# A LOOK AT A UFO BOOK

**"THE UFO CONSPIRACY: THE FIRST FORTY YEARS"** by Jenny Randles. 224 pages, illustrated. Published by Blanford Press, U.K.

The authoress, who is director of investigations for the British UFO Research Association, starts her book adamantly: "UFOs exist. The evidence that will confront you in the pages that follow makes that conclusion inescapable if you accept that science is about learning new things. We know more in 1987 than we did in 1937. There will be wonders in 2037 we have not the slightest inkling of right now. Anyone who says UFOs are impossible, because scientists have not 'discovered' them, has no understanding of what scientists do."

The theme of the book, as the title suggests, is that after forty years of investigation by various people in high places, including scientists, it is possible to conclude that there has been a world-wide cover-up about UFOs at an official level.

"UFOs have been investigated by every major government on earth" she says, "And are still being studied at an official level in China, France, Spain, the USSR, the USA and the UK to name but six leading nations.."

She goes on to analyse many remarkable UFO reports from around the globe, including the one from the 24th June 1947, whence the expression "flying saucer" was coined. The second chapter of the book discusses the persistent rumours that a flying saucer crashed in the New Mexico desert in 1947 and that the US Army Air Force (as it was called at the time) picked up the debris and moved the remains to Roswell Air Force Base, for analysis by top scientists. A major, Jesse Marcel stated in 1979, "It was definitely not a weather balloon or a tracking device, nor was it any sort of plane or missile. It was something I had never seen before, or since. It certainly wasn't anything built by us. "One presumes that the President of USA at the time, Truman, was briefed and that every other President since has known about it. Yet it is officially a secret Randles states: "This raises all manner of ethical questions. To keep from society the existence of an alien artefact would be a crime against science . . . . The west may well have wanted to learn the UFO technology first . . . Perhaps the technology is still beyond us."

Such honesty from the British UFO Research Association is very refreshing. Ananda Sirisena was the guest speaker at BUFORAs 11th Annual General Meeting in London, when he was invited to speak on the subject of Buddhist cosmology, to a well-attended gathering of UFO researchers. The fact that material scientists are now interested in the beliefs of other religions and attitudes about life on other worlds is an indicator that the cosmic tides are changing. Only a year ago, according to a poll conducted in the U.K. more than fifty percent of the population believe that flying saucers exist and that there is life on other planets.

The early years of flying saucer research were indeed exciting and heady days. From 1947 to 1969, the US Air Force amassed over 13,000 UFO reports, many of them made by pilots, air traffic controllers, astronomers, scientists and others with technical training. By no means were reports only from America, and 70% were still classified as unidentified when the Air Force's Project "Bluebook" was closed in 1969.

Jenny Randles describes the following Middle Eastern case. On the night of 19 September 1976 reports were received from witnesses around Tehran, Iran. They said that a strange light was in the sky. It was approximately 12.30 am and the thing was likened to a helicopter hovering with a massive searchlight. The Iranian Air Force officer who took the calls suggested that it was probably just a star.

B. G. Yousefi was this man. After several more calls, all repeating the story, he began to doubt his ready-made solution and realised he could make a capital error if he did nothing. So he went to have a look. There was a huge glowing light which was immensely bright. He could not identify it and contacted Shahroki Air Base to launch a Phantom jet.

The Phantom took off at 1.30 a.m. and headed north on an intercept course. The object was an estimated seventy miles from the plane, but so bright that it was easily visible. The recorded communications between the jet pilot, Lt. Jafari and ground control was published and was revealing.

Jafari, who was aged 23 broke through the "sound barrier" in his pursuit. As he closed on the object it was half the size of the moon, radiating violet, orange and white light. It seemed to know that he was coming and shot away as he approached! Jafari tried but failed to catch it. So ground control suggested he abandon the chase and return home. At almost the second that he agreed to do this, he called out: "Something is coming from behind. It is 15 miles away. . . now 10 miles. . . now 5 miles. . . It is level now. I think it is going to crash into me. It has just passed by, missing me narrowly."

The pilot was so shaken by this event that he asked to be guided back to Shahroki base. He had apparently lost all instrumentation and communication for a while, regaining them only after he broke off the intercept.

Meanwhile, at 1.40 a.m., a second Phantom jet had been launched at a range of 27 miles from the object. Its in-flight radar locked onto the flying saucer and recorded a closing speed of 150 mph. The jet reached its maximum speed but was unable to catch up with the rapidly accelerating object.

The pilot and radar operator aboard this second phantom were about to suffer one of the greatest shocks anyone in the air has lived through. An object was ejected from the UFO and propelled straight at them! It was a ball of light, estimated 12 feet in diameter and seemed too much like an air-to-air missile. The pilot decided to launch a retaliatory strike.

