farther north than the rest of its flight may have caused the sonic boom which rattled Winnipeg, Tuesday.

The main flight cracked through the sound barrier over Pembina, North Dakota 50 air miles south of Winnipeg, just after 10 am. Tuesday, creating a shock wave which broke some windows in that community.

But RCAF officials said Wednesday morning they learned, subsequently, that a lone aircraft had been picked up by radar only 38 miles south of the city, at an altitude of 37,000 feet.

This plane, spotted by the department of transport's radar approach station here probably was responsible for the boom.

It turned back shortly after it was picked up on the radar screen.

The U.S. border is about 50 miles south of Winnipeg. RCAF officials said there had been many phone calls about the boom itself. U.S. and Canadian aircraft under the North American Air Defence (NORAD) command can pass freely over the border. There were no reports of damage from the Winnipeg area.

FIREBALL MIGHT BE DOWN IN SASKATCHEWAN

A meteorite may have fallen in the province Sunday night, according to John Hodges, observatory director of the Regina Astronomical Society.

He said that at 9:15 p.m. "many Regians" were startled to see a bright flash appear in the south-east sky which moved slowly and got down to the horizon before disappearing.

Mr. Hodges said the society would welcome any reports available from persons having seen the spectacle known in astronomical language as a "fireball."

"In 20 years of endeavor, the society has traced all reported fireballs for the purpose of recovering a meteorite, but without success," said Mr. Hodges. He said the meteorite had been positively identified as belonging to the Taurid meteor shower which is at its maximum on Nov. 5 but last for some time. (Regina Leader-Post, November 7, 1960)

METEORITE JUST MISSES COUPLE

Melville, Sask., (CP)--A meteorite flashing to earth near Duff, Sask., Sunday night narrowly missed a young couple driving to Fort Qu'Appelle. Inspection yesterday showed fragments larger than hens eggs scattered over a 40-foot area some 20 feet from the edge of Highway 10, 17 miles west of here. Bill Gelowitz and his wife Doreen, described the meteorite as a "red streak in the sky that suddenly burst into a tremendous blue flame."

"We didn't realize until we found it just how close it came to hitting us," said Gelowitz. (The Toronto Daily Star, November 8, 1960)

MONSTROUS DRAGONS SNARL R.A.F. ROCKETS

Kuala Lumpur, Malaya, (Reuters)--The nuclear rocket age has run into trouble from a prehistoric monster that looks like a story-book dragon.

Royal Air Force men reported the nine to fourteen foot long beasts are interfering with rocket-firing practice on the islands of Song Song and Telor off Malaya's northwest coast.

At British request, Malayan game wardens this week ordered a full investigation. The foresters were told to keep their eyes peeled for Komodo dragons--hideous, lizard-like creatures with powerful arms and legs.

Hitherto, it was believed the creatures inhabited only remote areas of Indonesia. According to Indonesian mythology, they breathe smoke and grow to more than 14 feet in length.

The dragons are said to be far more dangerous than the seven-foot-long monitor lizards found on Indonesia's main islands.

British airmen reported seeing Komodo dragons when they went to Song Song and Telor islands for bombing exercises. They said the huge, ungainly monsters emerged at dusk from their lairs to eat crabs. Both islands are uninhabited. (Victoria Daily Times, October 31, 1960)

SNOWMAN TRACKED

Katmandu, Nepal (Reuters)--Fresh tracks believed to have been made by the legendary "abominable snowman" have been found in a Himalayan Valley by an expedition led by Sir Edmund Hillary, according to a report reaching here Fri. The tracks were seen in Rolwaling valley, three days' march north of Beding village where the expedition led by the conqueror of Mount Everest has established its first base camp.

Further details of the discovery are not yet known, but the report said one member of the expedition was trekking back to Katmandau.

The expedition will remain in the Himalayas for nine months, searching for the half-man, half-beast "snowman" and conducting research on the human body's reaction to continued living at high altitudes. (The Regina Leader-Post, October 29, 1960.)

I found Mr. Rushman at his home and we both drove out to the spot. He showed me the large footprints which were evenly spaced about 8 ft. apart, and right across one of the greens. He has since covered them up and reseeded it. But

took me to another spot where it had landed and I was able to get a good picture of one of the prints. They are about 12 inches wide and close to 18 inches long. They are about 1 inch deep in the soil.

