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STONE AGE X-RAYS?

Do prehistoric cave paintings and rock carvings contain a hidden secret within them?

PREHISTORIC ART, in the form of those magnificent cave paintings and rock carvings, often displays a greater insight into the world of the artists concerned than do many other artifacts. Is what we dismiss as "primitive art" more a reflection of the thought processes of an enlightened "primitive" Stone Age man?

It is difficult, if not impossible, to give a satisfactory definition of "primitive man" as distinct from "civilised man." Even if we take our own civilisation as a standard, the question arises which side or feature of that civilisation should be considered as decisive. Three elements have been suggested; Christian morals, scientific knowledge and technical achievements. But a close examination of both primitive and ancient cultures shows that in these things they differ from ours only by degree.


That stone age man possessed a level in perception of his world that was at least the equal of our own, I believe to be self-evident and is partially locked within the visual legacy we have uncovered at scattered sites across the globe.

In examining such art forms found in Africa, America, Asia and the South Seas, a curious correlation of style has consistently cropped up

and relates to what I have come to regard as "X-ray" drawings. These would seem to go beyond the stylised images and often geometrically charged pictures so familiar to most of us. They are quite detailed in content and contain within them skeletal outlines and sometimes internal organs present in both animals and humans alike.

I present copies of two such drawings here and in the case of the fish, taken from a drawing discovered in New Ireland, I have managed to successfully identify most all its component parts. It is as if it had either been dissected or, as I have come to regard such work, X-rayed. The animal shown is from a cave painting discovered in British Columbia, Canada and is a mythological scene depicting a wolf swallowing a human figure. Again, the animal's internal organs are clearly defined, as is its vertebrae. The human figure also appears

in X-ray form, the outline of its ribcage testifying to that fact.

Easter Island Has Many

THE FIRST KNOWN sighting of Easter Island was in 1687 when an English pirate named Davis sailed past while outrunning a hurricane. He reported it as "a fair high island" with sandy beaches and high mountains and for many years it was called "Davis Land", and was believed to lie in 27 degrees latitude approximately 500 miles west of South America.

After Davis sighted it, the island "disappeared" for 35 years. Other sailors searched in vain and it was not seen again until Easter Sunday, 1722. This time a Dutch sea captain named Rogeween landed on the island and renamed it Easter Island in honour of the day.

Perhaps "renamed" is not just correct, for the island did not fit Davis' description and it did not lie where he had charted it. As late as 1928 a tourist ship reported she had sailed over the latitude and longitude of Easter Island and found no trace of it. Yet when the next ship came along, a Chilean gunboat, there was the island safe and snug in its usual place. It has also been charted 300 to 500 miles from its present location. Some believe that, like the mysterious land shoals off West Africa, Easter Island is on the move.

Most everyone who has heard of the Island is aware of the strange sphinx-like statues that

stand implacably gazing out to sea. These images have no counterparts in the world. Their foreheads are high with protruding brows. Their eyes lie in deep shadow. Their noses are long and thin, chins square and heavy and the ears reach to the lower curve of the jaw. Each weighs some 20 to 40 tons. Who built them and exactly for what purpose continues to be an enigma.

There is yet another riddle that remains unanswered - the indecipherable writing. It is a curious form of communication which no one can read today. It consists of a script engraved on wooden tablets and taking the form of pictographs representing stylized figures of men, animals, fish and so on. Every other line is inverted, so that when one line is read the reader has to turn the tablet upside down to read the following line, and so on.

Now here is the real riddle of this odd script. The only other place in the world where similar writings have been found is at Mohenjo-daro in the Indus Valley in the desert country of western India!

...MARS CALLING EARTH...

DID AN AUSTRALIAN radio amateur (Ham) nearly 70 years ago receive intelligent signals from the planet Mars?

It was the night of August 22, 1924, when radio was still a youngster and the airwaves were not so overburdened with signals as they are today. When tuning was often carried out with the aid of a cat's whisker and antennae were lengths of wire usually 50 metres or more.

Mars was a mystery made all the more so by recent reports from Percival Lowell, of Lowell Observatory, Arizona, that the famous "canals" were the work of superior engineering intelligence on that planet.

