- The largest number of reports of UFOs comes from Kiev and the Crimea, - says Yaroslav Sochka, a researcher-ufologist, head of the club "UFODOS". -

Territorially, UFO active regions belong southern regions of Ukraine, where up to 40% of all reports come from. Why this is so is difficult to answer.

As before, there is a tendency to activity UFOs in remote rural areas, their special intensification in times of disasters and social unrest. Here, in fact, and now, during the global crisis, reports of UFOs are actively coming from the Crimea, Kharkov, Poltava, Dnepropetrovsk.

- Probably, not all messages are classified by you as significant?

- We enter about half a hundred pieces of evidence into the database every year (almost the same number of messages is ignored by us due to insufficient data or their obvious absurdity). And most recently, the Transcarpathian ufological club "UFODOS" launched a national archive of UFOs in Ukraine (UFOBUA). We collect evidence nepo

mediocre UFO eyewitnesses from different angles countries, there is an opportunity to analyze them, sys to thematize.

Recently, the number of photographic and video evidence has increased, which is explained by the availability of digital equipment. Thus, in most cases, you can immediately understand the fantasy roars an eyewitness or not.

And in fact real - though not declared - meetings with UFOs even more! Not everyone dares to tell about a strange flying object in the sky - there is still a fear of eyewitnesses to be eight neighbors, colleagues.

In addition, many UFO witnesses still simply do not know where, what and how to report. "Ufological illiteracy" of the Ukrainian population available.

- In that case, advise how a person should behave when he comes across a UFO? Most of us would probably be scared, panicked...

- As a rule, a meeting with a UFO is fleeting, without physical contact. Therefore, you should not panic and set yourself up for the negative in advance. When meeting with an unidentified object - no matter what it looks like, one should adhere to neutrality, behave restrainedly, but should not take any aggressive actions. It is important not to approach

to them.
If contact with a UFO has occurred, so have you even felt certain actions

from the side of the object, notify the places authorities, law enforcement agencies, fire the Commission on Emergencies, the military. It is desirable to involve in work on research of circumstances on a place of grazh Danish and military specialists.

More. In any case, try to document the event and contact ufologists to establish the facts. For in most cases, as practice shows, your testimony can be demanded ... only in the ufological environment.

UFOs in Ukraine in January of the new year 2009 begin to intensify! According to one journalist, the interest in ufology in Ukraine (and not only) is due to reports of UFOs that flew in Washington immediately after the inauguration of 44 US presidents (there was such information). And it follows that news agencies regularly receive information about UFO sightings, but publish them, as I understand it, only if such information is relevant at the moment! And therefore, we do not have objective information (UFO reports are simply ignored by news agencies)! Recognizing this sad fact, we begin to flip through the inter

Igor Bereznyuk, an employee of the Kharkiv Planetarium, last week photographed an unidentified flying object moving from Sumka Street towards the Blagoveshchensk Market. The object could not be a star, as the stars did not break through the fog. The flying object was a glowing ball and had the characteristics of a UFO: the silhouette did not look like the famous artificial aircraft, moved silently, did not blink and was able to stop abruptly and "hang" in the air.

This is not the first time that the Blagoveshchensk market has become an area of increased UFO attention. So, no later than in October last year, I. Bereznyuk filmed several other objects that were moving over the "Blagbaz": two objects with single lights and one consisting of three lights.

According to the ufologist, different people, often quite solid, come to the Museum of Cosmonautics and Ufology of the Kharkiv Planetarium - the first in Ukraine - and talk about UFO sightings.

"As an ufologist, I treat it from the point of view of space structure. Through messengers, through levels of development, more developed races try to teach us, to guide us. They always came to us, maybe even, they created us, the people, "I. Bereznyuk said.

UFO in Dnepropetrovsk (publication January 23, 2009, 8:30 <http://smi.dp.ua/dnepropetrovsk/nlo-v-nebe nad-pridneprovskom-101.html>)

A week ago, a resident of Pridneprovsk filmed an unidentified flying object on a video camera. The UFO appeared for about eight hours in the area of the Dnieper CHP and was in the sky for more than five minutes, moving all the time, changing shape and color. The video was shown to ufologist Anatoly Kulchitsky, according to whom the material is worthy of attention. In order to draw any conclusions, the material must be sent to the Academy of Sciences in Kyiv. According to the researcher, this is not an isolated case of UFO sightings over the Dnipropetrovsk region.