For the first time as far as we know, an AIM-9 SIDEWINDER infra-red homing missile was about to be fired at a UFO.

It never happened. At that precise moment, all power on the aircraft instrument panel was lost. Communications, internally as well as with ground control vanished. In panic, the pilot made a 'negative-6' dive and tried to evade the glowing ball. It was no use, the ball of fire kept coming at them, changing course and closing within seconds to a four-mile range. Then, in a perfect manoeuvre, the ball did a U-turn inside the path of the jet and flew back into the larger craft.

Communications and power returned to the Phantom jet, but the pilot decided that one warning was enough. In no way was he going to contemplate firing a missile at something beyond his comprehension. He and his radar man watched in awe as a second projectile emerged from the UFO and travelled vertically towards the ground. They expected to see an explosion on impact. Instead, the projectile landed and began to emit light over a vast area. Meanwhile, back in the sky, the original larger object accelerated to a speed several times that of sound and vanished within seconds.

The pilot took his jet down to 15,000 feet, all the time watching the glowing light on the ground to mark its position. The light eventually extinguished, plunging the desolate terrain below into inky blackness. Such had been the brilliance of the UFO as well as the light on the ground, that the pilot suffered considerable impairment of his night vision. He had to circle his base several times before landing in order to let his eyes adapt to the dark again. When his jet passed through 150 degree magnetic, it lost all communications again. This happened several times and a commercial plane in the area at the time also reported a similar problem with its radio.

At dawn, the pilot and his radar man were flown into the area to try and pinpoint the spot where the light came down. It was a dried-up lake-bed. Nothing was found there but a beeping noise was picked up on the radio in the helicopter. When they landed near strongest contact with the sound, they found an isolated farmhouse whose occupants stated that they had heard a loud noise during the night and had seen a brilliant light.

This summary is from an American Secretary of Defence dossier on the case, which was only released under the Freedom of Information Act. Randles states, "The trouble is that Britain, with its Official Secrets Act, has the mirror opposite of the Freedom of Information act. The conspiracy is so much easier to maintain, thanks to that."

"The time has come finally to remove this matter from the province of the Hollywood movie," she concludes. "The time has come to treat the evidence for UFOs with due respect." And she gives a great deal of physical evidence in this book.

The book covers cases from Australia, France, Spain, England, USA, the Soviet Union, Brazil, South Africa, New Zealand and Alaska. The authoress also analyses quite a few controversial photographic cases of

flying saucers from America, Trinidade Island in the South Atlantic, UK, Canary Islands and Norway.

Glaringly missing are UFO reports from the East, certainly none from Sri Lanka. It is worth noting here that the Sri Lanka UFO Register has been documenting flying saucer reports for a number of years and any readers who have been witnesses or who know of cases are urged to write to the Secretary of the Register at 6/D/78 Jayawadenagama, Wickremasinghepura, Battaramulla.

The book "The UFO Conspiracy" falls short of being considered a definitive book on the subject because it fails to analyse the contactees. Above all, it fails to mention Britain's leading contactee, Sir George King, Founder and President of the Aetherius Society. After all, the Aetherius Society has proved its contact in more ways than one. Readers who have seen previous issues of the journal of the Sri Lanka UFO Register will have studied articles such as: HOW AETHERIUS BROKE THE NEWS ABOUT RUSSIA'S NUCLEAR DISASTER and MARS AND THE WINDSCALE BLUNDER and realised that the Aetherius Society is a force for good in the world of ufology and is at the forefront of the controversial subject. Jenny Randles, by ignoring the Aetherius Society completely, in her discussion of the conspiracy to cover up facts about UFOs has, in this reviewer's opinion, failed to put a stamp of authority on her book.

Nevertheless, the book is recommended to students of the subject, despite one very silly remark. She says, "It really matters little what UFOs are" (page 205). It does really matter what UFOs are, Jenny Randles. Otherwise, why bother spending so much time studying the subject? Why write books on the subject? Why give interviews on the subject? Why pursue witnesses in an attempt to unangle the mystery? Why, why, why?

Such illogical remarks are however balanced by other, more intelligent insights. She says, "Perhaps an agreement was reached with whoever (or whatever) pilots these craft. In exchange for their friendliness, their presence would be hidden." Really, Miss Randles, are you suggesting that the UFOs have already made contact with terrestrial leaders?