The young Australian, known only as "Jerry", possessed a genius for radio construction and his results from an assembled collection of tubes, valves, coils, wires and batteries, found him regularly tuning in to radio stations as far away as Berlin, Rome, France and the Far East. It was a hobby that was to produce startling results, one cold cloudless night in the southern hemisphere.

He had chosen this particular evening well. For it was now that Mars was to be at its closest point to Earth for the remainder of this century. The receiver he had been working on was something new. Instead of the regular shortwave bands, the frequencies this radio could tune to were much higher. Very much higher in fact and beyond the current use of terrestrial stations.

He sat for hours that night, listening as the code kept repeating over and over again. Oh, how he had wished that as well as a receiver he had built a transmitter with which to respond to those mysterious airborne signals. Did they indeed come from the planet Mars? Perhaps the year 2000 will tell us, as the planet moves ever closer once more.

IN FEBRUARY of 1891 whilst the whaling ship 'The Star of the East' was off the Falkland Islands, a large bull cachalot, (or sperm whale), was sighted and the whale boats were launched. They succeeded in harpooning the whale but in securing it one of the whale boats was smashed and Seaman John Bartley disappeared, before the whale was killed.

They dismembered the cachalot the following day and Bartley was found alive in the stomach. He was a raving maniac for two weeks but completely recovered eventually, except for the bleaching of the exposed parts of his body which had been acted upon by the whale's gastric juices.

DO VAMPIRES EXIST? A horrifying catalogue of murder on an American fishing boat in 1867 made people's blood curdle when events during that fateful trip were eventually brought to light. It ended with a Portuguese seaman, listed in court records strangely as "James Brown," being charged with murder and vampirism. He was to serve 25 years in jail for his crime.

Brown worked as a deckhand and during 1867 he shipped out of Boston on a trawler bound for the Labrador fishing grounds off the Canadian coast. When the ship had been a few



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SHORT ANSWER TO ANCESTRY

WE PROBABLY WOULD not recognise him from Adam if he came up and poked us in the ribs! According to Prof. Gerard Lucotte, of the College de France in Paris, we are all descendants of a pygmy who lived 200,000 years ago in what is now the Central African Republic.

His Garden of Eden was located in a triangle of land between the Oubangui, the Sanga and the Lobaye rivers. Prof. Lucotte's theory differs sharply with other scientists, who have concluded that people evolved into modern humans independently in different parts of the world.

After studying blood samples from French males, Prof. Lucotte used a computer to find which parts of their genetic fingerprint would have been present in man's ancestor. Several African populations were studied and it was discovered that genetic material identified by the computer was prevalent among a remote tribe of pygmies called the Aka.

This seems to fit in very well with American studies conducted by Prof. Allan Wilson, of the University of California. His 1987 investigations at Berkeley concluded that Adam's partner, Eve, had been a sub-Saharan woman.

days out of port, one of the crew mysteriously disappeared. As they had run into some rough seas it was presumed that the sailor had been washed overboard. But when another man disappeared a few days later, the captain ordered the entire ship searched from top to bottom.

When the searchers reached the hold of the ship, even the most hardened seamen among them sickened at the sight that met their eyes. Brown was down on his knees, bending over the missing crewman, greedily sucking the blood from the man's body. Nearby lay the corpse of the first seaman who had disappeared. His body had been drained of every ounce of its blood.

Taken back to Boston in irons, Brown was duly charged, convicted and given the death penalty. But President Johnson later commuted his sentence to life imprisonment. While in jail, the seaman eventually murdered two other persons in order to satisfy his vampirish lust for fresh, human blood and was later to die himself at the National Asylum in Washington.

Few books have caused as much merriment as "A Century Of Inventions," published in 1655 by Edward, Marquess of Worcester. To its readers it seemed impossible fantasy, yet today we take the Marquess' ideas as a matter of course.

Born in 1601, inventor Edward listed plans for such "marvels" as explosive projectiles that could sink a ship, mechanical robots, an adding machine, a repeating cannon and how to make a man fly.

Experts believe the Marquess made a working model of a steam engine just before his death on April 3, 1667.