I was hoping they would be similar to the ones at the saucer site of July 27, 1957 (See SS&S #4 and 7) but they were more like a bird's print. While running through a pile of old Fate Magazines, I came across an article about a large, queer bird that was seen by several people in April, 1922 and again in March, 1957.

Mr. H.M. Granmer of Hammersley Fork, Pa., recalls seeing a large bird as big as a Piper Cub airplane. It was winging its way north flapping its wings like a blue heron. Its wingspread was estimated at about 25 or 30 feet. The Indian

Miss Sharpe said that this month, (November--G.D.) "there will be several governments finally acknowledging communication with outer space intelligence. A lot of skeptics who scoff at reports of saucers will change their minds." The U.S. government has been secretive about saucers and other phenomena "because they're afraid the people would panic. SAY ROCKET PART FELL IN TRANSVAAL
Pretoria, South Africa (AP)--Experts at the South African Council of Scientific and Industrial Research Laboratories are examining a metal ball, three feet in diameter, believed to be part of a moon rocket fired from Cape Canaveral, Fla., Sept. 25. The ball fell on a farm near Zoekmekaar in Northern Transvaal. Officials refused to allow photographing of the object. Several people in the Zoekmekaar area reported seeing flashing lights and spoke trails and hearing bangs in the sky soon after the rocket, designed to orbit the moon, went off course and disintegrated. In Washington, scientists of the NASA said the description given for the metal ball "doesn't fit the payload" of their unsuccessful moon shot. (London Free Press, October 25, 1960)

New York, Oct. 8 (AP) -- Mayor Achille Lauro of Naples, Italy, came away from a 45-minute chat with General Douglas MacArthur quoting a prediction that future wars would be interplanetary rather than between nations on earth. Lauro said the general "thinks that another war would be double suicide and that there is enough sense on both sides of the Iron Curtain to avoid it." However, Lauro added, MacArthur foresees trouble from outer space. "He believes that because of the development of science all the countries on earth will have to unite to survive and to make a common front against attack by people from other planets," the Italian mayor reported. Regarding the chances of settling east-west difficulties, Lauro said MacArthur gave this opinion: "The Soviets and the democracies will adopt the best characteristics of each other, and, in the process of many years, there will not be a strict line of demarcation between their ideals; therefore no cause for war between them." (end of quote)

Is there any significant meaning to this statement? Yes there is. In recent months there has been a proposal by the major nations for disarmament. Would this be a wise move at this time? Disarmament would endanger the already weakened economy of the world. Many discharged servicemen would be without employment as the defense plants that have employed thousands would be greatly reduced in production or closed. Hungry people resort to civil war. So whichever way we look danger is facing us; from war--or economic collapse from disarmament. There is one alternative. For the first time, another door is open. A changeover of the aircraft and instrument plants for production of outer space craft would assure employment for everyone throughout the world. It has been generally accepted that we

are being watched by some type of intelligence from outer space that are not from this planet. There are differences of opinions regarding this intelligence; where from and if they are humanoids. It matters little which they are and where from. Researchers who have given serious thought to the U.F.O. admit that these unidentified craft are operated by an intelligence superior to our own since they travel through space at will and perform feats which we consider impossible. These crafts have challenged our intelligence and caused us to think in terms of outer space. However, our efforts in this direction have been too slow. Space travel and research should have Top Priority, not by one nation but the world as a whole. The potentials of a space war cannot be fully ignored. It is true, as far as we know, the ones who operate the U.F.O. have shown no hostility towards the Earth's inhabitants. There have been rumours that such acts have taken place I can assure you, that as nearly as I can tell, with twelve years of experience with the space people coming from our own system, no hostile act has been committed against us. Their desire is to help us to get into outer space with ships of our own construction. The danger from attack could come from another system. The information that has been given to me is that there are systems out there that are hostile to our way of life and they have ships moving through space. With this possibility in mind, I agree with General MacArthur, that we should organize the world in defense of the world, against such an attack. Today we have no defense against such aggression. When we as a people are big enough to recognize that there are only slight variations of ideals and ideas among the nations of the world, that all depend upon their individual economic security, we can unite with one purpose defense of the world. This should not be too difficult when we learn to give and take ideas from each other and have a common interest; construction of space ships. As great as our weapons

of defense are including atomic warhead satellites, fast planes and rockets, they would be like putting up tissue paper in defense against the force that could come our way. This is not an idle thought for within the past twelve years we have tried to intercept the fast moving space craft to no avail. To build a fleet of ships will involve time and expense, that is why it is important for all nations to work together. So instead of reducing our resources let us swing them into this progressive endeavour, thereby eliminating war among nations and thus keeping industrial production at top speed. I sincerely hope that our space craft would not have to be used for defense against attack, for there are endless possibilities for their use in space exploration. But it is always wise to be prepared for the unknown.

