## 1. Cameraes

Hans Kr. Moe have still not received any list of suitable cameraes, not any copy of an international press release (it have not been made!), and not any writing paper. That's the reason why he still haven't send letters to different camera factories, asking them to support us with cameraes. But,- he have made some preparation, and the letter will be send as soon he get the support. (The press release will prove that this will give good advertising).

It might be difficult to get enough cameraes in time., Therefore, we must ask the people, those who goes up in Hessdalen in january, to bring cameraes. We should get an overview of the cameraes they will bring. Films can we support.

## 2. Electro-Magnetical Radiation.

### "Radiowaves."

At this time, we have one Tektronix spektrumanalyser (100 KHz - 1.8 GHz), and one old Hewlett Packard spektrumanalyser. The one with different modules for different bands. The one from Tektronix cover the whole band in one sweep. The limit will be the antennas used. (It is not sure that we can use these instruments continuously in 14. days)

## 3. Geological.

One person from "Seismological Observatory" (: this is confidential) have been in Hessdalen and installed a seismolog, type MEQ-800. Any earthcrack in the world will now be registered in Hessdalen.

## 4. Contacts.( )

Research Manager Holme at FFI ( Norwegian Defense Research Establishment) have confirmed, by telephone, that he have received an informative letter from Røed. He will put an geophysician on the case. When I called (week 48), this man was on business in the northern part of Norway. I informed Holme briefly about the action we are planning in january. I will take futher contact with Holme and the geophysician in the very near futkure. Instrumentation will be one of the topics to discuss. (This is confidential)

## 5. Newspapers.

One newspaper in Trondheim:"Arbeideravisa", have already written an article about Project Hessdalen. Unfortunately, this article had a lot of mistakes in it. I have send an informative letter to the journalist, and asked him to write a new article.- If we had written an international press release, I guess this wouldn't happen.

Rognes, Nov. 27, 1983

Sightings in Hessdalen and the areas nearby.

Monday, Nov. 7. at 06.45 p.m.

(Jon A. Aspås)

When the witness went out of his house he noticed an aeroplane passing from south to north. When this plane had come a bit north to Hessdalen, he saw an globe-looking object following the plane on its ~~xxx~~ right side. The object passed the plane and moved to its left side, where it stopped. The globe became larger, -about 5-6 times larger than a big star. After some seconds the globe crimped and disappeared to north/west.

(18.nov.1983)

Monday, Nov. 14. at 07.08 pm.

(Asbjørn Furunes and his wife)

The witnesses were driving from Singsås to Støren. When they came to Rognes, -about 60km north to H.d., they saw a red globe-looking object passing to east but it moved to south near Budal. The object moved below the clouds, and was seen in more than 20 sec. The witnesses stopped the car while they observed the object.

On their way to the UFO-meeting in H.d., they saw about 10 to 15 very short blinking lights, in yellow/white and blue, south to FJELLBEKK-HØGDA.