Mikhail Shcherbina, a lecturer at Sumy National Agrarian University, is one of the "dinosaurs" of Sumy ufology. He became interested in ufology during the perestroika. It all started with



books where the existence of UFOs was denied. But Mikhail Efimovich, having studied the facts given in the book, he interpreted them not against, but precisely in favor of the existence of unidentified flyers. He founded a student ufology club at the Sumy Pedagogical Institute, where he worked at the time. And then threw

- This case has stalled because there is no new information about UFOs. Everyone hoped that "official" contact with would take place soon

representatives of extraterrestrial civilizations and maybe they will help us in some way. But this did not happen.

Nevertheless, Mikhail Efimovich is convinced that this phenomenon must be investigated. "These objects are like guinea pigs to them. It seems to me that these creatures once flew into our system and live here. The moon, Mars, may be their bases. What they are, no doubt."

We also contacted Sergei Khvostov, an activist with the Sumy city youth association, the Center for Ufological Research, Contact. Sergei said that formally "Contact" no longer exists. Registration of the organization did not justify itself -

she did not add opportunities in terms of researching the unidentified, but there was an extra "paper" work. And some participants departed from the topic.

This is as far as Sumy is concerned. But in Kiev, according to Sergei, ufology is much more active. But the people of Kiev have more opportunities - primarily financial. For example, they have the necessary measuring equipment, good photo and video equipment, with which you can go to a place where the abnormal and unidentified have been seen, and claim to conduct research there.

UKRAINIAN SCIENCE IN THE YEAR

Many of us remember the rampant passion for "flying saucers" - the late 80's - early 90's of last century. Then the UFO boom was provoked by the lifting of censorship on such publications in the former Soviet Union. Meanwhile, "plates" roamed the sky of Ukraine since the Middle Ages (see, for example, Lyudmila Zaglada "A wonderful miracle appeared in Polotsk - at night there was a stampede, something moaned in the street, demons roamed like people...", "Facts and comments rii", March 17, 2004), and so to this day have remained unidentified flying objects. Over time, only the public interest in such "flying objects" has changed (the political and economic situation in the country plays a decisive role here), and the very fact of the reality of the "UFO phenomenon" is currently virtually undisputed.

Ufology, as a complex scientific field for the study of UFOs and related issues, was formed in the late 1940s in the United States. At present, there are state, military and civilian UFO research organizations in almost every country in the world. The productivity of ufological research itself is hampered by the following factors: secrecy of research at the state and military levels; economic factor, including the lack of funds for the construction of search, observation and laboratory bases (manifestations of the phenomenon are unpredictable, and we do not have money for "phantoms" and "ghosts", of course); and the superfactor: the unpredictable mimicry of the "UFO phenomenon" itself (its explanation requires a revision of many existing ideas about Life, Man, the Universe).

Public interest in the "UFO phenomenon", as mentioned above, is dictated by the political and economic situation in the country. This conclusion fully illustrates the experience of Ukraine. At the same time, research interest does not depend on "weather", as UFO registrations continue, and their activity does not depend on the change of political leaders, inflation, rising gas and oil prices...

Yes, research on the "UFO phenomenon" in Ukraine continues. The very structure of research has undergone radical changes since the UFO boom of the late twentieth century. We have not made any significant discoveries and achievements in the field of recognizing the phenomenon, but the evolution of the attitude of both scientists and ordinary people to this issue is noticeable. In general, this period was characterized by both ups and downs. In other words, there is the news is good and bad.

A significant event in this period was the decline of unhealthy interest in UFOs and "green men". In the official press, the flow of reports about UFO sightings and "contact insights" fell sharply, provoked by the "thirst for a miracle" of the reading fraternity. People stopped reading Mukhortov's prayers at night, attaching photos of aliens to sick organs, and wearing amulets recommended by "brothers in mind." Schizophrenics again became Napoleons, not guests from other solar systems. In public transport and in the workplace, the topic of "UFOs" has receded into the background (but it was the other way around!). Along with the "plate" excitement, psychics, accompanied by telepaths, mystics, occultists, and other supernatural gangs, have disappeared. A natural process, the outcome of which was seen by John Baker (US diplomat): "In your country, as a result of certain processes, these phenomena have become the center of public attention. It will pass ... And to study such things, of course, is necessary. to be engaged in specialists (S. Kurguzov, "Guests from the Mirror, or the return of aliens", -

Kyiv, "Youth", 1992, -217 p.).