CROP CIRCLES - JUST ANOTHER LOAD OF OLD CORN!


Can We Burst The Bubble On The Snubble?

WHAT A HARVEST throughout the length and breadth of the United Kingdom during 1990! As media interest was awakened again and weeks passed, so shapes appearing in farmers' cornfields responded by becoming progressively intricate and more profound. Simple circles, it seems, were just a touch mundane and by the time doomed 'Operation Blackbird' got underway there were some corkers - pictograms, no less, all set to tease press and public alike.

Crop circles are nothing new, of course, and not confined just to Britain either. They have appeared regularly on a world-wide basis for many years; anywhere there is a good crop to flatten and a ready audience to impress. Often inextricably linked with the UFO phenomenon, sightings of unexplained lights in the sky near a location of circles is not uncommon. The scoffers scoff, the believers believe and maybe the hoaxers carry right on hoaxing. Pretty soon you get the opinions of "experts" armed with unsubstantiated

facts, who seek to bolster their claims by conjecture. Get the picture? Then a relatively "iffy" cycle of events becomes elevated to cult status.

It is of course true that circles



are created - but by someone, not a something. The very process of such nocturnal happenings bothers me, as does a welcoming acceptance by many to embrace much of this "evidence." Look at any picture of a crop circle - the aerial ones are best of course. Identify just one which is truly geometrical in its pattern or structure. Circular outlines aren't quite circular, the centres often aren't so central and lines - the simplest of all to

create - never really are quite straight and true.

Evidence of man's work, not an alternate source I suspect. It reflects human error and judgement rather than the handiwork of a sophisticated alien intelligence. For that matter, neither can we ascribe the complex nature of recorded pictograms to spontaneous and unobserved effects from meteorological phenomena on growing corn. A vortex of swirling air or plasma would surely dissipate rapidly long before permanent compression could ever be applied to crops in this manner.

If I seem to give the impression of discounting all crop circles as necessarily hoaxes I am sorry. But it is dear to me that much of what manifested in many southern fields last summer was surely so. Enthusiasts would be better employed in establishing the earthly method used to successfully create circles and pictograms, while many times leaving undamaged both the stalks and ears of corn. Now that is a real mystery! **GM**

Is Mastram Babu A Fakir Or Just Lying?

INDIAN HOLY MAN 27 YEARS ON THE SPOT

DEFYING SCORCHING SUN, rain and bitter cold, an old Hindu holy man has remained in the same spot - out in the open - for an incredible 27 years!

No one knows who he is. He never talks. One day he appeared in the village of Chitra in western India, parked himself on the ground near a roadside tea shop - and has not gotten up since. He wears a calm, distant expression regardless of the weather and locals call him *Mastram Babu* (Contented Father).

"At first, the people didn't know what to make of him," said Jairam Patel, an old-time resident and tea shop regular. "He didn't say a word, wouldn't get up and didn't seem to require any food.

"But soon we realized he was an

extraordinary person. He was so peaceful! We began to treat him with great respect. Now he is virtually an object of worship."

Hundreds of people, rich and poor from near and far, come every day to pay their respects to Mastram Babu. They sit with him silently and occasionally he will accept a little food and water.

"One time he didn't eat for days," said Dr. K. C. Das, anesthetist at a nearby hospital. "Medically I cannot explain such a man who ignores nature completely. I have seen him many times over the past 15 years. I have been there with him in the scorching summer sun, at night, during winter in severe cold.

"He just sits or lies in the same place not moving anywhere. No one has ever seen him move from there."

Incredibly, Mastram Babu has never even gotten up to relieve himself. He urinates and passes a slight discharge on the spot where he has been for 27 years - and amazingly, there's no odour, reveals Dr. Das.

Murjo's Famed Elixir Of Youthfulness




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IT WAS THREE miles long and the topic of conversation in the village of Hutton Bessay, North Yorkshire, shortly before New Year's Eve.

What baffled villagers when they awoke one morning was the enormous length of nylon line neatly laid out through their streets. The trail started half a mile away, on the lane leading into the tiny hamlet near Thirsk. The single length of nylon stretched into Hutton, winding its way around the narrow streets and ended another half a mile beyond.