She says, "In fact, the chances are that the authorities were simply baffled. There is little doubt that the prospect of extraterrestrial spacecraft was taken seriously but unless something had indeed been captured at Roswell in July 1947, the cover-up was more likely a product of ignorance than of secret knowledge. The dire need was to find out what was going on: where the UFOs came from, what they were doing here, and so on. It may well have been sensible to manufacture the impression that UFOs were considered explained, as a method of distracting private scientific enterprise from probing the subject and possibly going public with its discoveries. If discoveries were to be made, it could well have been deemed important that security-cleared scientists got to them first (preferably western security-cleared scientists) . . . ."

Now there's a good paragraph.

# 1940's Pentagram in English Skies

In the summer of 1943 (or 1944), a group of four people observed an unusual pentagram in the sunnyskies. According to one of 5 the witnesses, Margaret Gadge, it was "a geometric design of scintillating stars linked by straight white lines". They first noticed it at 11.15 in the morning and the phenomenon remained stationary in the sky for several hours!

Miss Gadge described it as "beautiful scintillatign pastel colours in the form of stars." The sighting took place near Cranleigh in Surrey, England on a bright sunny day with blue skies. She cannot remember the exact date but knows it was during the second world war. They were all fascinated and puzzled by the shape. Her father suggested that it might be some kind of "American stunt".

Whatever it was, it covered an area of the sky estimated to be fifty times the apparent size of a full moon. The witness was in her early thirties at the time and had not heard of "flying saucers" then but now believes it was some kind of extraterrestrial device. After several hours, the shape had gone. Any explanations, anyone?


**A POLICEMAN told last night of his close encounter with creatures from outer space.**



# BUDDHA The Resplendent One

One of the noteworthy characteristics that distinguishes the Buddha from all other religious teachers is that he did not claim to be a divine being, a divine incarnation, a prophet or a messenger of a God.

The Buddha did speak of himself as a human being but not just another man. He was a man but an extraordinary man. He was beyond the human state inwardly though living the life of a human being outwardly. For this reason he is called a unique being, man par excellence

There are some who take delight in making the Buddha a non-human. They quote a passage from the Anguttara Nikaya (one of the original collections of the Pali Canon ii, 37) and mistranslate it and misunderstand it. The story goes thus:

Once Siddhartha Gautama the Buddha was seated under a tree in the meditation posture senses calmed tranquil of mind, in the attainment of composure by masterly control. Then a brahmin Dona by name approached the Buddha and asked him.

Will your reverence be a god a deva (devobhavissati.)

No, brahmin, I'll not become a deva.

Will your reverence become a gandhabba. (a spirit?)

No, brahmin, I'll not become a gandhabba.

Will your reverence become a yakka (a demon?)

No, brahmin, I'll not become a yakka.

Will your reverence become a human being?

No, brahmin, I'll not become a human being

Who, then, pray, will your reverence become?

Now understand the Buddha's reply carefully.

Brahmin whatever defilements (asavas) there be owing to the presence of which a person may be identified as a god, all those defilements in me are abandoned, cut off at the root, made like a palm-tree stump, not existent of a nature not to arise again in future time.

Those defilements whereby, if they were not abandoned, I should become a gandhabba, a yakka, a human being those defilements in me are abandoned, cut off at the root, made like a palm-tree stump, not existent of a nature not to arise again in future time.

Just as, brahmin a lotus red or white, though born in the water grown up in the water, when it reaches the surface stands there unsoiled by the water -- just so, brahmin, though born in the world, grown up in the world having overcome the world, I abide unsoiled by the world. Take it that I am a Buddha, the Enlightened One the Awakened One (Buddho mamdharehi brahmana.)

What the Buddha said was that he was not a god a gandhabba, a yakka or a human being full of defilements. From the above it is clear that the Buddha wanted the brahmin to know that he was not a human being with defilements. He did not want the brahmin to put him into any of those categories. The Buddha was in the world but not of the world. This is clear from the simile of the lotus.

## Should Ufologists Be Examining Contactee Messages?

In the past few decades the main UFO organizations have avoided the investigation of alleged contactees for several reasons. First, the contactees have been coming out with messages which often include statements from, and names or locations of, alleged extraterrestrials (ETs) and their spacecraft which seem absurd or ludicrous. Some messages included predictions which have fortunately proved either false, or wrong in timing. The ufologists assumed both that we can judge better than any ETs what is absurd and what is not, and that real ETs would feed us only true information. Second, they did not wish to deal with the spiritual side usually encountered in the messages, especially when it runs counter to prevailing Judeo-Christian thought.

Third, they wished to impress non-ufologist scientists with the reality of UFO sightings and associated "hardware" in the sky; this would be more difficult to do if they were to receive ridicule from scientists about the contactees messages. So they took to ridiculing the contactees (or their supportive investigators) as much as they feared ridicule themselves, thus asserting their own credibility for the eyes of scientific skeptics.