In addition to the fact that the nation has "recovered", there are a number of other positive aspects. For example, the quality (ie truthfulness) of UFO messages has become higher and cleaner. Writing stories about encounters with humanoids and flights to other planets became unfashionable and "the delusion of the gray mare..." in the archives of ufologists began to decrease markedly (the author does not say about the complete eradication and absence of this negative phenomenon).

But the medal has two sides. With the agony of the UFO boom, the public organizations of ufologists, which existed on the territory of Ukraine in practically all regional centers, began to disappear. Their existence depended (and depends) on the number and activity of members. And as soon as the Uphomianians receded into the background, the whole system, which was formed during the Soviet era, collapsed (however, as well as "Great, Mighty..."). At present, however, there are a number of informal organizations studying the topic of "UFOs", and, as a rule, these are groups of 3-5 people that exist in major cities of Ukraine. There are also virtual clubs uniting dozens of ufologists (like the Transcarpathian "UFODOS"), "multiple" public organizations (like the Sumy "Contact") and attempts to create an all-Ukrainian ufology center (like the Kiev "Probe").

The problems with the ufology research network are not as terrible as they are portrayed. First, virtually all archives accumulated by "dead" organizations are transferred "from hand to hand." Secondly, almost all the accumulated ufological experience, as well as new observations of UFOs, developments and developments in this area, can be "dug up" on the Internet. And third, there are a lot of serious researchers of the "UFO phenomenon" for whom "temporary difficulties" do not affect enthusiasm. In general, "in recent years, despite the fragmentation, Ukrainian specialists in mysterious phenomena and artifacts have continued research in areas of interest to them" (Minutes of the meeting of the Ukrainian Center for the Study of Mysterious Phenomena and Artifacts, Kyiv, October 21, 2004).

A special positive moment for the development of the ufological movement in Ukraine in recent years was the development of Internet technologies, which allowed UFO enthusiasts to fill gaps with a lack of information, as well as quickly communicate and accumulate facts and events for further analysis. Previously, ufological facts and opinions looked like a broken mosaic! Thanks to the Internet, they are accumulating into a huge pyramid, access to which is now unproblematic. And although the Internet offers great prospects for collecting and storing information, such resources in the Ukrainian sector are developing rather poorly. 1. Working languages: Ukrainian, Russian, English. Materials of the article are typed in the text editor MS Word for Windows.
2. Recommended structure of materials:
 - Statement of the problem in general and its connection with important scientific or practical tasks;
 - Analysis of recent research and publications, which initiated the solution of this problem and on which the author relies, the selection of previously unsolved parts of the general problem, which is the subject of this article;
 - Formulation of the goals of the article (task statement);
 - Presentation of the main material of the study with a full justification of the obtained scientific results;
 - Conclusions from this study and prospects for further exploration in this direction.
3. Sheet format: A4 (210x297 mm). Margins: left - 20 mm; right - 20 mm; upper - 25 mm; lower - 25 mm. Line spacing is single. Materials are typed in the following order:

Information about the authors - initials, surname (Times New Roman Cyr, font 11, bold) - alignment on the right edge, indentation at the top - 12 pt, bottom - 12 pt.
Name of materials (Times New Roman Cyr, font 11, bold) - alignment on the left edge, indentation at the top - 12 pt, bottom - 12 pt, all characters are capitalized, without hyphenation.

Text part

Abstract not more than 5 lines (Times New Roman Cyr, font 10, italic) - alignment in width (without paragraph, indentation on the left - 10 mm, right - 10 mm, top - 6 pt, bottom - 6 pt);

Article text (Times New Roman Cyr, font 11), indent of the first line of the paragraph 10 mm - width alignment, without hyphenation;

Images are provided in separate jpeg files (*.jpg, *.jpe). We do not allow the use of embedded graphics MS Word or other graphics programs. Figures must be in black and white;

Captions to figures (Times New Roman Cyr, font 10) - center alignment;

Table headings (Times New Roman Cyr, font 10, bold) - center alignment, numbering (Times New Roman Cyr, font 10, bold) - right alignment.

To set formulas, use the built-in formula editor in MS Word for Windows using the following styles:

- Text - Times New Roman Cyr;
- Function - Times New Roman Cyr; italic
- Variable - Times New Roman Cyr; italic
- LCGreek (Small Greek) - Symbol UCGreek (Large Greek) - Symbol;
- Symbol - Symbol;