Both the local army camp and North Yorkshire County Council have denied being responsible for the trail, according to *The Sunday Express* of 06.01.91.

This incident very likely has an earthly solution but there have been other instances where material likened to nylon fishing line had a decidedly aerial beginning.

During the 1970's, across the United States, there were a number of recorded events involving strange lines or wires that had been spotted simply hanging in the sky. One at Caldwell, New Jersey, in August, 1970, resulted in the lines eventually falling to earth in a huge pile; after remaining suspended for several weeks in spite of high winds and even storms.

In another case, four boys spent an hour hauling in a line that resembled nylon and which had partially dropped to earth during the night. It broke before they could pull the entire line in.

Again, in Greensburg, Ohio, during 1978, a man found a line snagged on a garden bush and started to drag it down. With his neighbour's assistance, the two eventually collected some 1000 feet of the material using fishing reels, before the line broke and it floated away.

Such material, when chemically analysed, has sometimes proven to be a type 6 Nylon (caprolactam), or possibly a copolymer type 6. But not one manufacturer could ever positively identify it as being their product. One sample examined had a fine hollow tube running through its length that gradually filled with a solid substance which also defied analysis.

VIBRATIONS, POWER SITES AND QUARTZ CRYSTALS

FIRST CONCEIVED in the human mind, the channel through which flows a minute proportion of the original vibrational word marking the beginning of the Universe, all material things -- from bricks to buildings, from highways to transport, from carpets to clothing, from runways to aircraft, from launching pads to satellites - have specific forms, lives and purposes.

However, these can be transmuted by application of certain exterior forces of intensified sound, light and heat, or by alien stimulation. Colour can also be an external agent to produce subtle reaction and change in the physical or chemical content of manufactured articles.

Yet nothing which is created is ever lost, as Nature amply demonstrates in simple illustrations of reproduction and rebirth; decayed leaves and scattered seedlings settling down eventually to the rhythm of fresh life born underground, changing form from the fallen to the gloriously risen to fulfill natural requirements.

Formation of new patterns, that emerge under the impact of outside influences equips a redeveloped form for renewed life and purpose on the industrial or domestic front. The same applies to natural things on a wider scale. For example, once energy is set in motion it cannot be destroyed.

It simply alters from one form to another when external forces are introduced in close proximity or when it is diverted from its original objectives. Everything is capable of radical or moderate change under fluctuating conditions and circumstances -- even that most precious of Cosmic commodities, *human life*.

It applies too, to a radioactive mineral that slowly breaks down and gives off harmful radiations in the process, although this comes into a different category. These lessons and many more, are being learned by pioneers in modern fields of scientific study and research. Which brings us a step nearer the puzzling heart of the UFO mystery, indirectly.

For there is a theory relating to Stone Age monuments which could quite feasibly fit in with important aspects of spacecraft propulsion, especially in connection with boosting drives obviously needed by celestial chariots after actual landings on Earth.

Solar ray storage or electromagnetic energy harnessing may be dissipated by earthing principles when landings are effected. From our experiences of extraterrestrial airships at Cradle Hill, Warminster, we have noticed that hovering spacecraft rarely touch the ground, instead tilting oddly from side to side several feet above soil or treetop level.

This indicates the desire of the occupants to avoid disconnection from power supplies once touchdown is achieved. Yet a craft landing near Stonehenge blacked out entirely on an autumn night of 1968, before becoming a ring of fire that evidently shot out from the stone

themselves, whereupon the UFO fled upward from our curious approach.

It is more than ever probable that these craft operate on a minor system comparable to that of a planet; generating their own electromagnetic-gravitational fields and working on an imbalance basis. At rest they do not rotate but they rotate or spin under a controlled fashion with a central liquid core, so as to generate their fields and thus move naturally within the magnetic fields of Earth and space generally.

It appears that evidence collected over eighteen years might alter present thinking on these mute and mysterious mounds and circles of stones, for it is now strongly suspected that they comprise a gigantic network of power potential when tapped at the right vibratory pitch.