Fourth, they naturally feared hoaxes and possible ridicule lest they later be found to have been taken in by a hoax. The Adamski case of the late 1950's and early 60's is perhaps the best known example usually claimed to be a hoax, although it is not clear that the man did not at first have some genuine sightings.

Fifth, contactees messages are usually accompanied by reports of occult events whose understanding defies 20th century science. Examples are mental telepathy and "automatic" writing, the modes of communication reported in many cases. Since such phenomena had been reported before but never established by science as genuine, they also were cause for rejection of contactee cases.

Reasons are accumulating, however, why this course of action by ufology has not been logical. The alien-abduction phenomenon has by now

reached such proportions, especially in the USA, that it is finally being recognized by the main UFO organizations as a real phenomenon. There, the abductee usually receives brief instructions or comfort from the alien (s) via telepathy, and may return from the experience with a short message or two, or be supplied with or recall messages later. The distinction between the abductee and the message-contactee is thus quite blurred: the abductee suffers greater trauma while the contactee receives a lengthier message to disseminate. Perhaps one quarter of all contactees in general consider themselves as both abductees and as contactees with messages. It is not scientifically viable to draw a line and accept the former as real and reject the latter as false or mistaken.

Then, too, some radio-wave astronomers are advocating that increased effort be given to searching the heavens for a message originating many years ago and many light-years away. Is it logical to allow only this search to receive scientific reputability, while rejecting searches based on the idea that ETs are in our vicinity and have been a ware of us for ages? Scientific literature has been accumulating on reasons why ETs may have one or more covert strategies for dealing with emerging societies. Such strategy could well include techniques for causing scientific spokesmen to disbelieve the evidence so that mankind will not be shocked into sudden or premature world-wide awareness of the UFO phenomenon.

Finally, at least one contactee case has been accompanied by a very large amount of supportive photographic evidence which, however, includes much occultness and some suspicious elements which supply ammunition for skeptics both within and without the field of ufology. It is perhaps not well known that the vast bulk of the hundreds of color photographs of posing UFOs from this Meier case have not, or cannot, be shown to be fakes of any kind. At the same time the case contains about the lengthiest alleged ET messages of any messages which make more sense both in their general scientific content and their spiritual content, in my opinion, than that from any other case. It is unfortunate that ufologists preoccupation with fear of ridicule has hindered the dissemination of this message, and helped to keep hidden the many supportive aspects of the case.

Hasty critics rush to conclusion and want others to know that the Buddha was not a human being.

In the same text, *Anguttara Nikaya* (1,22) there is a clear instance where the Buddha categorically declared that he was a human being.

Monks there is one person (puggala) whose birth into this world is for the welfare, and happiness of many, out of compassion for the world, for the gain and welfare and happiness of gods (devas) and humanity. Who is this one person (eka puggala?) It is the Tathagota who is a Consummate One (arahant) a Supremely Enlightened One (samma-sambuddho) Monks, one person born into the world is an Extraordinary Man a Marvellous Man (acchariya manussa.)

Note the Pali word manussa, a human being Yes, the Buddha was a human being but not just another man, but a acchariya manussa, Marvellous Man.

The Buddha texts say that the Bodhisatta (as he is known before he became the Buddha) was in the Tusita heaven (devaloka) but came down to the human world to be born as a human being (manussatta). His parents, King Suddhodana and Queen Mahamaya, were human beings.

The Bodhisatta was born as a man, attained Enlightenment (Buddhahood) as a man, and finally passed away into parinibbana (parinirvana) as a man, Even after his Supreme Enlightenment he did not call himself a God or Brahma or any Supernatural Being; but an extraordinary man.

## **UPDATE ON MARS AND THE WINDSCALE FIRE**

Subsequent to the article **MARS AND THE WINDSCALE BLUNDER** (published in **KALPA-NAVA** Issue No. 11, 1987) the British government released previously classified documents under its 30 year rule, which confirm that the Aetherius Society statement made on 29th October 1957 was astonishingly accurate. "However, other reports are still being kept secret. Some may be released in future years."

Mr. Jonathon Porritt, director of Friends of Earth, yesterday backed moves to seek compensation for civilians where cancer and other illness was likely to be connected to the accident. He also called for government assurances that all information about the Windscale fire had now been made public."

# Flying saucer squad prompts UFO dispute

A FLYING SAUCER has been witnessed by eight policemen over London, opening up old wounds between the promoters and debunkers of unidentified flying objects.

