

CASE NO 1.

An Abduction In Fife

On September 24th 1996, an astounding and rather frightening event, (allegedly) took place on a lonely part of countryside, beside a Fife road. Two females and their two children, at about 8 o'clock at night were driving to their local village for some supplies, when they unknowingly started to become aware of bright lights in the sky above them. These lights were not a normal street light's, since they were bright enough to illuminate a near by field as the witnesses got near, they saw that the beams of light that they had been witnessing for the past few minutes emanated from a dark, stationery object in the clear dark sky.

At first, they assumed that it must have been an aeroplane, however, when they began to study the object more, it became clear that it was a huge Triangular shaped craft which they estimated to be at least 80 yards across with a large dome on top. The craft that they were studying suddenly moved away, and the witnesses then heard the sound of a conventional craft somewhere in the vicinity at the same time. The witnesses tracking the object could see it, now high up in the night sky stationery, just like a normal night star. Later, on in the evening the witnesses went to the same spot, at around 21.45 Hrs, they had went in the village contacted the U.F.O Magazine to report the sighting. This time around in the same time there was a powerful blue glow coming from a point just above the tree level, above the tree level was a star like object pulsating all the while growing larger and smaller. It was then that they all noticed with a little alarm many small figures (some reports have mentioned hundreds) in the fields and woods. Several seemed to be taller than the rest at around a height of seven feet, the tall beings had dark skin, oriental shaped eyes and seemed to be supervising the smaller beings. The small figures were moving towards a black object on the ground, the witnesses became a little frightened by these events and left to go home yet again. However, the two women did return with a male boy this time armed with a pair of binoculars, when they returned the object was in the sky again, and they all could see it more clearly and described it as being amber in colour with dark indentations all around it, rotating slowly and occasionally tilting on it's axis.

The Roswell Incident

In July 1947, an incident occurred at Roswell, well an (allegedly) incident occurred at Roswell in which a large quantity of debris which was recovered by the 509th Bomber Group of the U.S. Army from a field which was owned by Mac Brazel near Corona, New Mexico. The debris recovered supposedly was very abnormal metallic foil like substance which was like skin when someone touch it, this debris could not be destroyed, it could not bend, crease or be cut.

On Tuesday July 8th A press release was issued by Colonel William Blanchard the commander of the 509th Bomber group at Roswell Army Air Field stating in the newspaper, "Roswell Daily Record", that the bomber group had recovered wreckage from a flying saucer and that it was of extraterrestrial origin.

The following day, the late general Thomas Du Bose received a top secret telephone call from Washington DC. ordering a complete cover up of what 509th Bomber group had recovered and saw that day, the late general was ordered by General McMullen that the story that was released in the Roswell Daily Record was not accurate and what was really found was debris from a weather balloon experiment that went wrong, called Project Mogul. Before Du Bose died he said that it was a huge cover up that the material recovered from Roswell was flown under heavy guard from Fort Worth Texas to Wright Field (now Paterson AFB) at Dayton, Ohio.

The Roswell incident didn't emerge until 1978 when Major Jesse Marcel the intelligence officer of the 509th Bomber group at Roswell at that time and one of the first officers at the scene said on national TV. that the wreckage he saw that day was nothing made on Earth and that this was all a cover up by the U.S. government. He states that the original press release was correct, it's obvious that the military wanted to keep something very secret which came down from the sky which was probably an extraterrestrial craft with beings on board.

UFOLOGY PROVES IT'S POINT

AN ARTICLE BY MALCOLM ROBINSON ON A RECENT TV. SUCCESS FOR UFOLOGY

Will Ufology ever be proved as a serious subject? We all know that it finds itself at the forefront of many media jokes, and no matter how impressive the evidence can be, apart from the would be believers, ufology has never proven it's point. Well not so, the case for Ufology was recently proven in court, (admittedly mock court) on Friday 21st of March 1997, Grampian Television based in Aberdeen, Scotland, completed it's series of programmes entitled 'we the jury'.