All such monuments in Britain may be aligned in a single geometrical pattern. This is the belief of John Williams, a solicitor living at Abergavenny, in Monmouthshire, Wales, who has carefully compared the positions of more than 3,000 prehistoric stone circles and single standing stones on ordinance survey maps.

He submits that every one is aligned to its neighbours up to twenty miles away at an angle of twentythree-and-a-half degrees. Over the years since 1951, he has taken thousands of photographs of standing stones and thinks he has discovered a significant clue to their use at various stages in the history of Man.

A surprising number of photographs he took suffered from what seemed to be unfortunate fogging, marring negatives and prints. He thought nothing more of this

filming setback for years, putting it down to bad camera work. But in 1959 a friend and he photographed the same timeworn batch of ancient stones near Brecon.

Both operated similar type cameras and film and the dismissed setback of 1951 was recalled. The developments were rather startling in effect. Both pictures came out with a fogged band across them in identical sections of stone. The pictures were taken in colour and the fog-band was a distinctive dark blue.

Something in the composition or nature of the stone, some hidden quality, was spoiling the film. It was a kind of ultra-violet light. Since then, a friend told me, John has experienced more examples of the same peculiar phenomenon when employing colour film; although cameras used are free of faults.

Patently, he sought to establish the cause - and ascertained after exhaustive investigation, that all these prehistoric standing stones contain dark quartz; some being heavily impregnated. This is a crystal substance similar to that used in conjunction with the old-fashioned cat's whisker in early types of radio receiver.

John reasonably deduced that the stones therefore form a giant network, although admitting, he cannot guess for what purpose. He is not a Ufologist. Yet his research efforts offer clues to those who investigate this fascinating subject.

AMONG THE APPARENTLY multitudinous abilities that UFO's exhibit, that of instant appearance and disappearance are two of the more interesting. We know, of course, that only two things will deflect light from its original course - an interface of refractive index, (for example a lens) and gravitation. Basically though they are the same, as each works on the principle of vector displacement between two systems.

I avoid Einstein's gravitational theory here, which considers the space surface as a manifold within access dimensionality, for this would imply ideas not perhaps of current popular agreement. For it is true, that while man makes his way to the stars, he is still living on a flat world. The theory becomes quite practical once artificial gravity is produced.

A puzzling aspect is the topology of a field which, just like a lens, would be capable of deflecting light in narrow channels around the sides of perhaps a spacecraft and successfully deflecting them back on their original course. Such a field, I believe, would only succeed in diffusing the edge of a craft - thus making it more difficult to spot against a hazy cloud formation for example. Perhaps this is all that would be considered necessary, for it becomes practically impossible to determine the structure of an object if a screening device were employed during turbulent atmospheric conditions.

However, airborne observers on encountering a craft using this principle would get a very different view. Perhaps one similar to that of a Russian flag navigator of the Polar Aviation Service (1), who in 1956, having pierced the clouds over Greenland one day, suddenly spotted a strange flying vehicle. It resembled a "big pearl coloured lens with wavy, pulsating edges." After about 15 minutes of aerial tag, the crew of the Russian aircraft suddenly changed course and headed directly for the object. It responded by climbing sharply and melted out of sight into the blue sky above them.



The fact does remain though, that the forces necessary to deflect light are more than considerable. Indeed, the whole gravitational force of our own Sun can only deflect the light of a star by a fraction of a degree. An

intelligence capable of producing artificially a compact system enabling a craft to operate a light-wave manipulative field, far greater than that achieved by our own sun, could also use the same g-force as a power unit.

For gravitational force is not just an attraction between bodies, but a continuum in itself. It is a vector displacement between the systems fixed to the bodies and, as such, would still be operative if the bodies were removed. Even as the systems themselves would be displaced - though they are not referred to. In theory then, we could construct an infinity of systems.

I think, perhaps, that the most effective type of field any intelligence would employ is a negative and positive g-force 'sandwich' as shown by the accompanying diagrams: D 1 and D 2. This has the effect of replacing much of the original light-waves, except for the edges of a disc-shaped craft. A UFO using this principle would therefore be quite invisible but for an inevitable 'fuzzy' edge of the field itself. Perhaps in our scrutiny of the sky, we should concentrate a little more on peculiar cloud formations!