The UFO was seen in the early hours of Sunday morning by Zena Sfeir, 16, a Rugby School pupil who was raking the sky with her telescope looking for the full moon. Miss Sfeir, who lives in Kensington, London, said yesterday that the flat, saucer shaped UFO, grey-green with pink blobs, looked like a "swimming jellyfish". When it spun round, it changed to electric blue.

After an hour's tracking the Sfeir household telephoned the local police. "One policeman came round, saw it and called in a few more," Miss Sfeir said. "They called in two more and they called in two more. In the end eight policemen were witnesses. The moment they saw it they were complete believers."

News of the sighting put the Aetherius Society on full alert at its headquarters, a converted shop in Fulham Road London. The society, which is passionate about flying saucers, regards the Kensington spaceship as further vindication of its beliefs and a well-earned rebuff for mockers like the astronomer, Patrick Moore.

"We're just literally on the phone to the police about it now," Dr Richard Laurence, the society's secretary said. "There's a lot of police interest in flying saucers because they're always on duty looking at the sky. They get a lot of sightings and often feel frustrated because I think they're up against some sort of police of no comment."

"For instance, my colleague's been shifted from department to department for 40 minutes and ended up at the same place three times. That's always a sign there's a bit of a panic on."

"Patrick Moore says it's just Jupiter. I know him of old. I've been on TV with him. As I said to him then, I wouldn't talk about astronomy because I don't know enough about it and he doesn't know anything about flying saucers and should keep quiet about them. Patrick Moore is one of those people who've set out to debunk the subject. Another one is the science correspondent of The Daily Telegraph whose name eludes me at the moment. None of them knows anything about it. They're all prejudiced. We don't think it's strange or eccentric to believe in flying saucers. On the contrary, we think it's eccentric to disbelieve."

## UFO SIGHTED

AN unidentified flying object stalked a family on Australia's desolate Nullarbor Plane, family members say. "It smelt really foul" Patrick Knowles, aged 24, said in a television interview yesterday, after his two brothers and his mother said they were pursued by the object. Authorities are taking the claims seriously after similar sightings by a truck driver and offshore fishermen in the Great Australian Bight, Reuter.

# 'Ello, 'ello . . . that's a UFO

A UFO has been spotted in the night skies over London and that's official, according to Scotland Yard today.

A total of eight startled police officers watched the greygreen, pink and electric blue object as it span, banked and hovered above Kensington.

A Yard spokesman said, "Police officers saw an unidentified object after a call from a members of the public. We are unable to say what it was."

The bizarre incident, which has been reported as a UFO in the station log at Kensington, took place shortly after midnight on Saturday.

## Alerted

Zena Sfeir, 16, had mounted a telescope on the doorstep of the family home in The Little Boltons after spotting a light in the sky.

She called in the local law to verify her sighting. The first sceptical P-c to arrive was astounded to see a saucer shaped object, dazzling in colour.

He asked for assistance and a further two officers arrived. They in turn called back to the station and five more came along.

They spent thirty minutes watching the UFO through the telescope and a pair of binoculars.

## UFO lands on car

PERTH, Australia Thursday (AFP) - Police scientific officers said Wednesday they would examine a car on which an unidentified flying object (UFO) is said to have landed while the vehicle was being driven across the lonely Eyre highway, which links western and south Australia.

Mrs. Faye Noes and her three adult sons told police they saw a bright orange object early on Wednesday near Mundrabilla, about 80 kilometers (50 miles) west of Eucla.

They said they were heading towards south Australia when they encountered the object in the desert.

It landed on the roof of the car, turning the vehicle around and blowing a tyre.

The vehicle's radio and their voices were affected during the incident.

## Cop that, it must be a UFO

An outsize UFO has been spotted in separate incidents by two police crews.

They both described it as a giant oblong block of brilliant light spinning silently through the sky at tremendous speed.

Sergeant Steve Godwin, who was on patrol in Walsall, West Midlands claimed last night: "It was far bigger than a plane."

A senior police officer said: "We are studying their reports."

# CLOSE ENCOUNTERS OF THE FOURTH KIND

THE Knowles family had a close encounter of the **FOURTH** kind, excited UFO experts said last night. That involves actual abduction of a human being by aliens.

An encounter of the first kind is when a UFO is spotted. The second results in a physical effect, such as the scorching of grass by a UFO. And in the third encounter aliens are seen or contacted.

Author Jenny Randles said: "If this story checks out it's the ultimate encounter, the fourth.

"In this kind, people lose periods of time and have some memory loss either self-imposed or induced from outside.

This is probably because they underwent such horrors that the memory is blurred to hide them.

In America, there are claims that abducted young people have been subjected to some kinds of physical and genetic experiments.

## Reports

"This car would have been lifted up for a reason. It would not surprise me if the family underwent some kind of investigation they do not remember. It seems par for the course."