This programme is set up in a court and takes in both Topical issues, issues that the general public would like to see being debated. For it's last programme in the current series, they decided to debate the issue of Ufo's in Scotland and the people who have claimed to have seen them, were there and was there a case to answer, are Ufo's and aliens sightings a reality?. For the first time in the history of Ufology the subject was to be given a serious hearing in court with a professional jury made up of individuals from all walks of life. Presenting the case, for the Reality of Ufo's was Malcom Robinson, founder of the Scottish Research Group, " Strange Phenomena Investigations" whose study into the wave of UFO sightings over Bonnybridge in Central Scotland is well known. Opposing the belief that Ufo's are a reality was ArchSceptic and Debunker, Mr Stewart Campbell from Edinburgh whose books debunk Ufo's and the Loch Ness monster are well known. Supporting Mr Stewart in the court audience were many Professional and amateur astronomers including Professor Archie Roy of Glasgow University.

Clearly, then the opposition were of high standing and their views that Ufo's were a non reality would no doubt be presented with academic vigour. Mr Robinsons supporters for the motion that Ufo's were a reality were made up. primarily of UFO witness which also included Scotlands most famous UFO abductee's Gary Wood and colin Wright and also SPI members including Billy Devlin. The stage was set then for what looked like a heated debate and never have more truer words have been said. Mr Robinson then took the floor and spoke to the jury about, close proximate UFO sightings, radar visual sightings and the fact that the sheer volume and weight of impressive UFO case were growing each year. He asked the jury to consider this and also to remember the fact that this was truly a Global phenomenon of immense importance. The hushed court did listen intently as Mr Robinson delivered his speech after which it was the turn of the sceptic Stewart CAmpbell to present his case reading from notes (Mr Robinson didn't require this stimulus to get his point over) Mr Campbell asked the jury to consider that there was no real evidence to prove that Aliens or Ufo's were visiting this planet, and that the whole natural explanations from temperature inversions layers to mirages.


The Probare Institute

THE PROBARE INSTITUTE: The verb to, "Prove" has it's root in the Latin word, "probare".

This is what we are about using rational scientific methods to provide definitive proof of the existence of Ufo's. The probare institute was founded in 1995 by a group of engineers, it grew out of those debates of trying to reconcile the lack of hard evidence with the fact that millions of people have experienced UFO phenomena. The probare institute is totally independent we are not funded by the government nor do we have any mysterious benefactors, a spokesman was quote as saying. (Please note that Lanarkshire UFO Group have no alliance with the probare institute) Our approach is agnostic neither believing nor disbelieving in Ufo's, what we do believe is that if they exist then they can be observed and recorded scientifically. We are not concerned with cover up's theories, governments may or may not have proof of Ufo's, we intend to make all our findings available for public discussion. THE DEFINITIVE PROOF: Ufo's may exist in one or two realms, firstly, they may be real, whether they are alien or advance terrestrial technologies is not really the question here. What matters is that they are tangible, concrete, real. If this is the case then they can obey the laws of physics. Put it this way if they can be seen they can be photographed, if they can be heard, they can be recorded. Secondly, they may be supernatural or ethereal, existing beyond the realms of the real universe. If this is the case then no scientific enquiry will reveal their existence it is rather like trying to scientifically prove the existence of God. It cannot be done, however, they may be a mixture of the two supernatural entities which can manifest themselves in the real universe. We cannot comment on the supernatural aspects, but whatever their origin if they exhibit natural phenomena- light, heat, etc. Then we can observe or record them with instrumentation what constitutes definitive proof, short of capturing a UFO/ whilst we would like to capture one we see this as being highly unlikely.

We believe, however, that it may be possible to provide proof using high altitude rockets, radar and electromagnetic detectors. If our results are negative, this does not rule out the existence of Ufo's. WE would just try again with better instrumentation.

THE PROBARE EXPERIMENT: UFO DETECTION within two extremes, firstly, Random sightings which by their nature do not involve rigorous scientific methods. Secondly, a vast detection network similar to the surveillance systems of the MOD The former is unsatisfactory, the latter impracticable, we had to be realistic so if anyone requires more information send an stamped address envelope to John Baines.