Suffering From Wind

WHEN A COLD high meets a warm low, look out! What can often happen is that the resultant whirling column of air created ends up spinning so fast, it suddenly becomes a tornado.

These winds are relatively uncommon in the United Kingdom, but that didn't stop 58 tornadoes being reported in a single day, as they swept Britain from the Isle of Anglesey to the east coast, on Nov.23, 1981. The strongest recorded tornado in this country was at Southsea, Portsmouth, back in December 1810. It measured force 8 on the Meaden-TORRO scale.

The power they possess is staggering. In 1986, 12 Chinese schoolchildren were whipped up into the air by a tornado and then miraculously dumped unhurt on sand dunes, some 12 miles away. In 1880, a whole house was sucked up by a spiral of spinning winds that crossed Missouri, USA, and it too was carried for 12 miles.

Quite the worst catastrophe occurred in April, 1989, when a tornado swept over Bangladesh killing nearly 1300 people.

What's The Difference?

COMPUTER DESIGNER Charles Babbage ran out of funds so was unable to finish his project. The Science Museum has subsequently stepped in to complete it, only because Babbage originally designed the computer in 1830!

The reconstruction of the inventor's *Difference Engine* is nearing completion and the Museum is spending thousands of pounds on the computer to see if it would have worked.

A special exhibition celebrating Babbage's 200th birthday will take place in London and run from July 1st until January 1992.

who will claim to defend Poland and Hungary. And whose fate will never be certain." He named him "Hister".



A CAT; A SAUCER AND BOTH MISSED BY A WHISKER



EDITED REPORT FROM MY SOUTH AMERICAN FILES

IT WAS exactly 11.45 a.m. on May 17, 1968, when I was returning from a trip to the Chaco and covering the section of road between Otumpano and Cedralao. I was driving at about 75kph (roughly 47mph) when, in the neighbourhood of Kilometer 1020 of the route I saw a wildcat cross the road and stop on the grass verge on my left. Seeing the animal so tranquil I immediately visualized the possibility of shooting it. So I picked up my gun which I always carry between the front seats and took my foot off the accelerator.

When I was about 60 to 70 metres from the cat it reacted with a sudden violence and disappeared into the woods with a jump. Almost simultaneously I felt a strange sensation in my body, which was more intense in the arm that was carrying the gun and I dropped it.

Although very surprised by the way the cat had fled and also at the strange sensation I felt in my body, rather like an electric shock, I instinctively pressed my foot to the accelerator again. As I did so, I noted an apparent lack of response from the engine and tried pumping my foot on the pedal. At the same time, checking the instrument panel and glancing in the mirror at the road behind me.

Apart from a cloud of dust rising from the car there was an apparent slight increase in luminosity of the air which lasted a moment and this, added to the other extraordinary things, began really to intrigue me. I tried to start a summary of what had happened on the way, my eyes fixed on the road ahead and the engine running normally again. Then I happened to see, half covered by the windscreen shield, something even more extraordinary - a flying saucer.

I immediately took my foot from the accelerator again while, at the same time, trying not to block my view of the object with the car shield. Hardly worrying about keeping the car straight, I took in as much detail as I could. The object seemed a good size, perhaps something like 15 to 20 metres in diameter and was visible in a clear blue sky. Because the weather was

so good, it meant I had no reference points on which to base the object's size and distance. It threw no shadow on the ground and seemed to have been about 190 to 200 metres away from me.

Its shape was like that of a meat plate covered by an inverted soup bowl and minus any projecting parts. It possessed a very smooth surface of a semi-brilliant metallic grey colour, with a sort of darker grey band circling it about one metre in width.

In an instant it was gone and I had been so absorbed in contemplating it, it was only later I realized that I was smiling. On the one hand, the fact that the apparatus had gone leaving everything in peace - and on the other, the sensation of complicity with the fantastic legend of the flying saucer. This stirred facetious thoughts in my mind. It was like having a fish of 30 kilos at the end of your line. Many people simply would not believe me!