Mr. Randles, director of investigations for the British UFO Research Association, said the Nullabor area had been the site for early nuclear tests and there had been frequent reports of UFOs there.

There was a major sighting in 1957 when a disc-shaped flying saucer was spotted hovering above the detonation site.

Mrs. Randles said the encounter mirrored at least two similar incidents in England.

In June 1978 a Gloucester family's car was lifted and dumped onto a strange road, and in 1981 three women had a similar experience as they drove in Shropshire.

Another expert, Dr. Richard Laurence, agreed that aliens were attracted by nuclear testing.

"We believe extra terrestials are very worried about the terrible effects atomic power could have on our world and through the solar system," he said.

"These incidents are increasing greatly and we believe that a definite reason for this is the development of nuclear power and weapons."

But he added: We believe they are quite friendly."

## Riddle of the eggcup UFO

TWO groups of people have reported credible separate encounters with a UFO in Australia say police.

In the first sighting, a family of four claimed their car was chased by an eggcup-shaped flying object along a remote highway, plucked from the ground and covered in a sort of volcanic ash.

Faye Knowles, a mother of three, also said her speech and that of her sons became slurred during the encounter.

The crew of a tuna boat 50 miles away said they were buzzed by an unidentified flying object and their voices became blurred as a result.

Police said the sightings occurred minutes apart. "We were a little sceptical at first," said Sgt Jim Furnell of Ceduna police in South Australia. "But after investigating, we are treating the reports very seriously."

### Pressure

Forensic scientists will examine the blackish powdery ash found inside and outside Mrs Knowles's car. She told police she was driving through the Nullabor Plain from Perth in Western Australia when she saw a glowing object in her rear window at 2.45 am.

"It apparently picked the car up off the road, shock it quite violently and forced the car up off the road, shook it quite violently and forced the car back with such pressure that one of the tyres was blown," said Sgt Furnell.

"While this was happening the family said their voices were distorted and it was as if they were talking in slow motion."

Sgt Furnell said Mrs Knowles had to drive nearly 400 miles to report the incident. Her car was damaged and covered in ash and the family was shaken.

He said the fishing crew could not have known about the Knowles family's experience when they reported a UFO sighting in the Great Australian Bight.

## Alien bodies

IN THE light of his alleged taste for matters constellatory, President Reagan might care to reconsider the claims of a British author that the CIA in 1952 discovered the remains of four extra-terrestrials near the site of a supposed UFO crash in New Mexico.

The claims were made last year by Timothy Good in his book, *Above Top Secret*. Good published a top secret memo purportedly sent by the first director of the CIA, Adml Roscoe Hillenkoetter, to President - Elect Eisenhower in November 1952, which reported that "four small human like beings had apparently ejected from the craft at some point before it exploded."

Good's storey was denied by the American authorities, who insisted that the memo was a counterfeit. In the past month, however, a senior American academic has come out in support of the document's authenticity.

Dr Roger Westcott, Professor of linguistics at the University of Tennessee, compared the style of Hillenkoetter's report with that of personal letters he wrote, concluding that they were penned by the same man. With Good's book being published for the first time in America next month, the news of Nancy Reagan's star-gazing could not have been more opportune.

## Concrete welcome mat for UFO's

BLMWOOD, Wisconsin, Wednesday (Reuter) A two-square-mile (5 sqkm) concrete welcome mat for Unidentified Flying objects (UFOs) is being planned for this village in western Wisconsin, the man in charge of the project said on Tuesday.

"We believe these spaceships are manned by an intelligence which has been watching up for a long time" said Tom Weber, founder for the UFO Site Corp of nearby Chippewa Falls.

"They are simply waiting for us to take the next step and give some kind of invitation."

Weber is seeking funding from believers around the world for the multi-million dollar landing strip to be built on rolling Wisconsin farmland near Blmwood. The concrete slab outlited with landing lights and a communications system would be manned by scientists around the clock, Weber said.

Residents have made 25 to 30 UFO sightings the past few years, convincing Weber and his associates to build the welcome mat here.

## Like a cool wind going across your forehead

A controversial new book 'Light Years' by Gary Kinder, published by 'Viking' tells you the incredible story of aliens from outer space.

It gives you a ball-by-ball commentary of how a Swiss Eduard Meier came into contact with these beings and how scientists and experts studying Unidentified Flying Objects (UFOs) were stunned by Meier's revelations.

Meier who has only one arm once studied Buddhism and now lives with his Greek wife, and according to the author of the book, has been in regular contact with these beings.

He also claims that since the age of five, he has been telepathically contacted by aliens from a planet 500 light years from earth, in a cluster of stars known as the Pleiades.