SAULT STE MARIE MI 4322 Y3 L20 REPORTS

June 12/1960 -- Wayne Petrunik, a schoolboy, while at his home, sighted a UFO. It appeared in the southeastern sky, bright silver. The object was moving south, and was seen to glow and fade. Finally, just before a minute of observation, it vanished into a cloud. The UFO appeared over the Michigan Sault, as the boy lived on a hill in Sault, Ontario. It was first seen about noon. The entire sky was cloudy, but did not rain at the time.

March 13/1957 -- James Gough, a neighbor of mine and I were standing outside near the side door of my home. The time was about 10:51 p.m. when we were scanning the skies. We were discussing astronomy during this time. I had the only telescope on hand when I decided to observe the skies away from the full moon. Suddenly my friend noticed six objects crossing the moon's disc. They were oval heading apparently towards the southwest. He called my attention, but the objects had already disappeared into the dark. I found out next day that they had been seen by other residents.

April 21/1957 -- The time was about 12:15 p.m., the sky was clear so I decided it would be a good night to look through my telescope. Just as I was about to raise the instrument, a saucer appeared right over me in the eastern sky. The object was pretty close to me and I could make it out very well. The saucer was circular and had a dome on the top. At the side of the dome was a round window, but with no one inside. The object was heading south-west at a terrific speed. The color of it was a light yellow.

SOVIET HOVERCRAFT--Soviet designers have developed a 400-ton sea hovercraft vessel which can travel five or six feet above the water at a speed of about 106-125 miles an hour, Tass said today. (Victoria Daily Times-October 27, 1960)

GREEN OBJECT SEEN IN SKY

A mysterious object, which had a green light, travelled across the sky in the vicinity of Phoenix, Arizona about 3 a.m. today.

Police headquarters was swamped with telephone calls from persons who said they saw it.

Operators on duty in the control tower at Sky Harbor Airport said they saw the object which appeared to be only a few miles away.

"Somebody said they saw it breaking up into pieces in the vicinity of Tempe," the police desk sergeant said.

One caller said it "looked like a meteor, but it was nothing like any meteor I've seen before."

CAVE CARVED IN DIM PAST TO BE SOUGHT

A group of Victoria men plan to launch a search this weekend for a cave believed to have been carved out of the side of a Vancouver Island mountain sometime in the distant past.

The cave, thought to be somewhere between Shawinigan Lake and Port Renfrew, was discovered by a prospector who is now dead. He described it as having carved steps and other signs of occupancy. Don Abbott, assistant anthropologist of the province museum, will accompany the group as an observer. (Victoria Daily Times, Nov. 10, 1960)

MOON LANDING

Earth scientists may have actually seen and photographed the Soviet moon rocket that smashed into the face of the moon. Hungarian astronomers report seeing a sharp black dot the size of a pencil point on the moon on Sept. 13, 1959--just when the Soviet rocket was to hit. The dot became progressively lighter and bigger, looking finally like a smudge from a pencil tip eraser. Swedish astronomers at the same moment photographed a black dot in the same lunar location. Another photo 2 mins. later showed only traces of the dot. (Edmonton Journal-11/11/60)

"MR. SANDMAN" MAY EXIST ON PLANETS NOT DISCOVERED

Philadelphia (AP)-- There may be a sandman on some yet undiscovered planets, a team of University of Penna. scientists said today. The sandmen were envisaged as living creatures having silicon--an essential constituent of sand rocks--as their basic component, instead of carbon. Carbon is the key element in the chemistry of all life on earth. The researchers told about it in a report to the opening of the autumn meeting of the National Academy of Science. The team, headed by researchers M. Abendini, also envisaged that some day vitamins and hormones, for use in medical fields, might be prepared from sandy substances.

They said that for the first time they have prepared new, simple silicon-containing compounds which are closely analagous in both chemical and physical properties to a number of familiar compounds based on carbon.

At the present time, our knowledge of these simple silicon compounds is at the stage where carbon chemistry was 150 years ago.