British explorer launches Congo expedition to prove existence of 30ft saurapod, nicknamed *Makale-Mbembe* by local pygmies. Sightings date back to 18th century.

UNDETERRED BY AN earlier attempt that failed, Dorset man Bill Gibbons is hoping to raise about £8,000 to finance an expedition to the borders of the northern Congo and neighbouring Central African Republic, seeking a

dinosaur-like creature thought extinct millions of years ago.

Tribemen who inhabit the remote swampland have nicknamed the 30ft saurapod *Makale-Mbembe*, or "One who stems rivers", and reports of its existence were first recorded by French missionaries during the 18th century. The creature is said to have a long neck and tail, with feet almost 12 inches across. It is believed to live off leaves and fruit.

There have been other expeditions, including those of American, Japanese and Dutch teams, but nothing apart from a few footprints has ever been recovered. Bill Gibbons' attempt will involve only two or three people and will be conducted with the guidance of Prof Bernard Heuvelmans, president of the International Society of Cryptozoology.

A Fresh Sight On Oregon

"IT'S LIKE FINDING the Holy Grail," declared University of Oregon professor William Orr, at the discovery by one of his students of a fossilized shastasaurus skull.

The find was made during a class outing to the state's Willowa Mountains and, in particular, an area that had recently been blasted for a road project.

Estimated to be some 220-million-years-old, the fossil proves that Oregon was once connected to China, according to Orr. He adds that the Pacific Northwest was an area that had broken away from the Chinese mainland and drifted toward North America millions of years ago.

FLIGHT OF FANCY

FORGET HANS CHRISTIAN, one R. Anderson came up with his own fairytale when he claimed, in a letter to *Cassell's Saturday Journal* of January 4, 1893, to have achieved the first man-powered flight while stranded in Zanzibar some six years previous.

Anderson found himself up a creek with only bamboo and grasses, when his hoped for meeting with Stanley went awry. With native help he fashioned some long bamboos and giant leaves into a kind of platform and on two sides of it he added a fan-shaped wing, extending from the centre about 30ft.

He made each wing by running out bamboos and then stretching broad leaves across them. He even added paddles (I) to steer the contraption and the conscripted Africans were made to gallop off towing Anderson and his machine.

"Immediately I soared," he wrote and jerking the rope from their hands began paddling furiously, adding that he "remained in the air all night." The very next day the wind fell and his machine eventually came into contact with some trees and began to break up.

"In 18 hours I had travelled upon the air some 100 miles," Anderson recorded and ended firmly: "No, it's no use saying that flying can't be done, because I've done it."

Wise Men Followed White Dwarf's Nova

AN ASTRONOMICAL EVENT two thousand years ago, as recorded in St. Matthew, Chapter II, of The Bible, never has been substantiated in Western records. The star of Bethlehem, that sudden phenomenon of the skies, is one heavenly happening with scant reference even among astronomers of the Middle East.

But ancient Chinese and Korean astronomical records of the period give several tantalizing hints of a 'something' sighted around that period. In the *Astronomical Treatise of the History of the Former Han Dynasty (the Ch'ien-han-shu)*, investigators have found this entry: 'Second year of the Ch'ien-p'ing reign period, second month, a hui-hsing appeared at Ch'ien-niu for over 70 days.'

Due to the fact that it was stationary it cannot have been a comet and for the period for which it was observed would be typical of a nova - a so-called new star that is in fact a runaway thermonuclear explosion on the surface of a white dwarf in a binary system.

A SOLAR TEMPLE which predates Stonehenge has been uncovered near Godmanchester, Cambs, and is more elaborate than any found so far in Europe, reported *The Daily Telegraph* on 18.02.91.

Archaeologists say the 2900 BC neolithic site was once comprised of an arrangement of vertical wooden posts and obelisks that were aligned to both solar and lunar cycles.

IT IS A mystery but a fact that - precisely every 12 sideral hours the Earth throbs with something akin to a heartbeat. This 'pulse' occurs once every 11 hours, 57 minutes and 57.3 seconds, according to physicists at the University of Rome.