"It happens like a shot" he says. "Like a cool wind going across your forehead."

The messages, he claims, directed him to remote locations, where the aliens landed a spaceship about 21 feet across and met him.

At first everyone laughed at him but when Meier produced evidence of clear pictures of the spaceship hovering above the trees, people began to examine his claim a bit further.

He also showed the people a diary in which he had recorded his meetings and conversations with 'Semjase' a 330-year-old female alien. Those who read it were stunned because they found it was written beautifully full of scientific facts and ideas and because Meier was a simple farmer who had no education at all.

Meier amazed scientists and showed perfectly round landing tracks, in the grass no one could reproduce.

However some of the UFO investigating organisations in the United States still dismiss Eduard Meier's claim as a hoax although they cannot prove how a man with no money, no laboratory, no accomplices, a simple camera and only one arm could have faked such pictures.

However many scientists believe intelligent life probably exists on other planets.

## US govt. team found dead aliens, UFO researcher says

LONDON, Monday (Reuter) - The United States held a top-secret investigation into Unidentified Flying Objects (UFO) after World War Two and found the bodies of four humanoids from a crashed flying saucer, according to Britain's leading UFO expert.

The Observer newspapers today quoted UFO researcher Timothy Good as saying a US government committee codenamed 'Majestic-12' examined and then covered up UFO crashes in the late 1940s.

According to Good's book 'Above Top Secret: The Worldwide UFO Cover Up' to be published in July, the MJ-12 committee was set up by President Harry Truman and checked reports about unidentified aircraft sighted in the United States.

Following a report from a local farmer, the committee launched a search for a crashed UFO in a remote area in New Mexico in 1947.

They found the bodies of four humanoid creatures, Good said, quoting what he says is a briefing paper by then CIA head Roscoe Hillenkoetter for Truman's successor Dwight Eisenhower.

'Four small human-like beings had apparently ejected from the craft at some point before it exploded. These had fallen to earth about two miles (three km) east of the wreckage site. All four were dead and badly decomposed due to action by predators and exposure to the elements', the document said.

The Observer said it had seen the briefing but inquiries in several US archives had failed to authenticate it and it could be part of an elaborate hoax.

## We've found Yeti

A TEAM of researchers have come within 30 to 35 yards of a creature they believe to be an abominable snowman.

Tass News Agency reported that the group, led by Igor Tatsl, sighted the creature during a visit to the Pamir mountains in Soviet Central Asia near the Afghanistan border.

The group from Kiev is preparing for another trip and hopes to make closer contact.

Mr. Tatsl and other members of the group noted several night visits to their camp by the creature. "After watching the people for some time, it went back into the thickets," said Tass.

The group tried not to scare it and hoped for a daylight encounter soon. The report added: "There is evidence it is showing an interest in them and attempting, even if timidly, to make contact."

## Scientists discover 'hole' in Antarctica's ozone layer

NEW DELHI, Tuesday (Reuter) - Indian scientists conducting experiments in the Antarctic say they have discovered a mysterious 'hole' in the earth's ozone layer over the icy continent.

"This is one of the most challenging things we have ever come across in atmospheric chemistry." Dr. H. P. Rajan, a member of India's sixth expedition to the Antarctic, which returned recently, told the Press Trust of India today.

"Whatever the source is, we need to understand it, because this is a change in the ozone that is of absolutely unprecedented proportions" Rajan said.

Scientists have warned that pollution is destroying the ozone layer, the earth's main shield against the sun's ultraviolet rays, and could lead to a rise in cases of skin cancer.

Rajan was quoted as saying a major worry was that the cause of the 'hole' is still unclear.

## Bermuda triangle mystery resolved?

MOSCOW, (APN) The theory of Soviet scientist Genrikh Talalayevski explains many strange phenomena in the Bermuda triangle. In his calculations the rotating body loses weight and at a critical speed even gains negative weight. He has proved experimentally that a gyroscope rotating at a fast speed becomes 14 per cent lighter.

With these data Talalayevski has explained the nature of tornadoes, which can lift and carry at large distances men, animals and even houses. The discovery of whirlpool formations in the ocean has led him to the idea of resolving the Bermuda triangle mysteries from the standpoint of his theory.

"According to the gravitation equation which follows from my theory the rotating body on the whole loses in weight" Talalayevski says. "In the meantime in the centre of rotation the weight increases. The more the body's initial mass the more it grows. This is what happens in the Bermuda triangle: gravitational anomalies emerge in the centre of big oceanic whirls. When a ship gets in the centre of rotation, the powerful gravitational force carries her to the bottom, where the strong currents complete the tragedy and carry the flotsam and jetsam hundreds of kilometres away."