"Since all living substances contain both simple and complex carbon compounds it is somewhat fascinating to wonder whether silicon compounds will within the next 150 years, be introduced into living substances in place of analagous carbon compounds."

"The existence of living things, containing silicon exclusively, in the place of carbon--so-called 'living rocks'--altho' improbable at the stage of our present understanding, is not necessarily impossible..."

"It is possible that living things, with their chemistry based on silicon instead of carbon, may exist in some of the billions of yet undiscovered planets having an atmosphere of different composition from that on earth." (Madstock Sentinel Review, November 14, 1960)

FIERY OBJECT FLASHES OVER CITY-- METEOR RULED OUT

Some fiery object flashed across the sky last evening about 6 o'clock, touching off reports of plane wrecks in the four state area of Ohio, Indiana, Kentucky and Illinois.

State and local police finally decided the flashing object was not a burning plane. The object was seen by Jack Gramm, 843 Cascade Drive, Forest Park, a General Electric Co. engineer in charge of the ceramic unit of the Flight Propulsion Department.

"I am involved in rocket materials," he said, "and I made careful observations. I thought it might have something to do with the experiments of the Discoverer. I saw it just as I came out of the plant and I checked my watch. It was 6:06. It was a double object and its light was much greater than I have ever seen, sort of a yellow with a light orange cast.

"There were two fire balls, each with a tail, and the tail of the leading one extended almost back to the rear one. They were directly in line. It came in from the south and was going north, a little east of north. Its angle on the western horizon was 50 to 60 degrees. It was below the clouds and I estimated its height as 30,000 to 40,000 feet. It lasted five to six seconds.

"Both of them were several feet in circumference. It's hard to tell, but maybe 50 feet. They could have been a quarter of a mile long."

Tome Van Flandern, a member of the local moon watch team, to whom Gramm reported his experience, said the fact the object was below the clouds practically ruled out the possibility it was a meteor.

"Meteors invariably burn themselves out long before they reach cloud level," Van Flandern said.

Dillsboro, Ind.--Nike base: Several soldiers reported seeing the flaming object explode and fall to the ground about 6 p.m. Col. Charles Arvin at Wilmington, in charge of all Nike bases in this area, said the object could not be traced on radar and he had no idea what it was.

Switzerland County, Ind., near Markland Dam: Unidentified motorist reported to Sheriff Albert Rosenberger he saw a burning plane. No plane found.

Fort Knox, Kentucky: Kentucky State Police and Army helicopters conducted a long search in Breckinridge County after reports a burning plane had fallen to the ground. No plane was found.

Canton, Ill.: Sheriff's deputies and state police checked the area after an airliner reported a burning object, probably a plane, was seen falling. Nothing was found.

F.W. Wagner, chief engineer at Radio Station WZIP said he disconnected the antenna as usual at 5:30. When he touched it about 6:30, he said, he received a severe shock. Fearing it was shorted he tested it and found nothing wrong but then discovered that when he held the lead-in about one-fourth of an inch from the antenna there was enough electricity in the air to light a 100 watt bulb.

"I've never seen anything like that before in 40 years in this work," he said. "It must have come from that object that passed over."

OBJECTS OVER LAKE ONTARIO

Two bright objects zooming into space above the lake this morning startled thousands of early-rising Torontonians and caused police and newspaper switchboards to jangle. The traffic control center at Detroit said it was tinfoil falling from jet planes on a radar test

The U.S. government has finally released photos of the Avrocar as shown below. Lettered on the front you will see AVRO AIRCRAFT. On the opposite side are the words US AIR FORCE - US ARMY (not all visible in photo). This craft has been under development for a number of years at Avro Aircraft in Malton, Ontario. Last November, 1959, a model (one of three) was shipped to Moffet Field, Calif., for high speed tests. Wind tunnel testing was suspended this summer while modifications were made. Increased interest by the USAF in the results of the supersonic version of the Avrocar has been shown and a second engineering study program similar to the original one is anticipated in the near future. A shareholder queried Sir Roy Dobson, chairman of A.V. Roe, Canada, about Avro's flying saucer. "It's still going on, experimentally. We're getting support from the US government and the Canadian government," he said. The point I am trying to stress is that this craft is of Canadian origin. The US hopes to purchase substantial numbers of saucers to give infantry troops unprecedented mobility and speed. According to the latest misinformation in the December issue of a well-known US east coast saucerzine which also printed a photo of this saucer, but from the opposite side, they said: "It has no connection with the Avro saucer..."