Experiments began in 1983 and involved setting up a complex piece of apparatus designed to detect gravity. Giant blocks of solid aluminium were balanced so delicately that scientists are able to monitor any unusual vibration in the component electrons. One block is in Italy and another was set up in the same fashion in Geneva, Switzerland. The latter block, some 600 kilometres away, guards against the possibility of local error and the theory is, that anything recorded simultaneously in both blocks is likely to be due to more distant and more basic causes.

While the experiment itself has so far failed to produce any evidence of the hypothetical gravity waves, the enormous two-pronged aluminium antenna has recorded the beat. This is set relative to the Earth's movement through the galaxy and not about its own axis. Perhaps its cause is connected with lunar and solar tides but strangely effect can be felt more strongly in Rome than in Geneva.

HE GOT IT TOGETHER

YOU REMEMBER THE Six Million Dollar Man, of course? Well he had a 19th century counterpart in London and astounded public and press alike during his rambles around the capital.

Formerly employed supplying coal to a steam engine, the unfortunate man was horribly injured when it exploded one day. In 1847 a skilled London surgeon set about the awesome task of reconstructing his severely disabled and badly disfigured patient.

The man was given a glass eye, wore spectacles and a wig. A missing arm was supplanted by one made of wood, as were both his legs. He had a nose fastened to the skin of his forehead and his lower jaw was made from silver, capped by a set of artificial teeth. Part of his skull was of caduchobie as was his palate, both ears and a large portion of his abdomen.



Always On Time

IN CHEMISTRY no two substances can unite without observing definite mathematical laws. All whole tones in music are multiples of eleven, in vibrations per second. Who can fail to be struck with awe at the accurate timetable of the universe, the stupendous speeds of the planets, all travelling on their appointed course like a huge railroad system, yet none colliding, but so accurate is their timetable that their relative positions can be set down for any future date.

Does the earth revolve by mere chance? The surface speed is approximately 1,100 miles an hour. If it dropped to, say 100, we would be roasted in a 240 hour day, and what life survived would be frozen in the similarly long night.

The earth is tilted at 23°. If it were not so we would have no seasons.

Science tells us that if the crust of the earth was but a few feet thicker there would be no oxygen and hence no life could exist. Likewise, if the sun were much closer we would roast, if much further away we would freeze. If the moon were any nearer the tides would sweep practically all but the mountains. If the air had been much thinner many disasters would overwhelm us. Yet the fact is we find thousands of laws combining to make life on earth possible.




MR. LONG'S COLUMN

A CLOSE ENCOUNTER took place January 17, as an iron asteroid came within 106,000 miles of Earth. Although a mere 30ft wide, if it had struck the planet astronomers reckon the impact would have been "like a very large bomb," making a crater some 300ft wide and 100ft deep.

SMELL THE AROMA - Having explored some 44 per cent of the planet, the Magellan probe has revealed that Venus's atmosphere was formed about the same time as Earth's.

Composed of sulphur and carbon dioxide, the Venusian atmosphere also creates high winds and its surface shows evidence of spidery lava flows.



FORT'S AERIAL CANNON SPIKED ?

That our world is a busier and therefore noisier place than a century ago is recognised by all of us. What, therefore, has happened to the 'Barical guns', the 'Mistpoetters' and the 'Brantick', reported so frequently in Victorian times especially?

I refer, of course, to the oftentimes reports of booms, much like distant artillery or thunder, which have always mystified people in many parts of the world, although no satisfactory explanation has accounted for them. Charles Fort gathered numerous reported cases that appeared in his chronicles of the unexplained.

From time to time one hears of such incidents still, although they remain relatively uncommon these days and are often dismissed as supersonic booms from unseen aircraft.

I well remember such occurrences fairly shaking the houses and windows in the West Country during 1976 and 1977 and on more than one occasion my own home in Bristol resounded to what seemed like a seismic thumping. In

contd. spite of inquiries and investigations carried out by Bristol University, the police and a local Royal Naval Air Station, neither quarrying activities nor aircraft could be held accountable. The supersonic Concorde of both Britain and France, whose flight paths take them regularly across this part of the world, were absolved of causing the booms.

So, can anyone bring us up-to-date on this age-old mystery, or does it cease to exist as one?