**‘‘Hush up’’**

The incident happened, says Alan in a November dawn as he was driving his panda car just 150 yards from the police station at Todmorden West Yorks.

Alan, twice commended, for superb detection work and a highly-rated hobby on the Yorkshire Ripper squad, claims he saw a diamond-shaped UFO hovering only five feet off the ground. Its windows were tinted and the bottom half was rotating, he said.

That was the start of his inter-galactic experience which, he claims, ended up in a huge police ‘‘hush up’’ so the Public would not be alarmed.

**Hypnosis**

He later had to quit the West Yorkshire force after being severely wounded in a brawl.

‘‘And I bet they were very relieved to get rid of me, said Alan of Summerfield Road, Todmorden.

They treated me badly after I told them of my sighting. One of my senior officers said it was probably best all round that I left.’’

Father of three Alan, now a club steward, added that when he saw the low-flying starship he tried to call for help.

**But his VHF car radio and personal walkie-talkie had both mysteriously stopped working.**

It was under intense regression hypnosis that Alan’s space ordeal came to light.

Yesterday, with his solicitor at his side, the former PC said: ‘‘it was clear from the way I was talking that I had been supposedly kidnapped by this thing.

‘‘After seeing this object on the Burnley trunk road in Todmorden I was full of panic. It was about 20 feet across and the bottom half of the craft was rotating.

‘‘Under hypnosis I felt a floating sensation. I then spoke of being in an examination room.’’

‘‘A giant VDU screen filled the inside of the space ship’’ he went on.

**I recalled a man about seven feet high looking down at me. His lips did not move yet he was speaking in a language I understood.**

He wanted me to lay down on a large table. Then he strapped connection wires to my right wrist and left foot.

**Report**

‘‘Robot-type machines which came and plugged themselves into my connections. They made noises like morse code.’’

The British Unidentified Flying Object Research Association took up his case and compiled files on the 1980 encounter.

# Highway Chase by the aliens

**AUSTRALIA** was gripped by UFO fever last night as a family told how their car was plucked from the road by aliens.

Still visibly frightened, Mrs. Faye Knowles appeared on television to describe her ordeal on a remote highway.

She said a huge, egg cup-shaped object loomed into her rear-view mirror as she and her three sons drove across the Nullabor Plains from Perth early on Wednesday.

She accelerated at top speed but failed to lose the UFO.

Then the terrified family stopped, got out and hid in bushes-but the mystery craft still wouldn't go away.

"It was there, waiting for us, looking for us", she said. "It was up the road a bit further from us.

"When we hopped into the car to take off again it came after us. It wouldn't leave us alone."

Then the UFO pounced on the Ford felstar saloon, clinging to the roof.

"I wound down the window, it came in the car like smoke. I thought we were going to die.

"We were going silly-something was going into our heads. We did not know what it was.

"It felt like we were dying, I was screaming. I was hysterical."

The car was picked up from the road and shaken violently.

## Force

Faye and her sons Patrick, 24, Sean, 21, and Wayne, 18, tried to shout but their voices became slurred as if they were talking in slow motion.

Then the car was returned to the ground with such force that one of the tyres burst.

Patrick said: "Something seemed to be on top of us. It seemed to get a grip on the car.

"The car began to smoke. The dogs in the car started going crazy. We wound up the windows and the car began to smoke up inside.

"It smelled like it was dead bodies or something. It smelled really foul-like gas or something."

Truck driver Graham Hewley told how he found the bewildered and frightened family in a road house after the encounter.

"They were still in a state of shock," he said. Even the dogs were cowering in the front of the car.

#### Damaged

"There was soot all over the car and four dents as if the car had been picked up by a magnet.

"I can't explain it but I know I saw four very terrified people."

Mr. Hewley said truck drivers had seen mysterious lights over the stretch of road for the last 30 years.

"We don't stop unless we can help it", he said.

**A truck driver and car driver, travelling in the opposite direction on the same highway, also reported seeing the UFO.**

And the crew of a tuna boat 50 miles away said they were buzzed by a strange object and their voices also became blurred.

There were further sightings over Tasmania.

Police said the sightings were all independent and there was no way the witnesses could have known of each other's encounters.

"We were a little bit sceptical at first," said Sergeant Jim Funnell.

"But after investigating, we are treating the reports very seriously.

#### Hurt

"It apparently picked the car up off the road, shook it quite violently and forced the car back with such pressure that one of the tyres was blown."

Forensic scientists will today examine the black ash left inside and outside the family's car.

The Royal Australian Air Force has been warned and is launching its own investigation.
